CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – OCTOBER 2006

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased to 10,746 in October from 10,566 in September. **Average Daily Population decreased** again, for the sixth month in a row, from 9,041 to 8,966. This is the first time ADP has been below 9,000 since March 2005 (8,998). The **pretrial and hold populations decreased** from September to October; pretrial from 5,699 to 5,521 (which is the lowest since December 2004 when it was 5,393) and hold from 377 to 366. The **sentenced population increased** from 2,917 to 3,035.

Overall Average Length of Stay increased slightly from 25.7 days in September to 25.9 days in October. **The ALOS measurement for agency holds decreased** from 70.2 to 67.6 days; this is the lowest ALOS for agency holds since July 2004 (63.8 days). **Pretrial ALOS decreased** from September's 7.3 days to October's 6.7 days, while **sentenced ALOS fell** from 29.9 to 27.5 days (this is the lowest since May 2004's 26.4 days). Breaking down the pretrial population, felony ALOS decreased from 11.3 to 9.8 days, while misdemeanor ALOS increased from 3.0 to 3.4 days.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings and terminations both increased in October: filings from 2,713 to 2,879 and terminations from 2,949 to 3,032. The termination rate remained high, at 105.3%. **The active pending case inventory decreased slightly** from 10,249 to 10,216. **Filings into the RCC and EDC increased in October compared to September.** RCC filings went from 1,621 to 1,698 while EDC filings went from 725 to 824. **99 trials were completed in October**, a 54% increase over the same period last FY. **The October trial rate fell from September's 3.7%, but remained high at 3.4%.**

Justice Court Filings

DUI filings fell September to October, from 1,048 to 816. The numbers of **Orders of Protection increased**, from 424 to 507.

Adult Probation

General and intensive pretrial supervision decreased from September to October: general from 885 to 818 and intensive from 1,202 to 1,193. **Electronic monitoring populations increased** from September's 236 to October's 245.

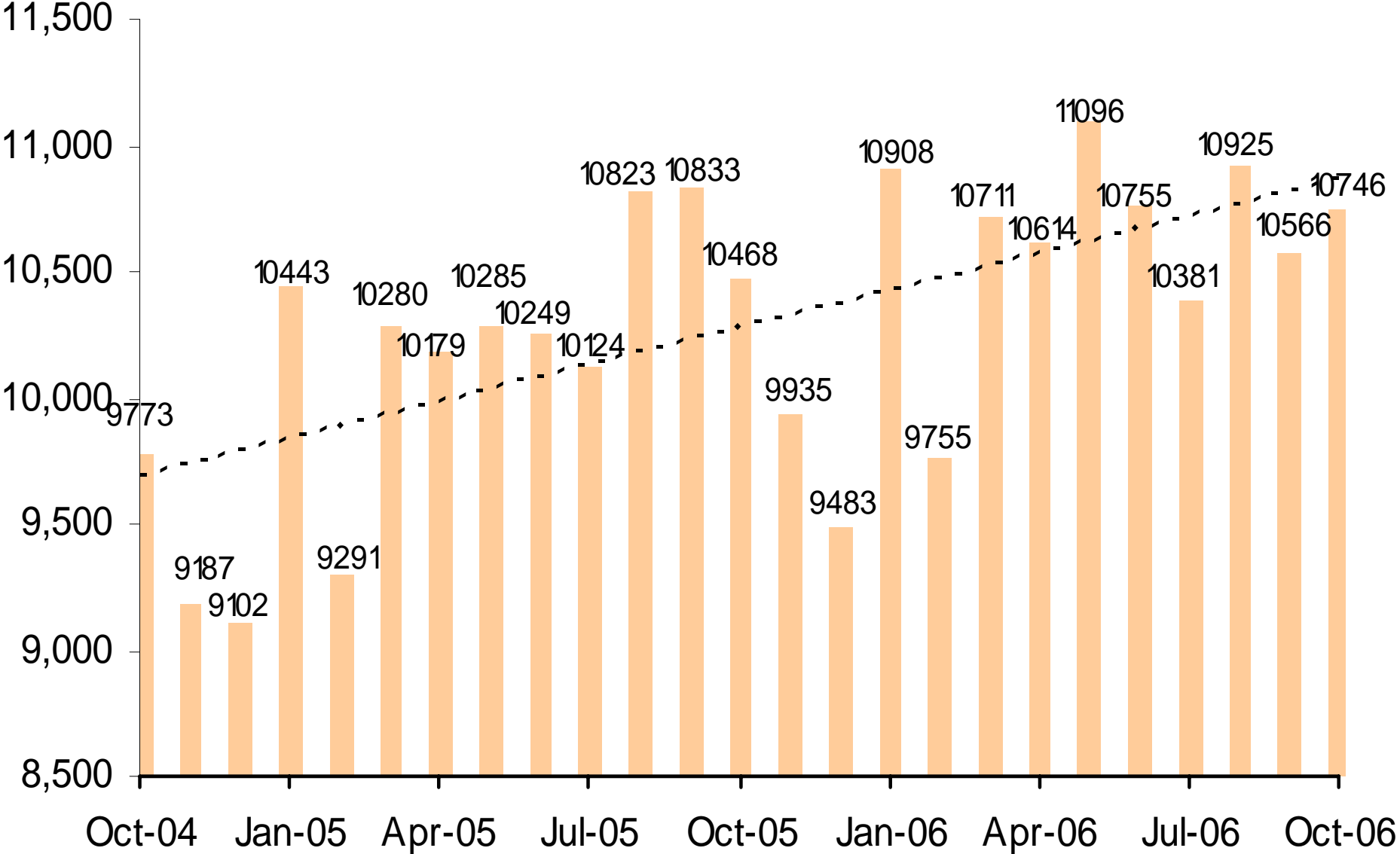
Levels of standard probation supervision decreased in October compared to September, from 29,930 to 29,697. **October's levels of intensive probation (1,286) remained nearly the same as September's 1,283.**

Juvenile Detention and Probation

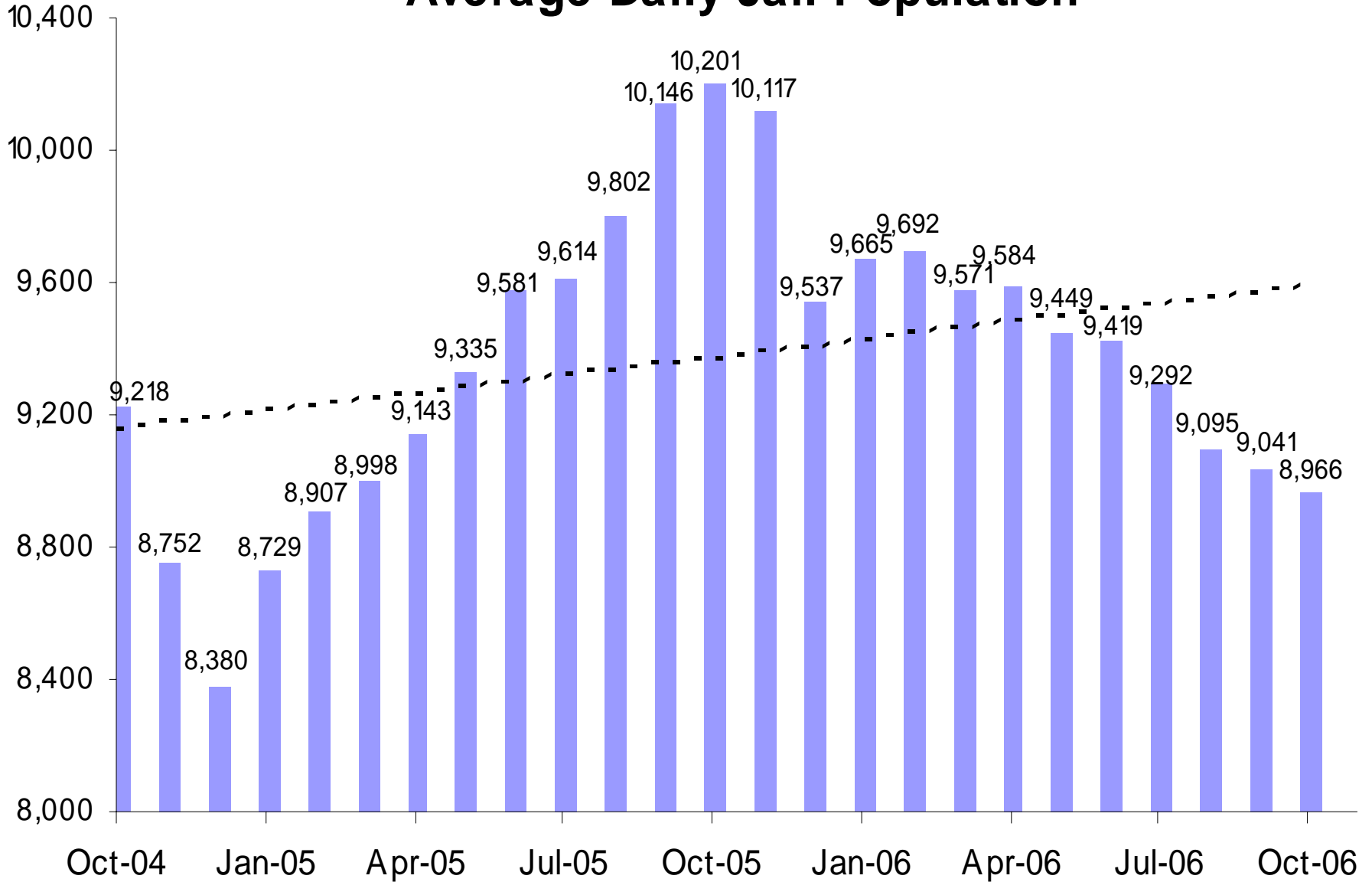
The **Average Daily Detention Population slightly increased** from 405 in September to 425 in October. **ALOS increased** from 16.1 to 17.3 days. **October's Electronic Monitoring was 140**, compared to September's 146. **Home detention increased** from 217 to 221.

Levels of juvenile standard and intensive probation increased slightly from September to October. Standard went from 4,326 to 4,337, while intensive went from 515 to 517.

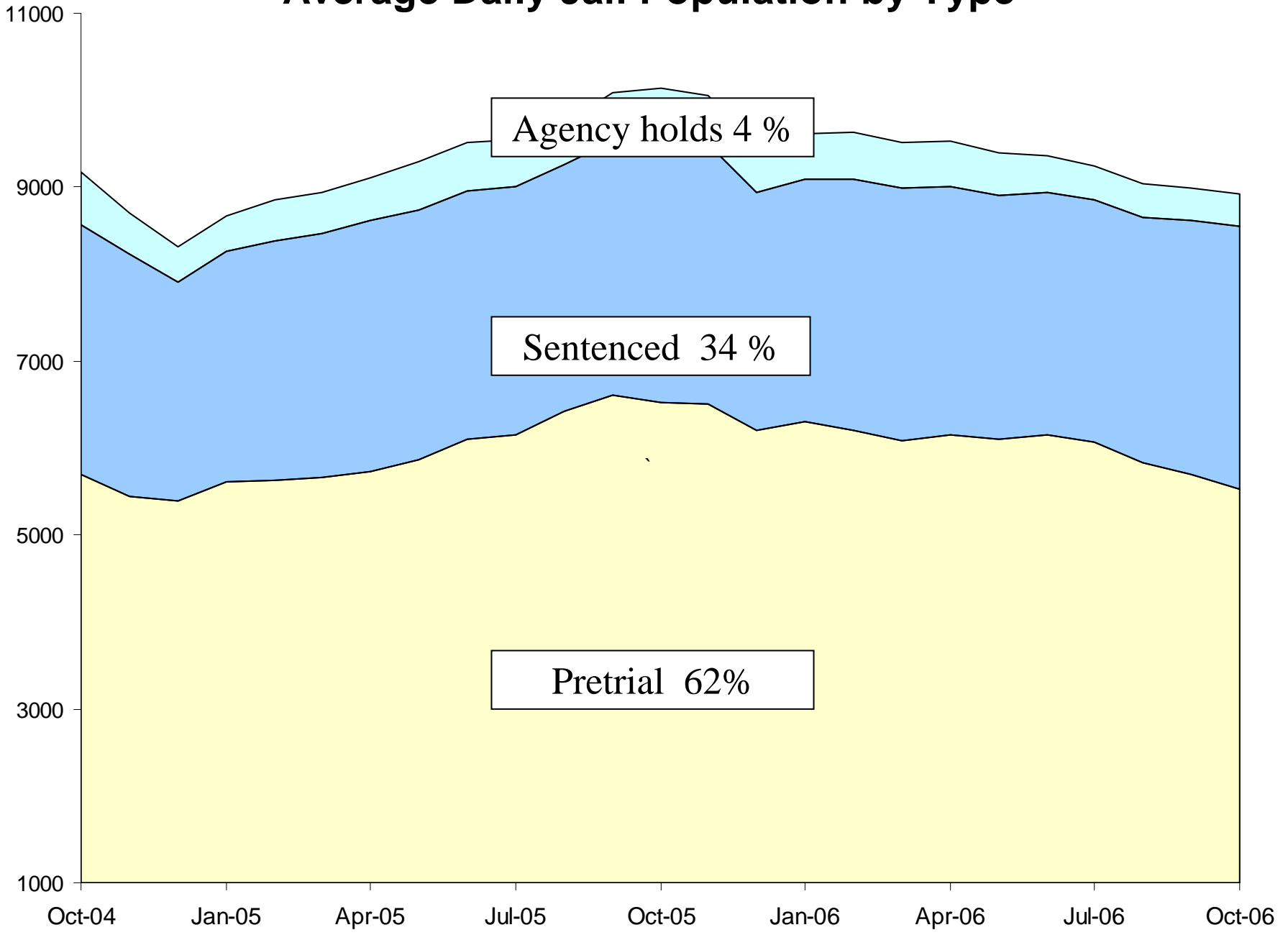
Jail Bookings

Average Daily Jail Population by Type

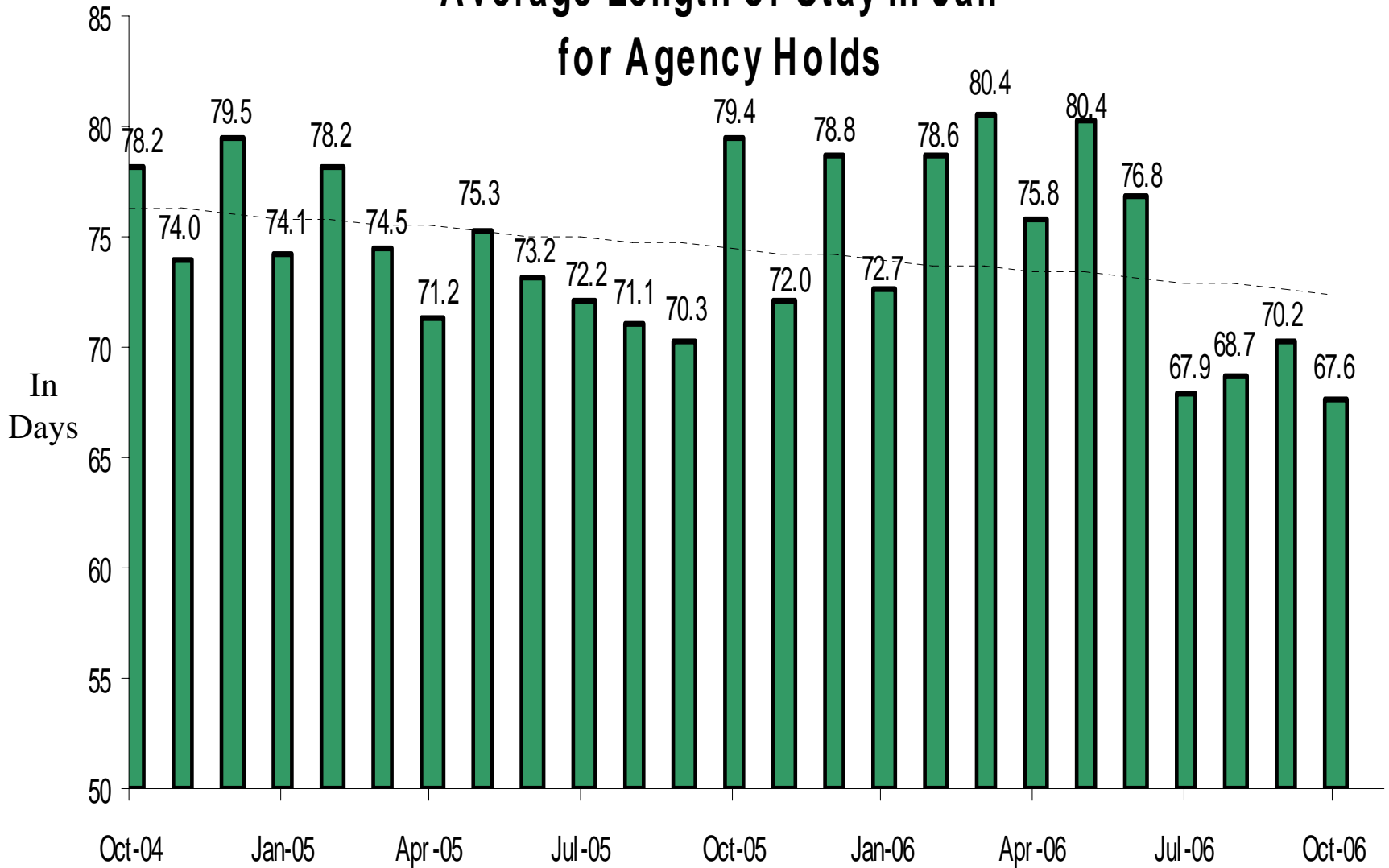

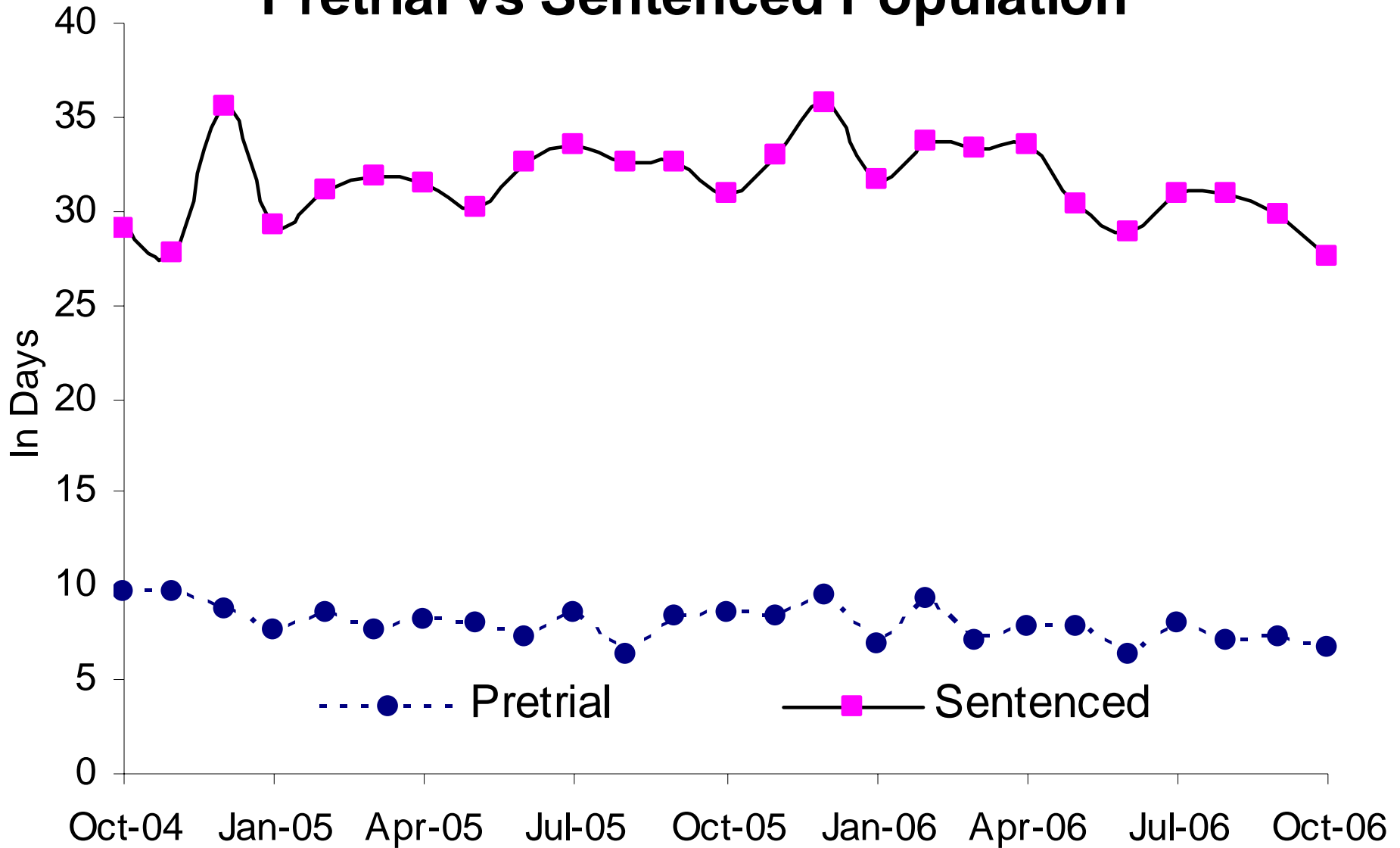

Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds

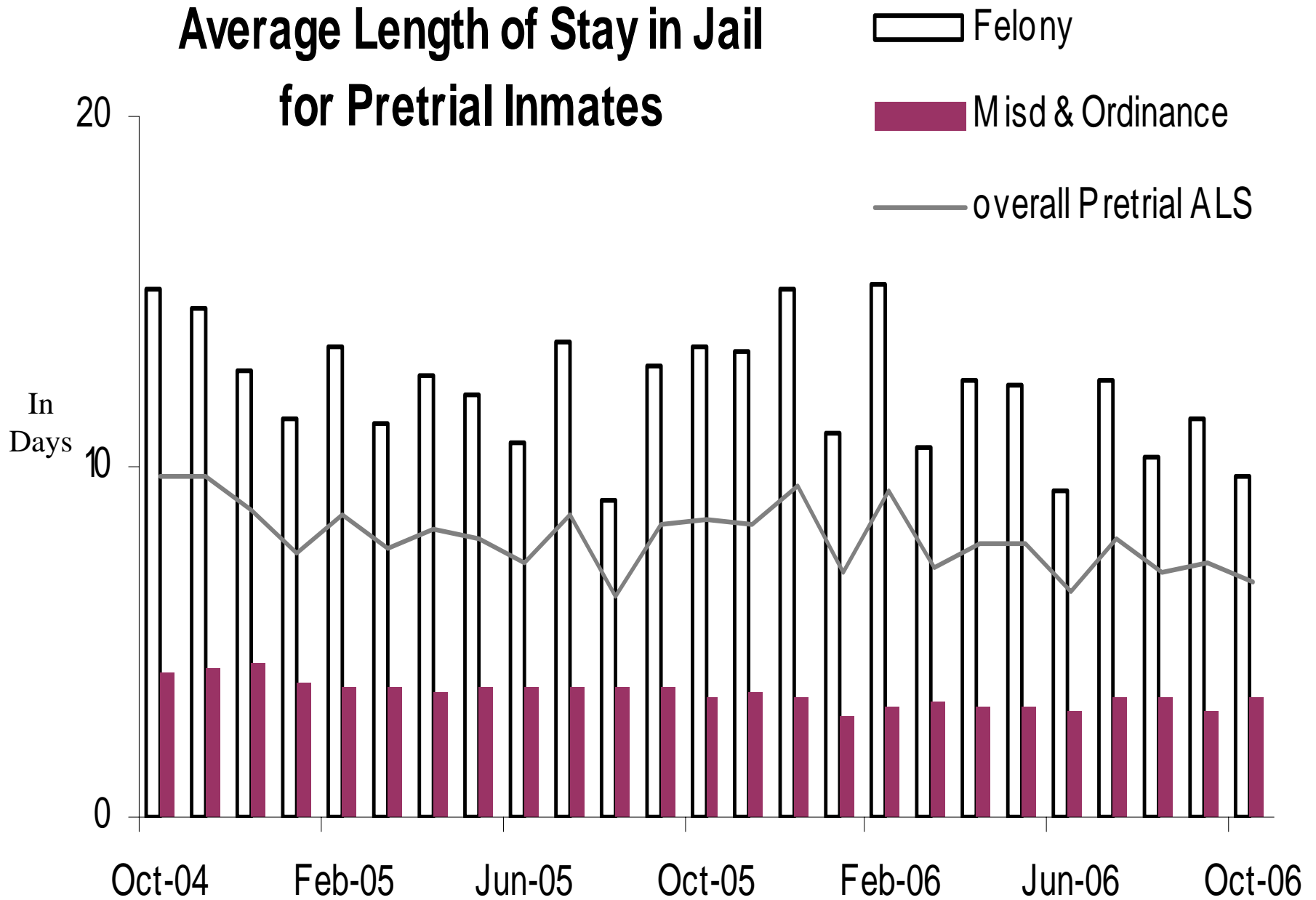

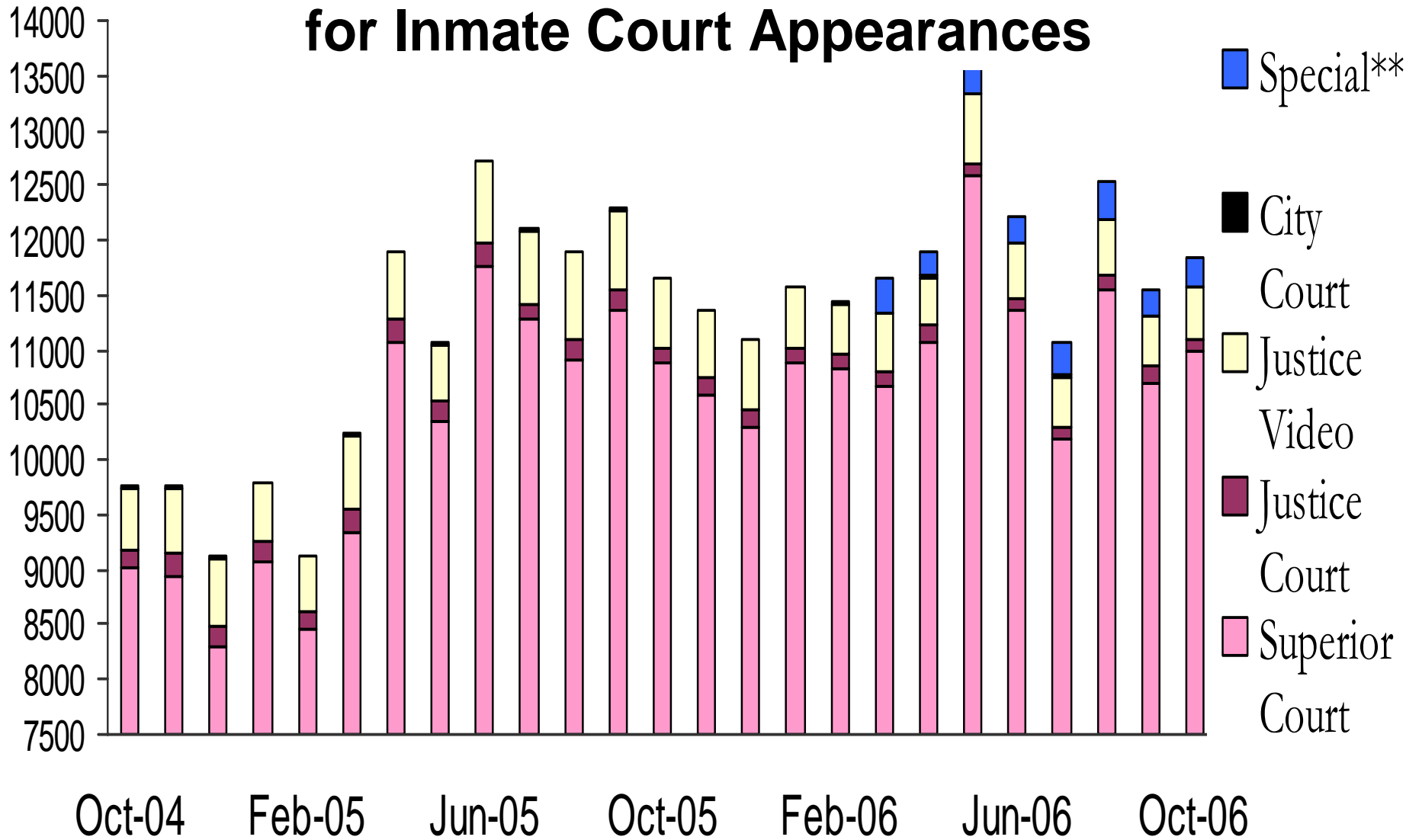
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



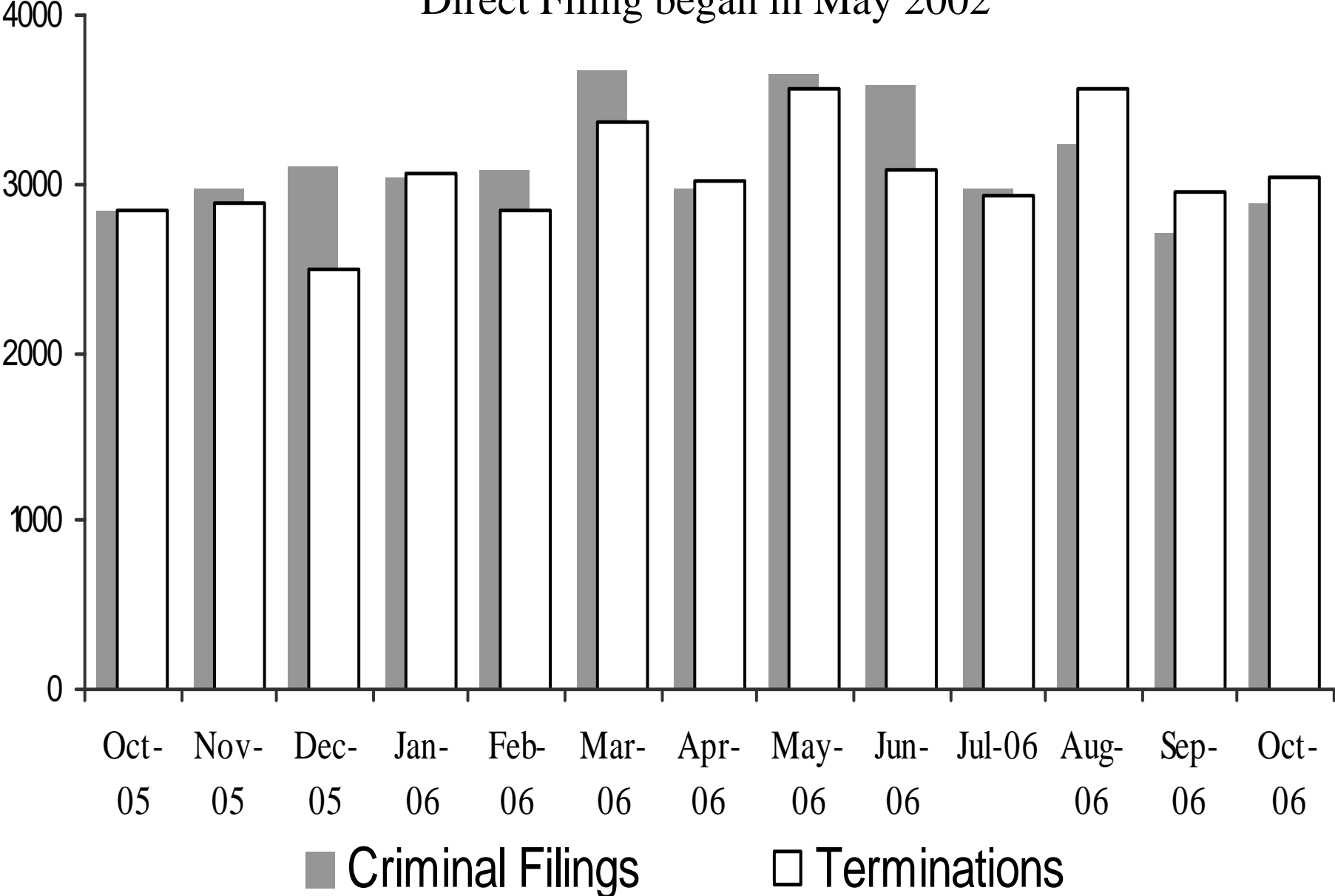
Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



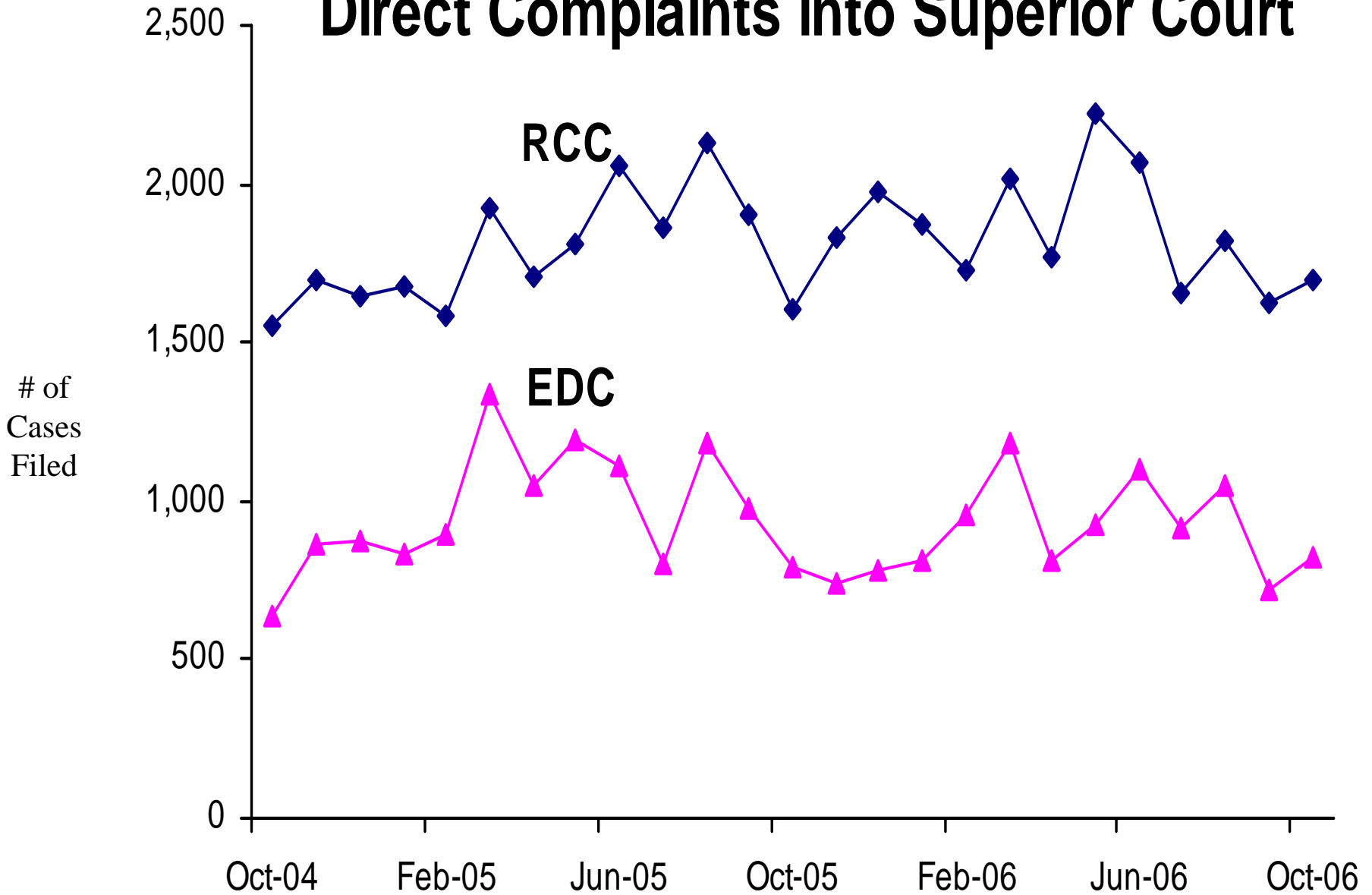

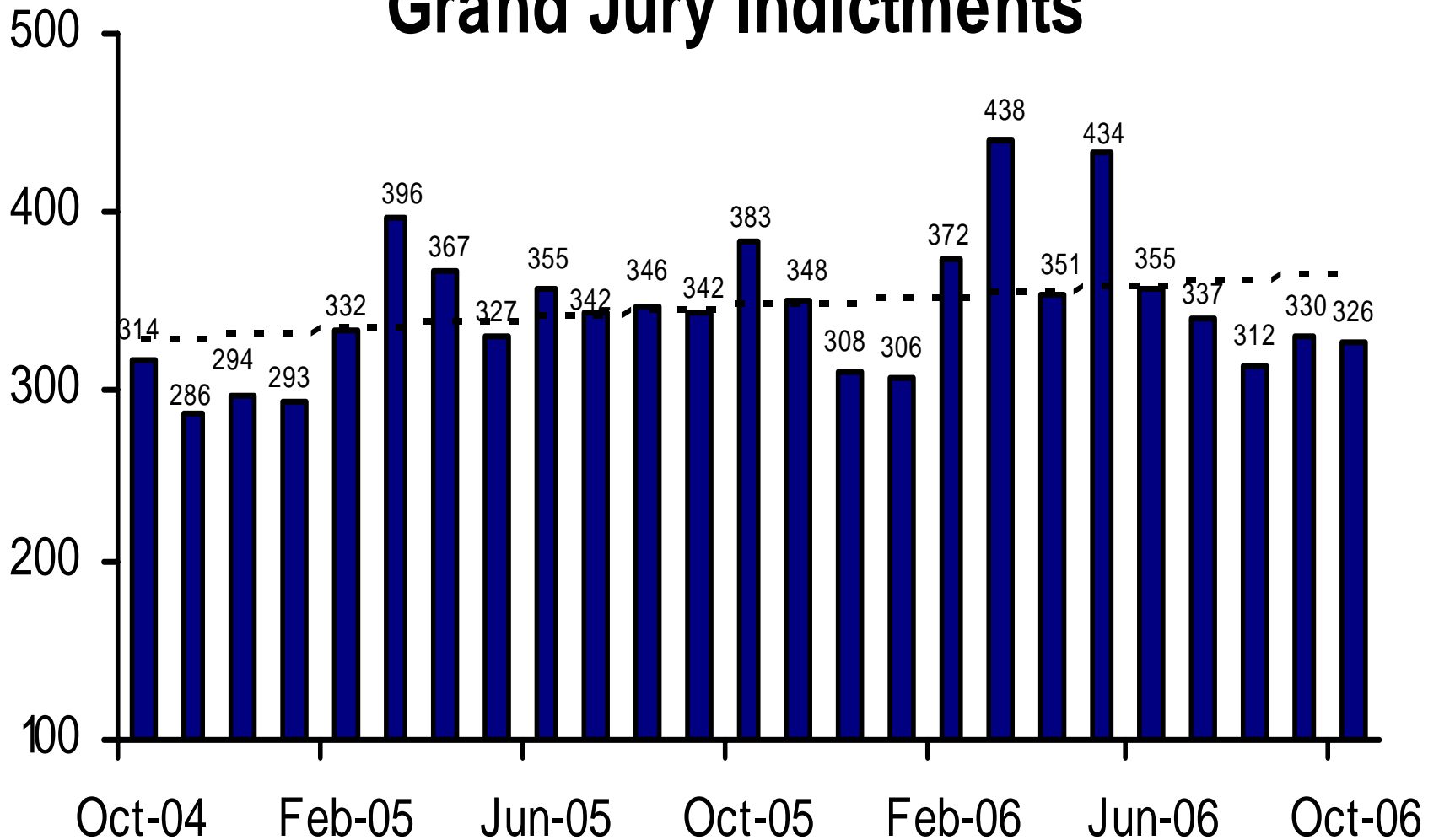
Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court

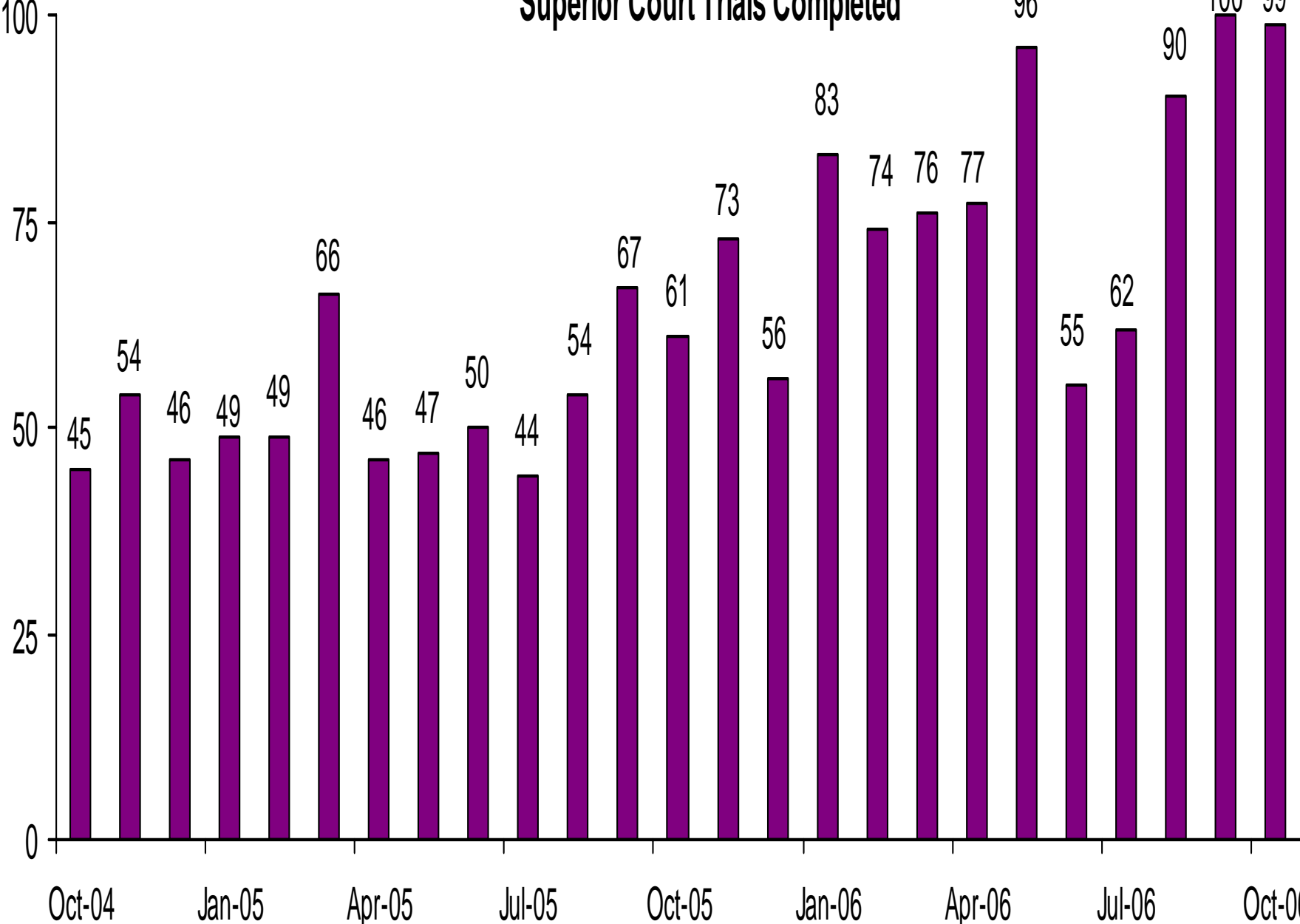


Grand Jury Indictments

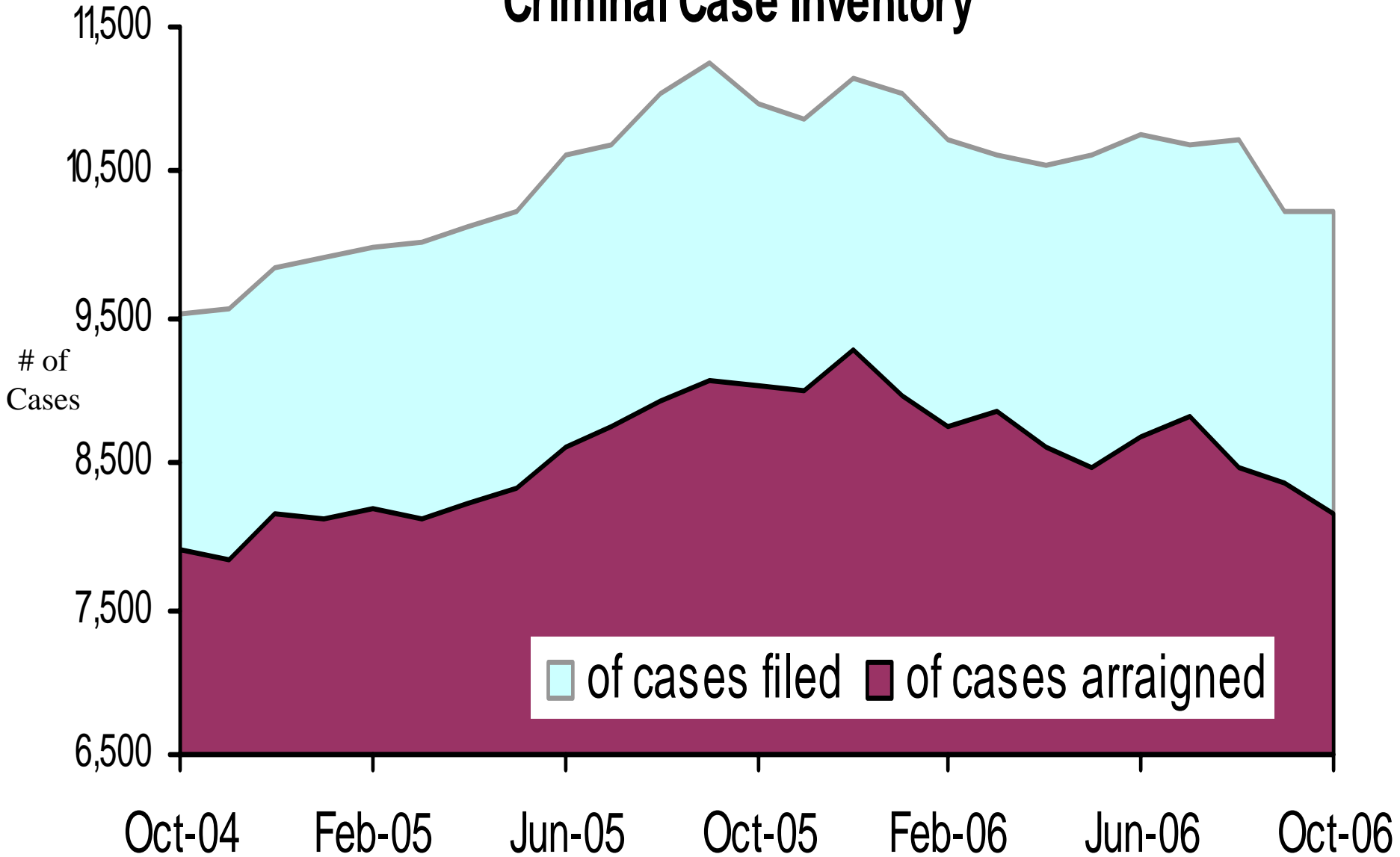

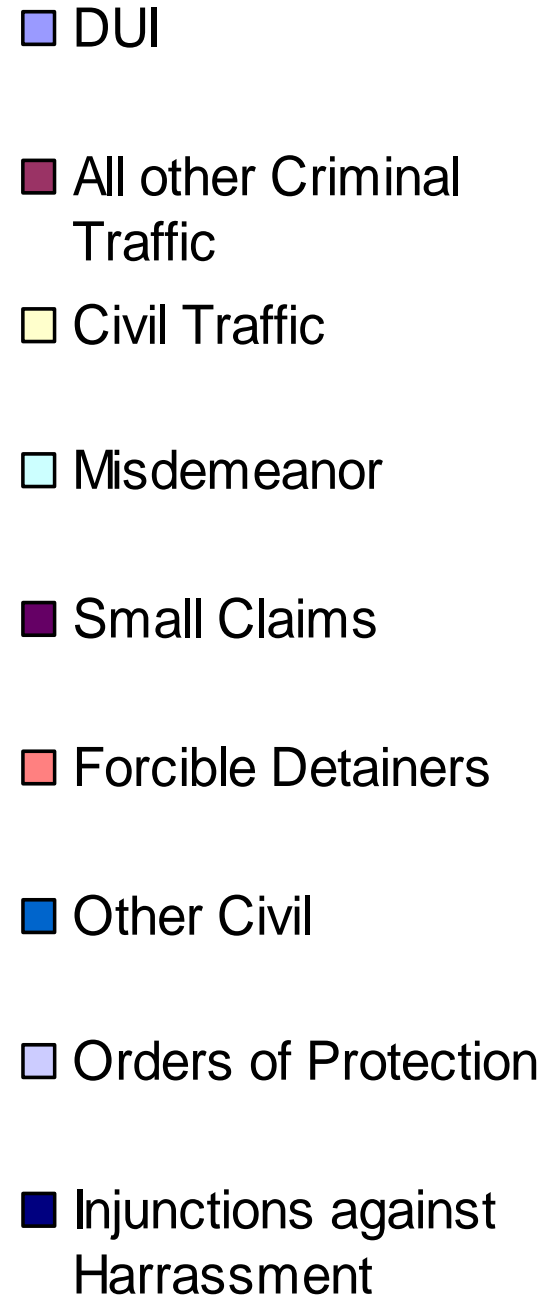
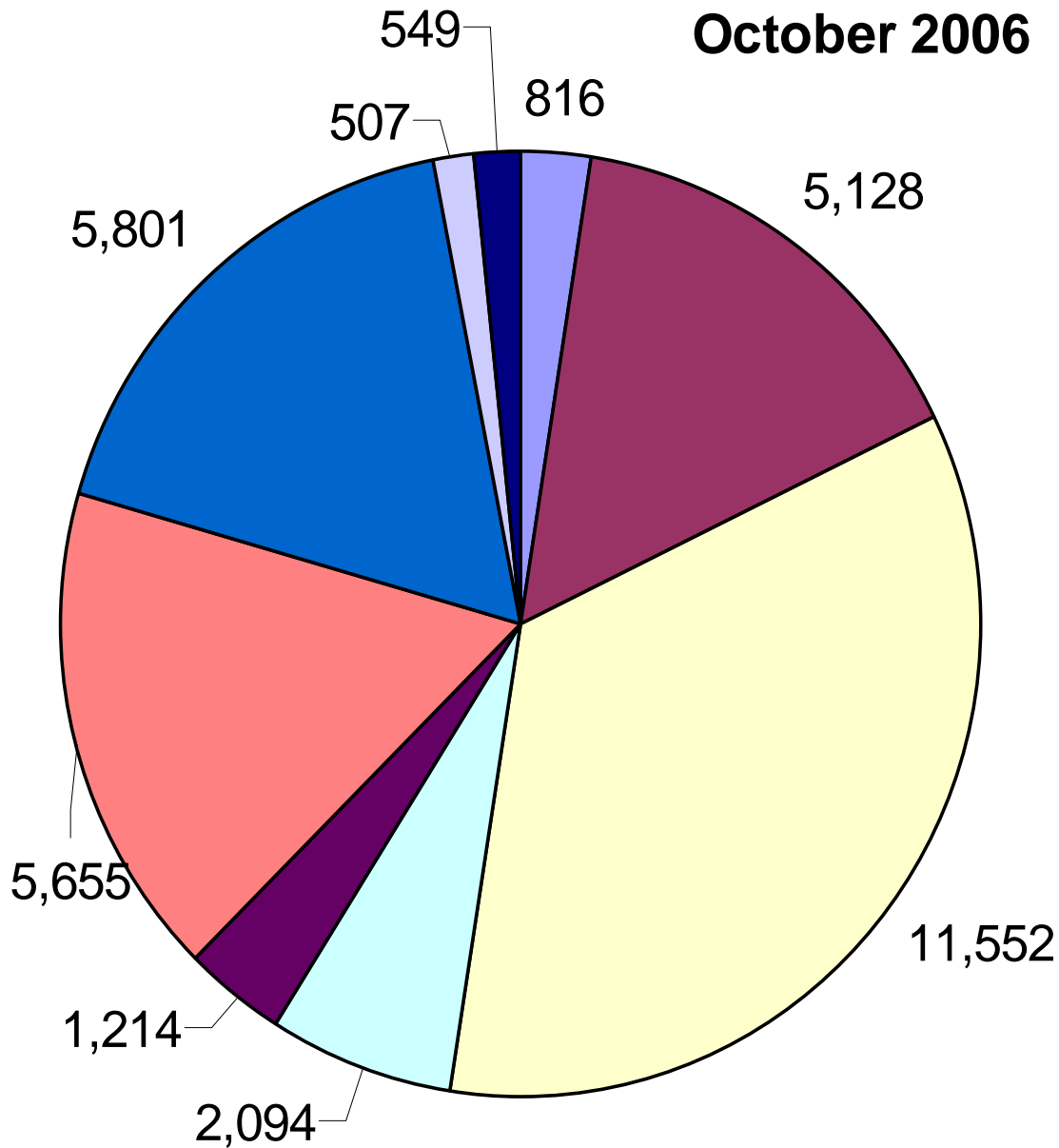
Superior Court Trials Completed

Justice Court Filings October 2006

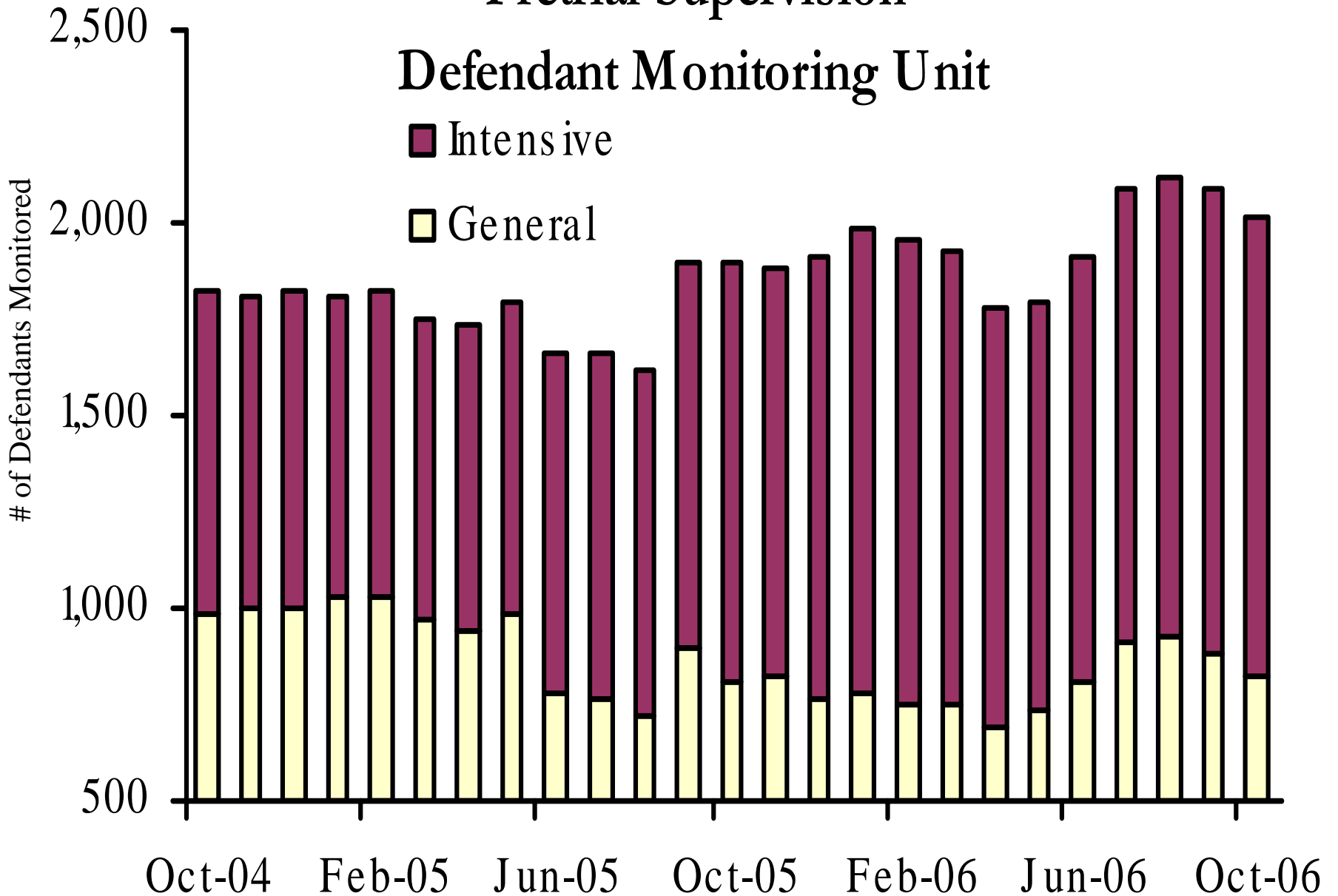

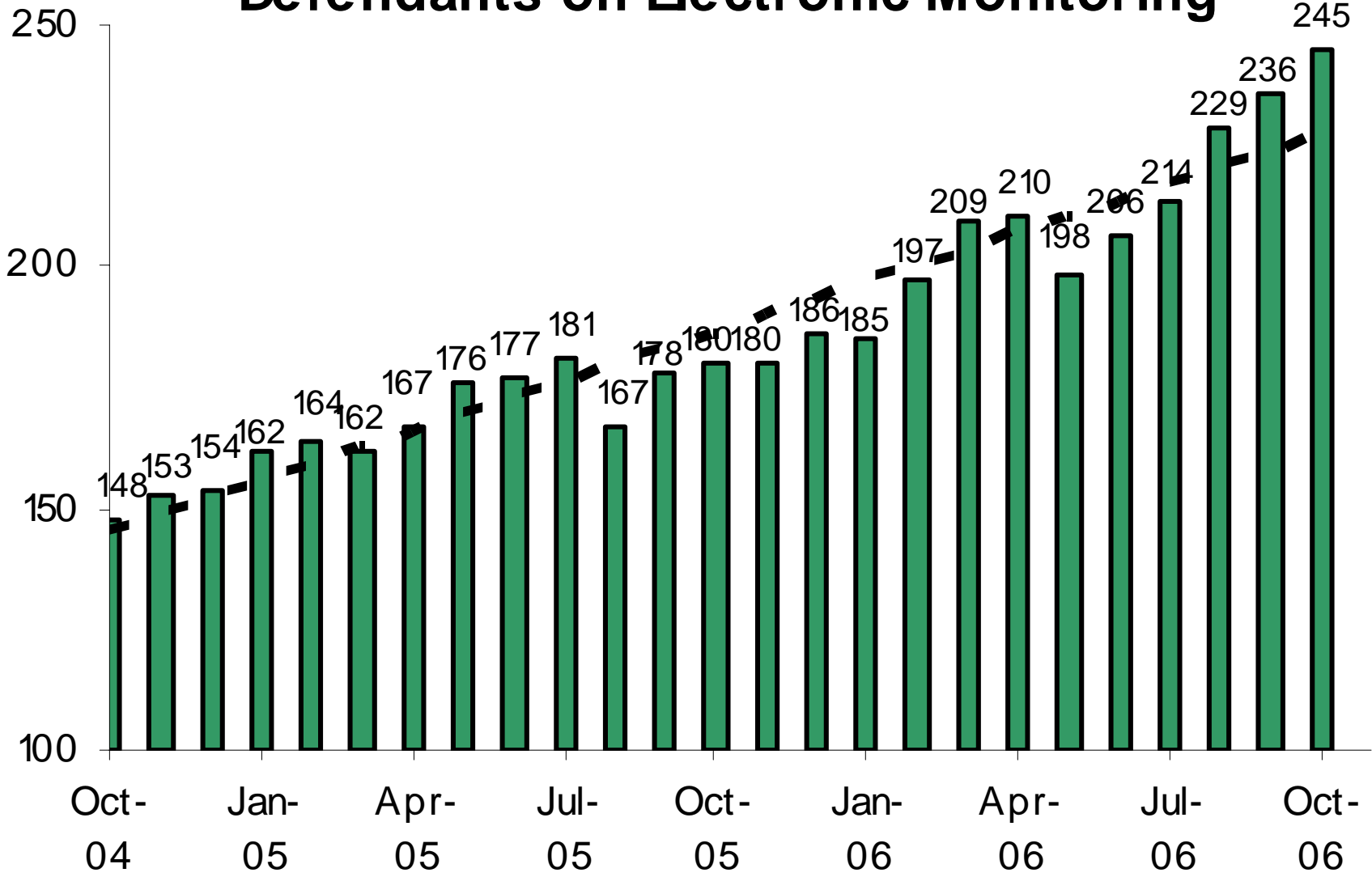

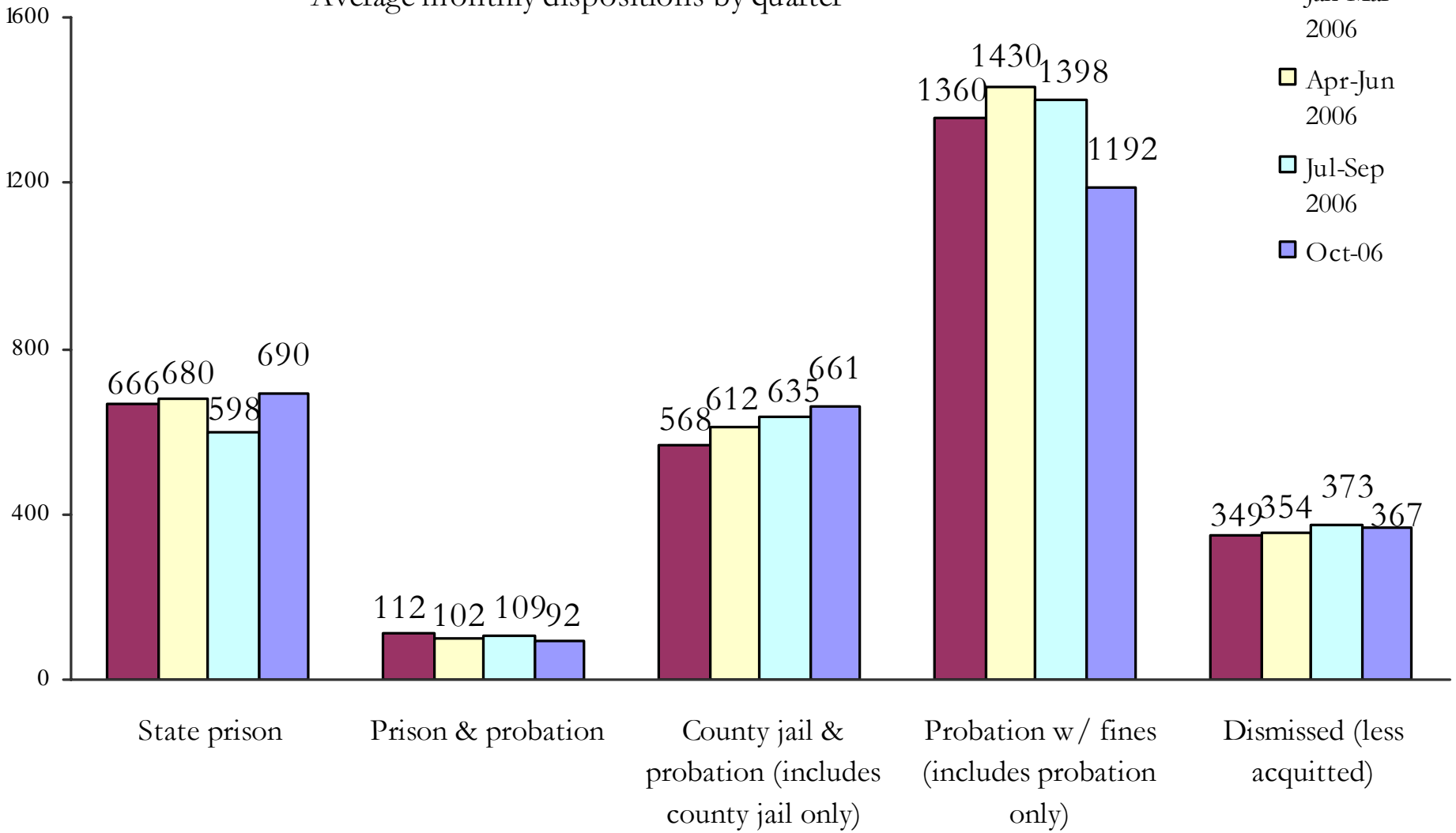
Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring



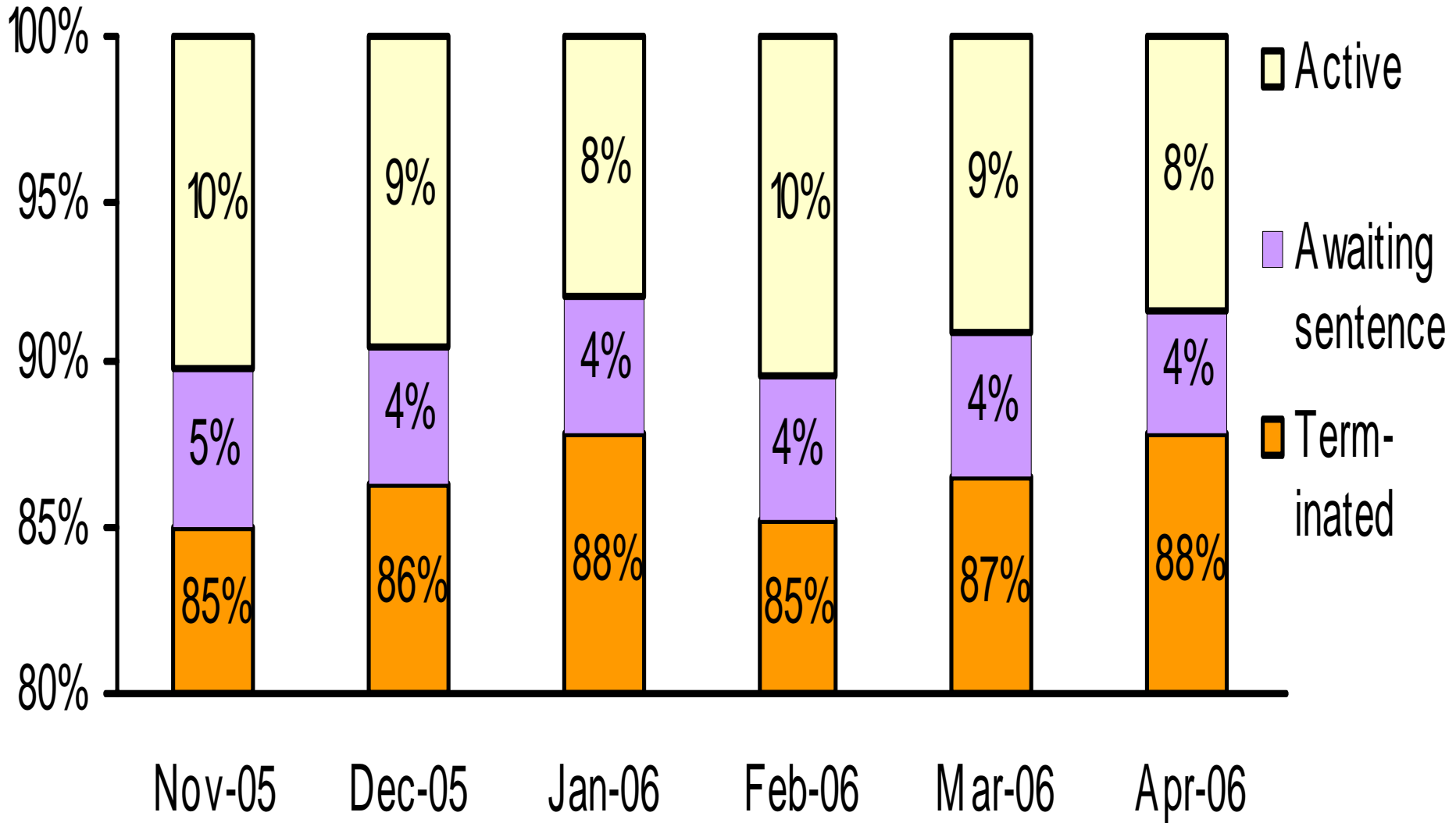
Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter

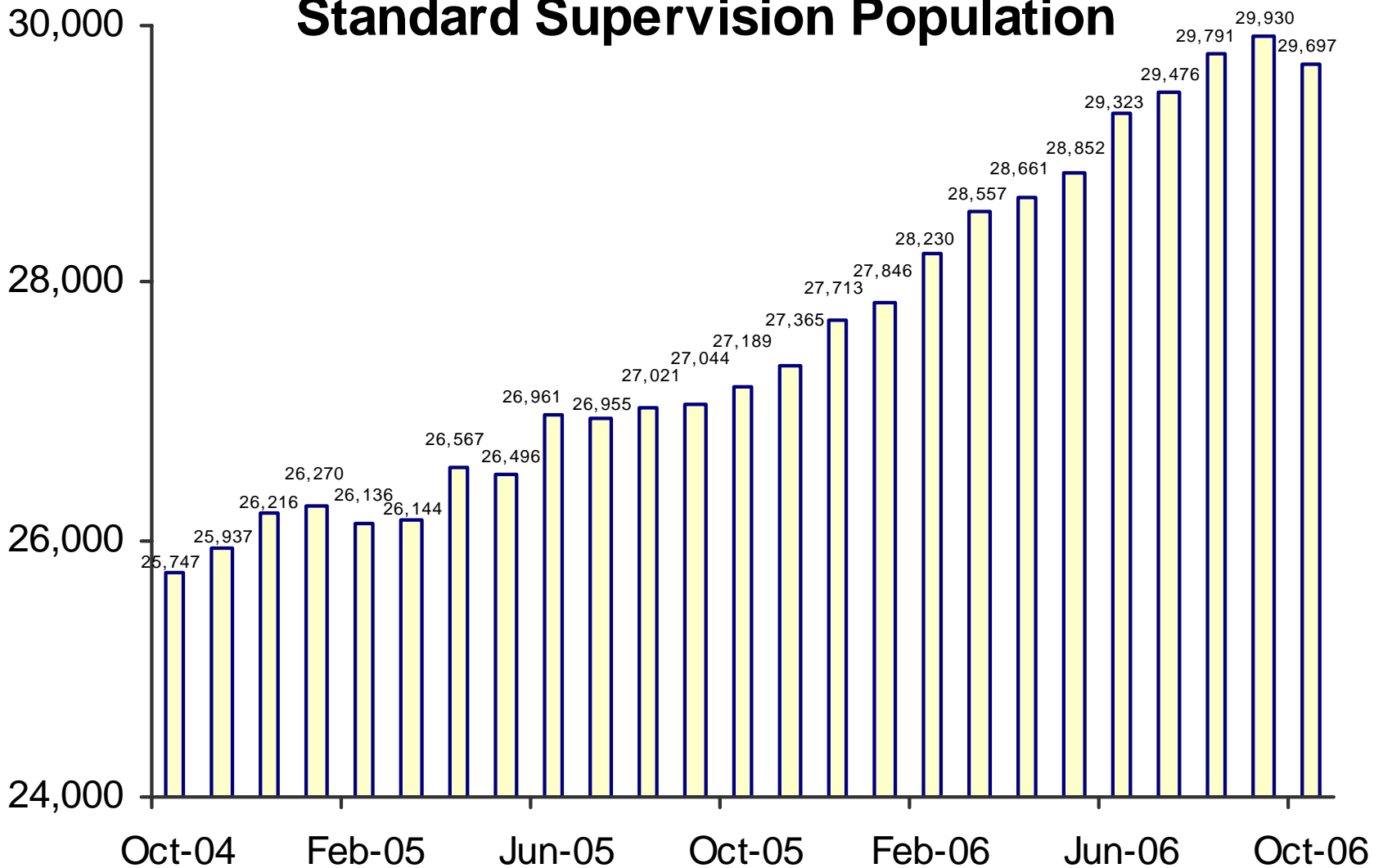

Status of Cases After 180 Days

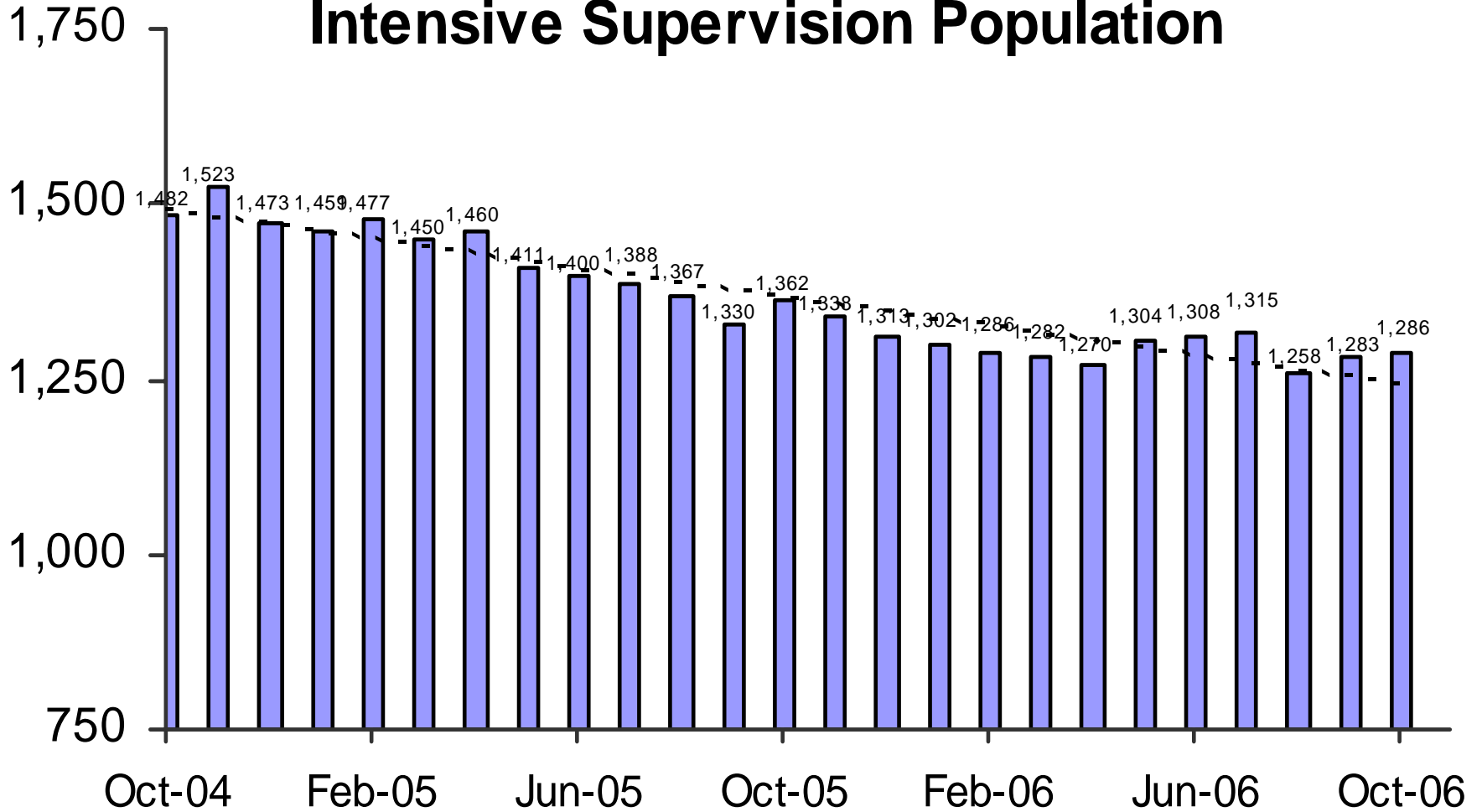


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

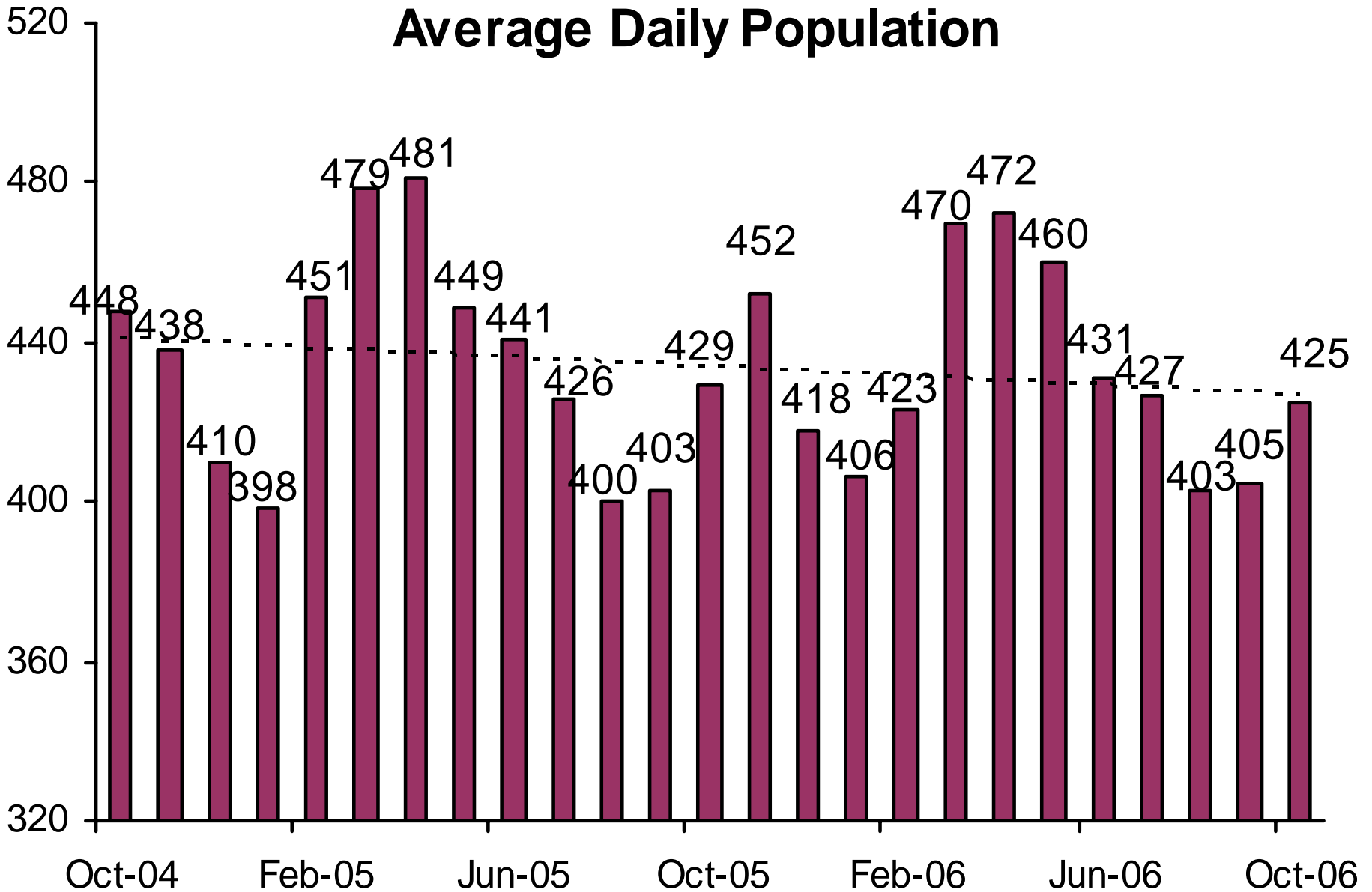

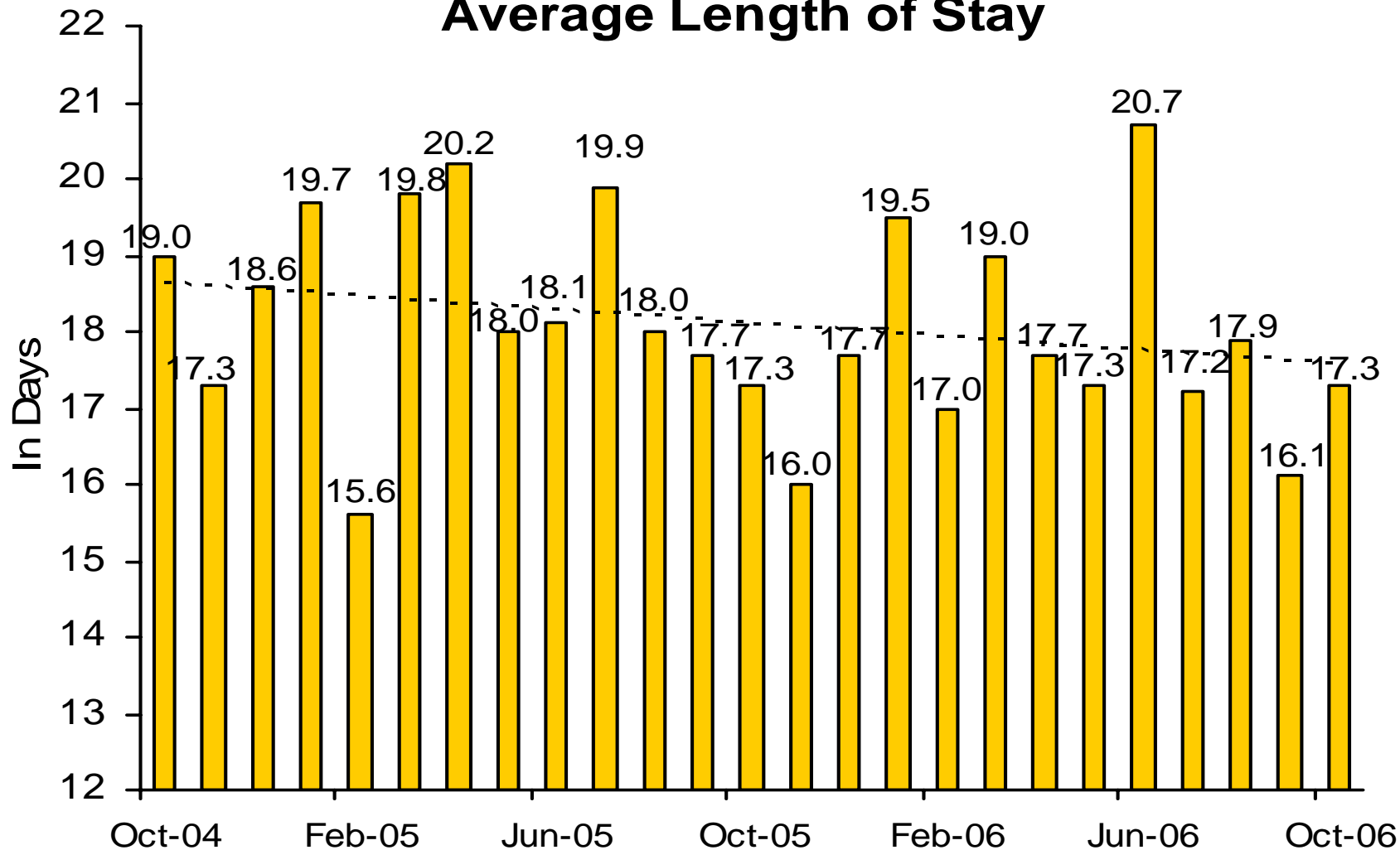
Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population



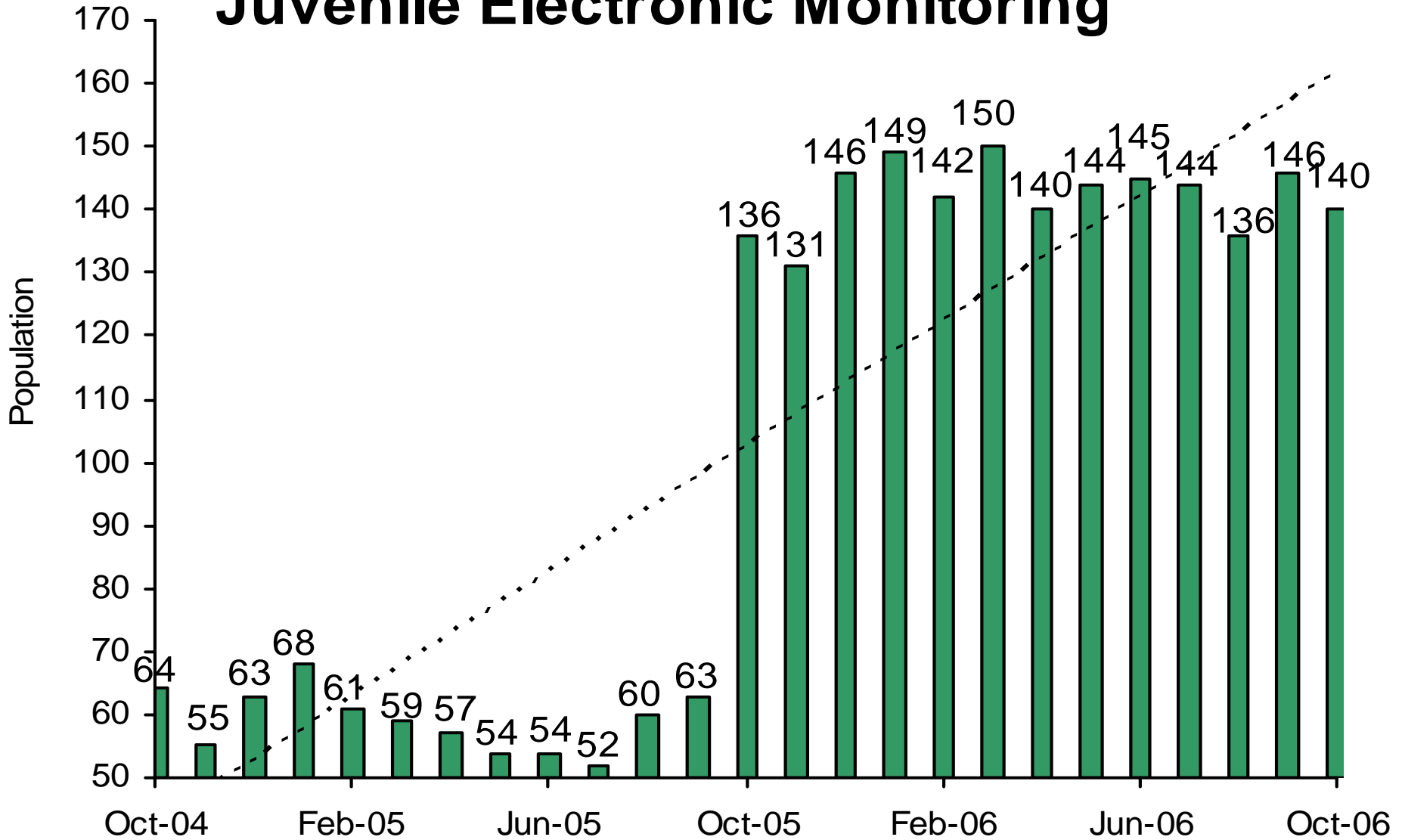
Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay

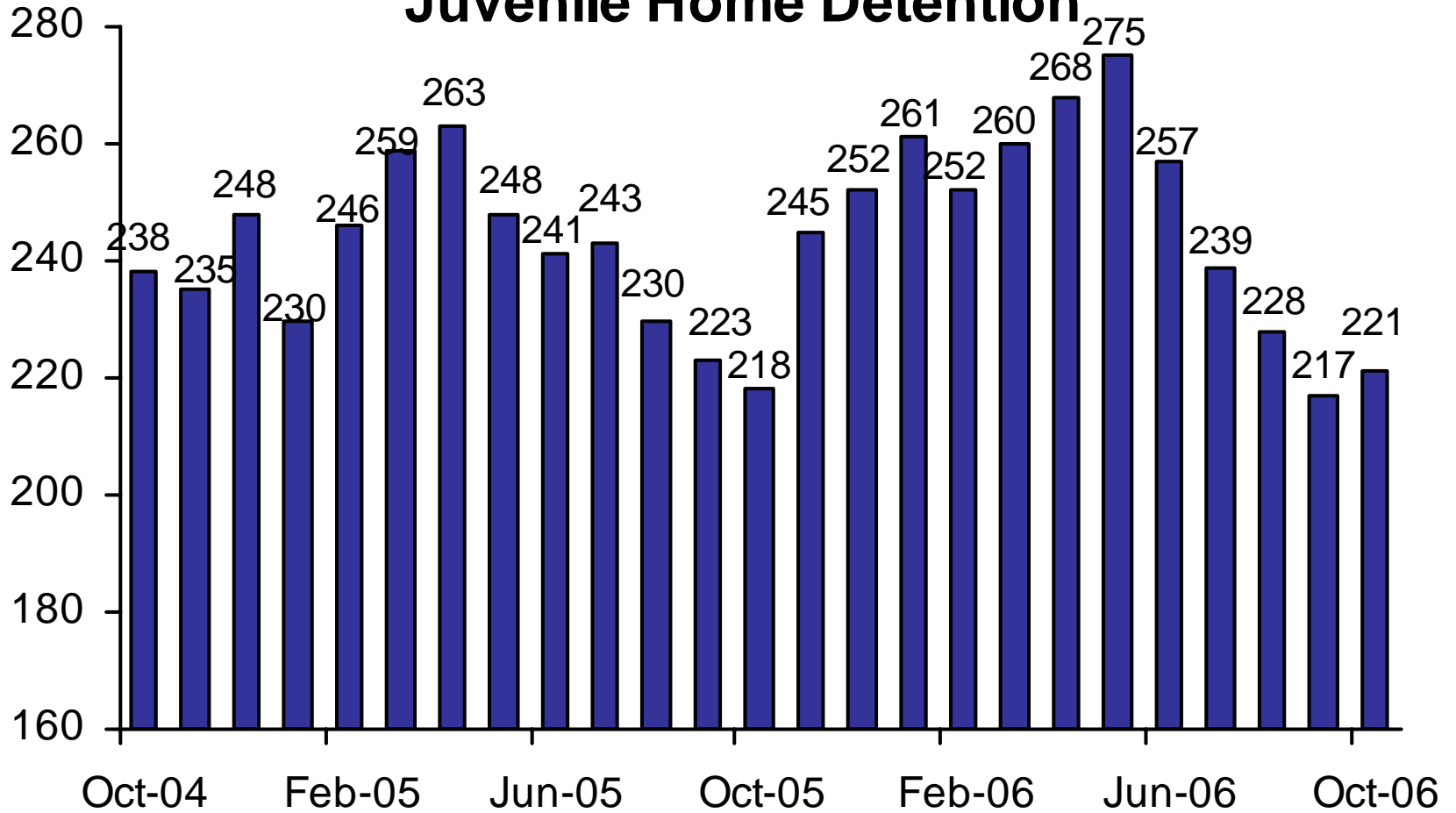


Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
