CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – May 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 9,406 in April to 9,686 in May.
- **Releases increased** from 9,076 in April to 9,718 in May.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 8,134 in April to 8,373 in May.
- The **Pretrial ADP increased** from 6,091 in April to 6,356 in May.
- The **Sentenced ADP decreased** from 1,791 in April to 1,769 in May.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 188 in April to 181 in May.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 25.5 in April to 26.1 in May.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial increased** from 6.7 in April to 8.4 in May.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced increased** slightly from 22.5 in April to 22.6 in May.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds decreased** from 66.9 in April to 68.2 in May.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings decreased** from 2,841 in April to 2,790 in May.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 3,077 in April to 2,731 in May.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 98%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,406 in April to 11,449 in May.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,650 in April to 1,733 in May.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 898 in April to 756 in May.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 63 in April to 47 in May.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.7%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 600 in April to 626 in May.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,071 in April to 3,475 in May.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,771 in April to 10,771 in May.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 4,526 in April to 5,141 in May.
- **Total Filings increased** from 25,334 in April to 27,994 in May.

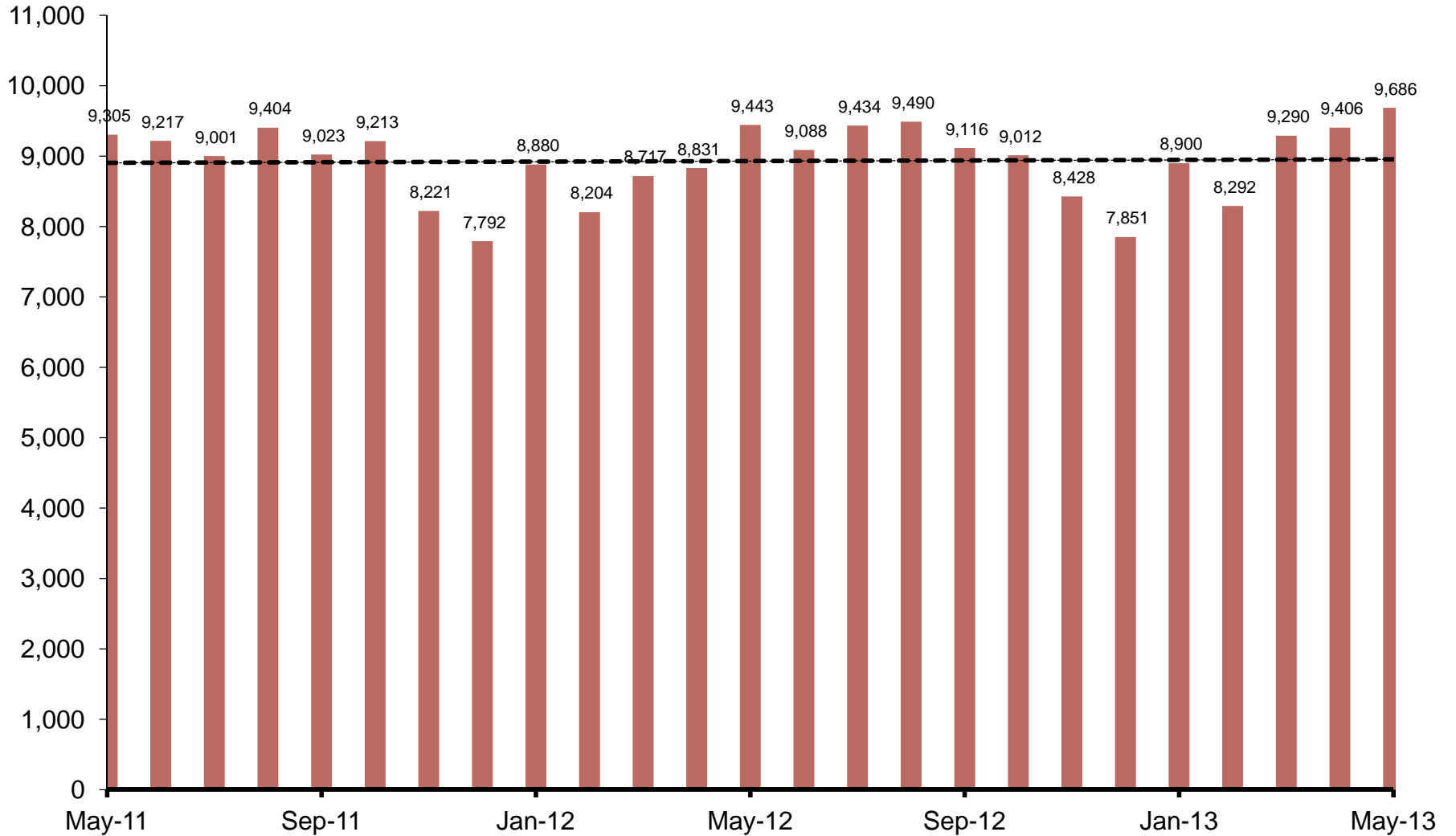
Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 1,639 in April to 1,608 in May.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased slightly** from 440 in April to 441 in May.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,443 in April to 21,438 in May.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 746 in April to 771 in May.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 6,939 in April to 6,912 in May.

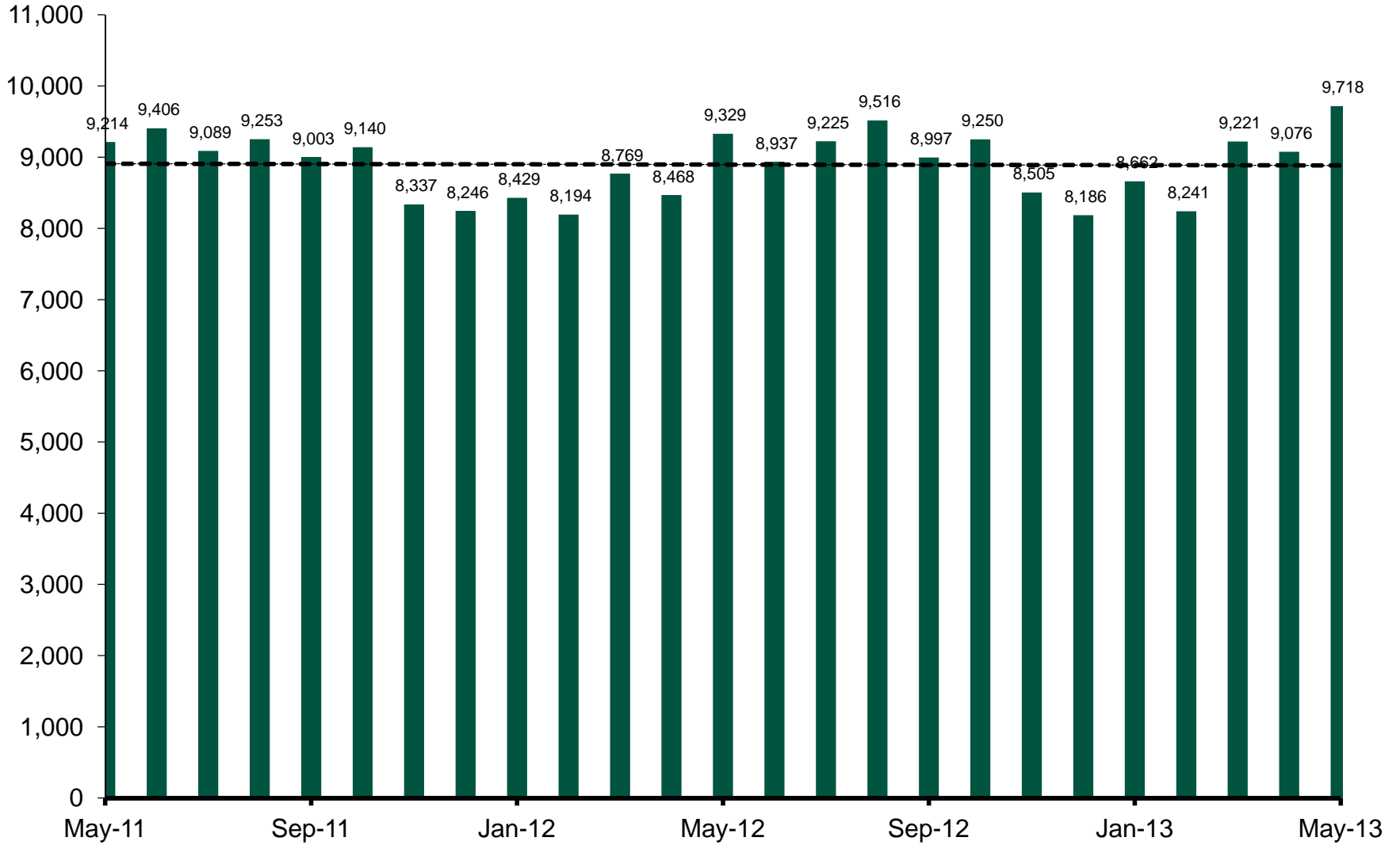
Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 209 in April to 224 in May.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 14.2 in April to 14.7 in May.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation decreased** from 2,401 in April to 2,349 in May.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 264 in April to 257 in May.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections decreased** from 32 in April to 30 in May.

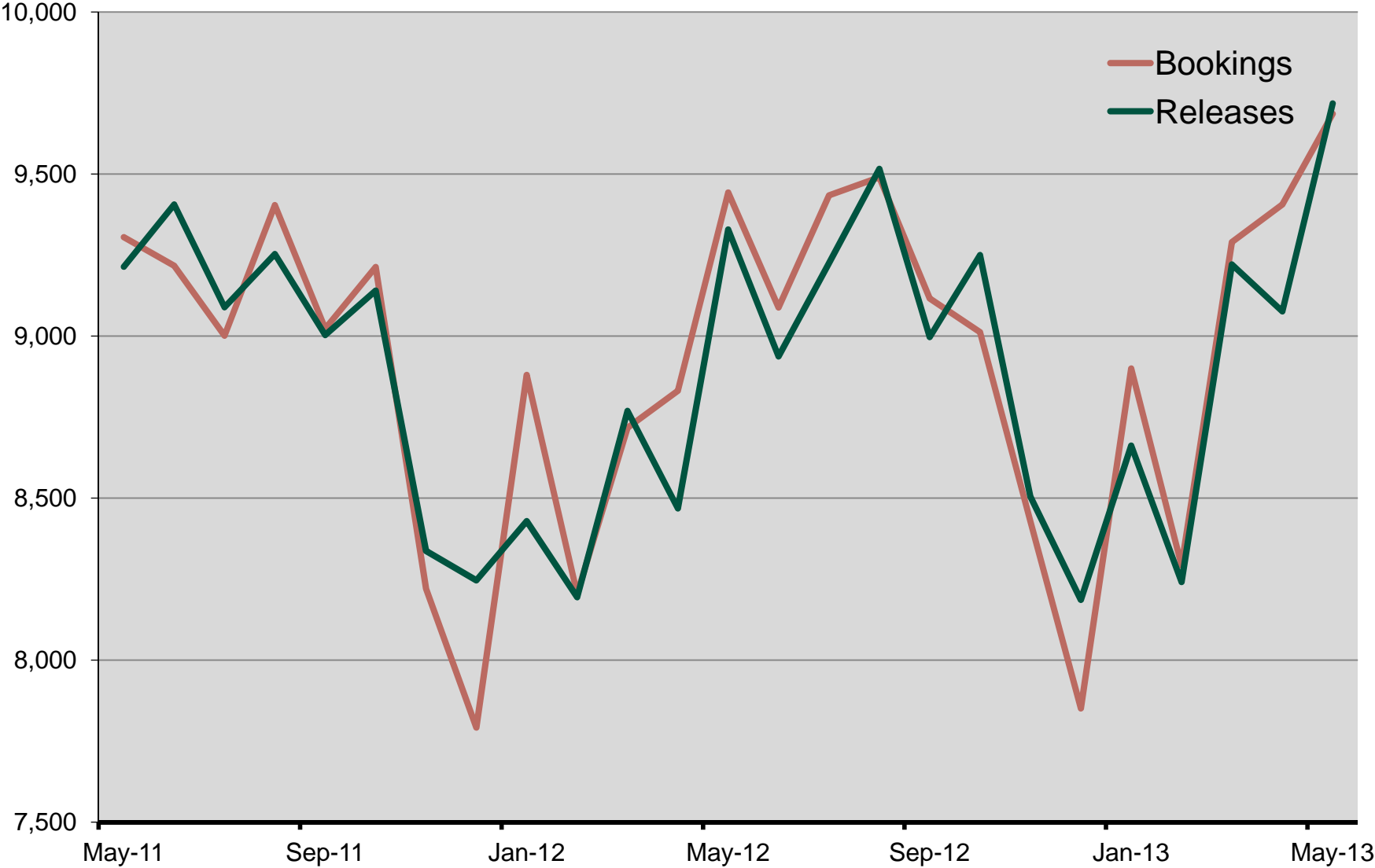
Jail Bookings



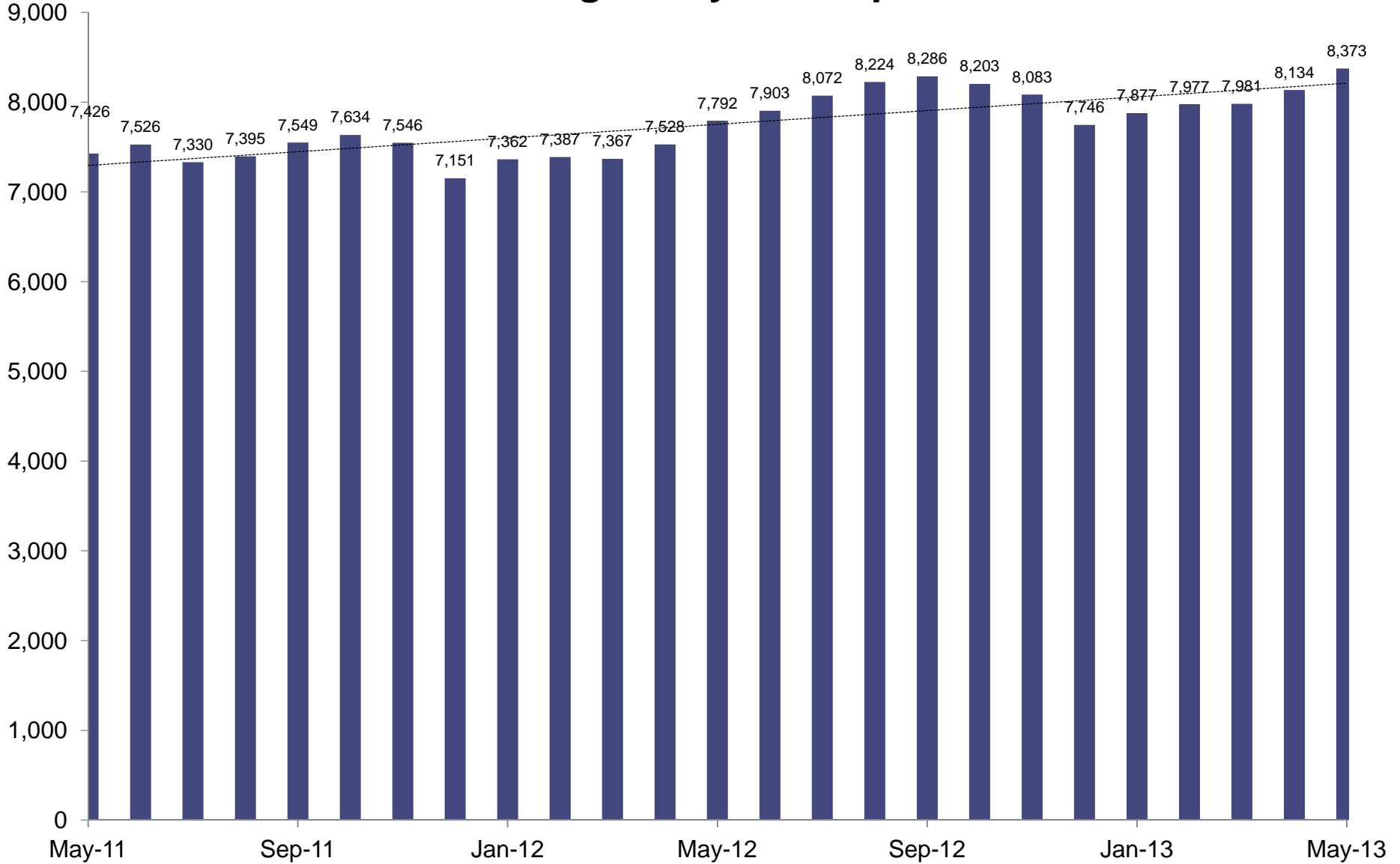
Jail Releases



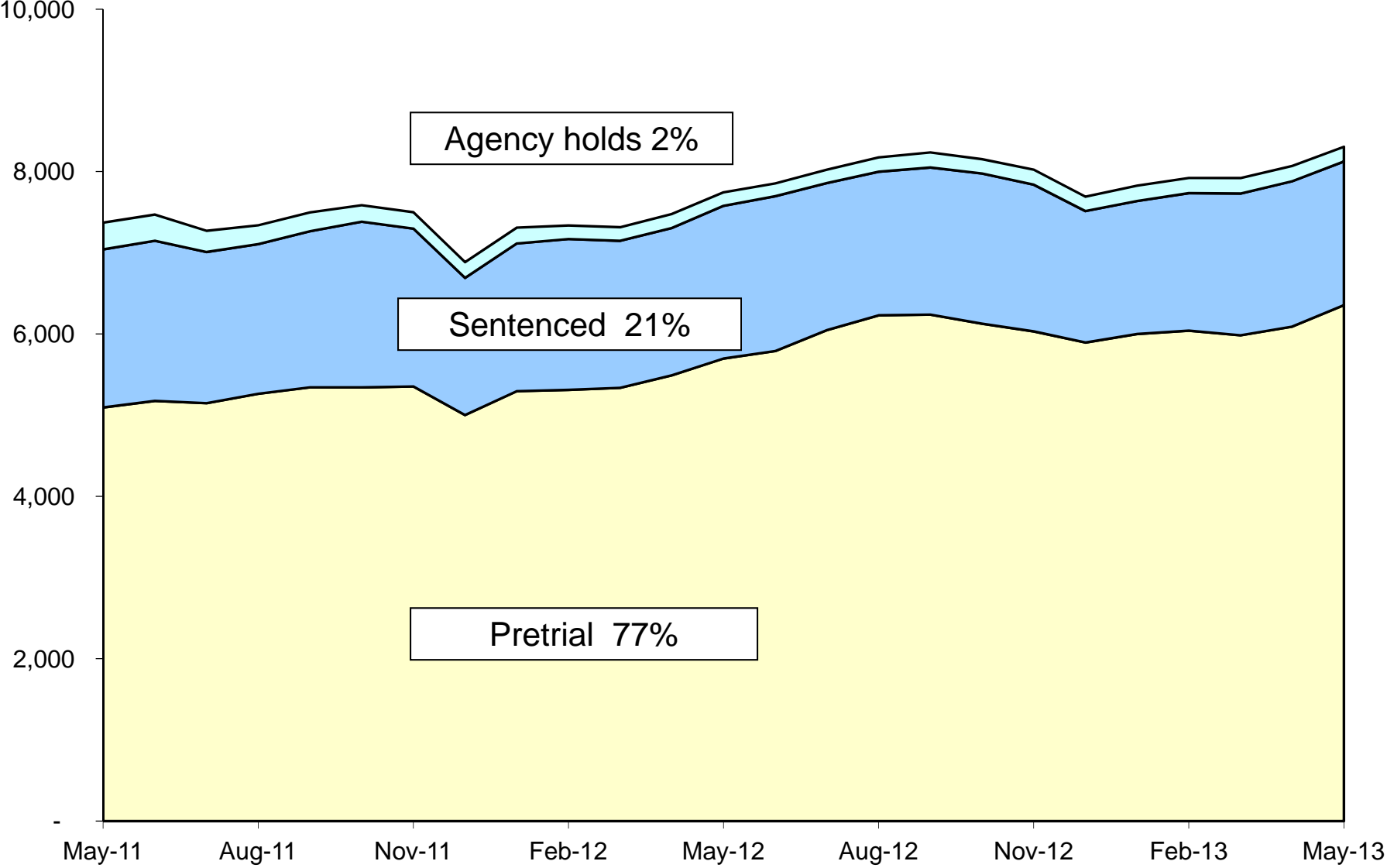
Jail Bookings and Releases



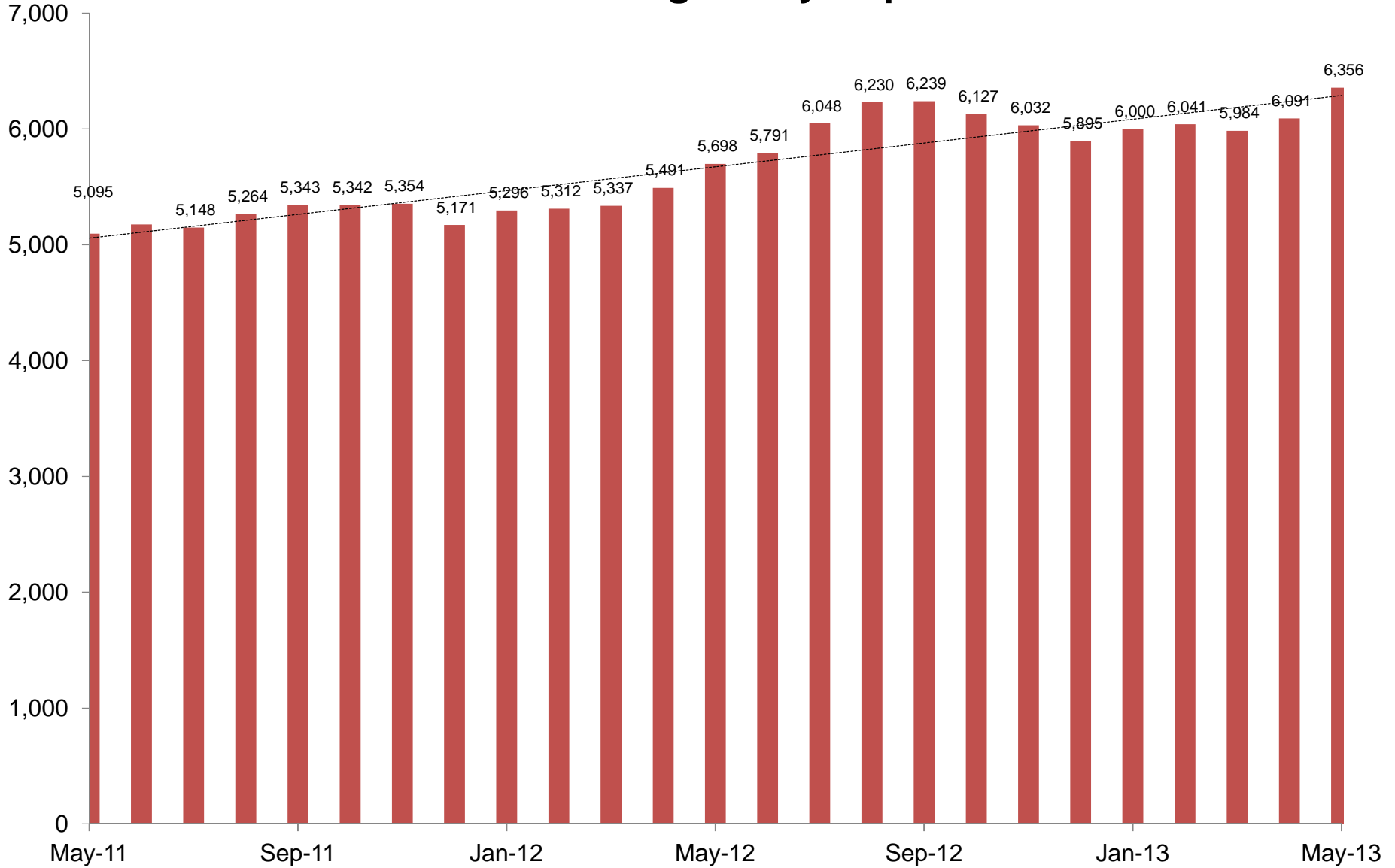
Average Daily Jail Population



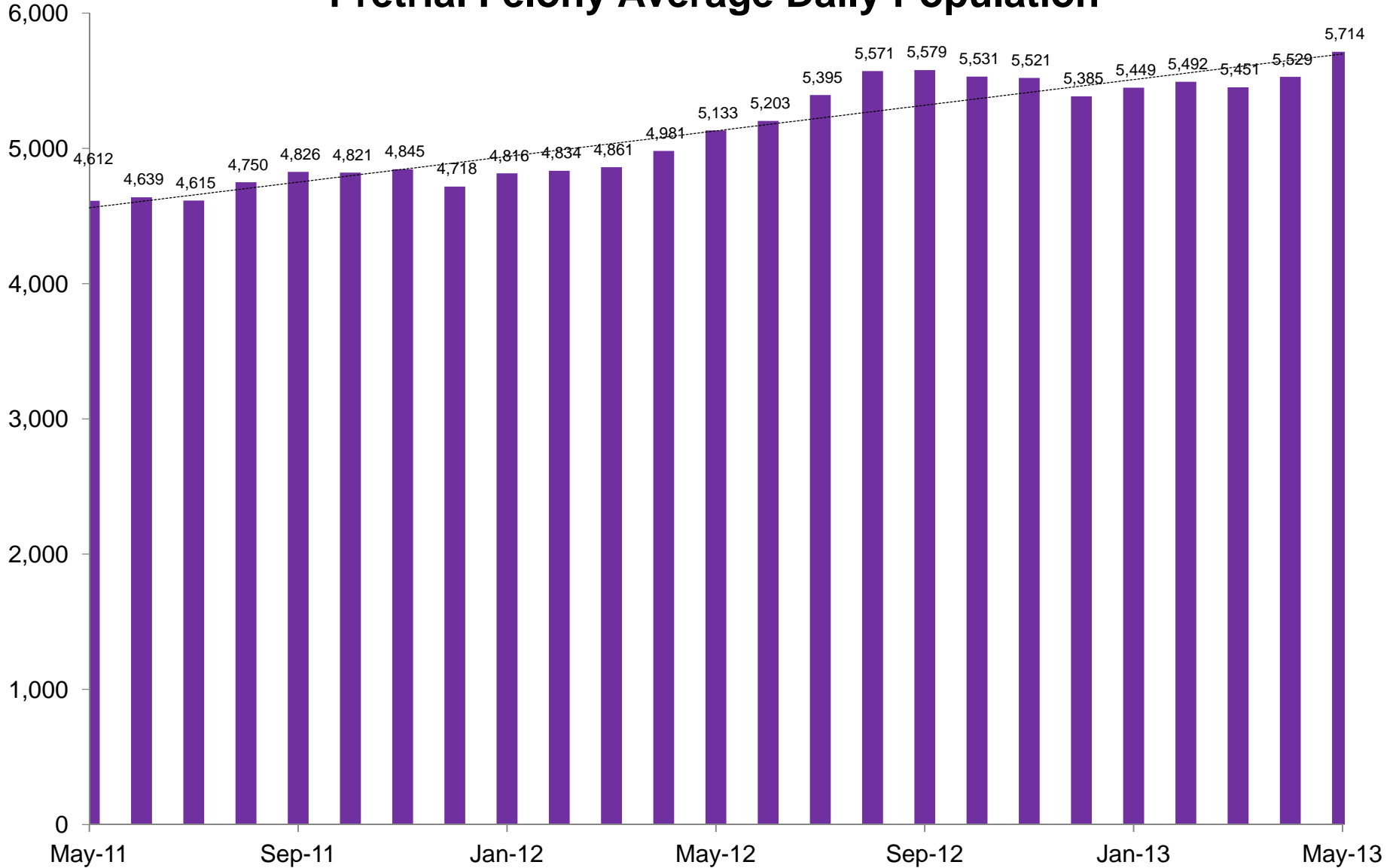
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



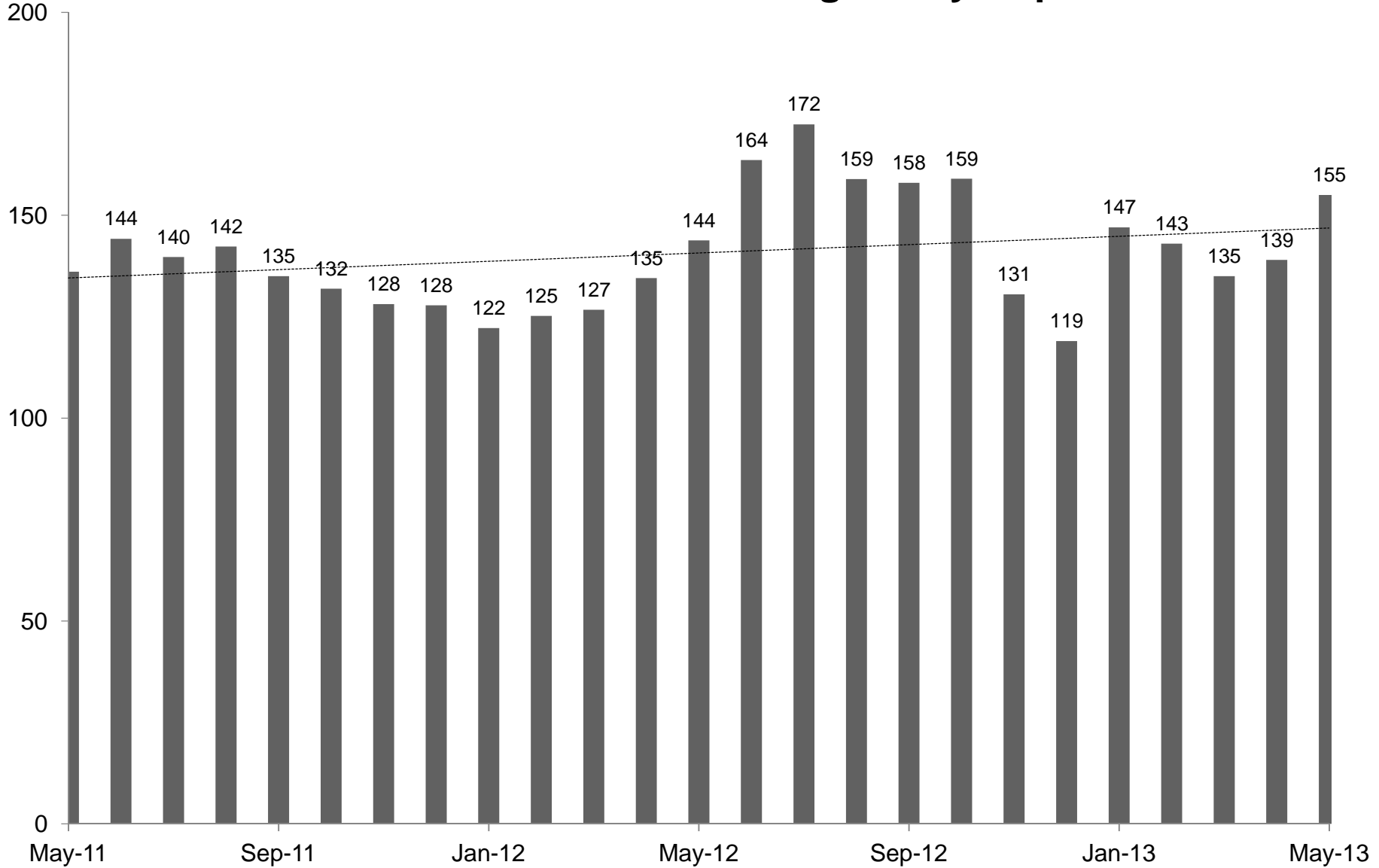
Pretrial Average Daily Population



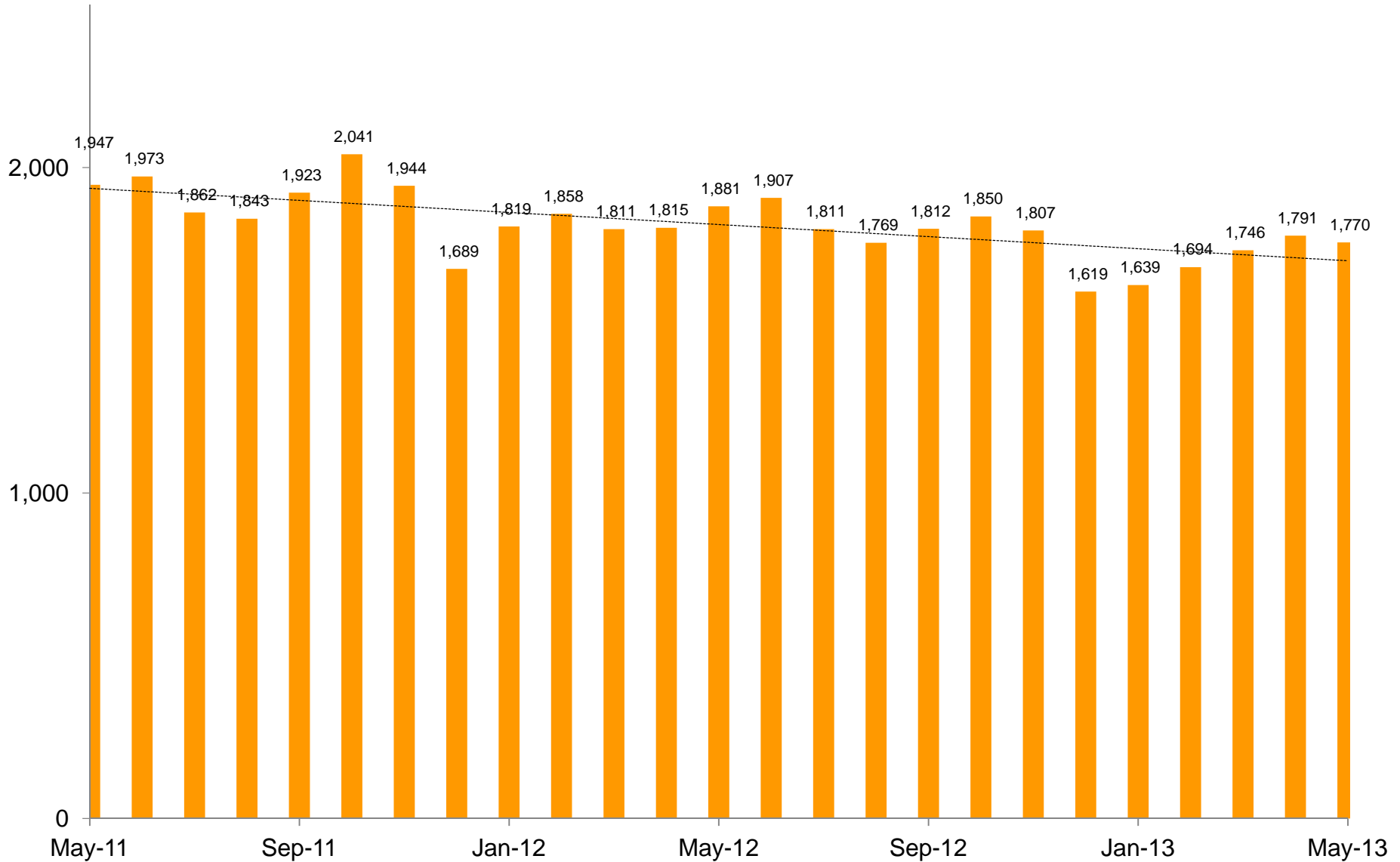
Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population



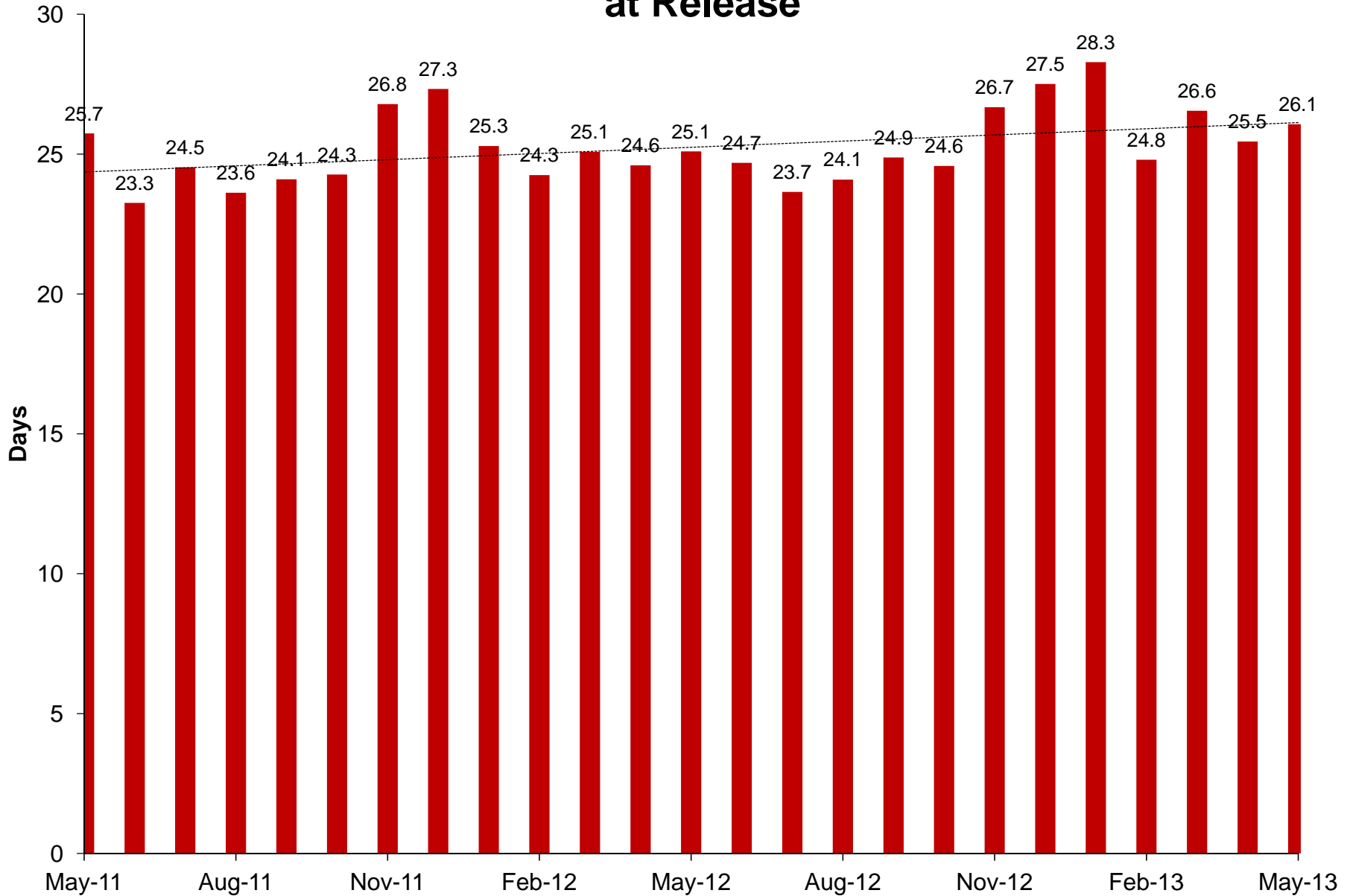
Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population



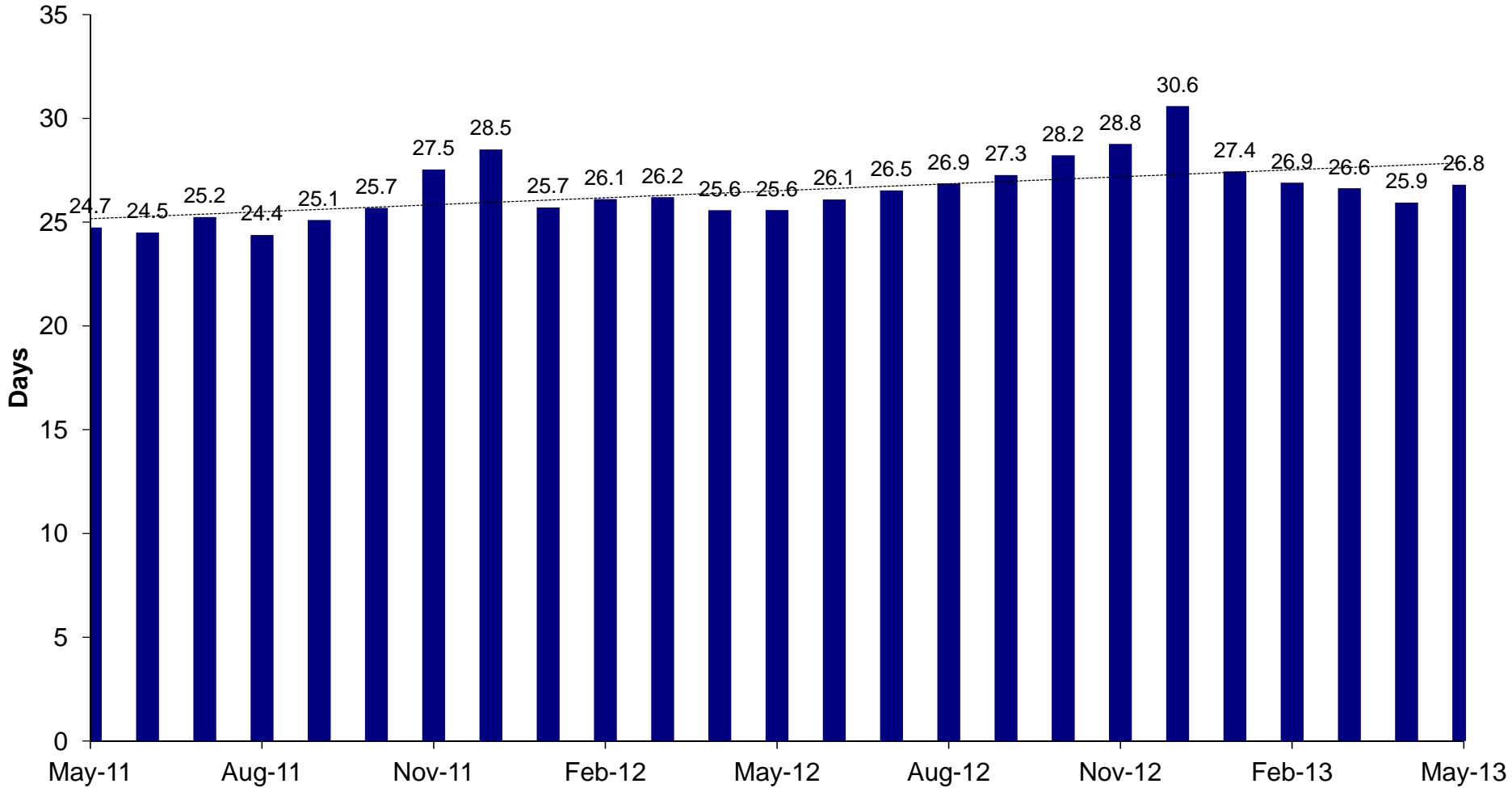
Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release

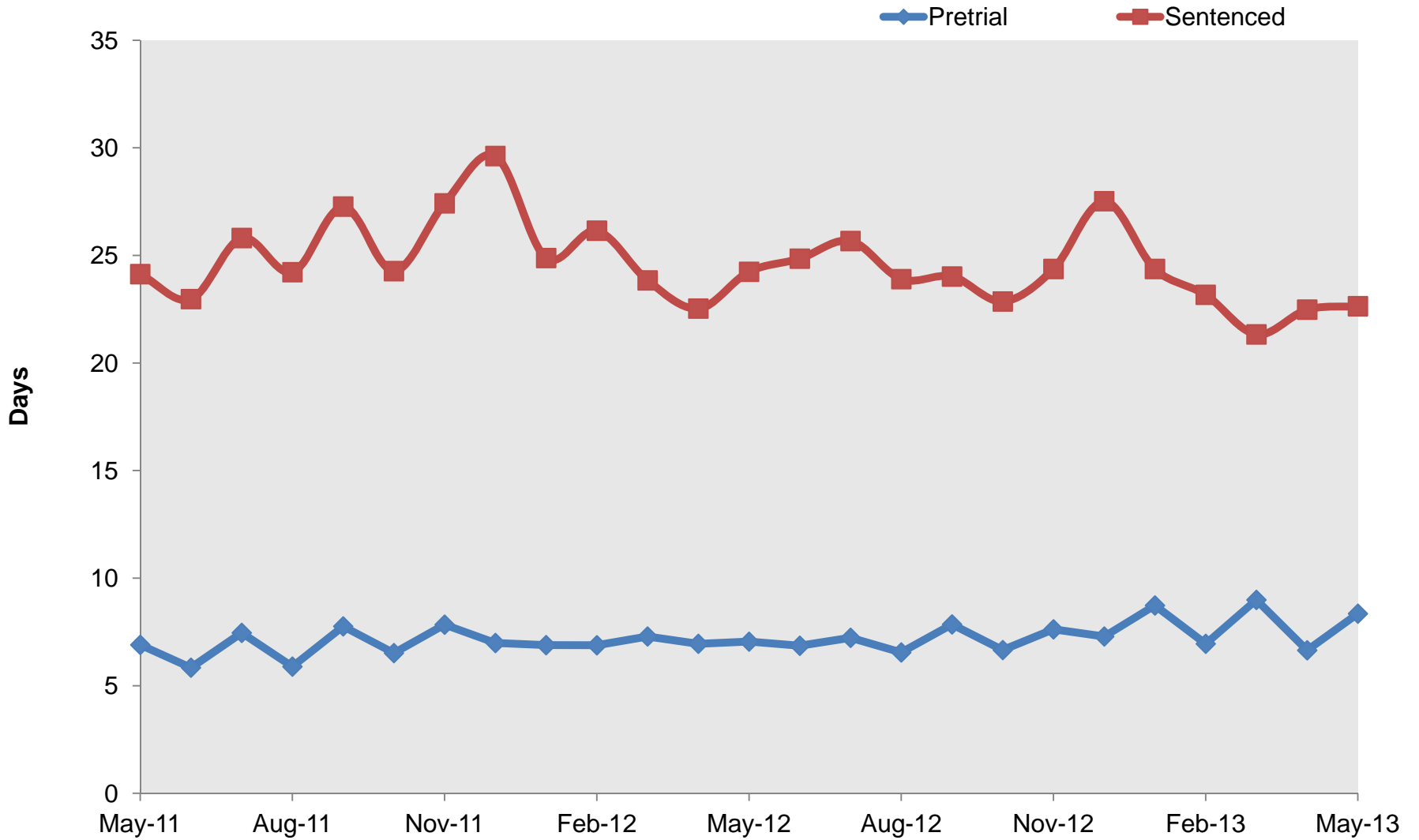


Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

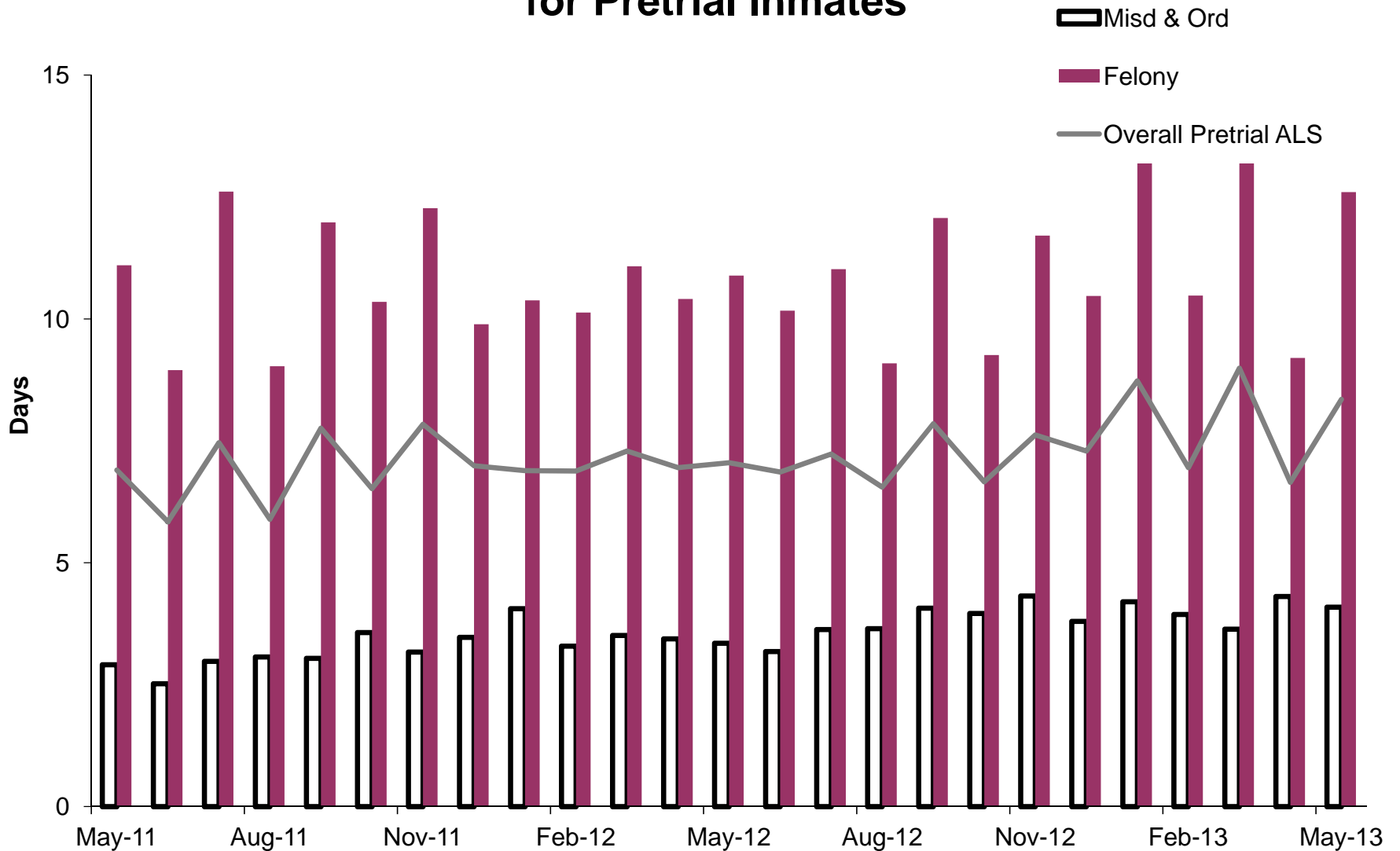

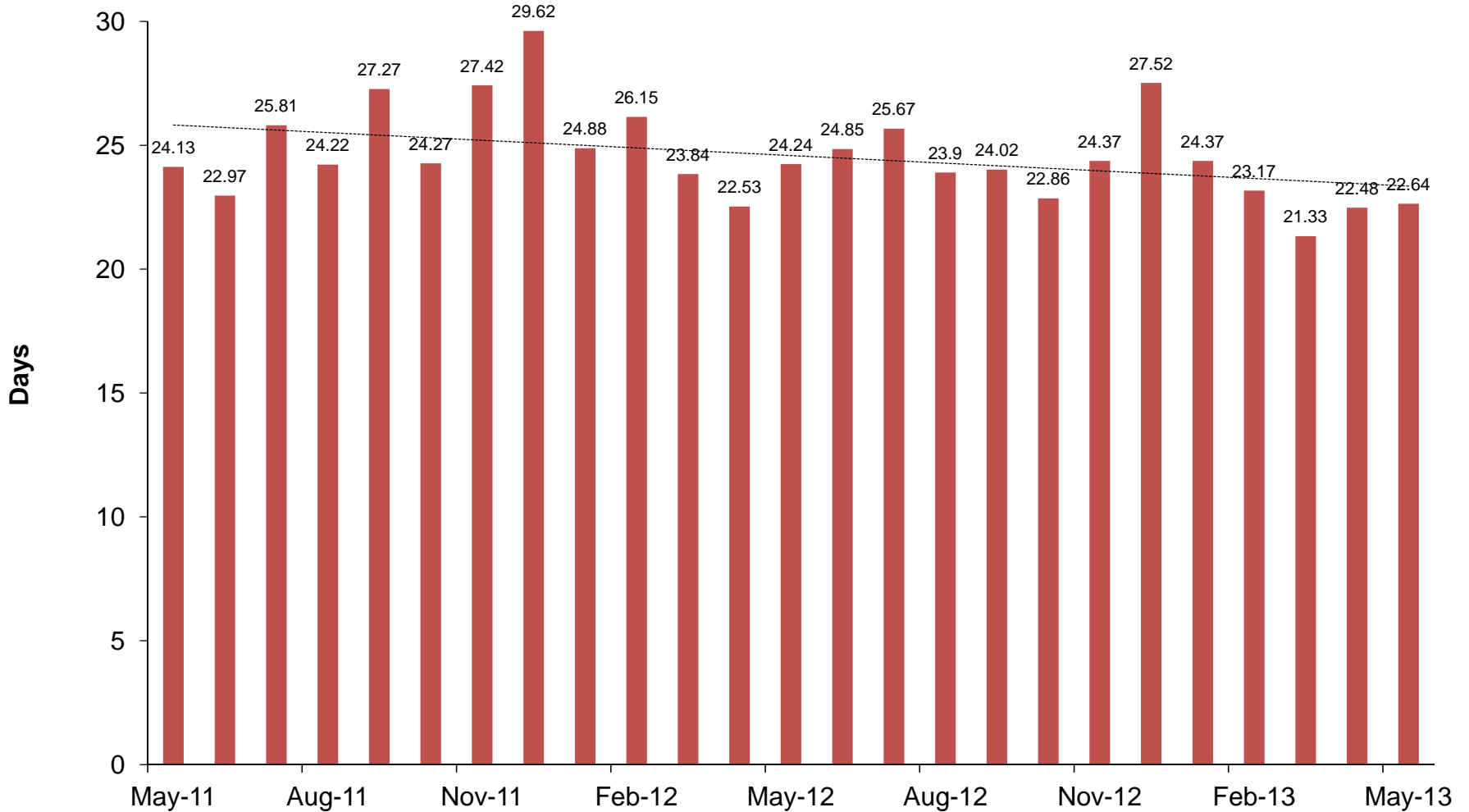
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates



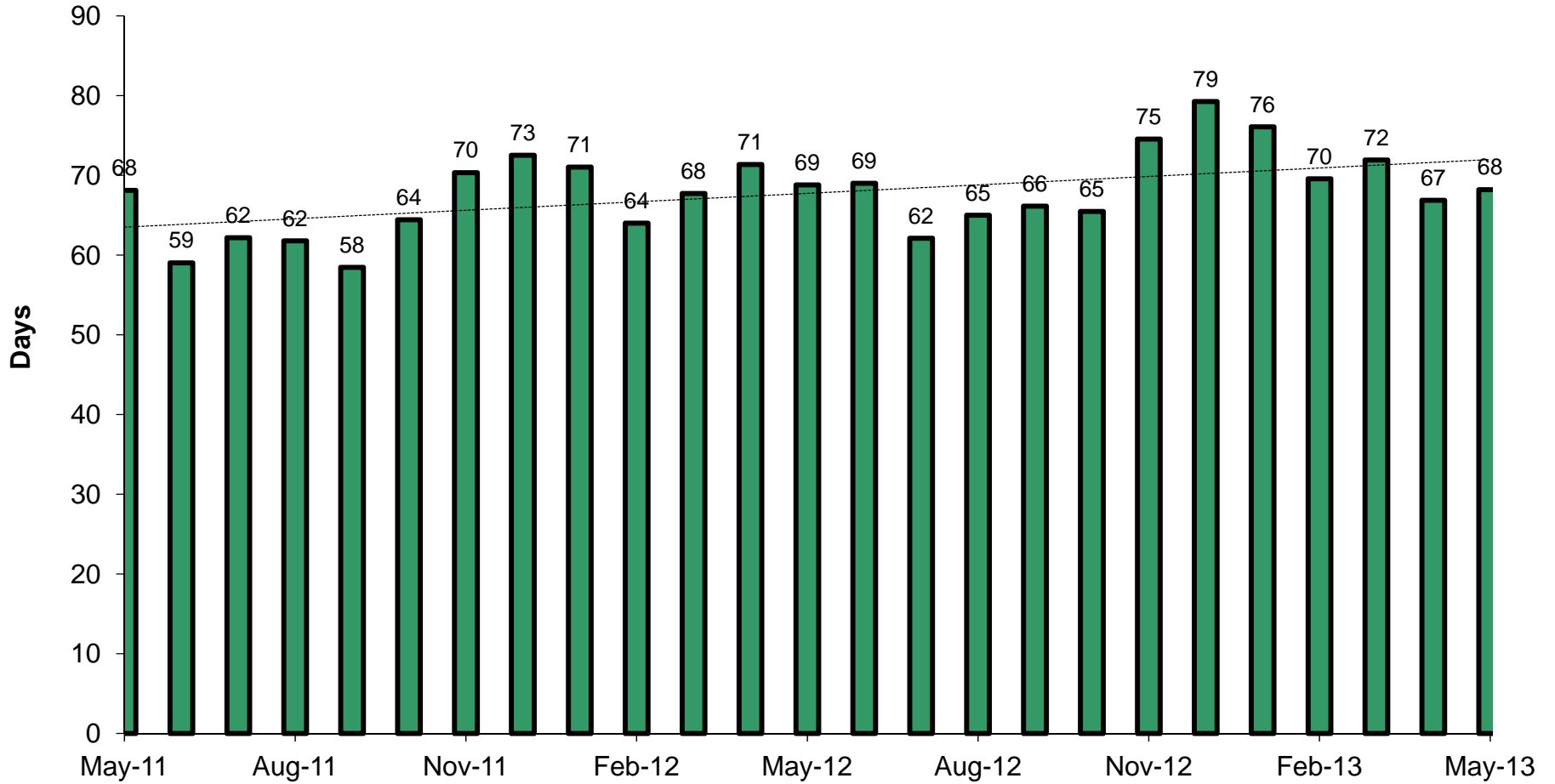
Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates

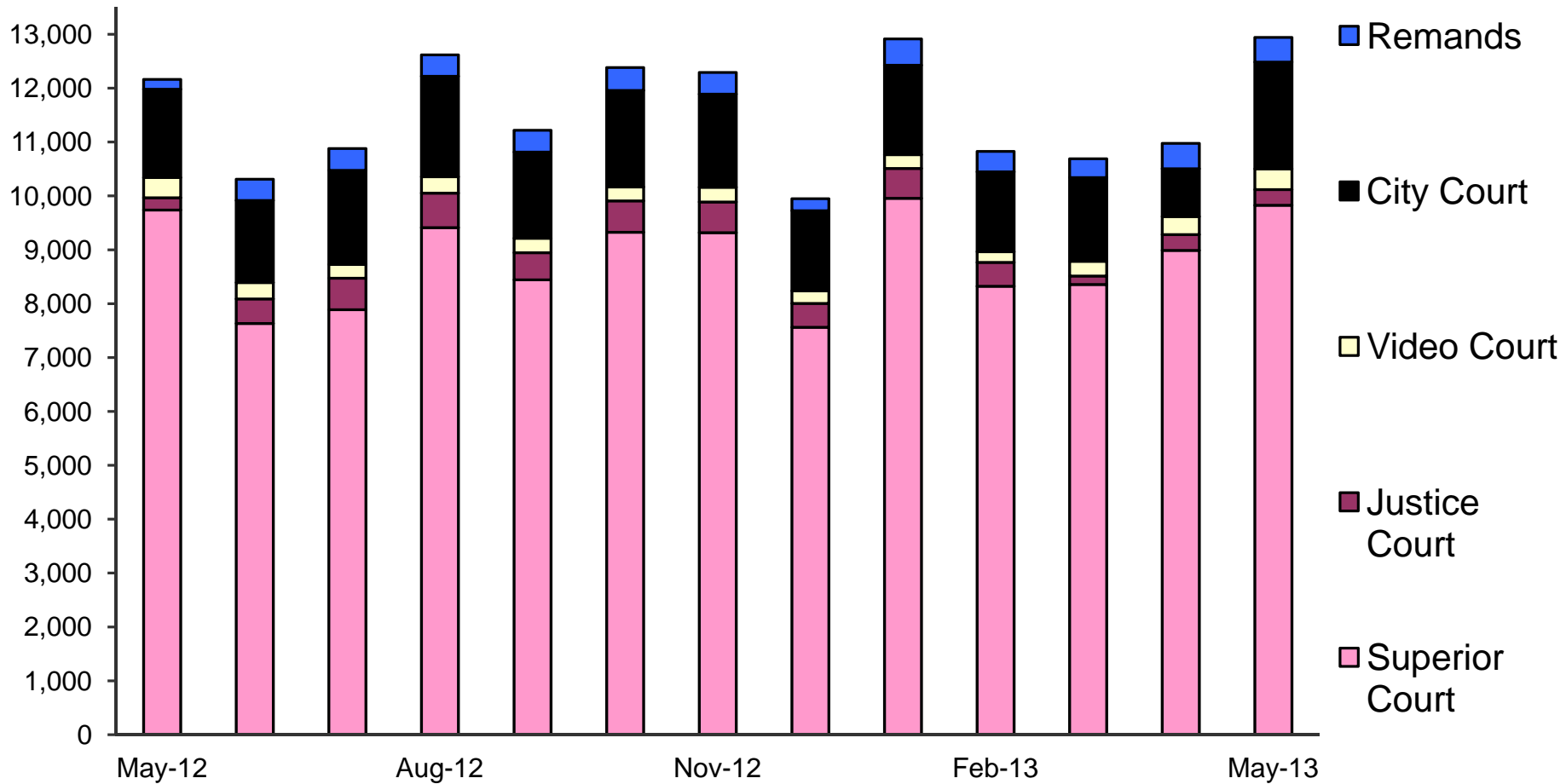


Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds

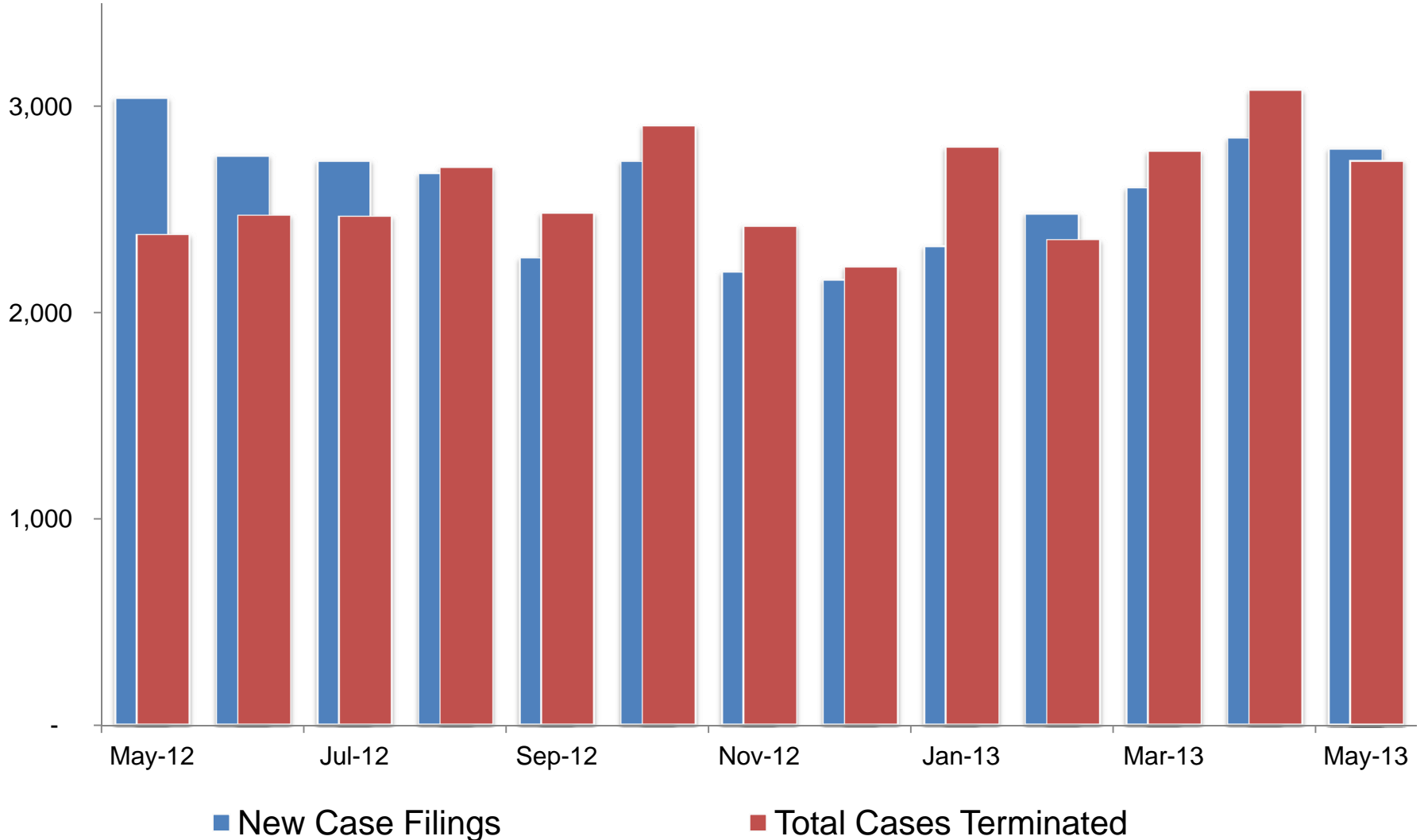

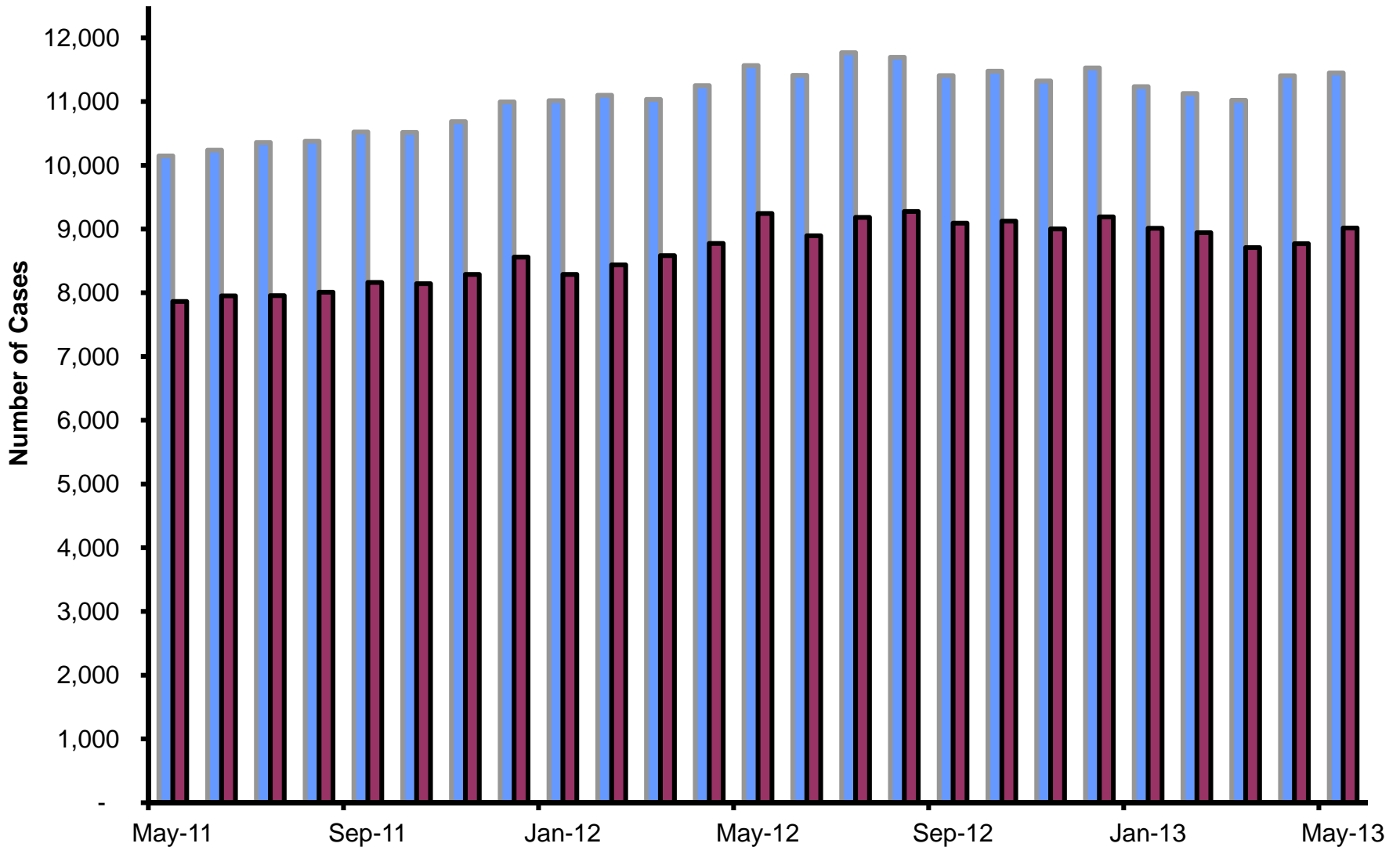

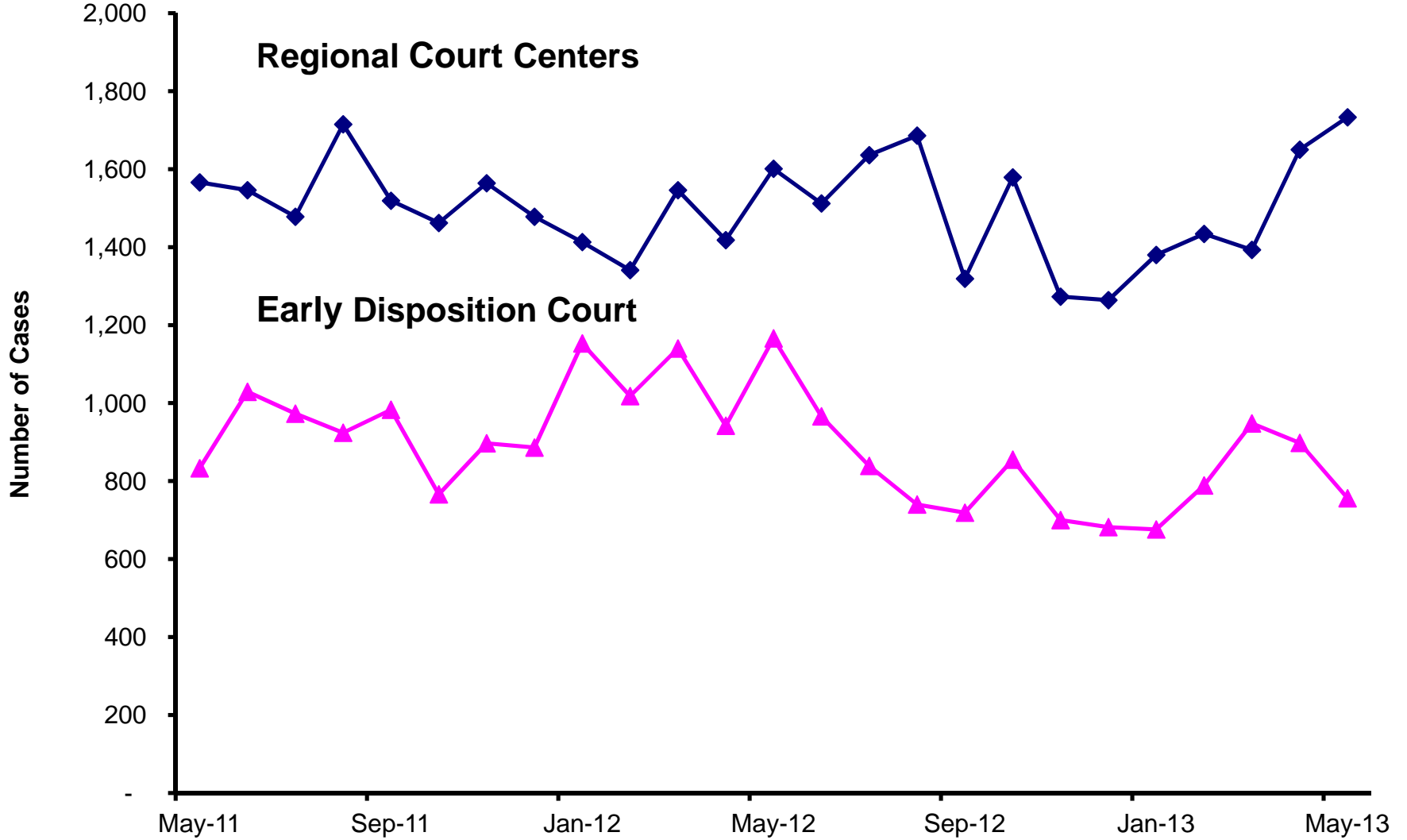


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Direct Complaints into Superior Court

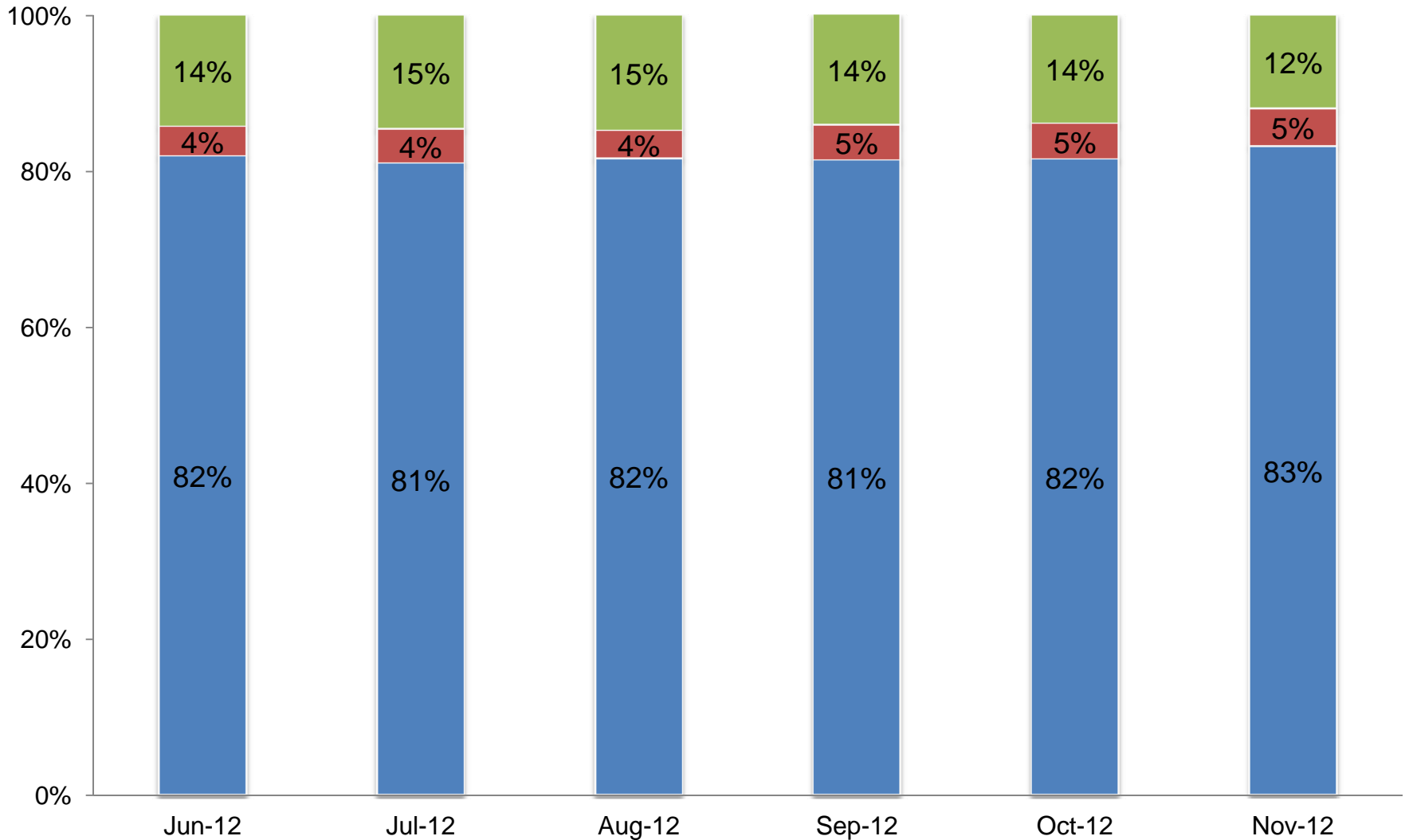


Status of Cases After 180 Days

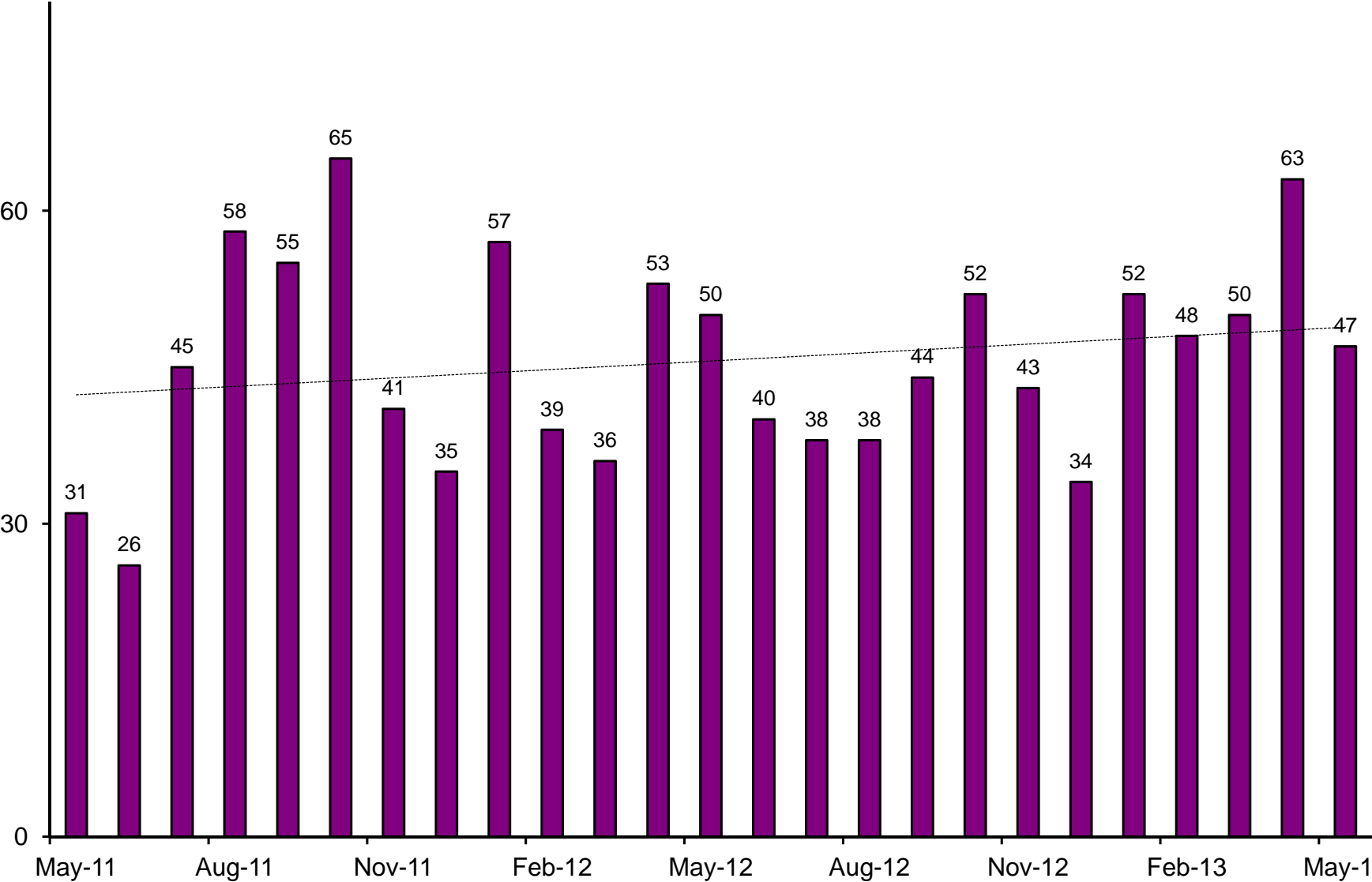

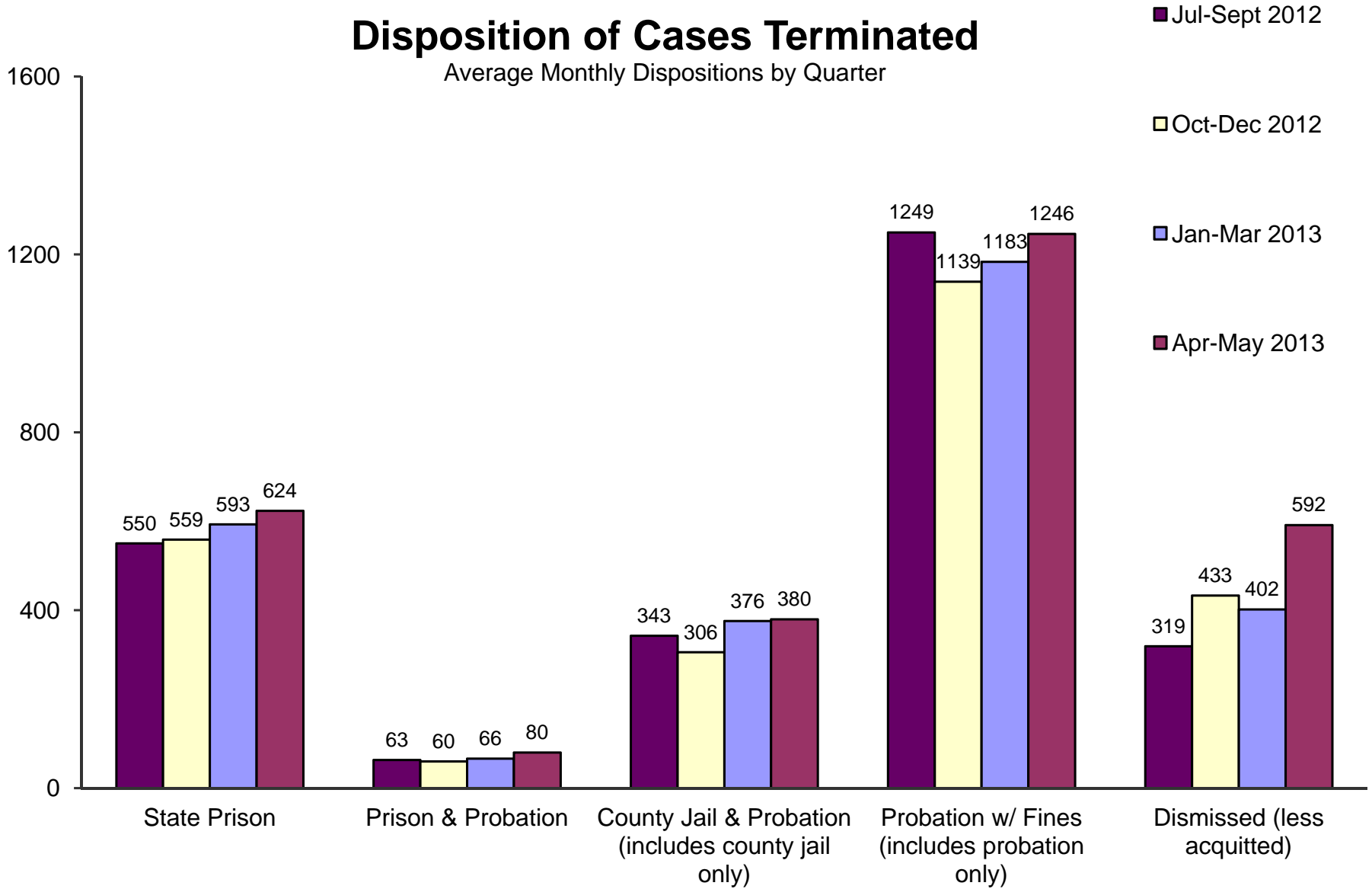


Superior Court Trials Completed

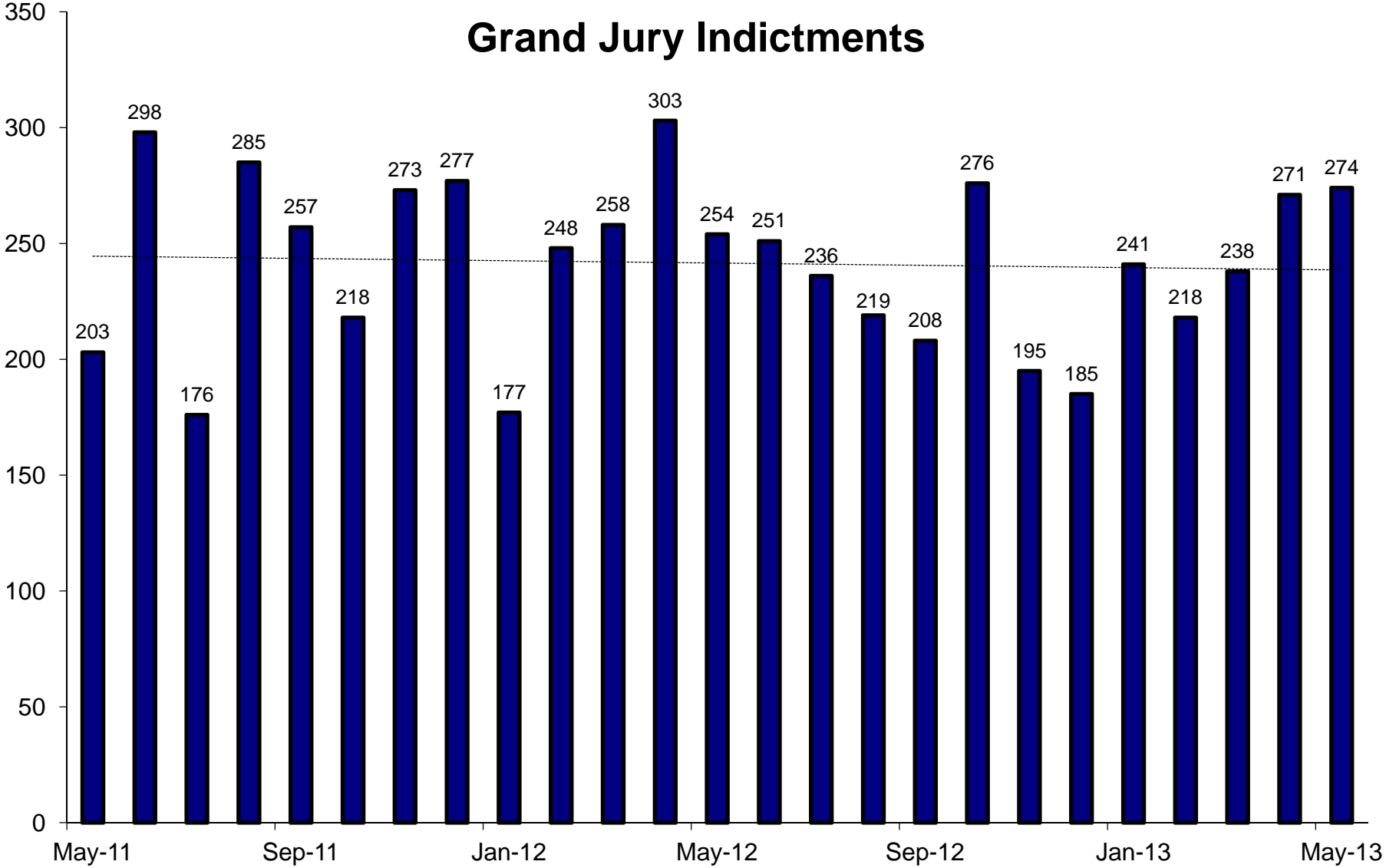


Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter

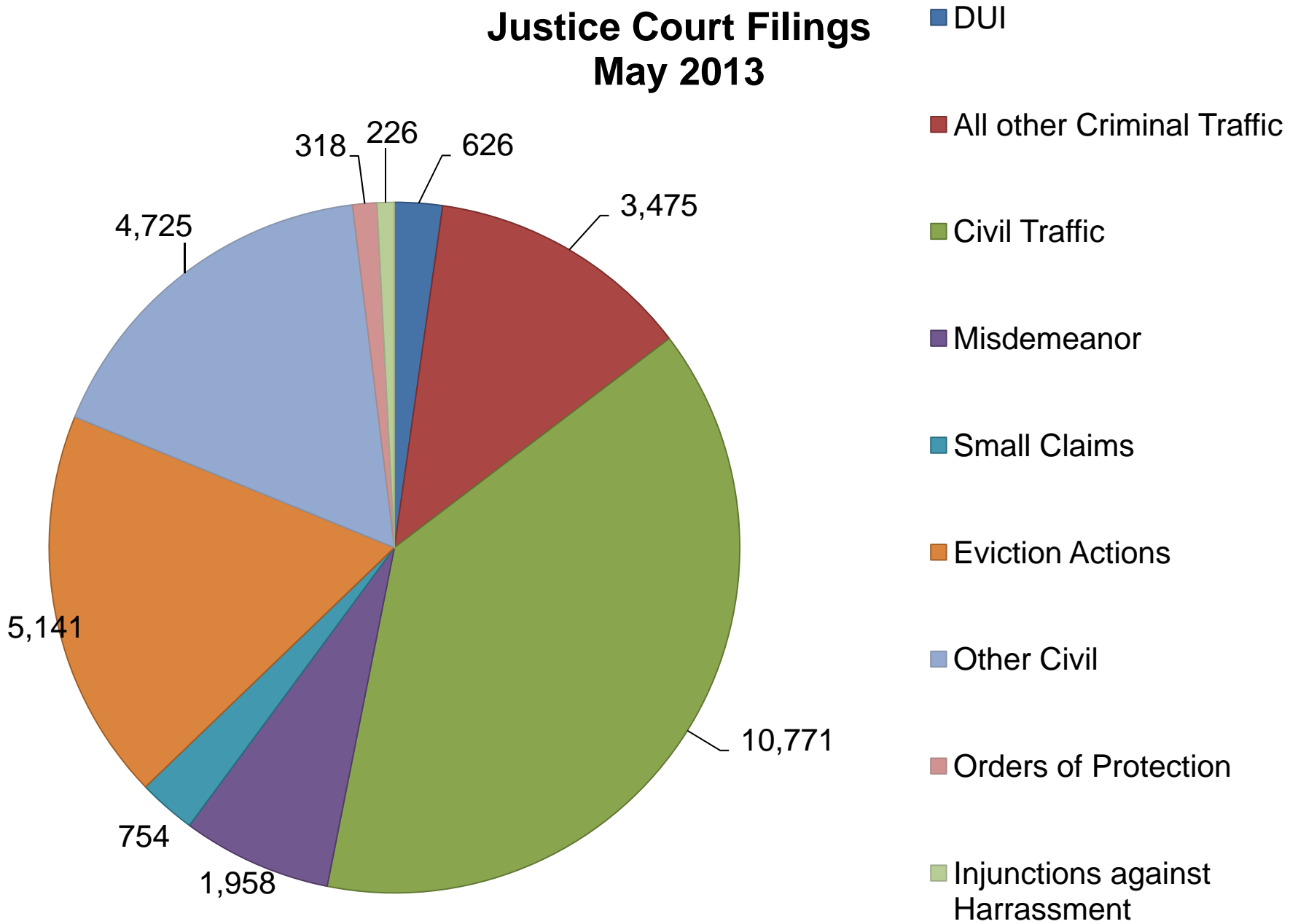


Grand Jury Indictments

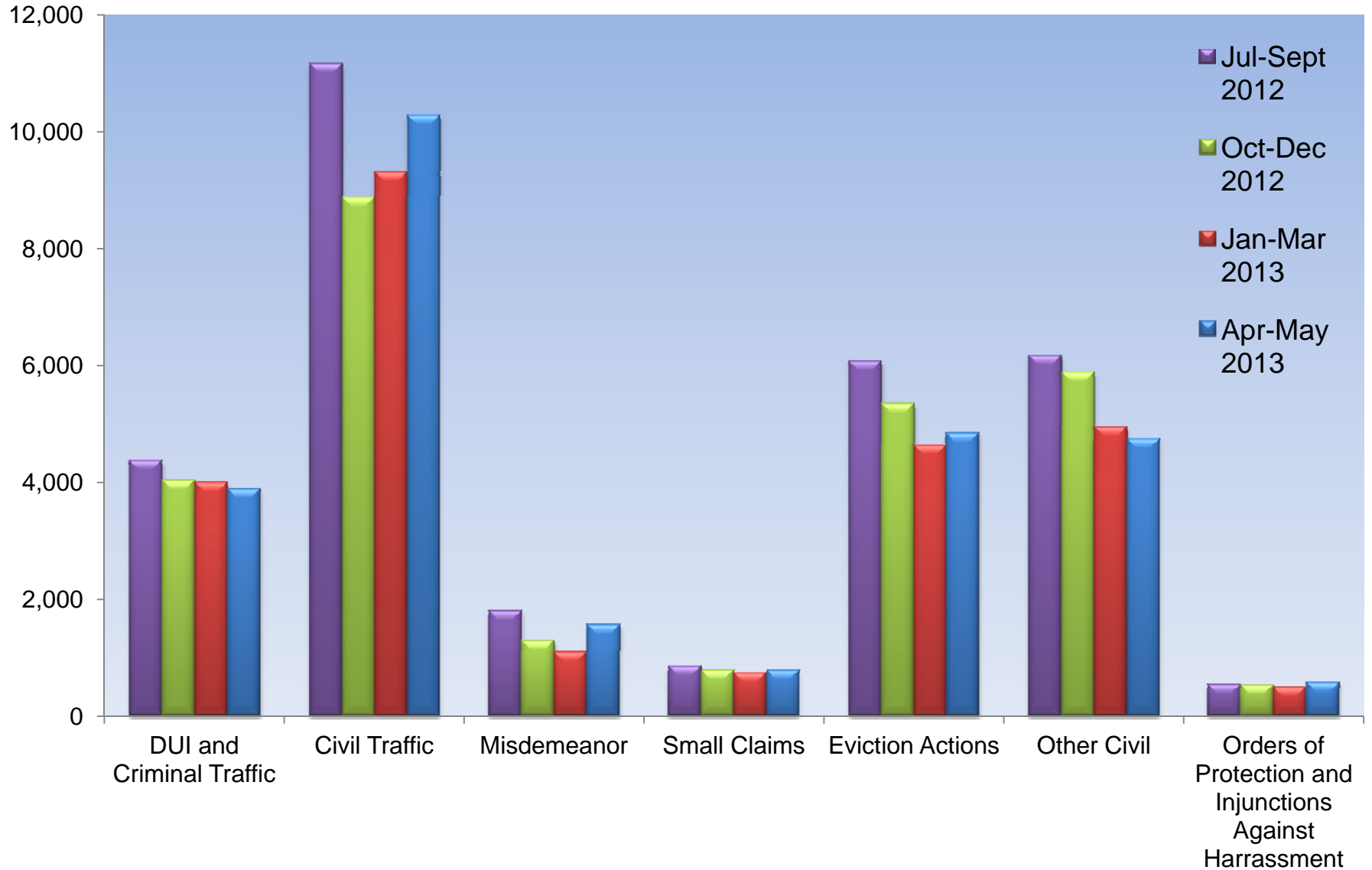

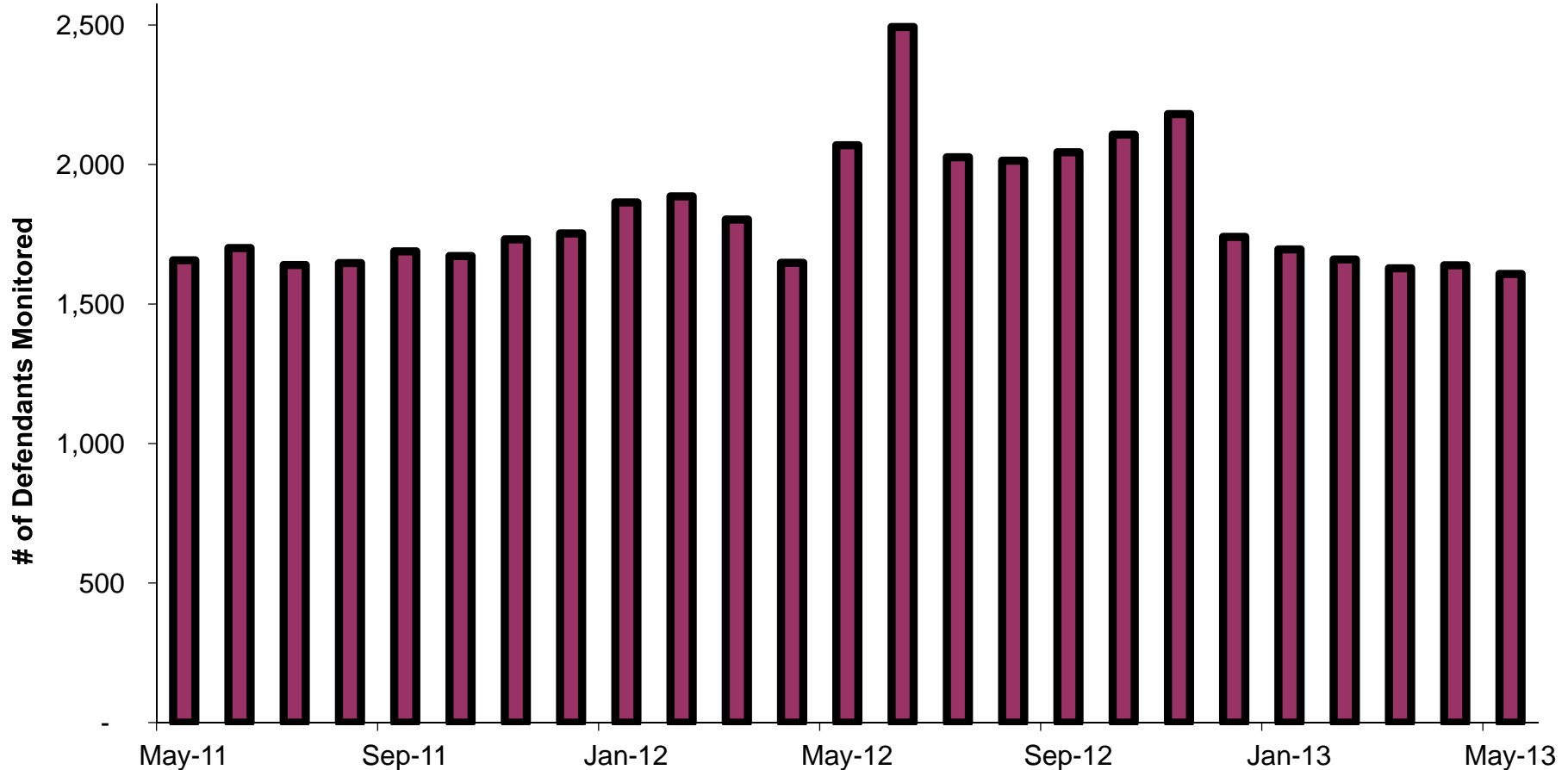
Justice Court Filings May 2013



Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average

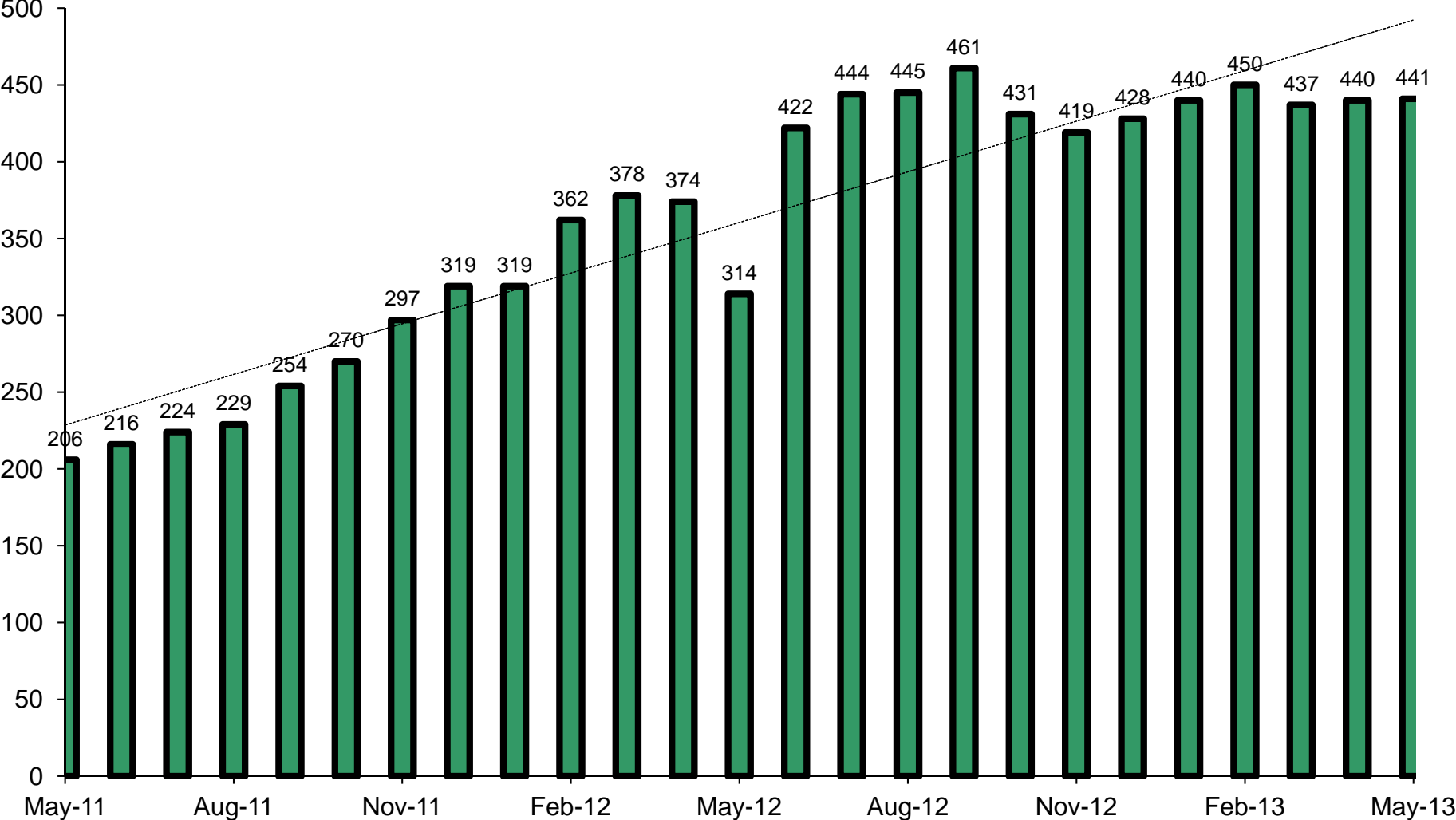


Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload

Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring

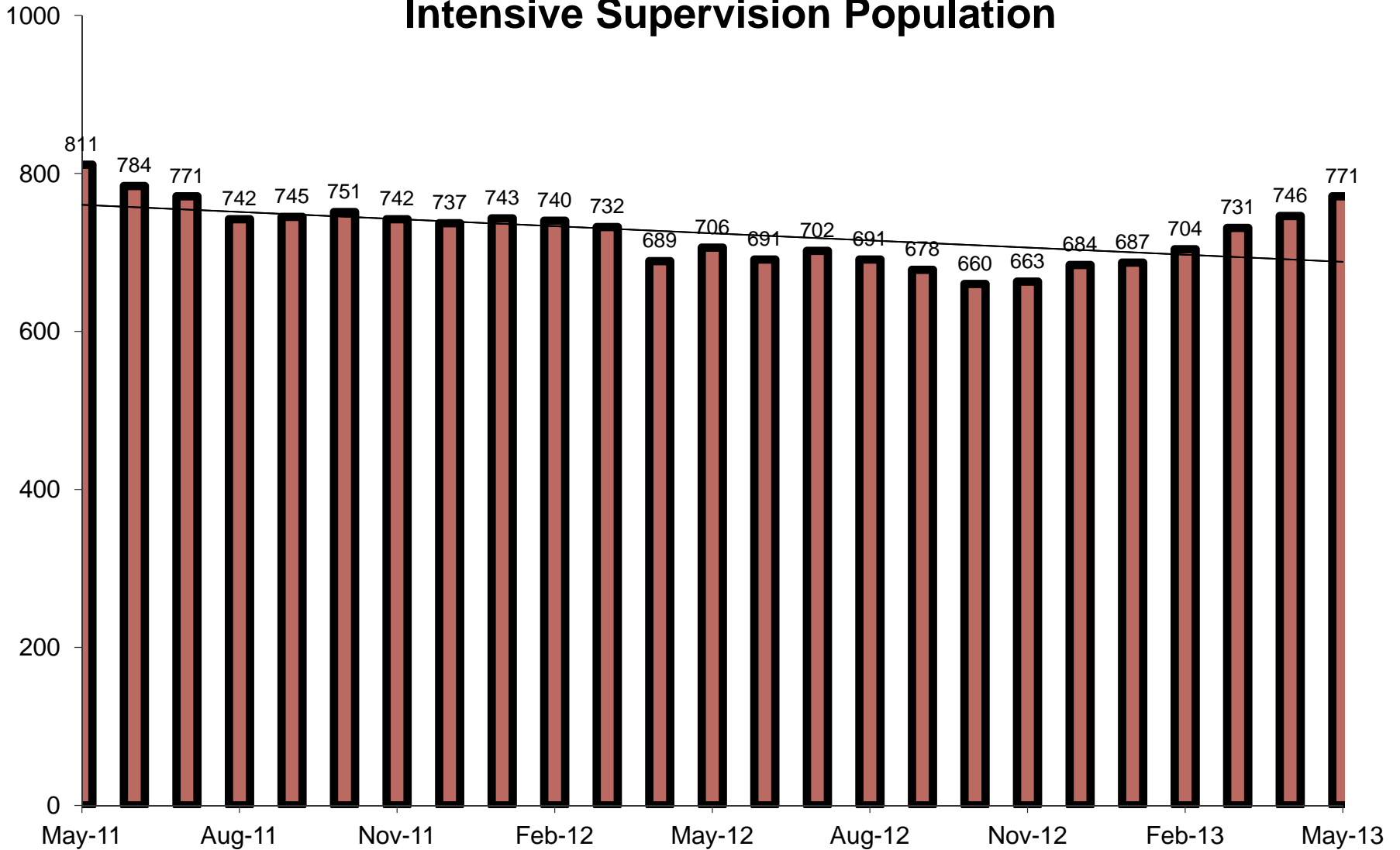


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

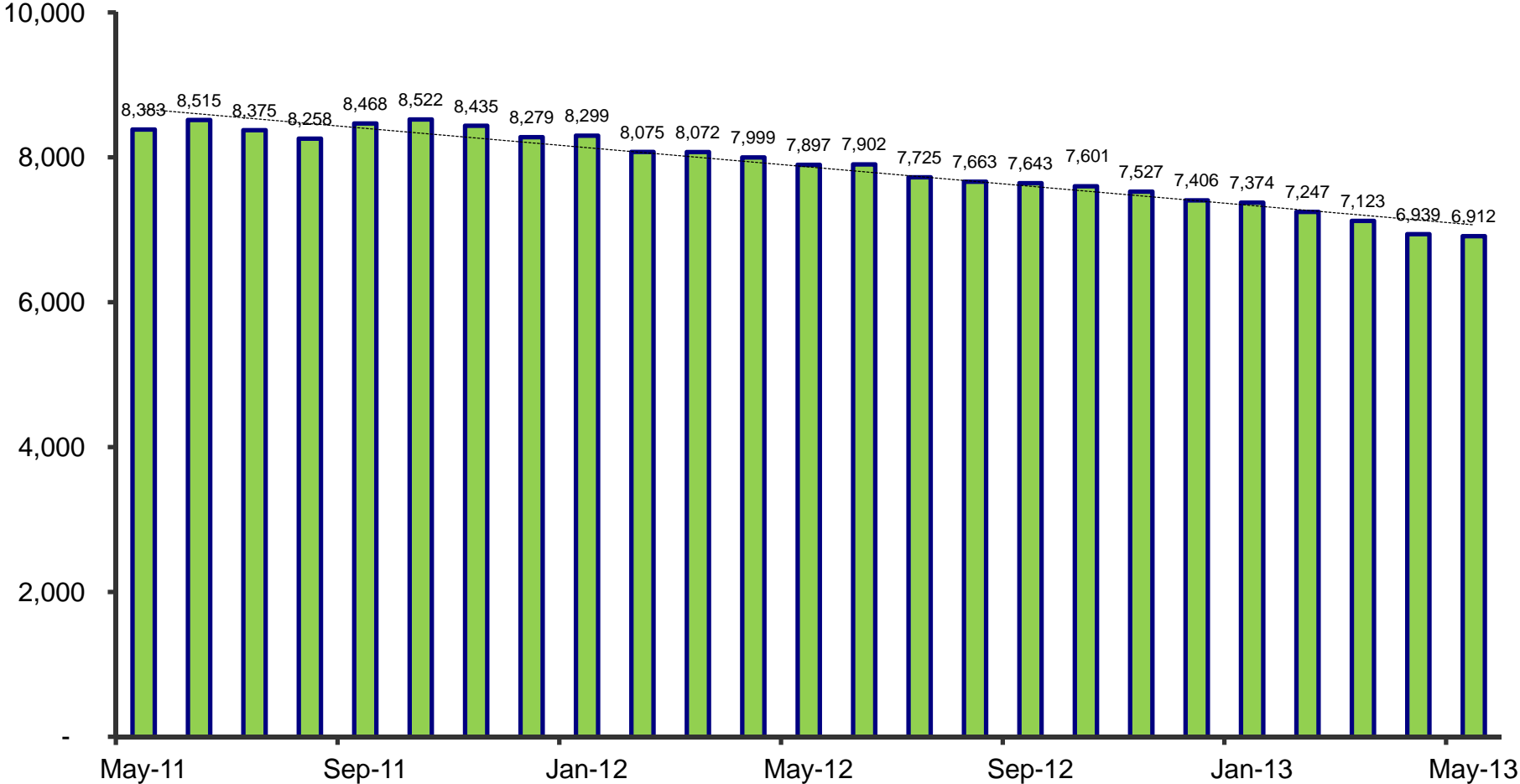

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population

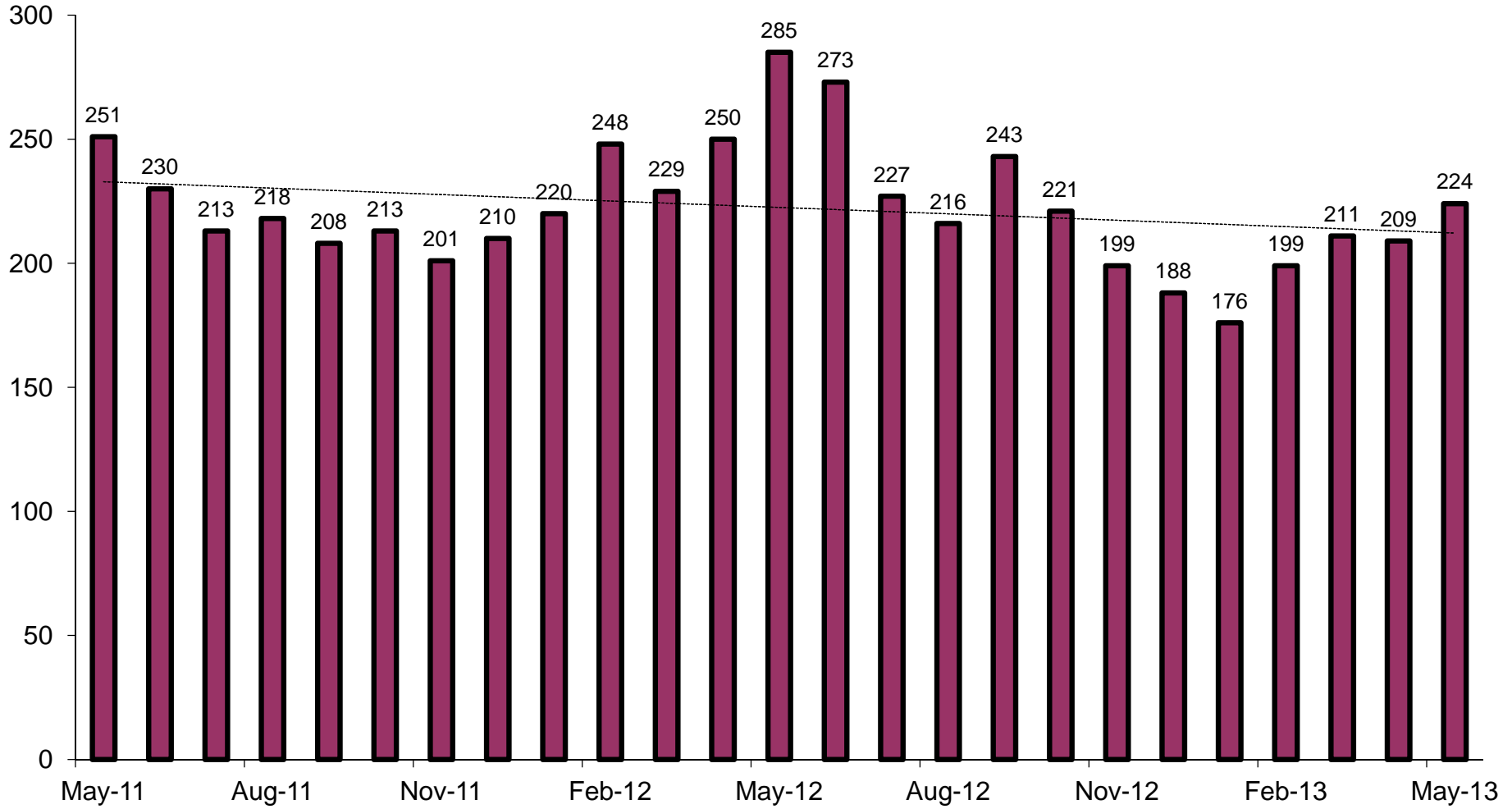


Adult Probation Unsupervised Population

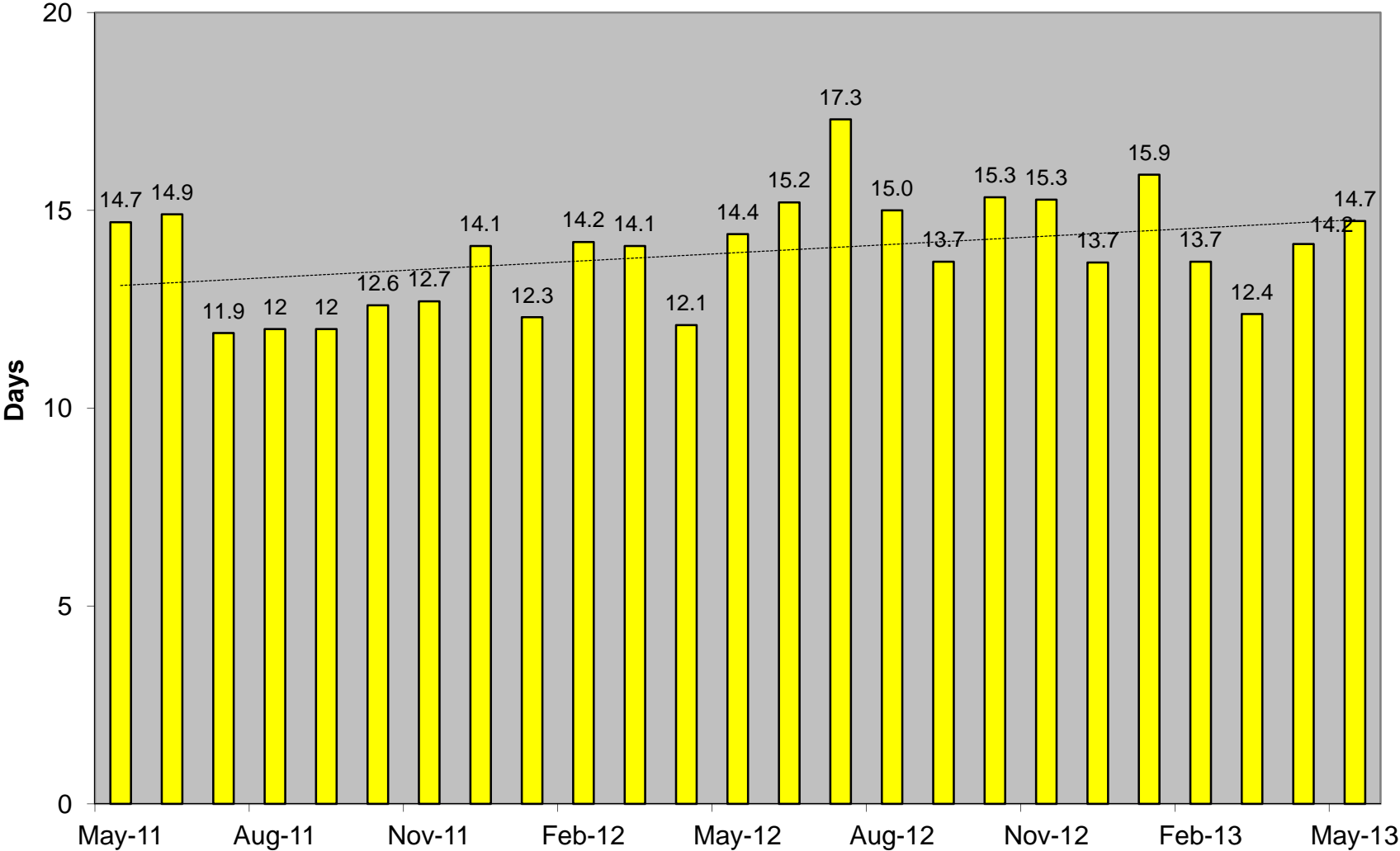
