CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes –January 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 7,851 in December to 8,900 in January.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 7,746 in December to 7,877 in January.
- The **Pretrial ADP increased** from 5,895 in December to 6,000 in January.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,619 in December to 1,639 in January.
- The **Agency Hold ADP increased** from 177 in December to 189 in January.
- The **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release increased** from 27.5 in Dec to 28.3 in Jan.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial increased** from 7.3 in December to 8.7 in January.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 27.5 in December to 24.4 in January.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 79.3 in December to 76.1 in January.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,155 in December to 2,317 in January.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,215 in December to 2,796 in January.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 121%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,527 in December to 11,234 in January.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,264 in December to 1,380 in January.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 682 in December to 676 in January.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 34 in December to 52 in January.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.8%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 1,138 in December to 1,151 in January.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,346 in December to 4,010 in January.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 8,893 in December to 11,011 in January.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 4,868 in December to 5,477 in January.
- **Total Filings increased** from 25,795 in December to 28,869 in January.

Adult Probation

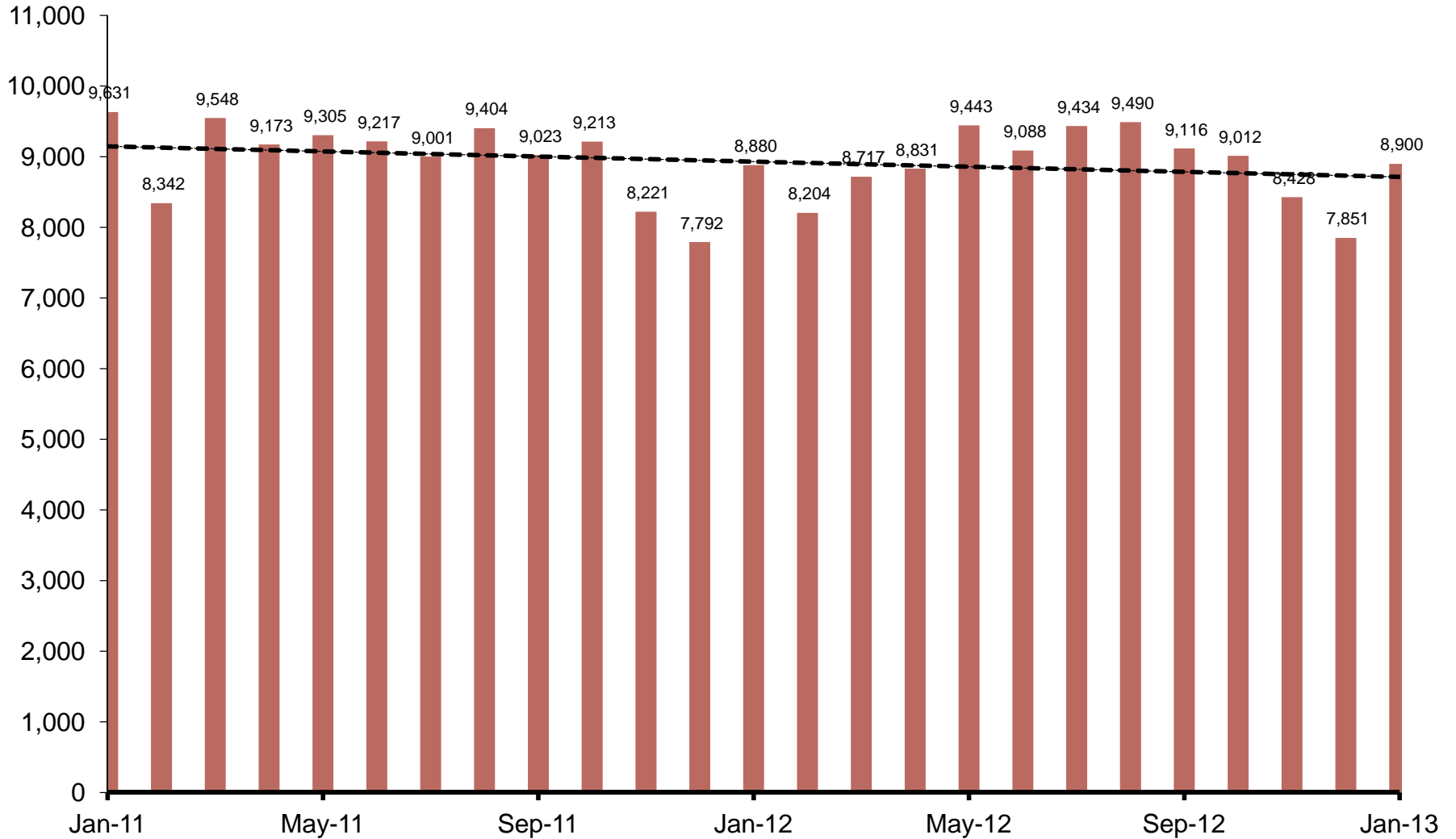
- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,741 in December to 2,219 in January.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 428 in December to 440 in January.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,530 in December to 21,367 in Jan.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased slightly** from 684 in December to 687 in Jan.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,406 in December to 7,374 in Jan.

Juvenile Detention and Probation

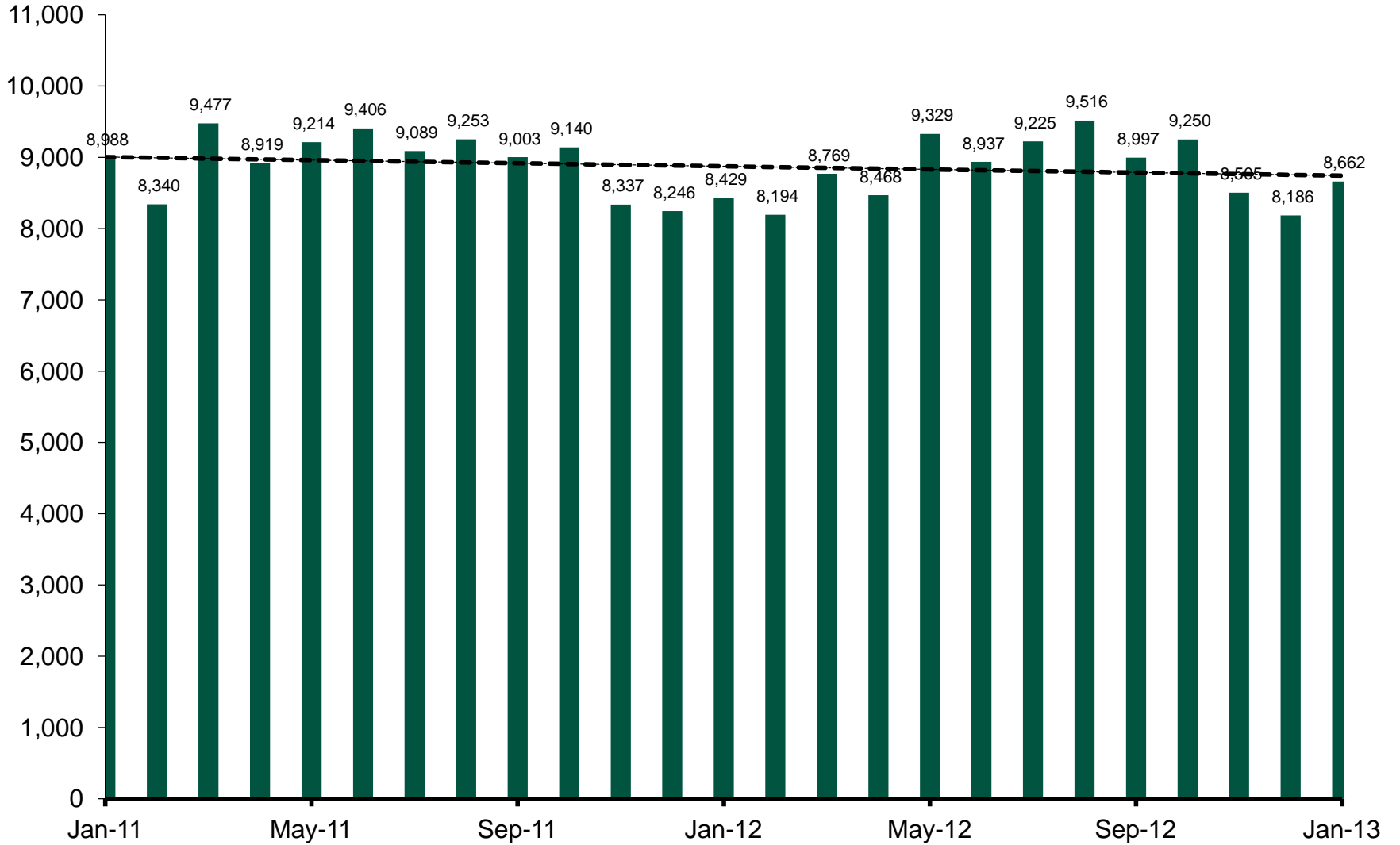
- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 188 in December to 176 in January.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 13.7 in December to 15.9 in January.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation increased** from 2,348 in December to 2,396 in January.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation decreased** from 227 in December to 212 in January.

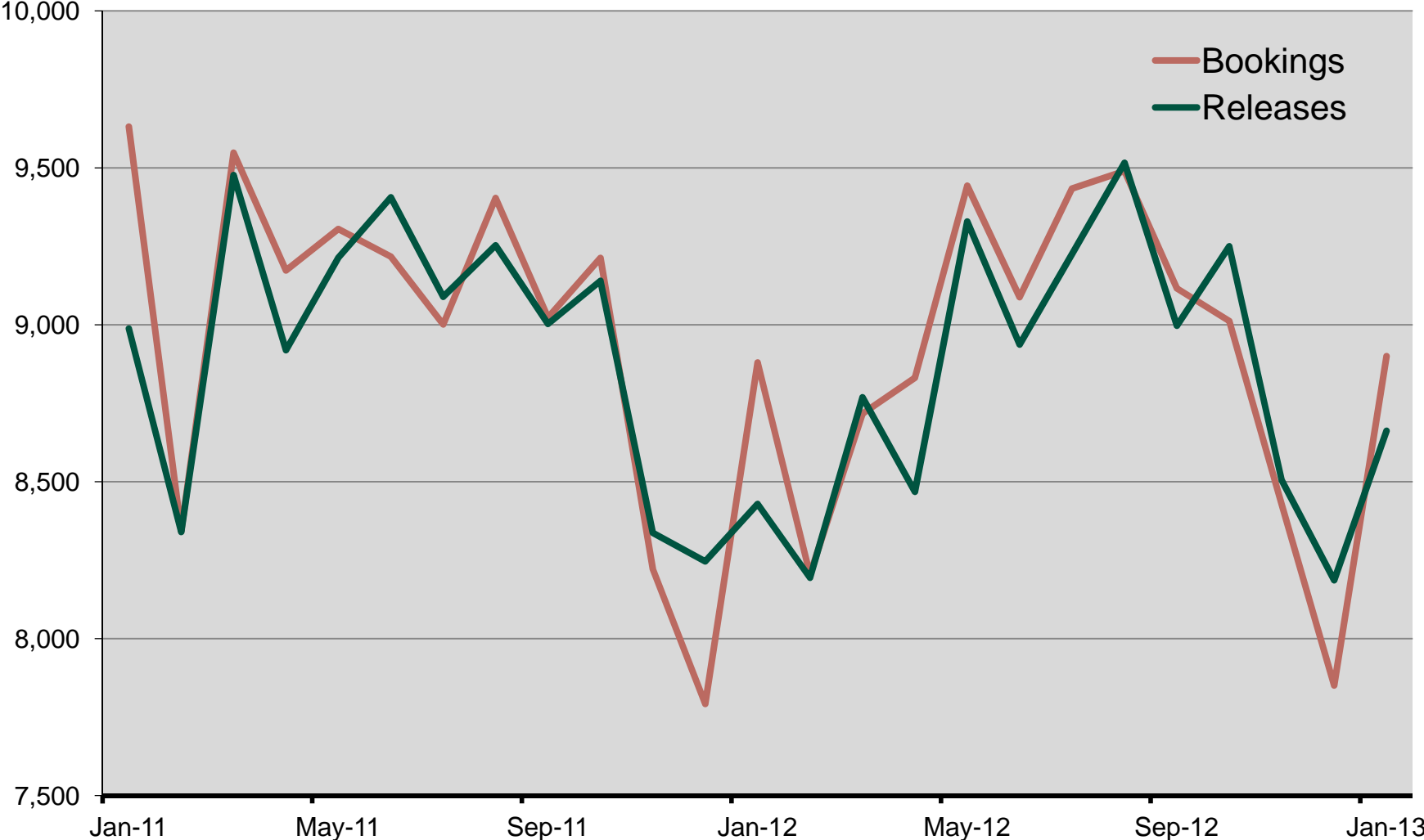

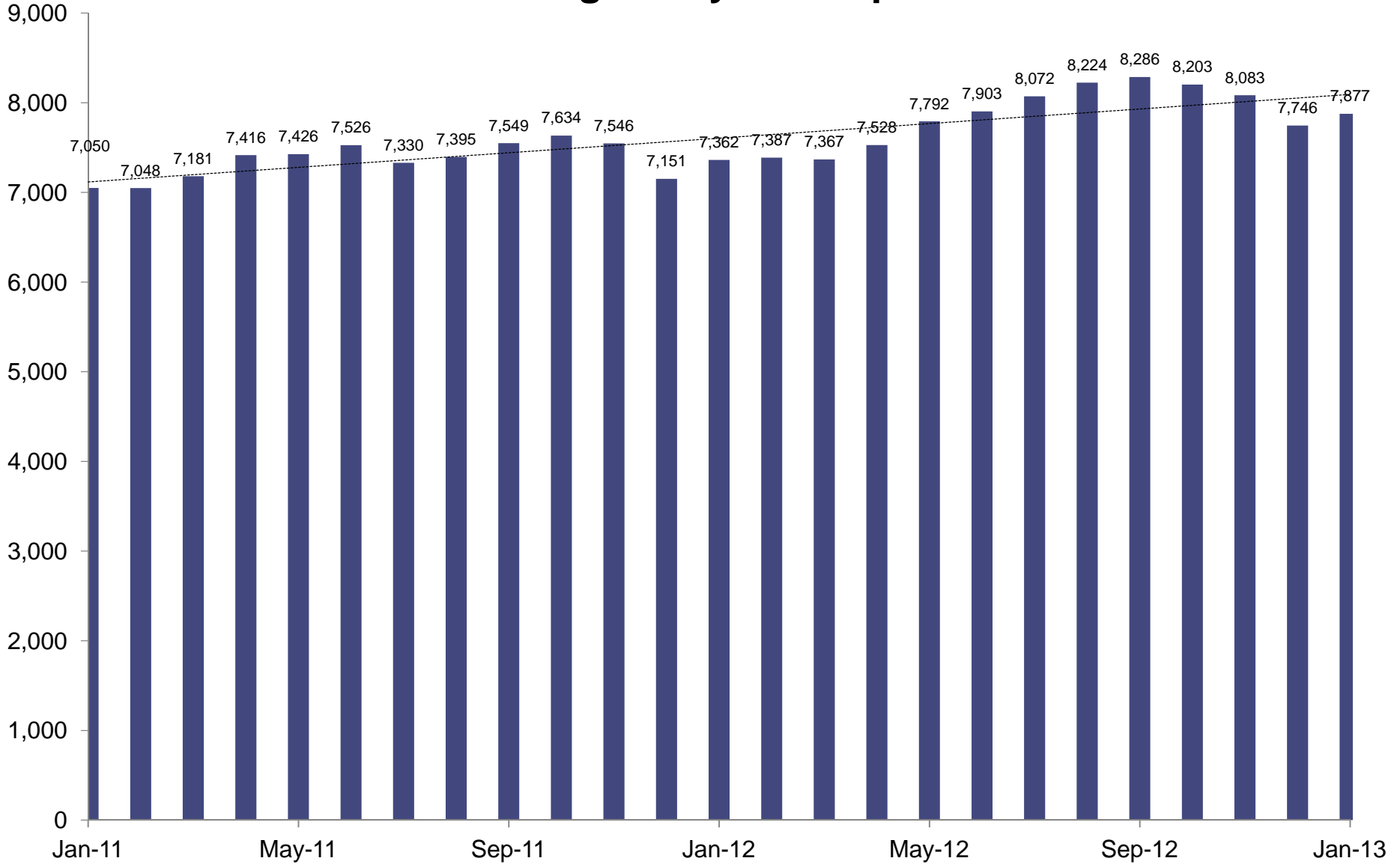
Jail Releases



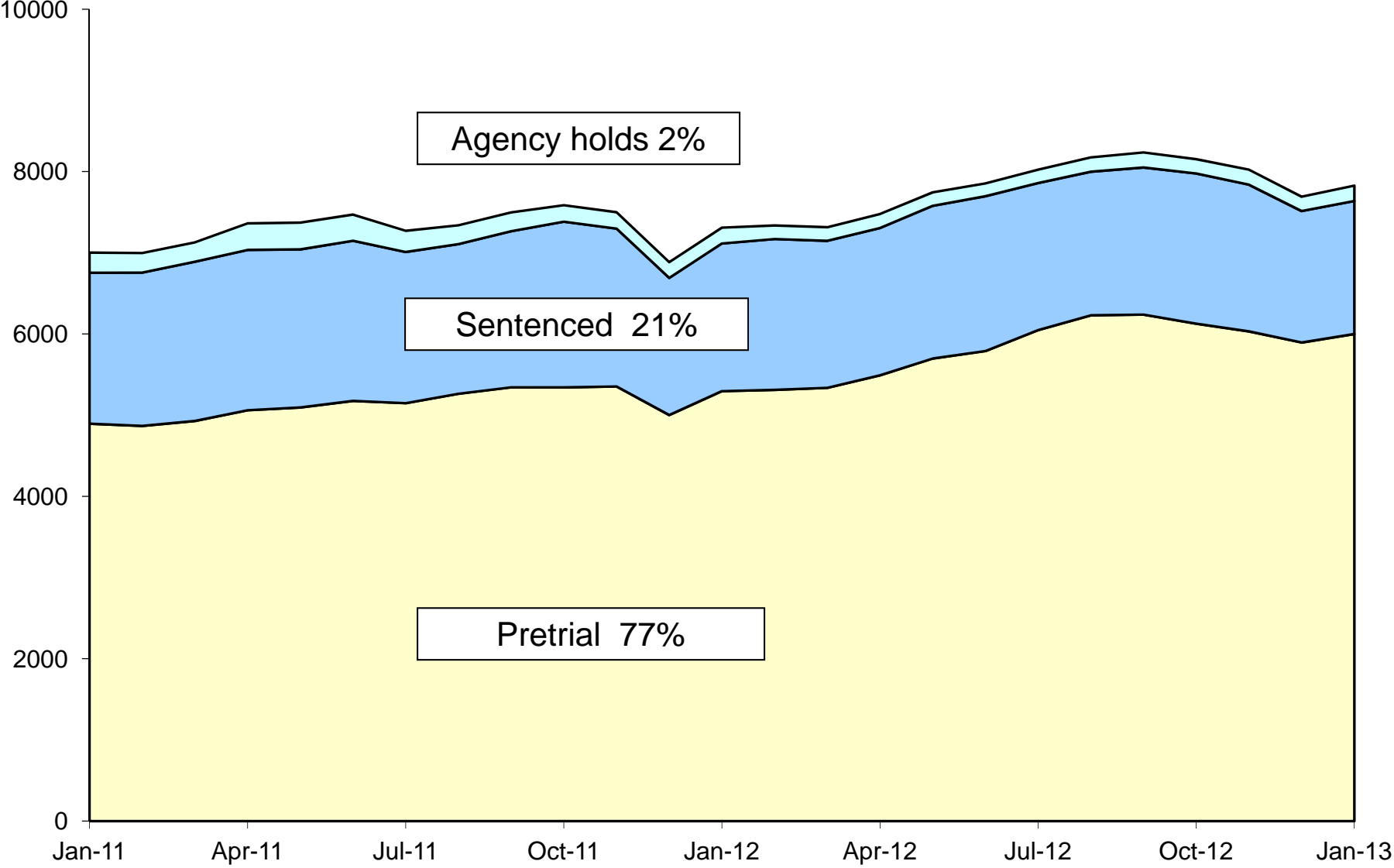
Jail Bookings and Releases



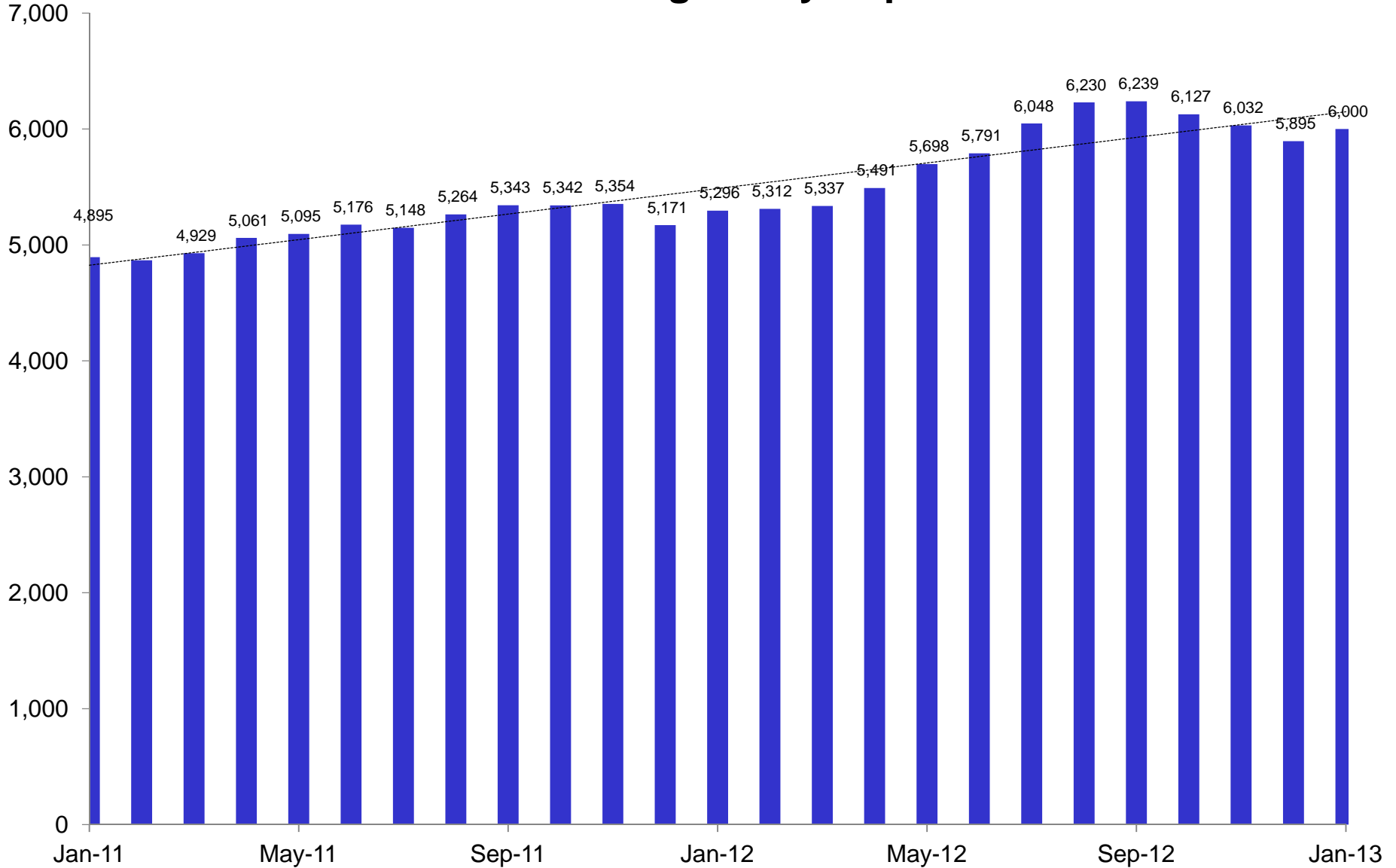
Average Daily Jail Population



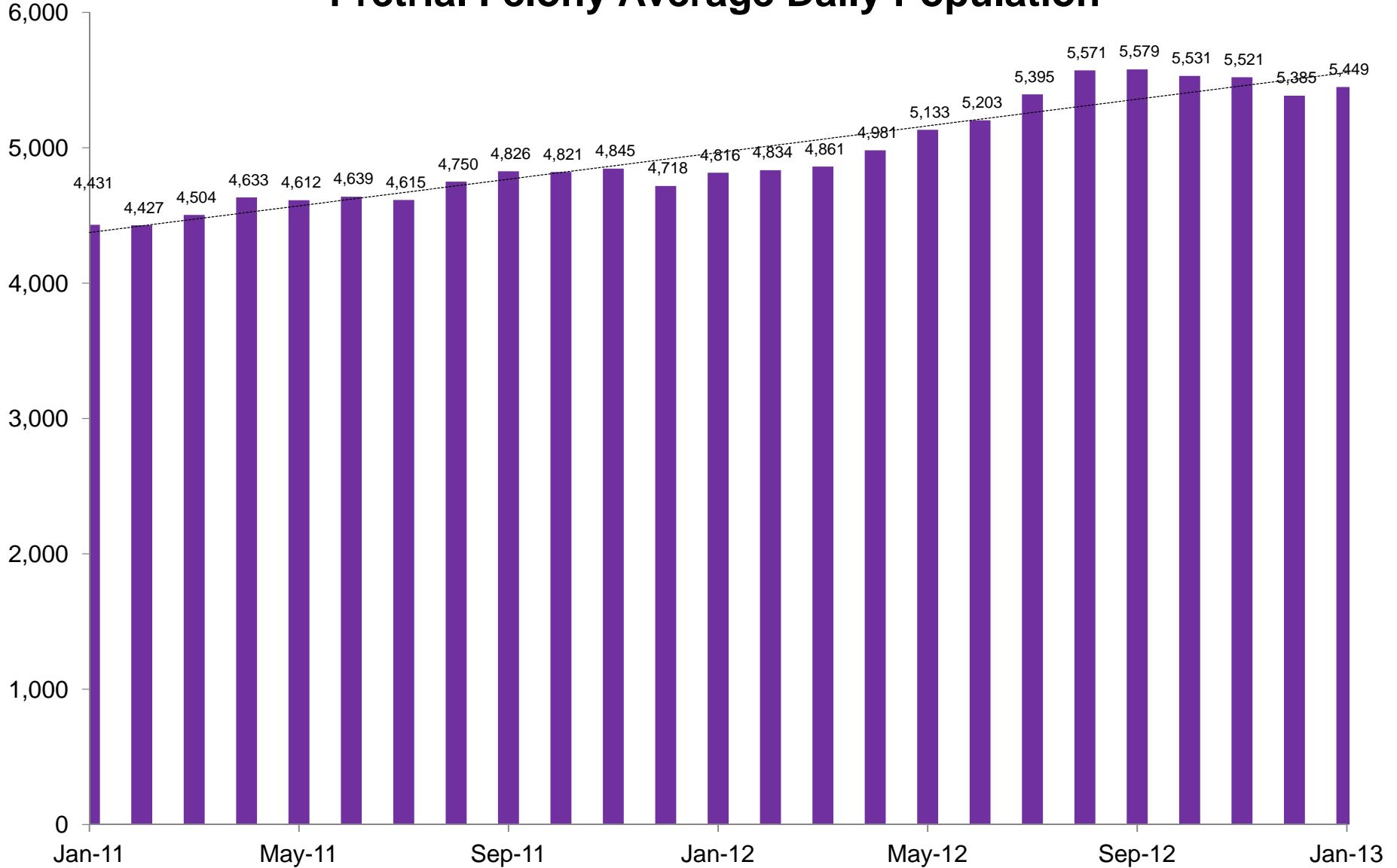
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



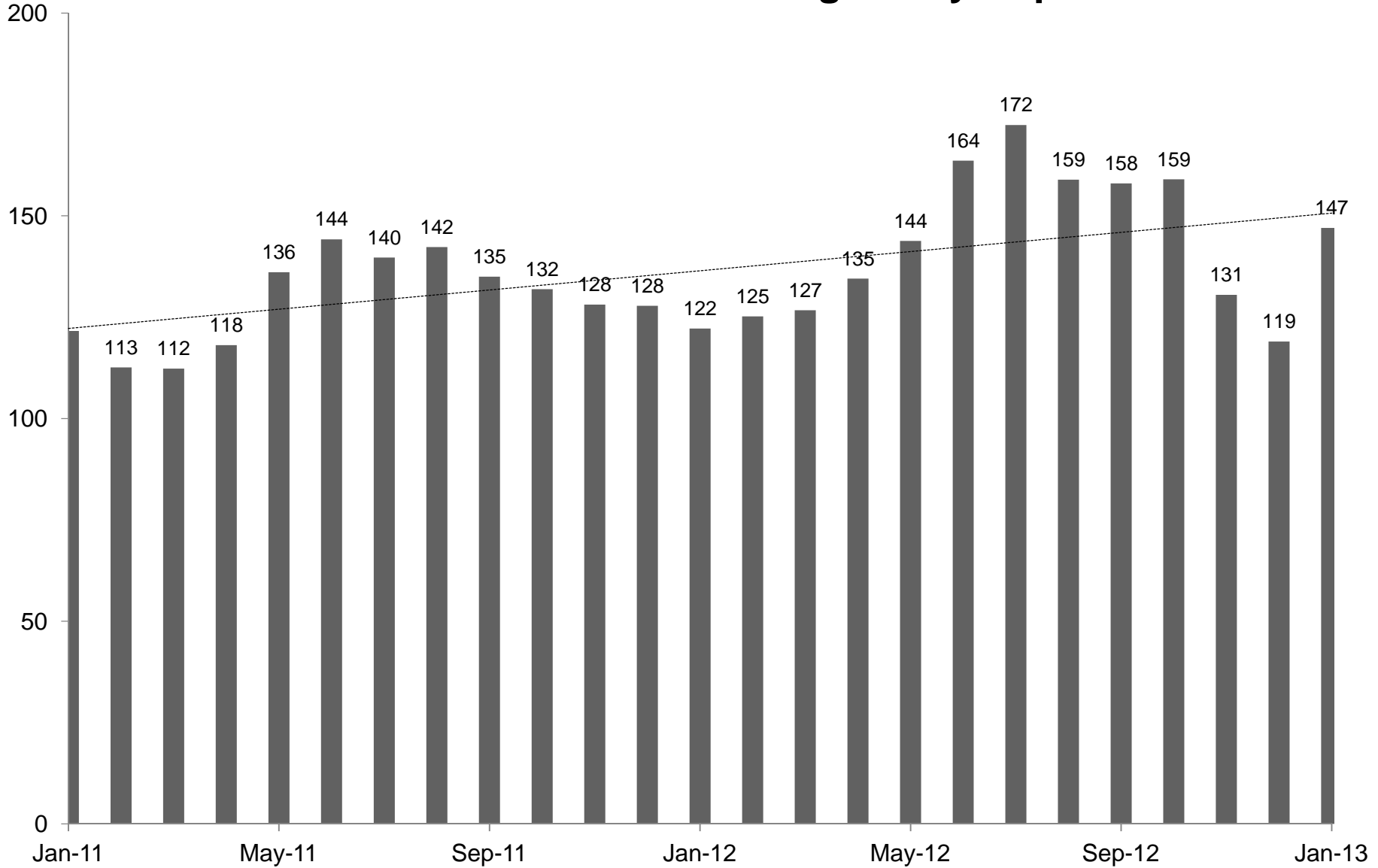
Pretrial Average Daily Population



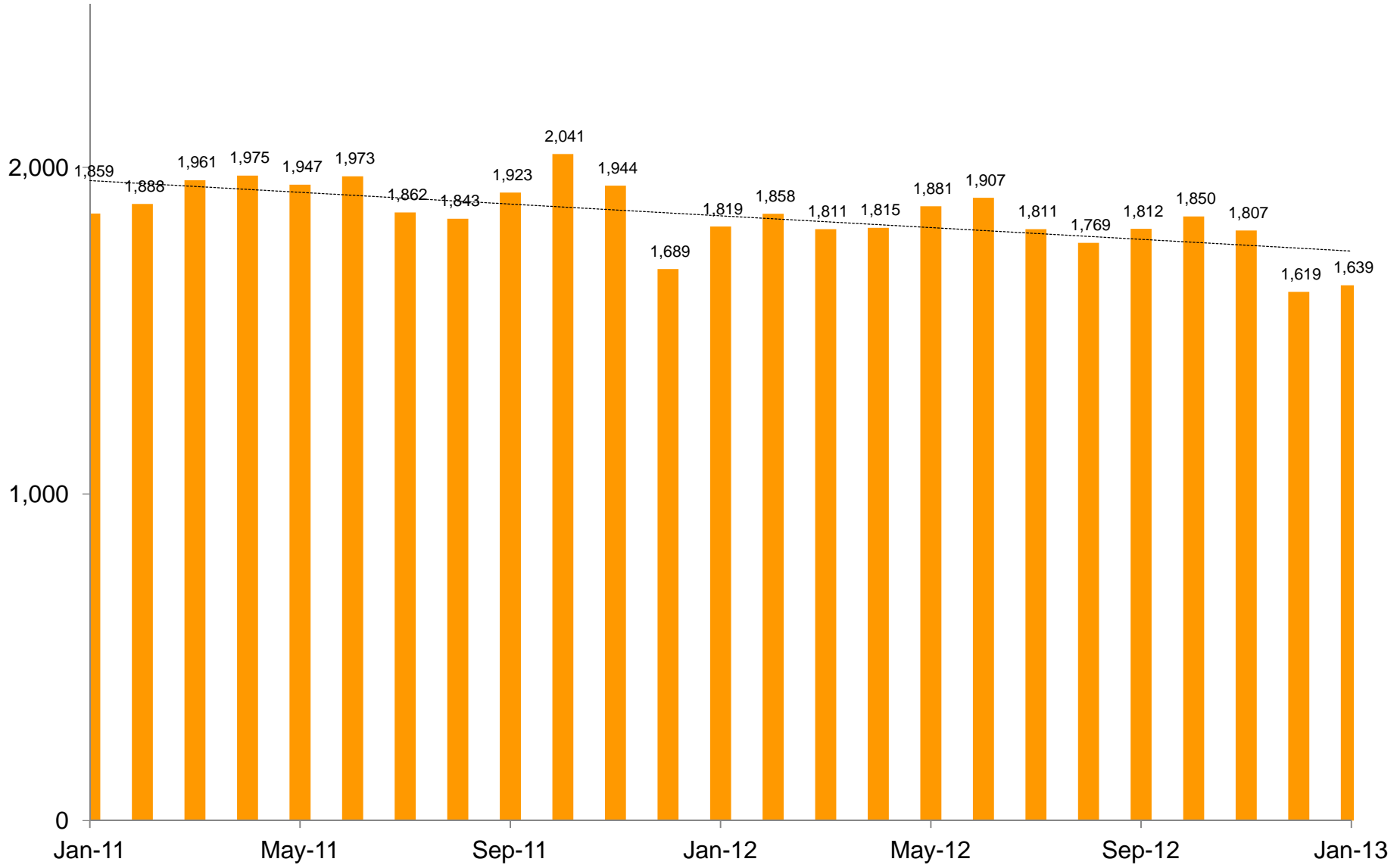
Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population



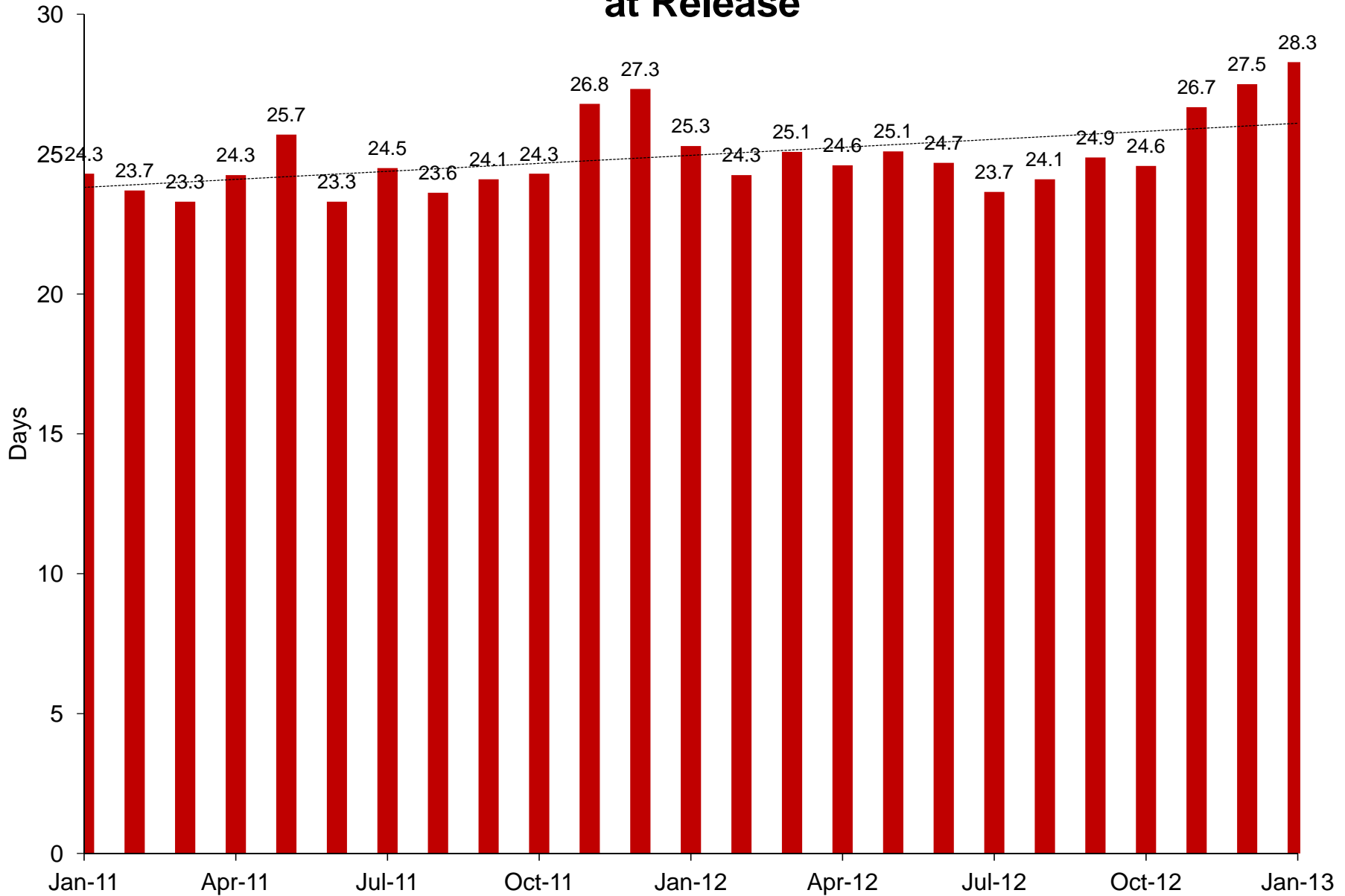
Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population



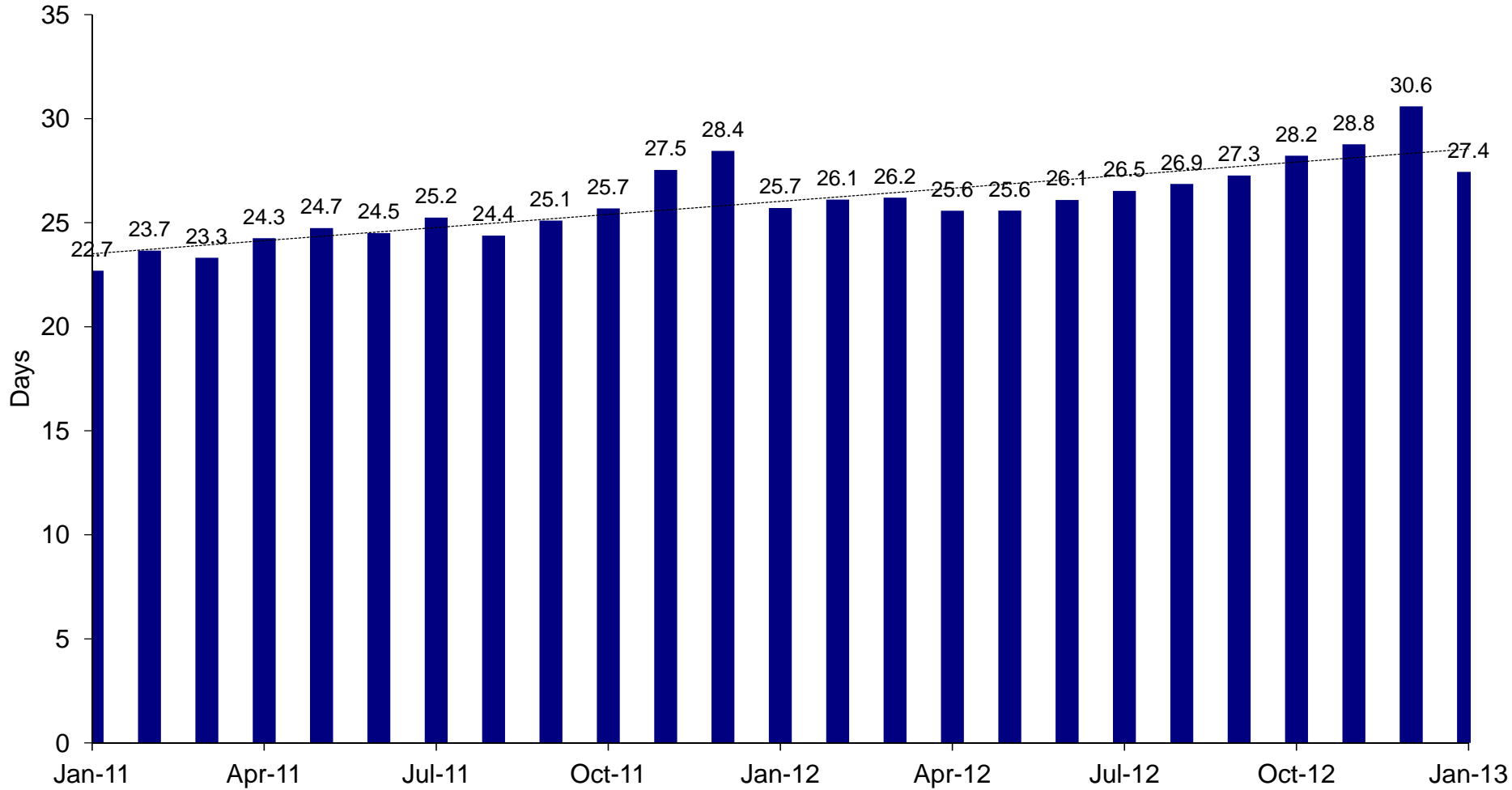
Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release

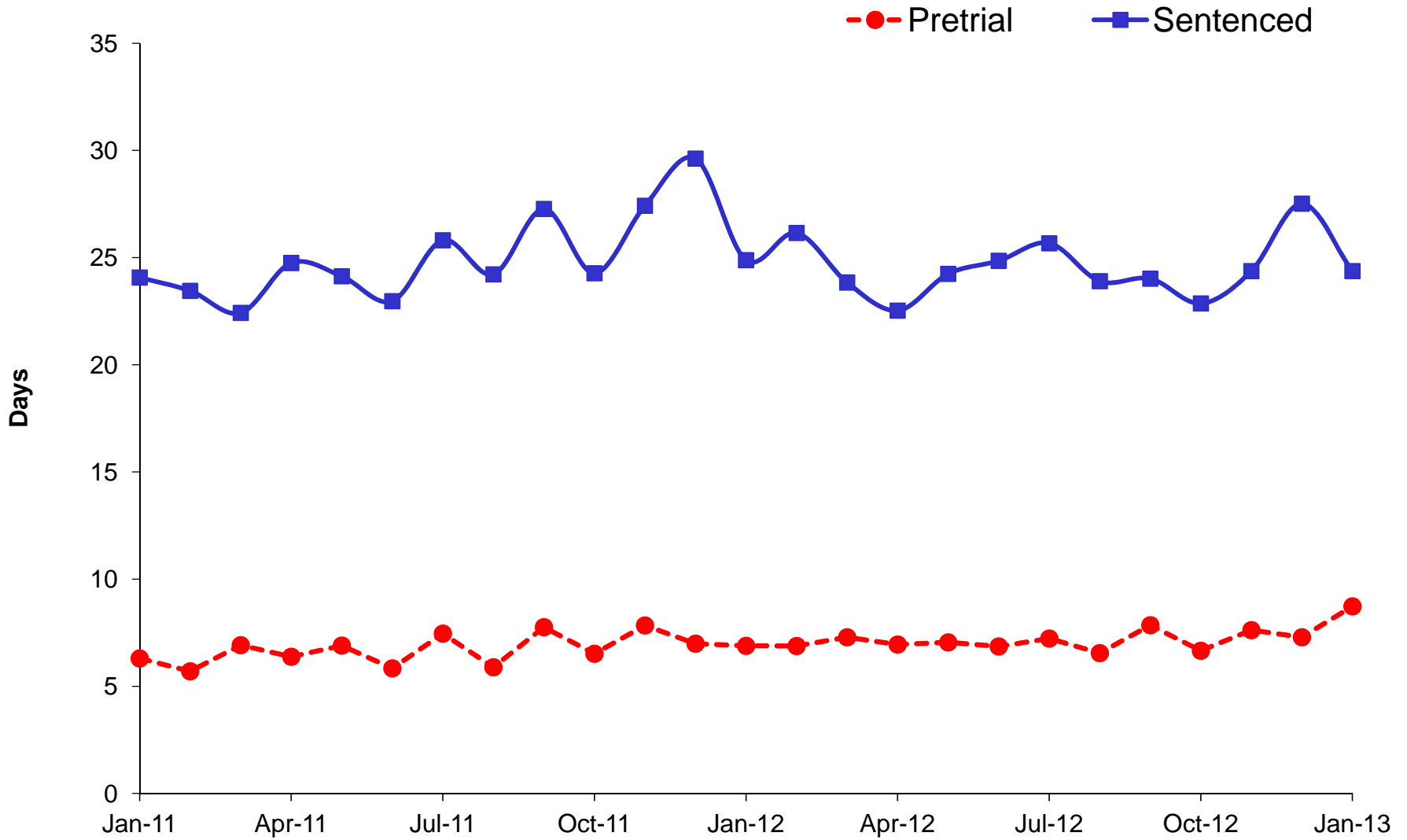


Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

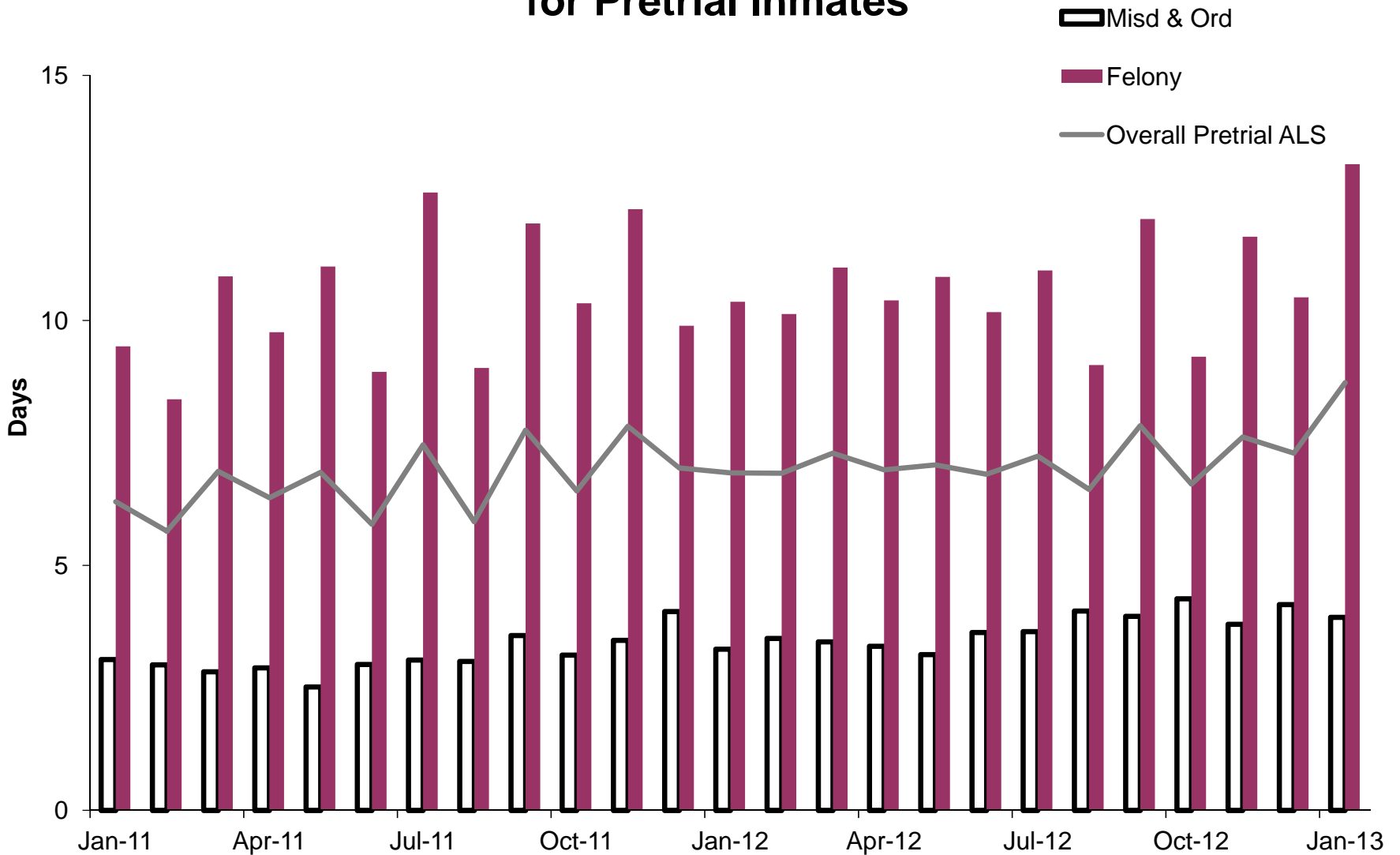

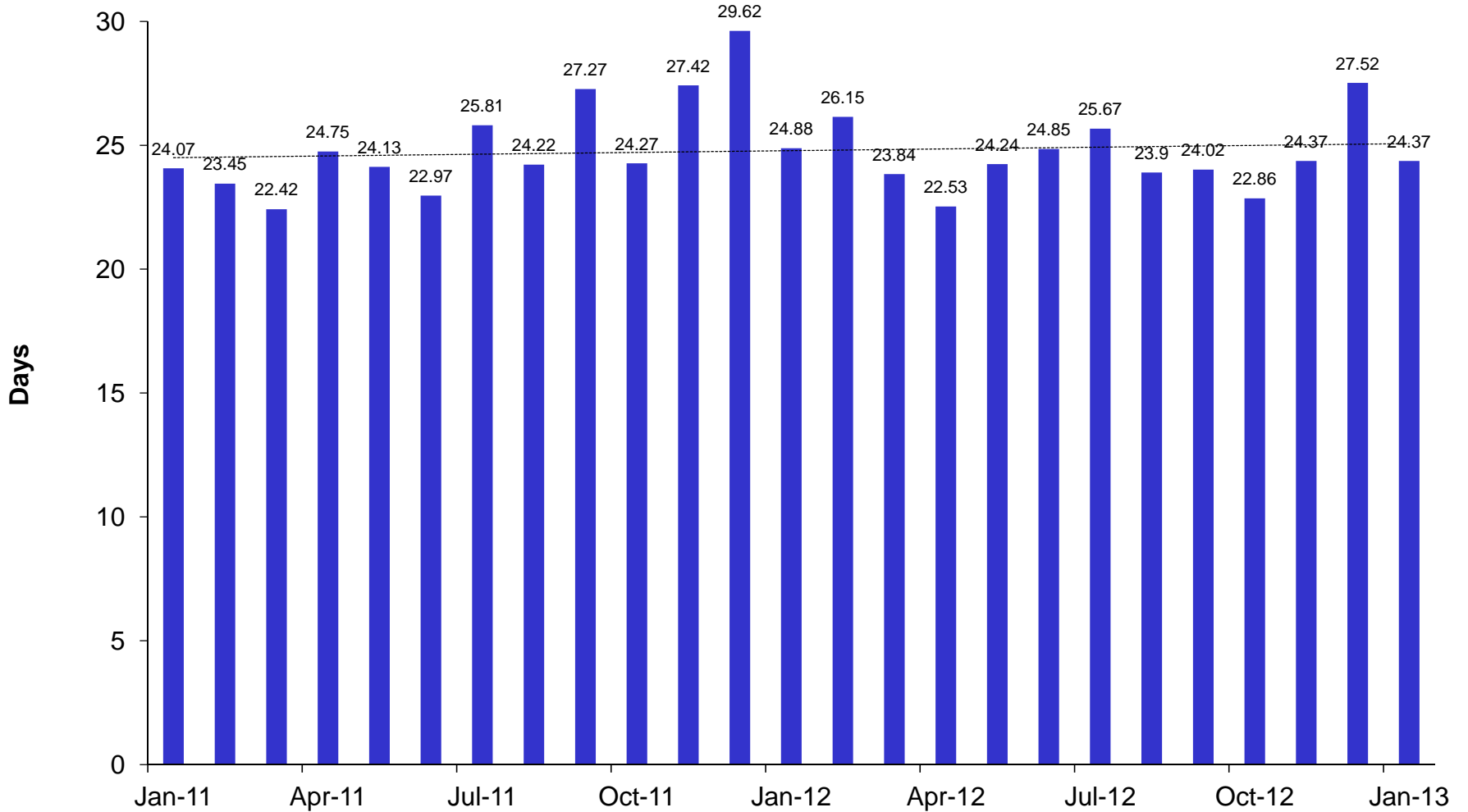
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates



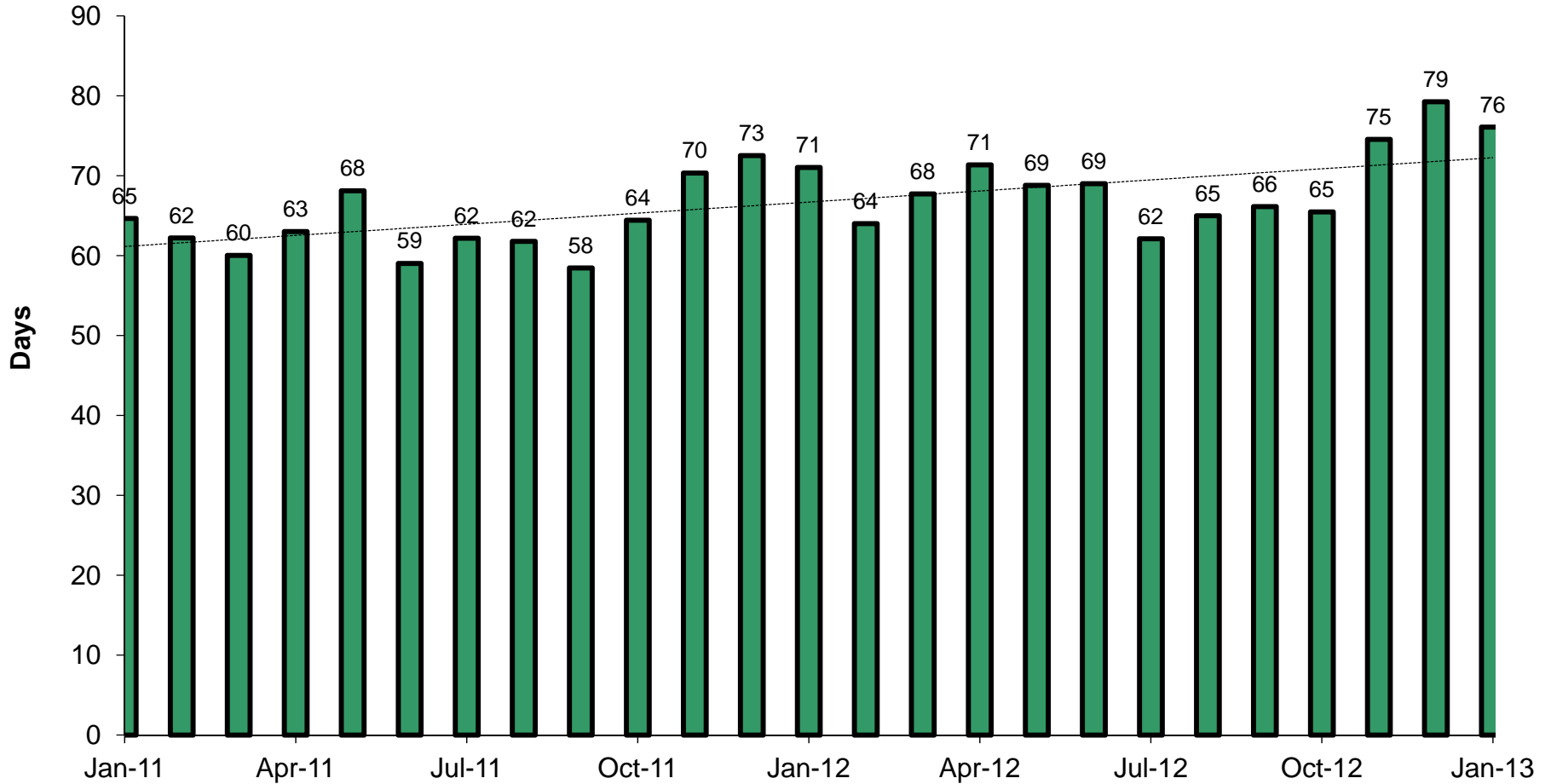
Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates

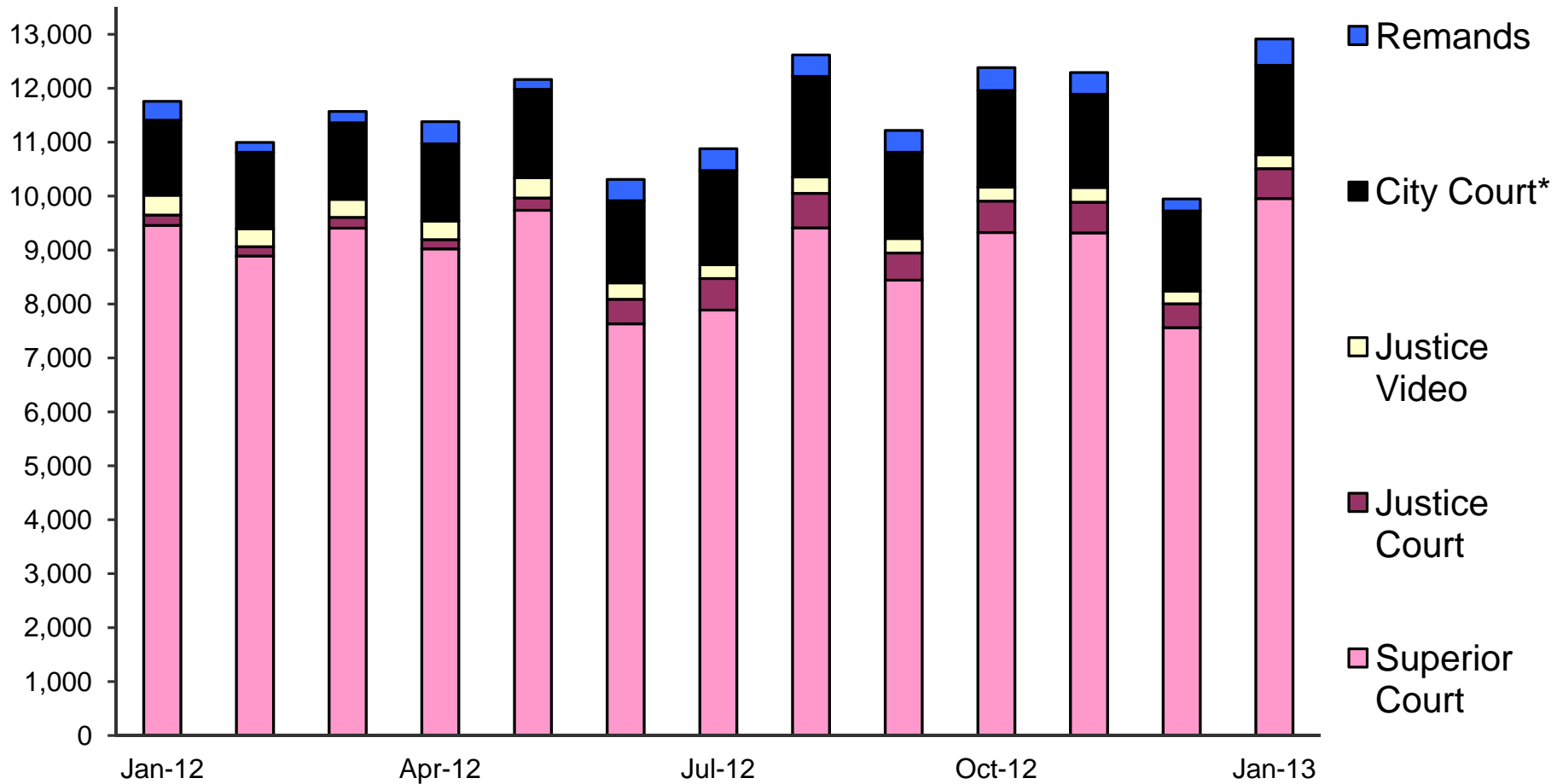


Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds



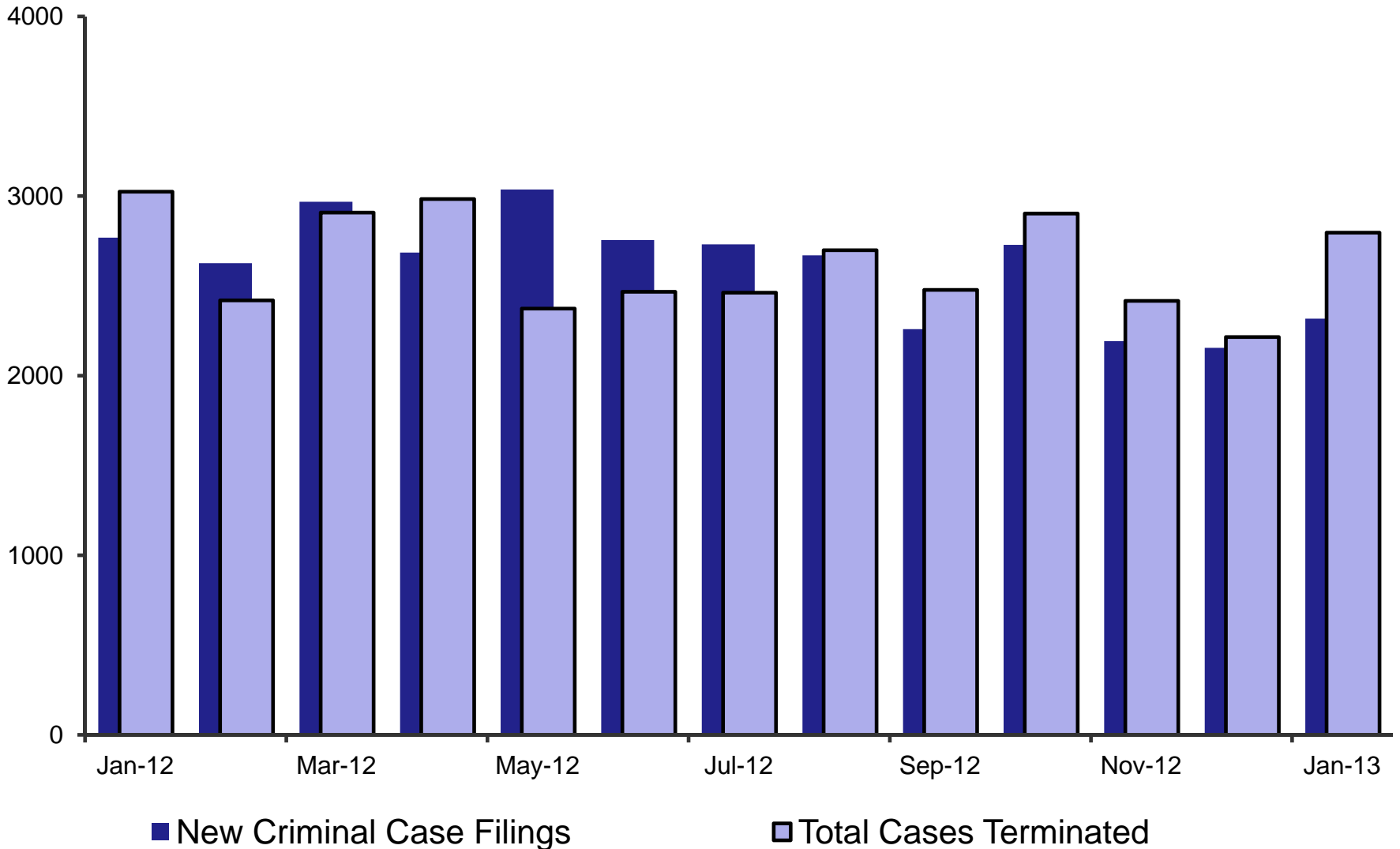

Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



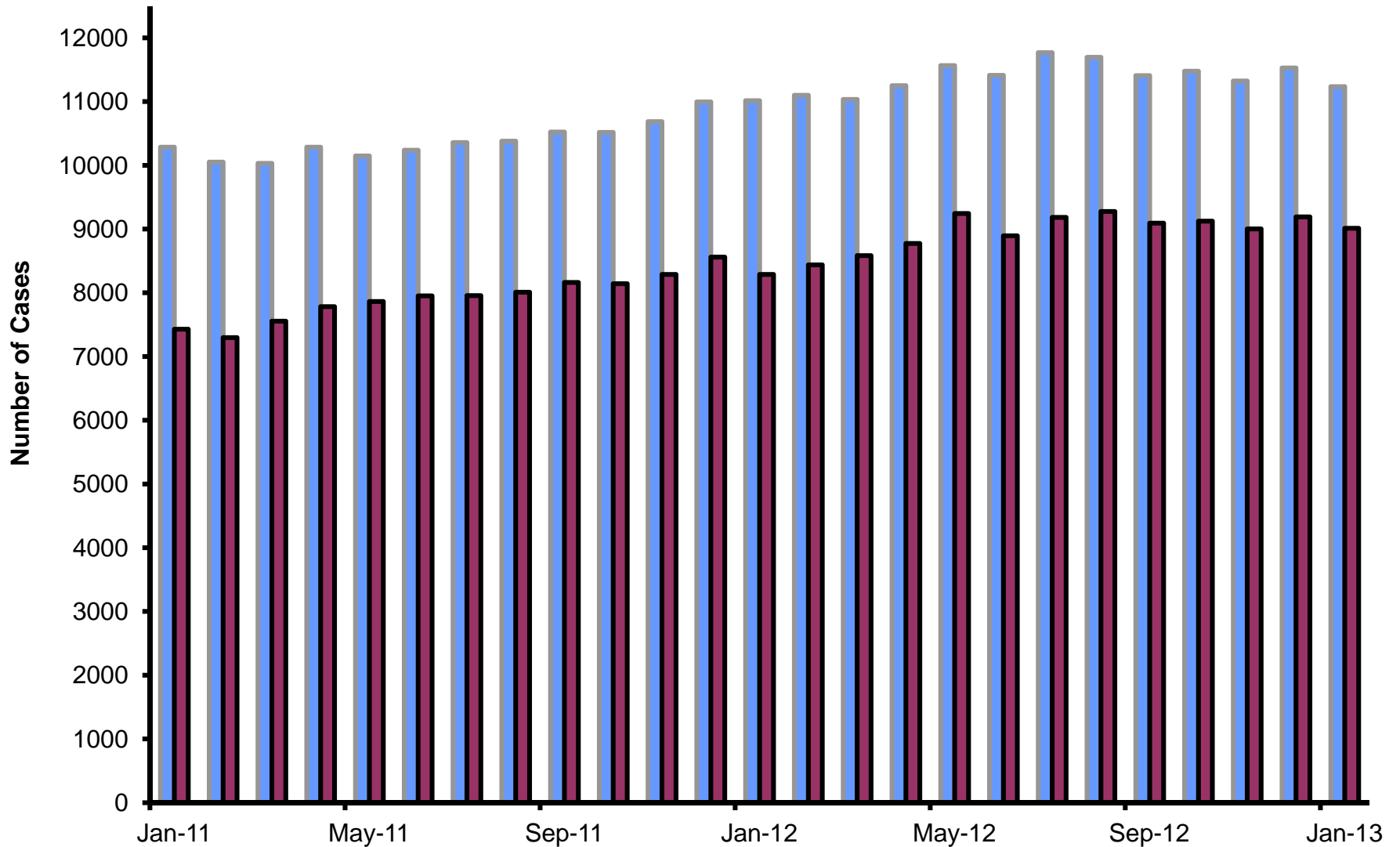

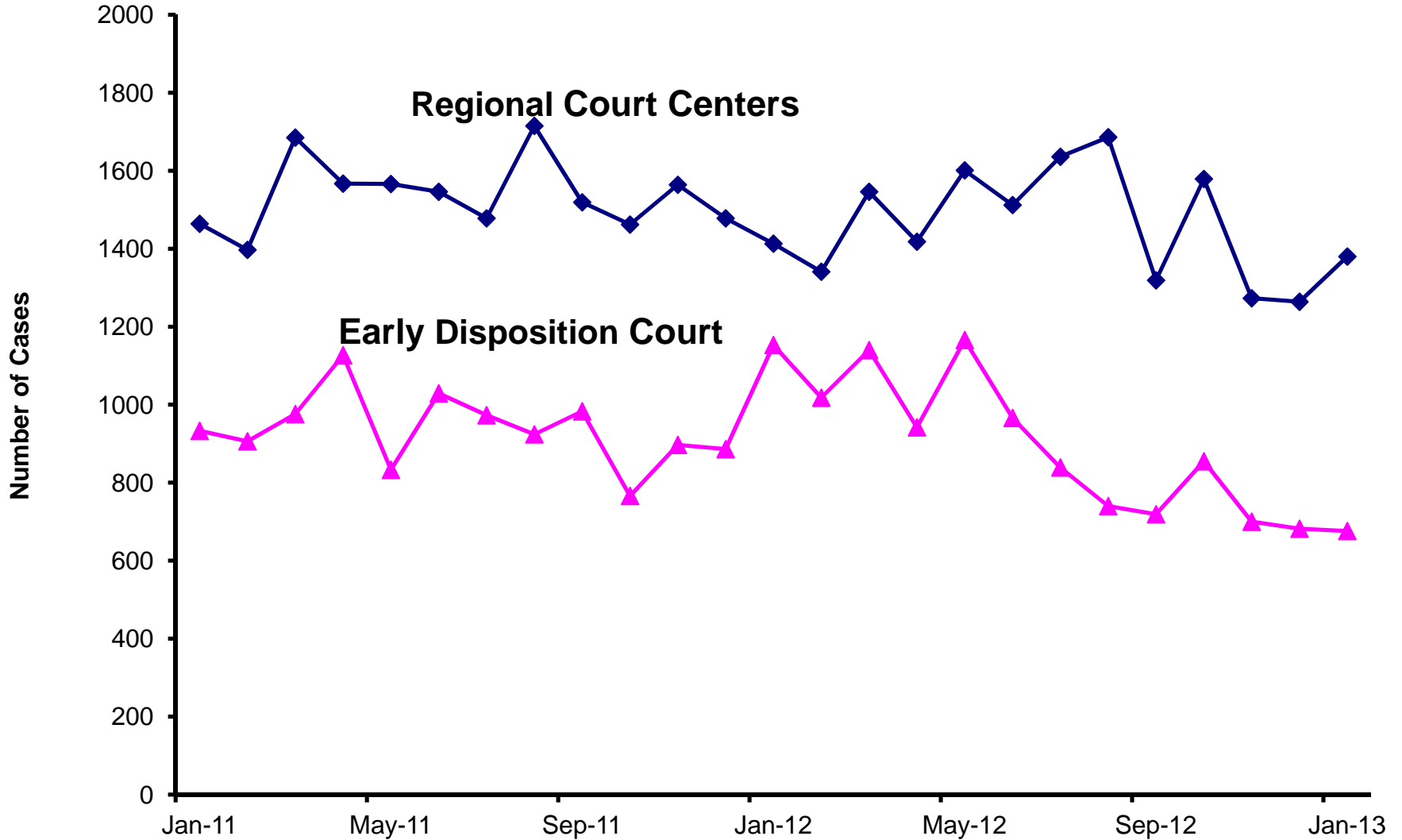


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

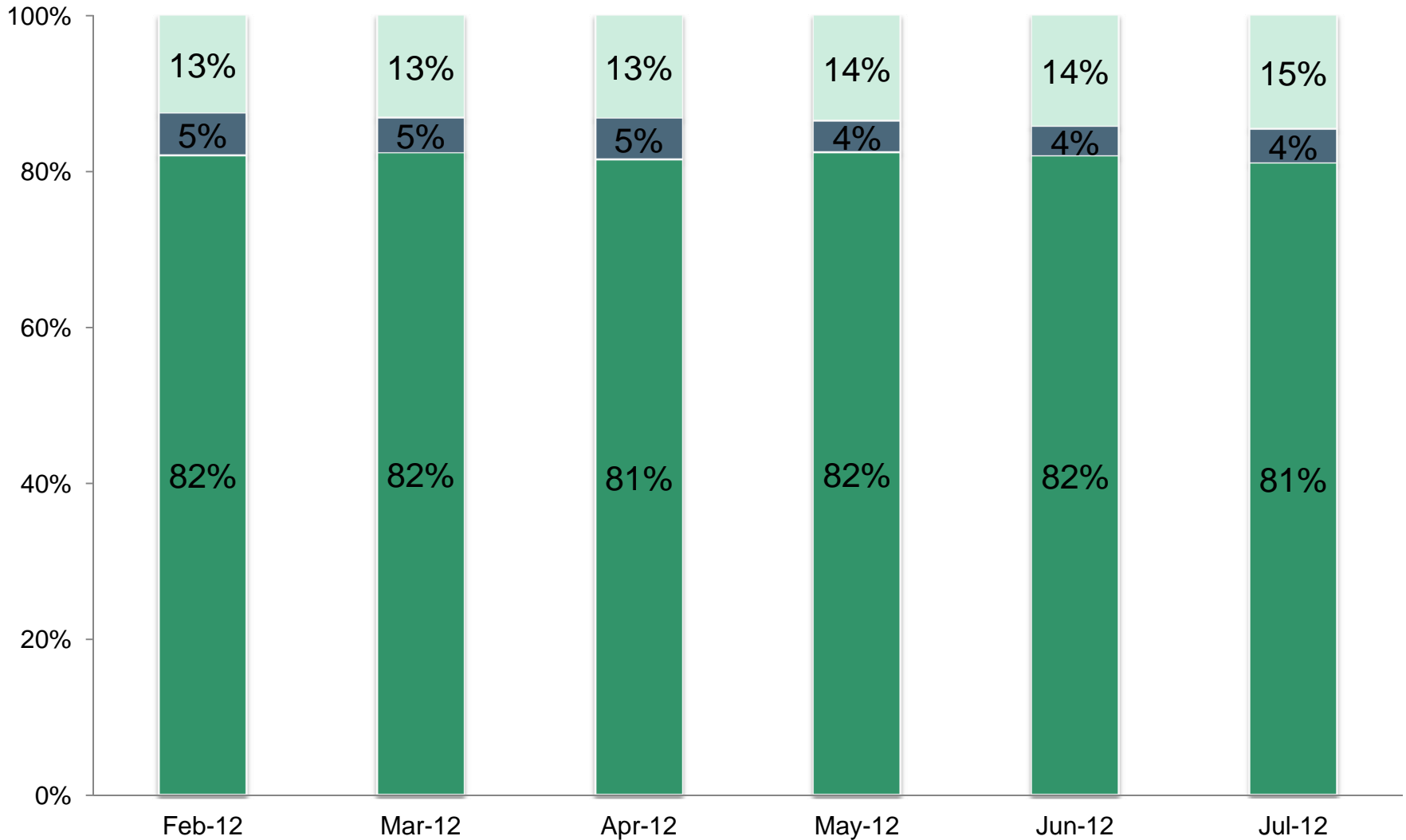


Status of Cases After 180 Days

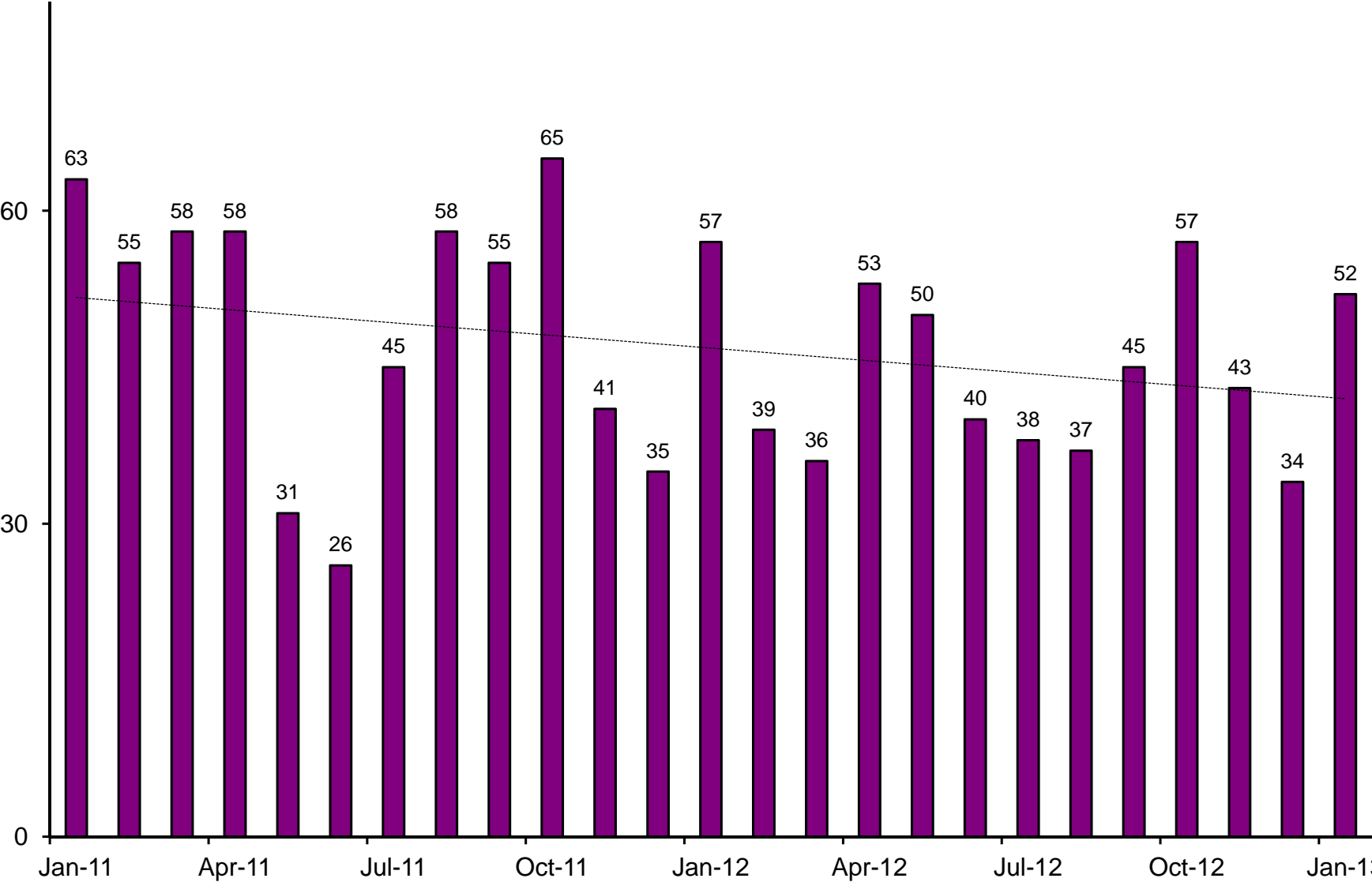

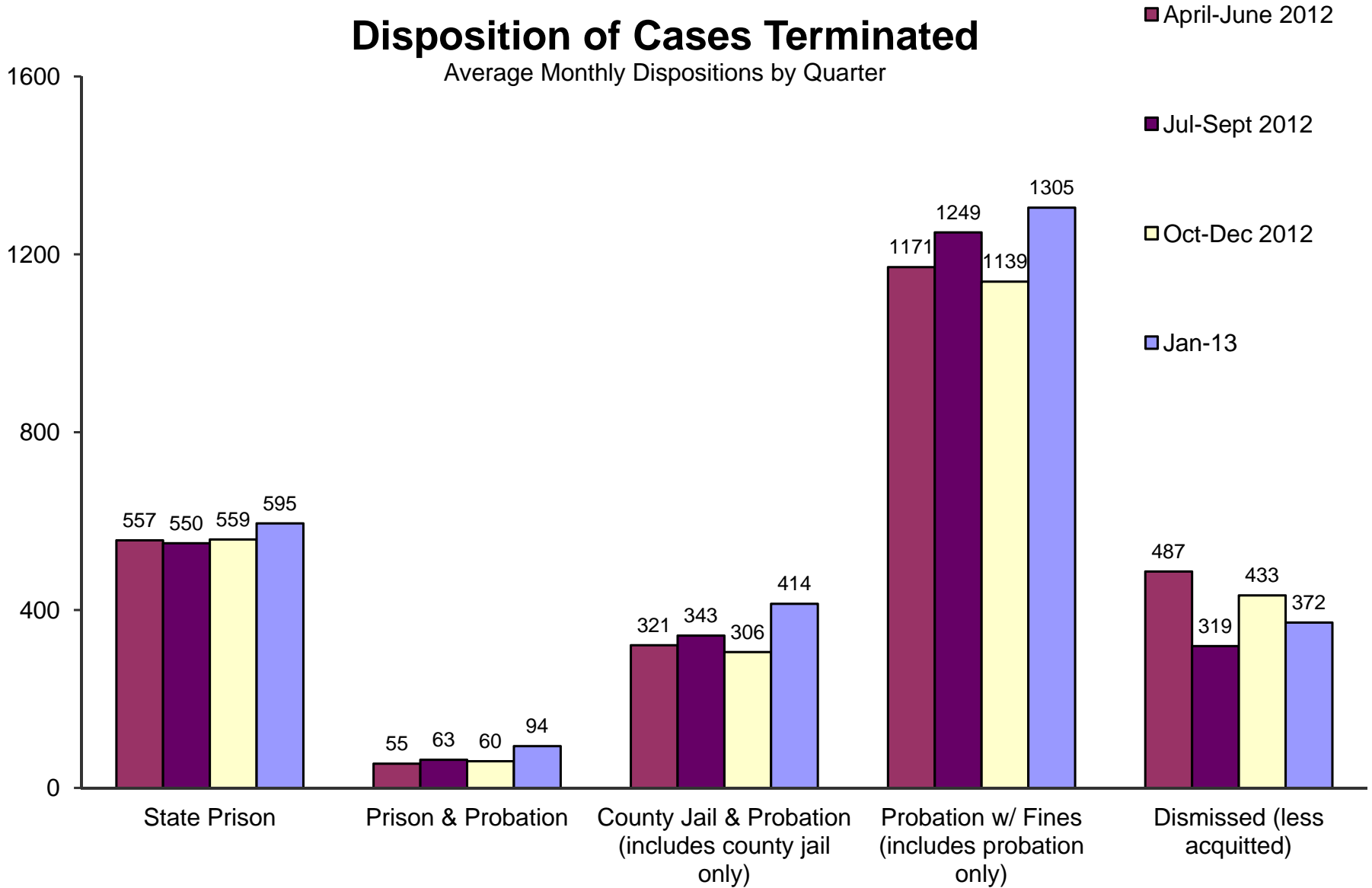


Superior Court Trials Completed

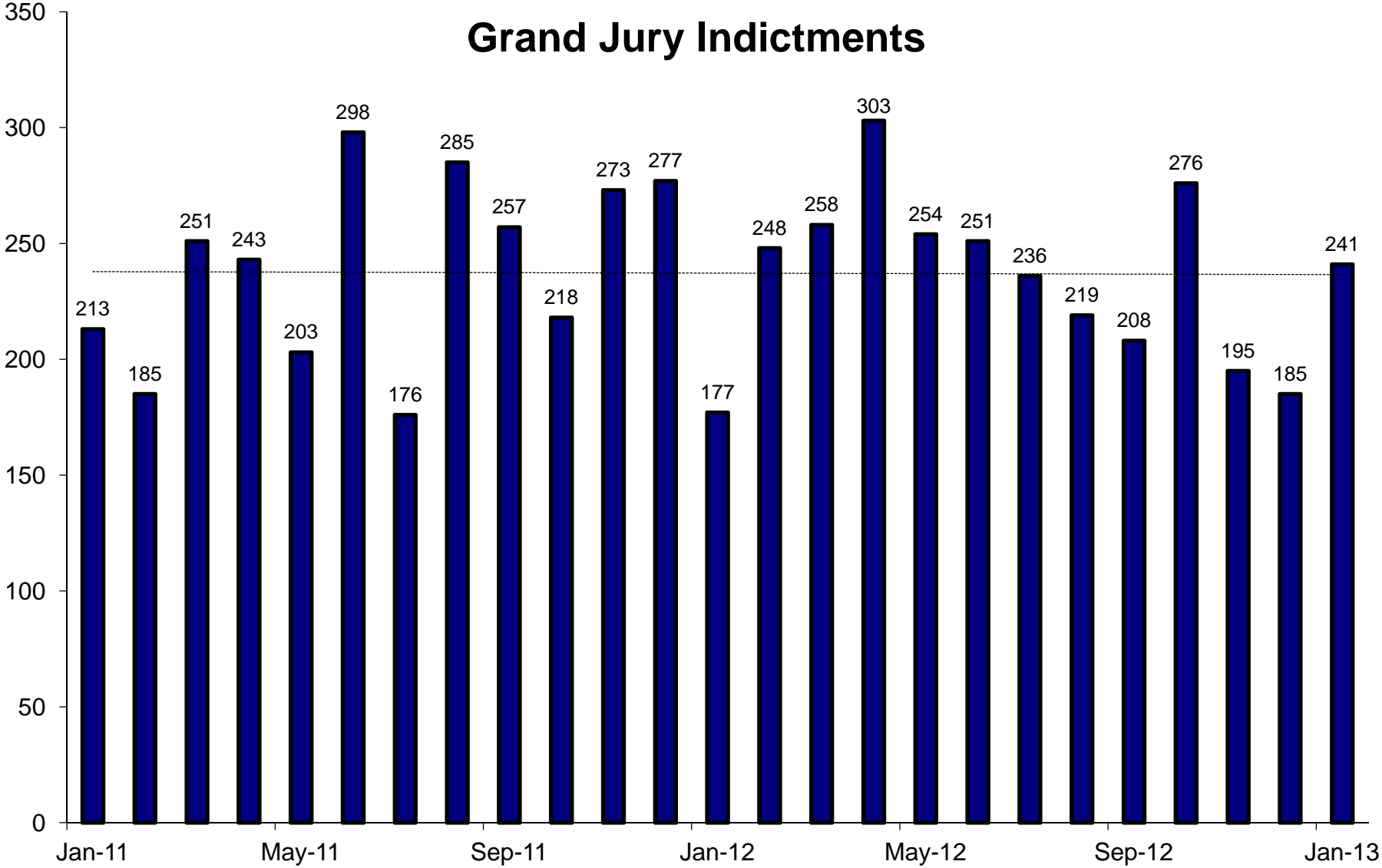


Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter

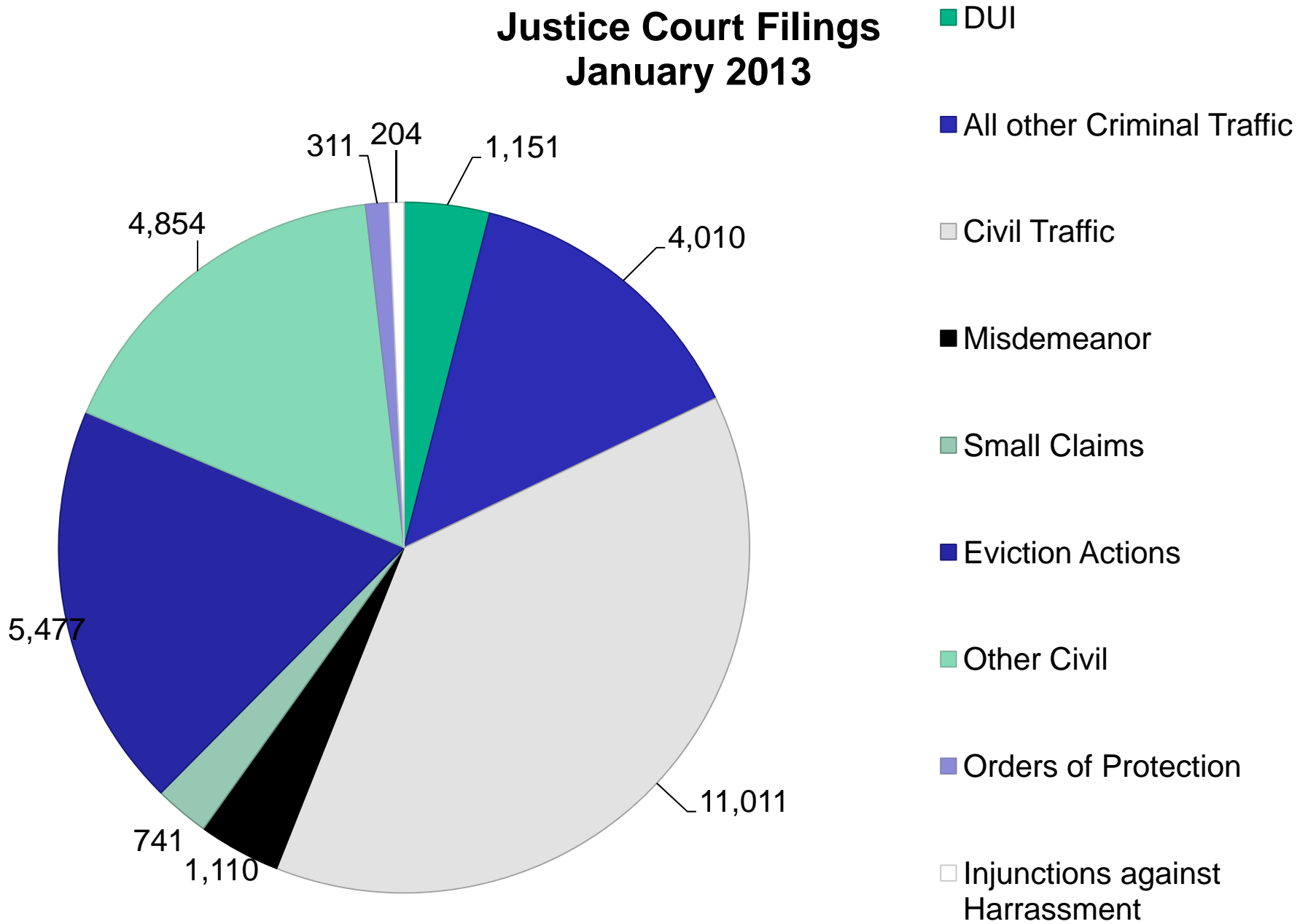


Grand Jury Indictments



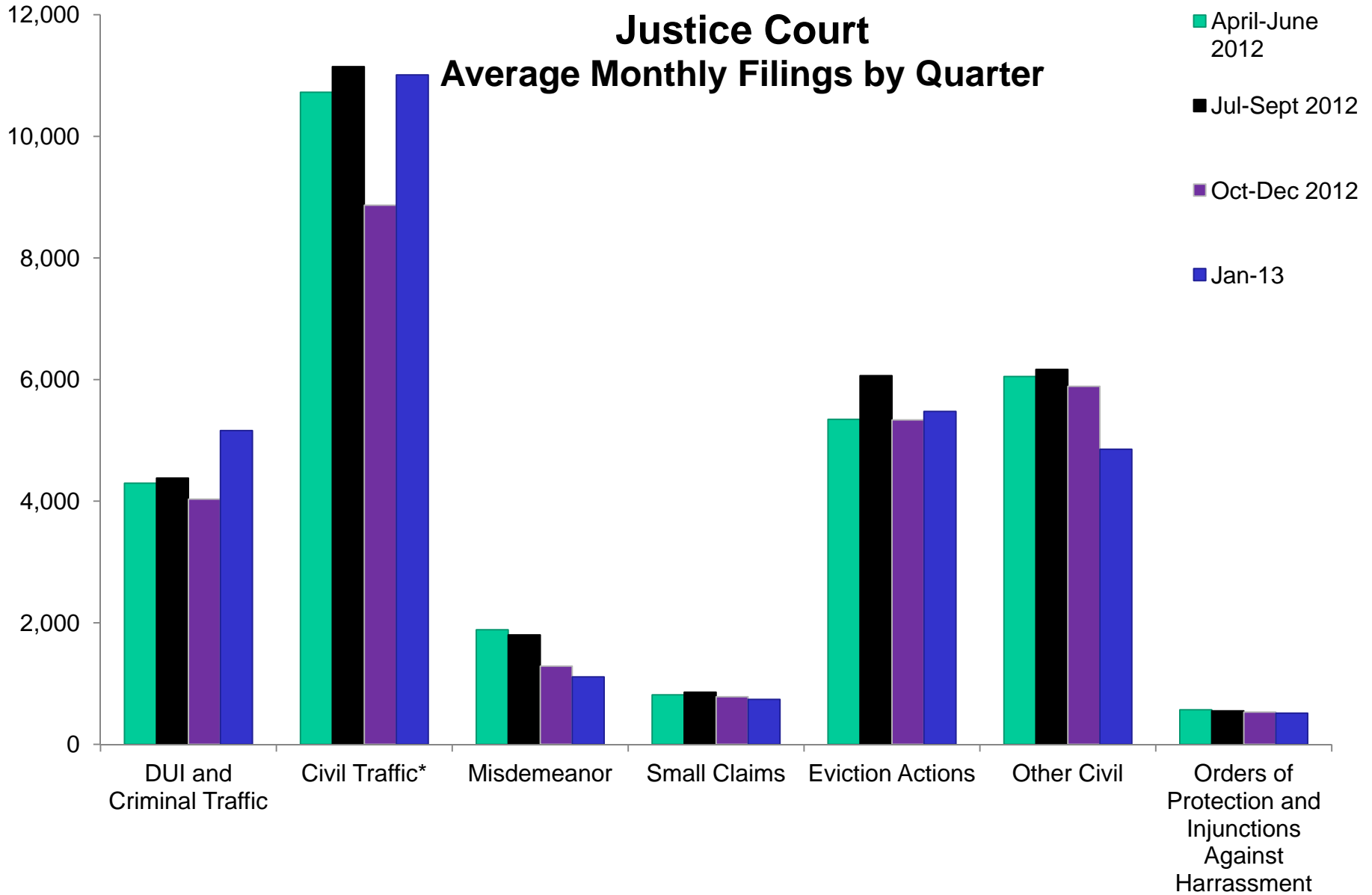

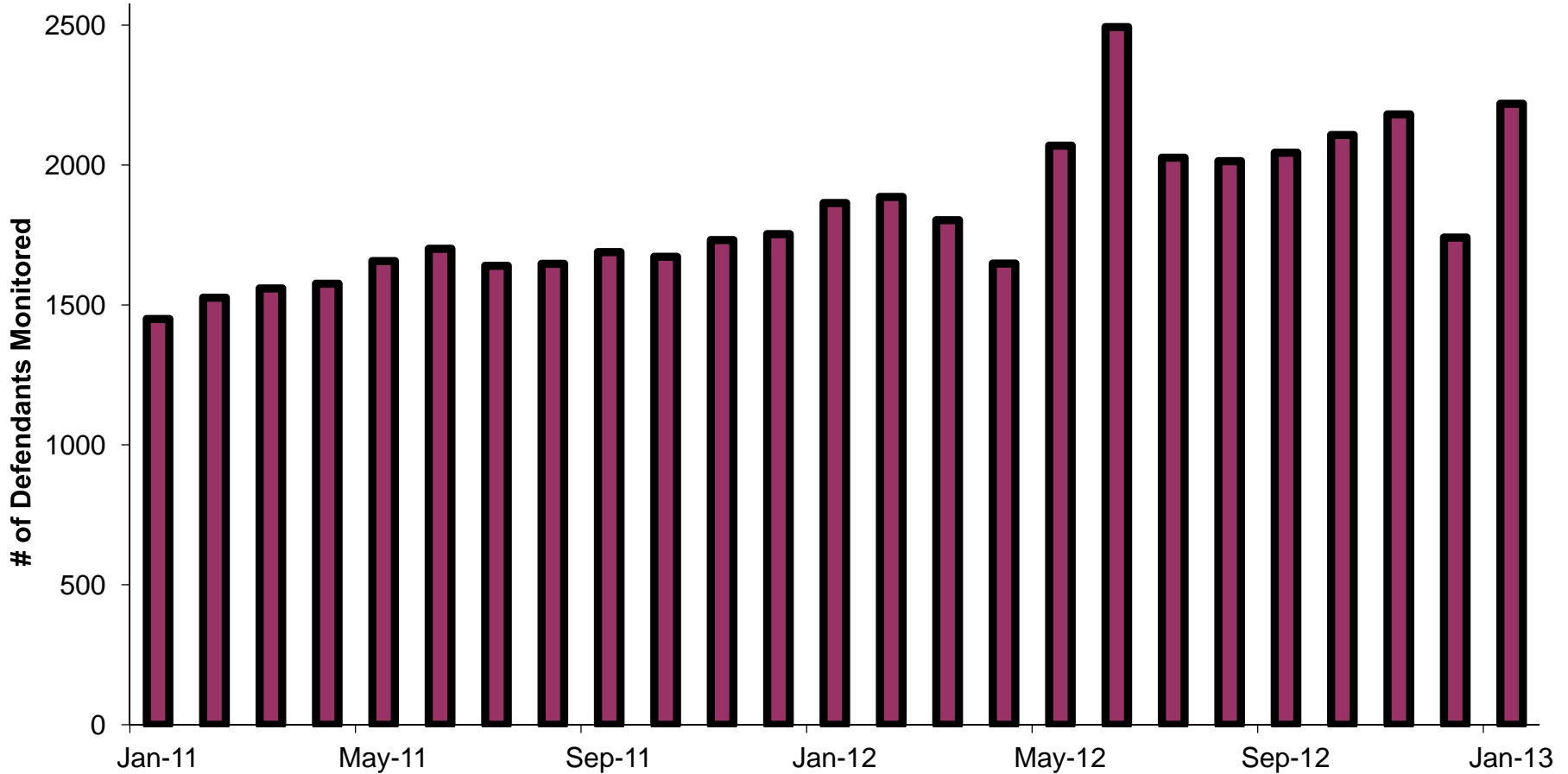

Average Monthly Filings by Quarter

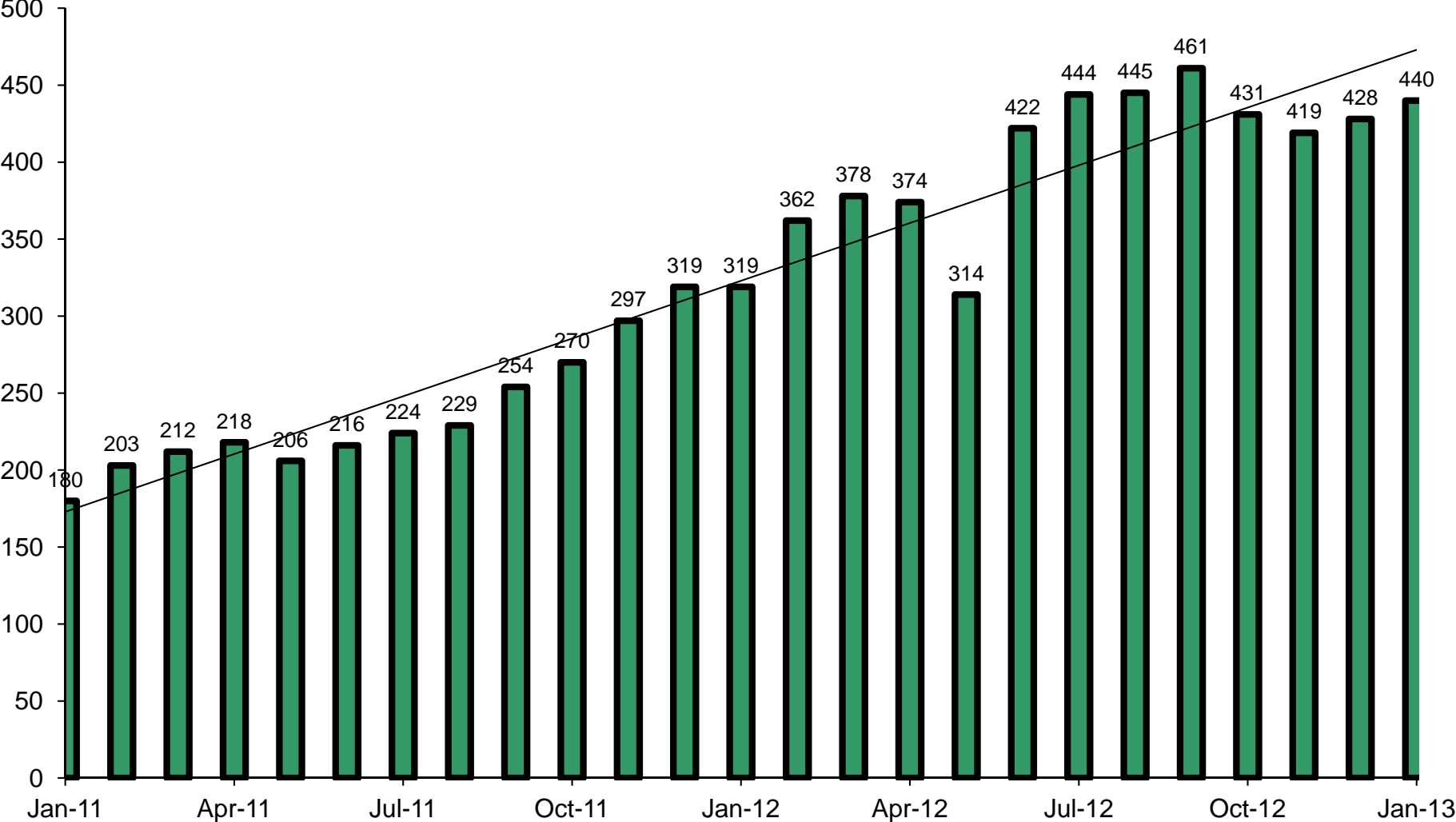


Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload

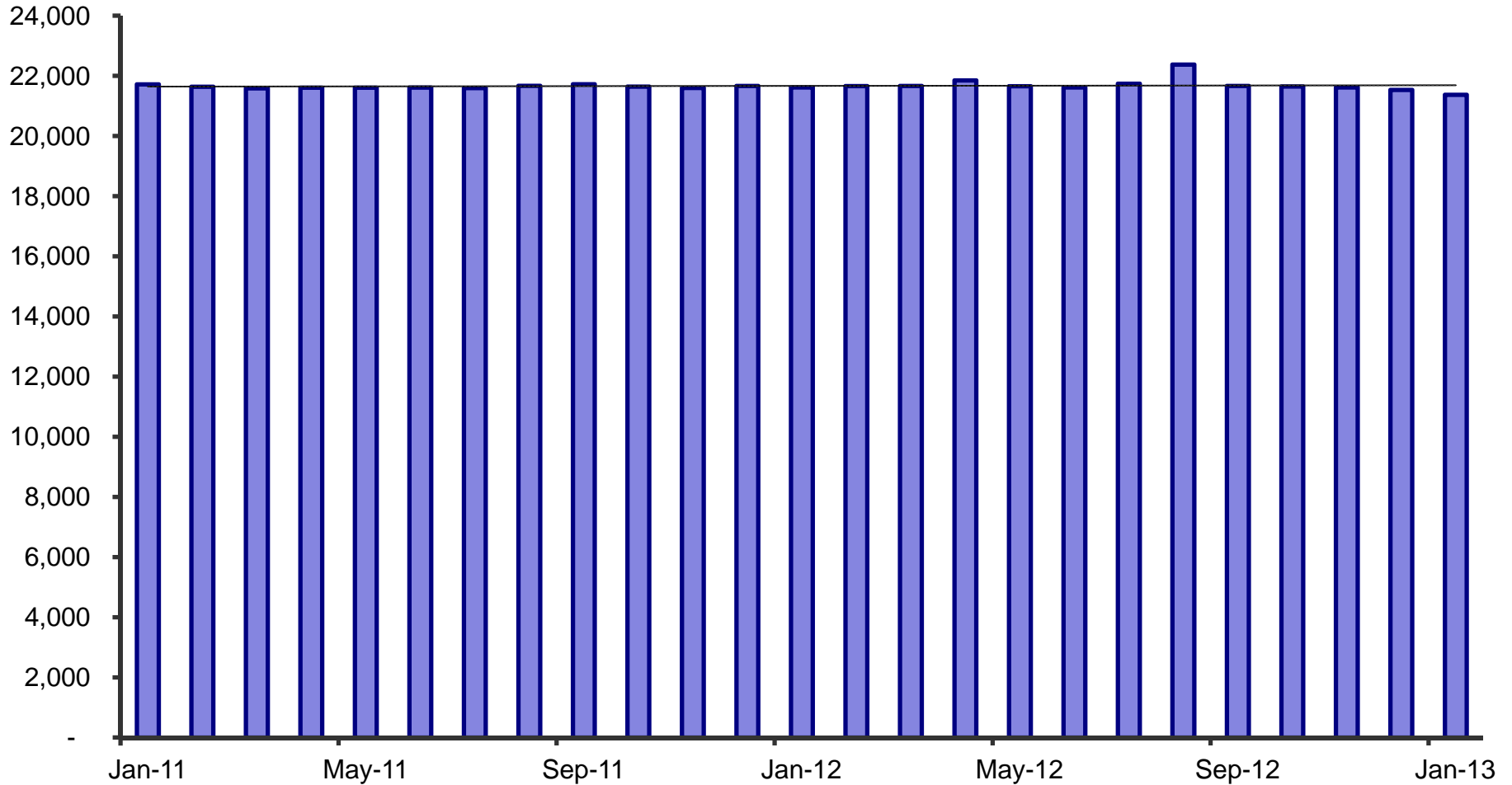

Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring

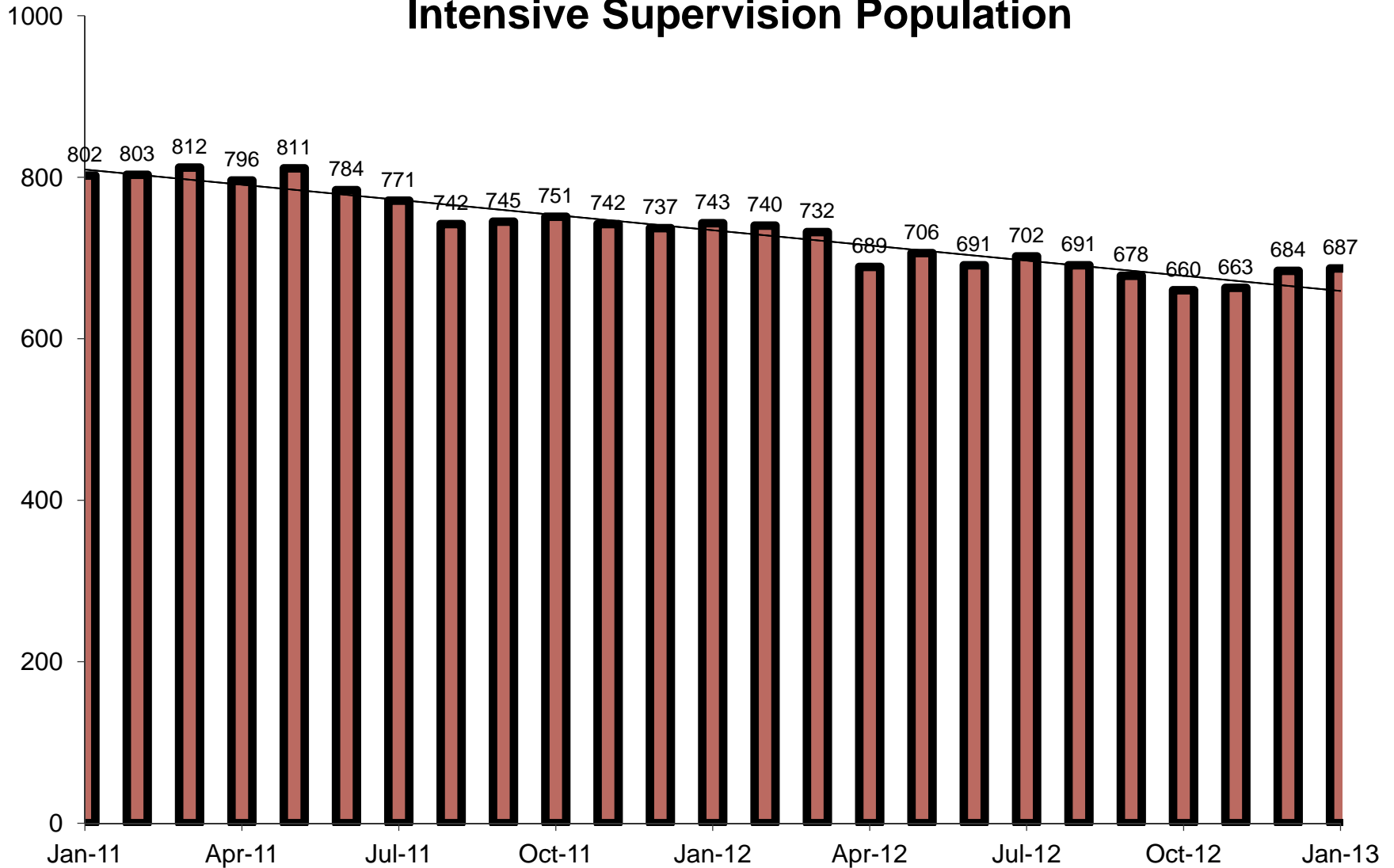


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

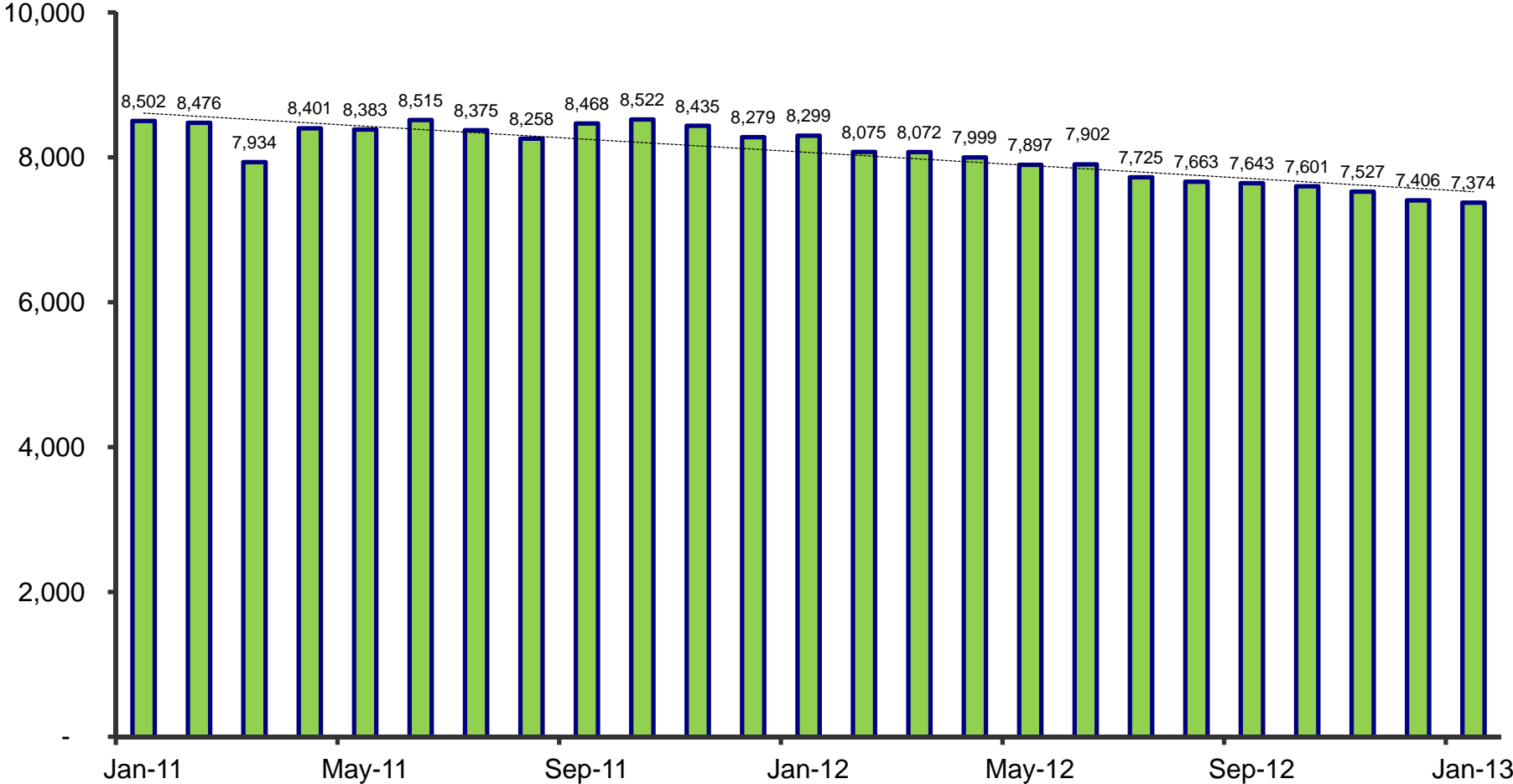

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population

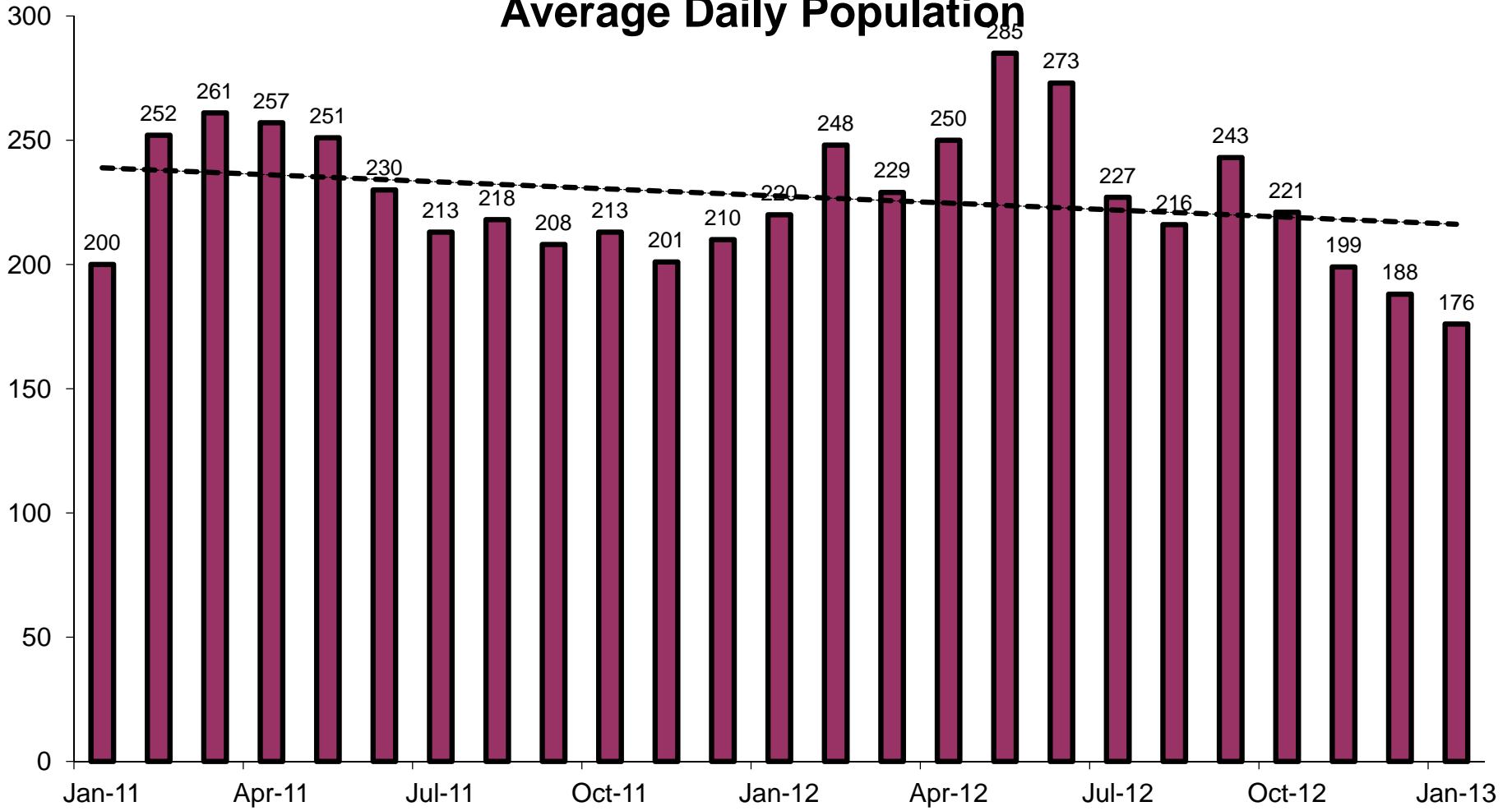


Adult Probation Unsupervised Population

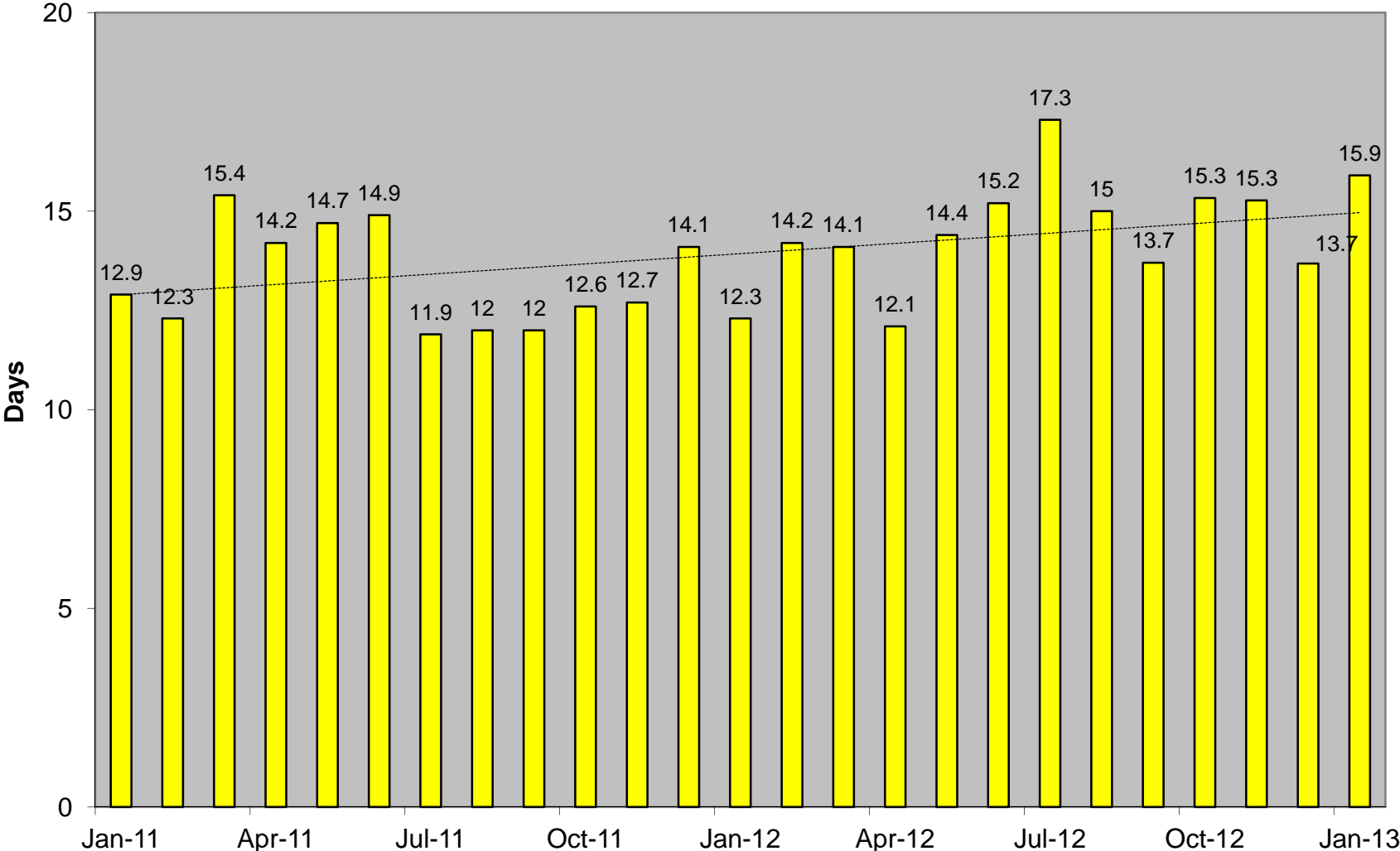
