CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – April 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 9,290 in March to 9,406 in April.
- **Releases decreased** from 9,221 in March to 9,076 in April.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 7,981 in March to 8,134 in April.
- The **Pretrial ADP increased** from 5,984 in March to 6,091 in April.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,746 in March to 1,791 in April.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 191 in March to 188 in April.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release decreased** from 26.6 in March to 25.5 in April.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial decreased** from 9.0 in March to 6.7 in April.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced increased** from 21.3 in March to 22.5 in April.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds decreased** from 71.9 in March to 66.9 in April.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,600 in March to 2,841 in April.
- **Case Terminations increased** from 2,777 in March to 3,077 in April.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 108%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,021 in March to 11,406 in April.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,393 in March to 1,650 in April.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 948 in March to 898 in April.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 50 in March to 59 in April.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2.1%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 514 in March to 600 in April.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 2,787 in March to 3,071 in April.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 7,789 in March to 9,771 in April.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 3,839 in March to 4,526 in April.
- **Total Filings increased** from 22,804 in March to 25,334 in April.

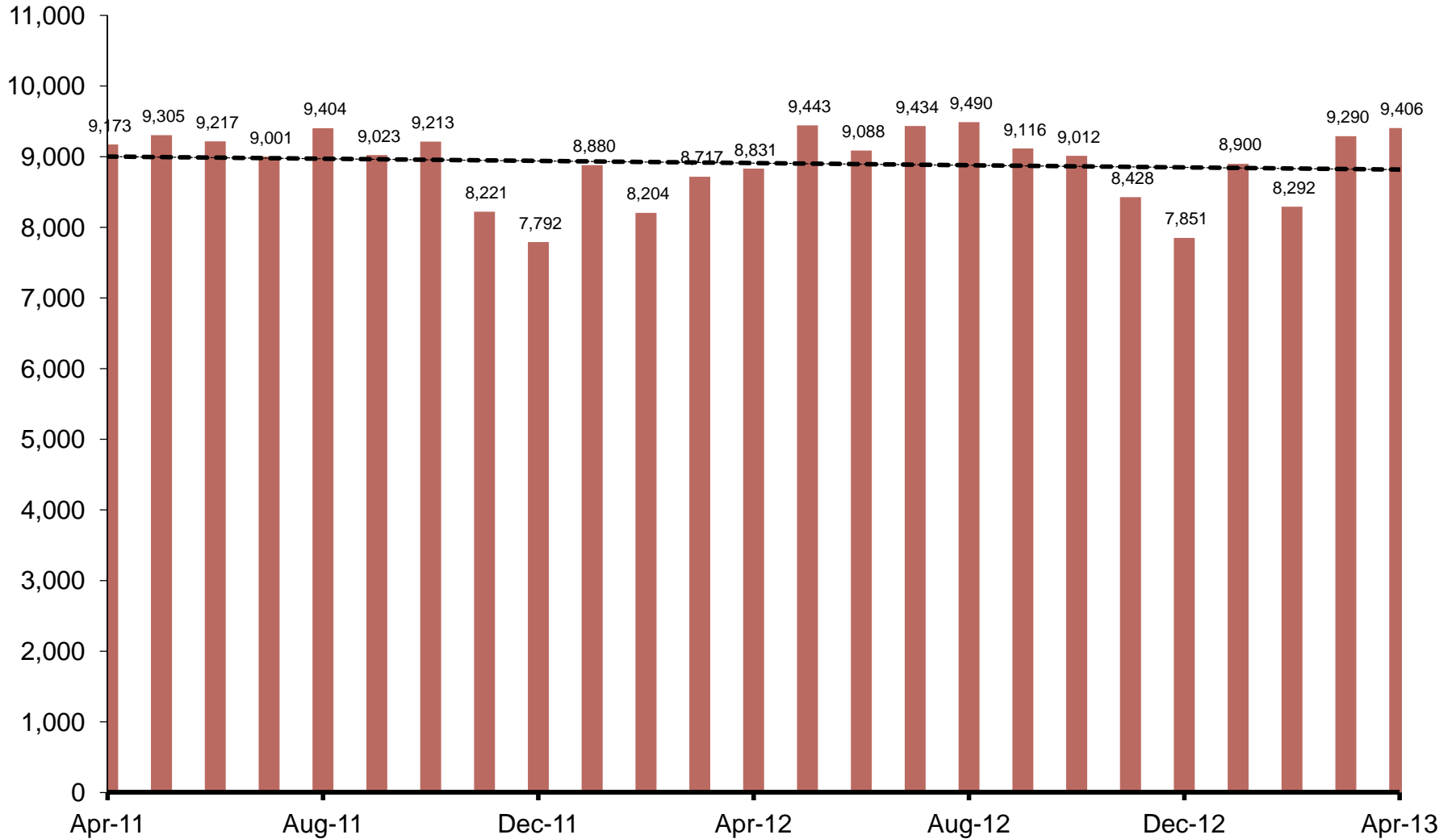
Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,628 in March to 1,639 in April.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 437 in March to 440 in April.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,517 in March to 21,443 in April.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 731 in March to 746 in April.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,123 in March to 6,939 in April.

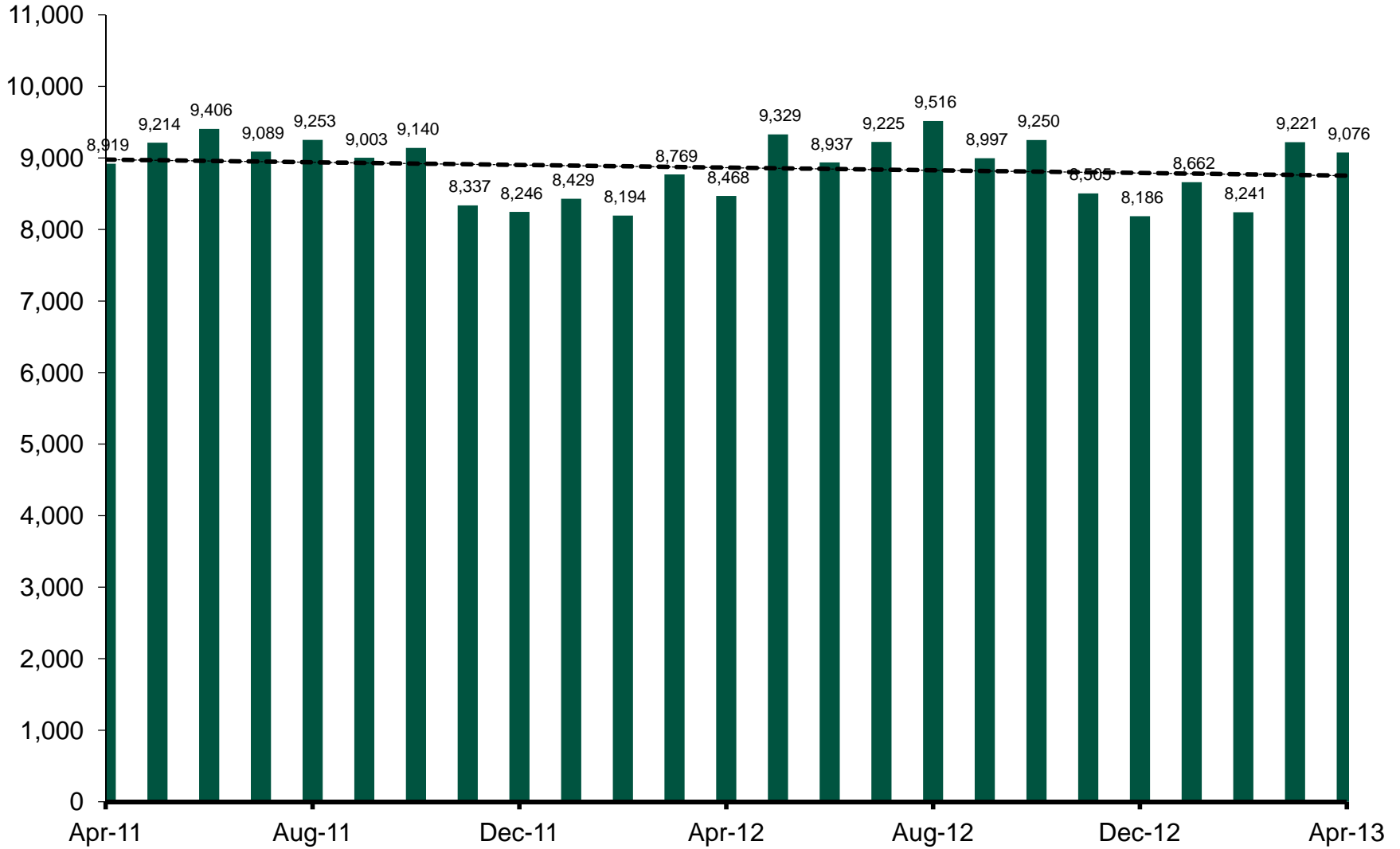
Juvenile Detention and Probation

- The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 211 in March to 209 in April.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention increased** from 12.4 in March to 14.2 in April.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation increased** from 2,388 in March to 2,401 in April.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 243 in March to 264 in April.
- Monthly **commitments to Arizona Department of Juvenile Corrections** increased from 17 in March to 32 in April.

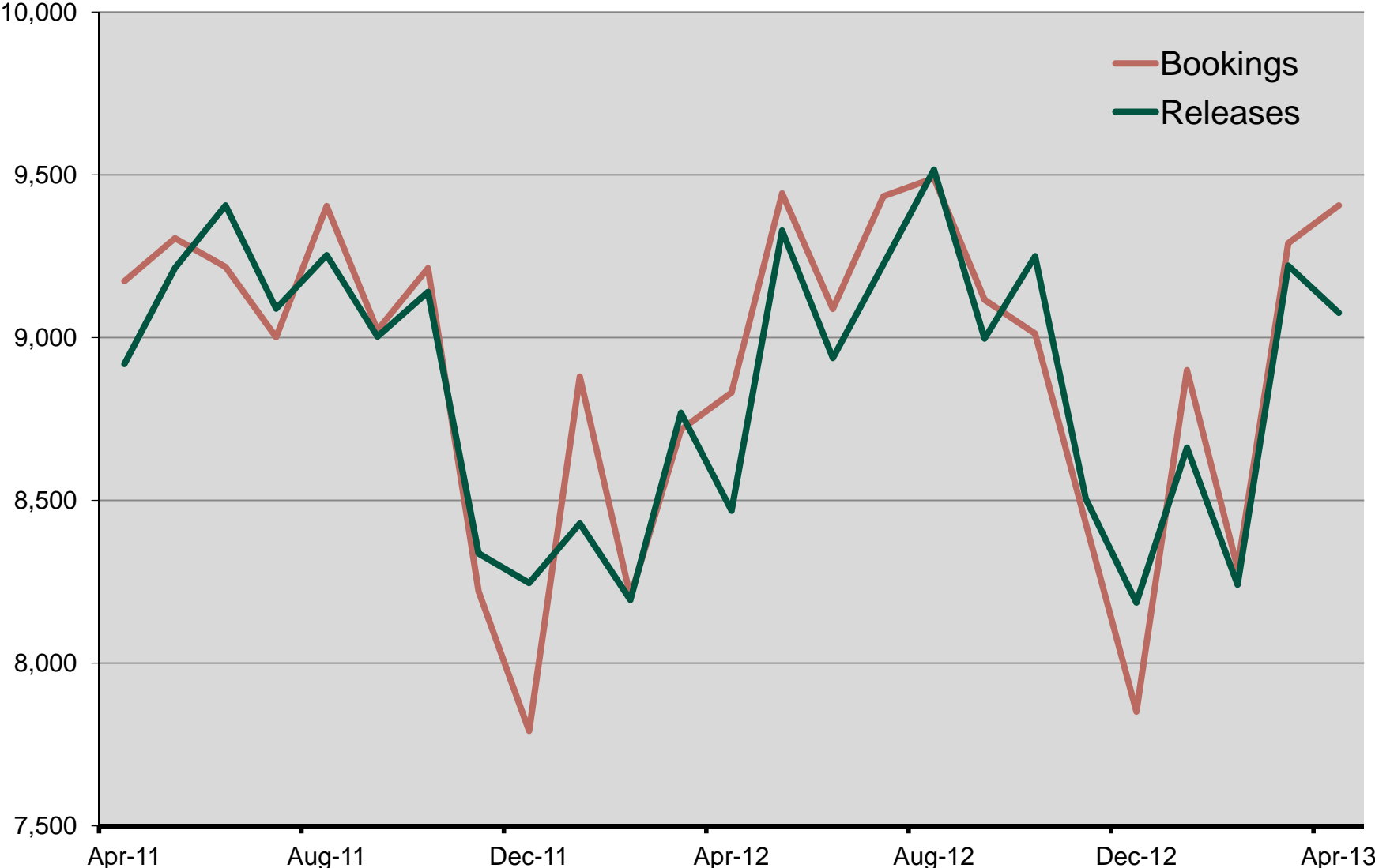

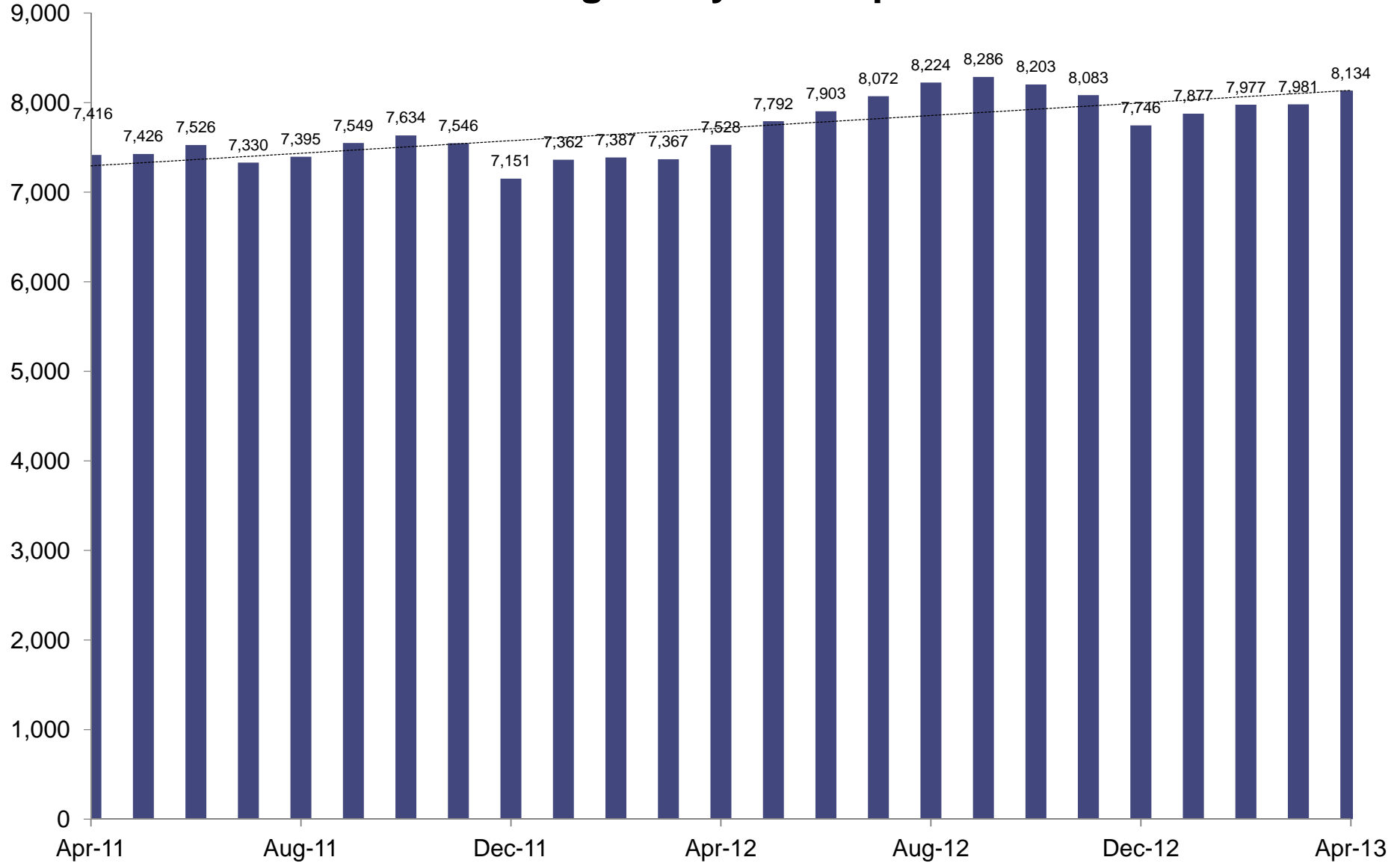
Jail Releases



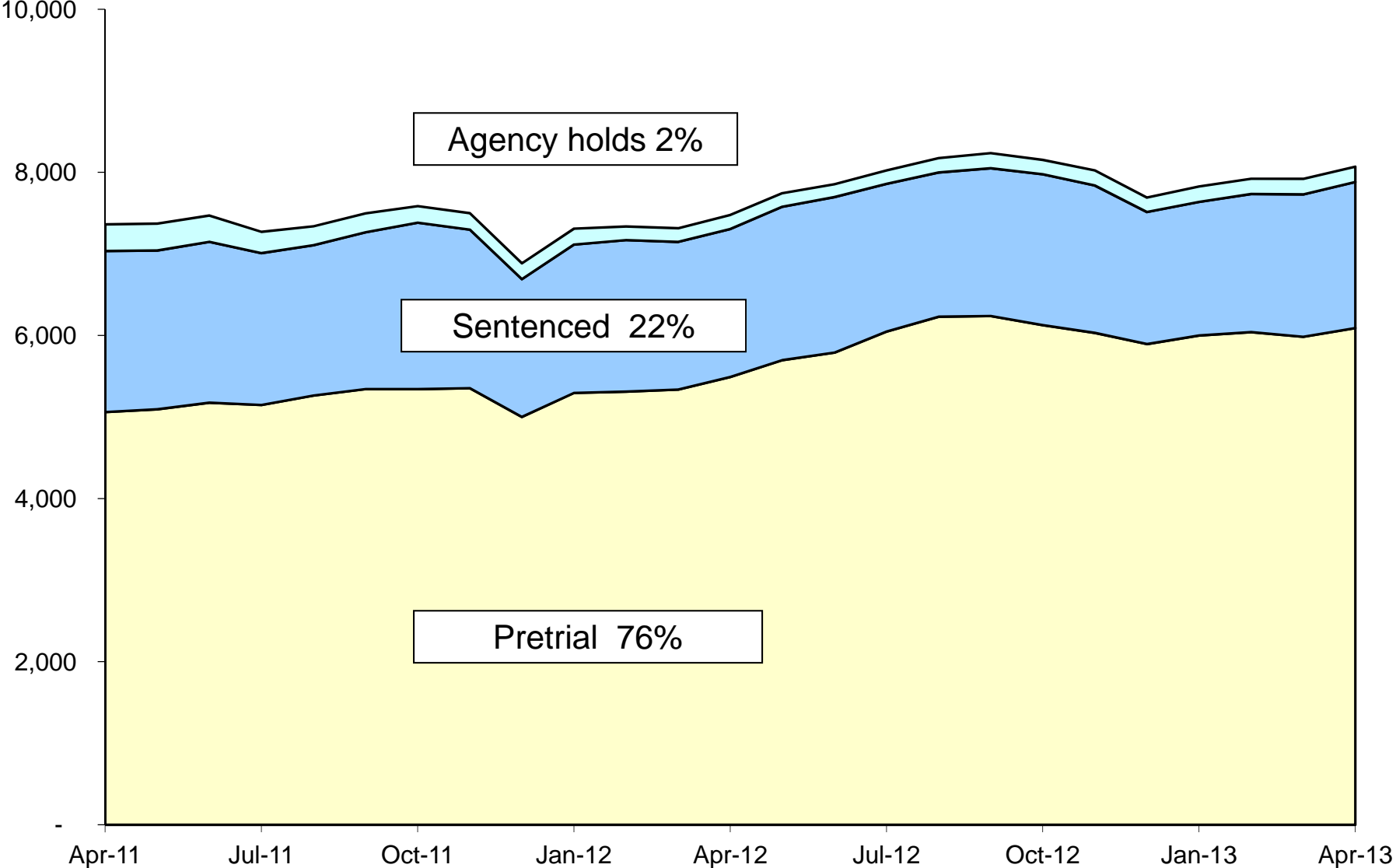
Jail Bookings and Releases



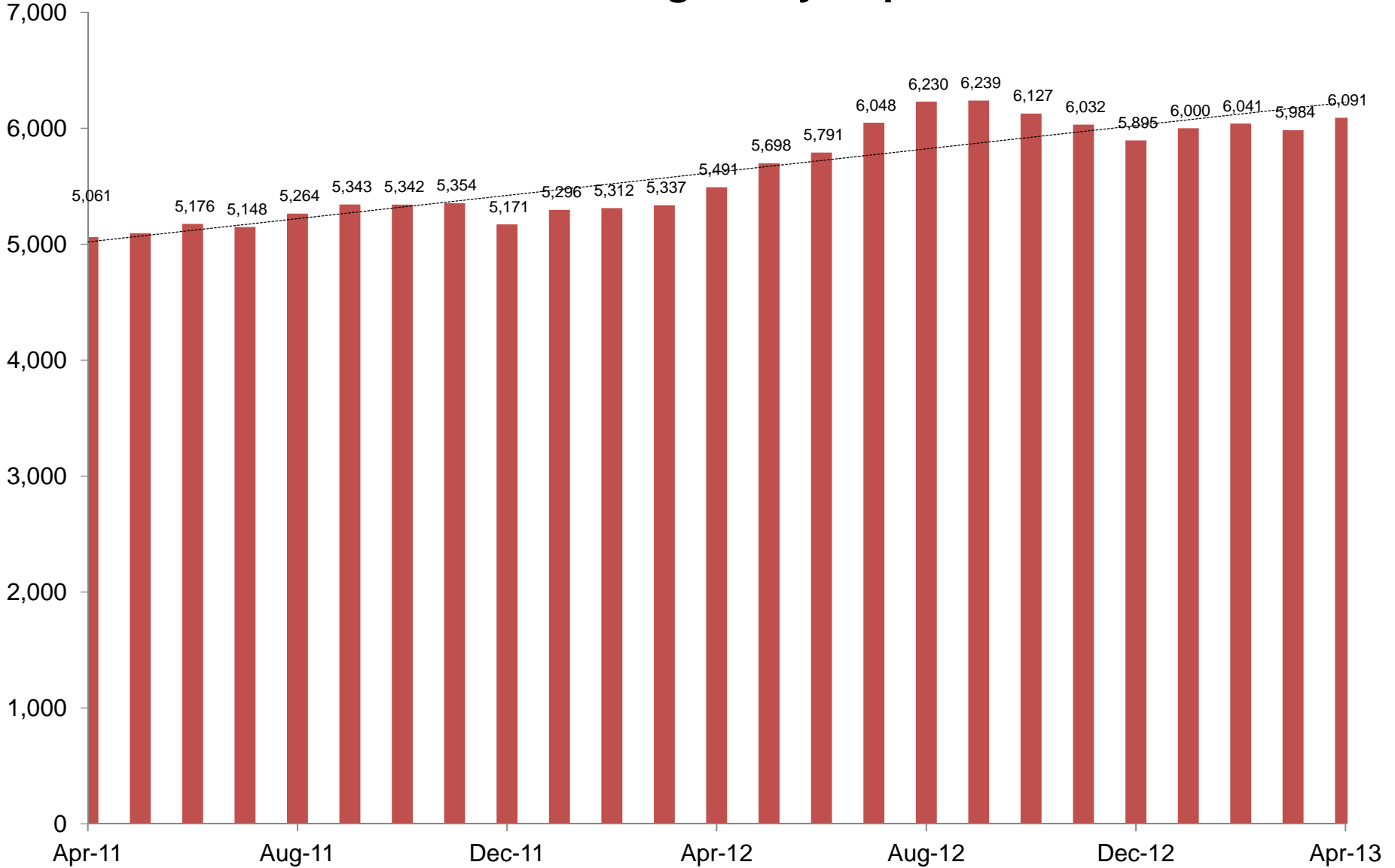
Average Daily Jail Population



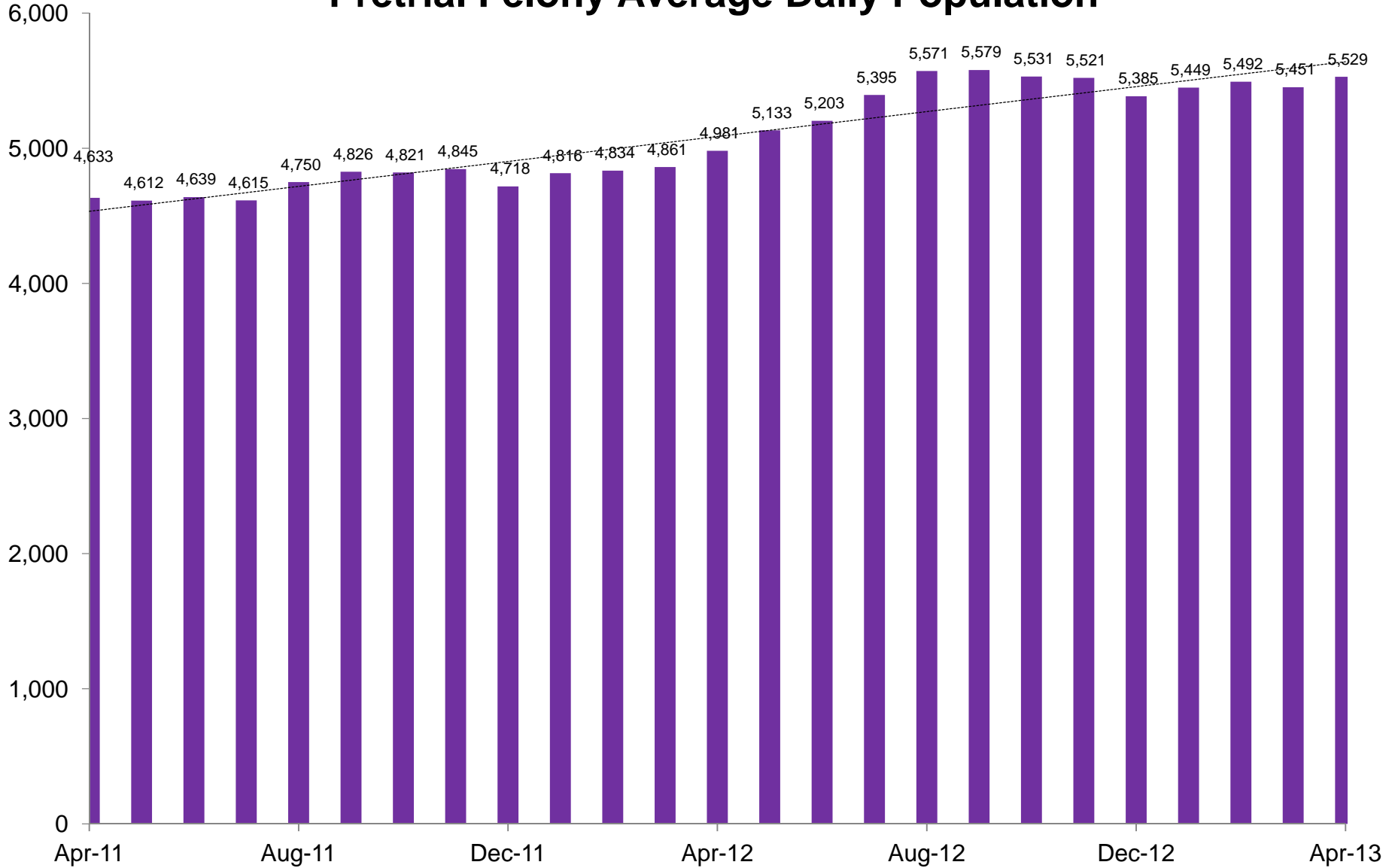
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



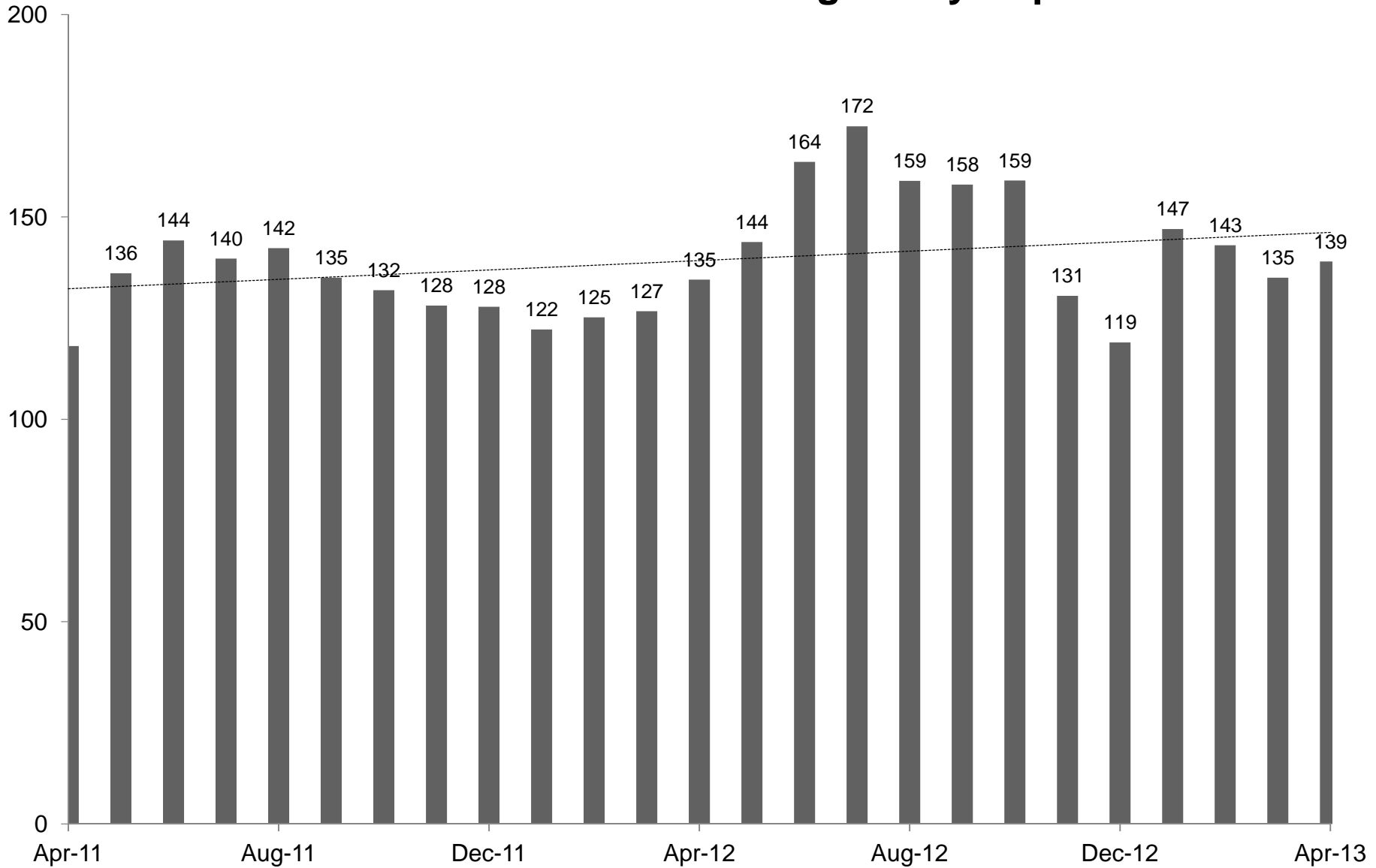
Pretrial Average Daily Population



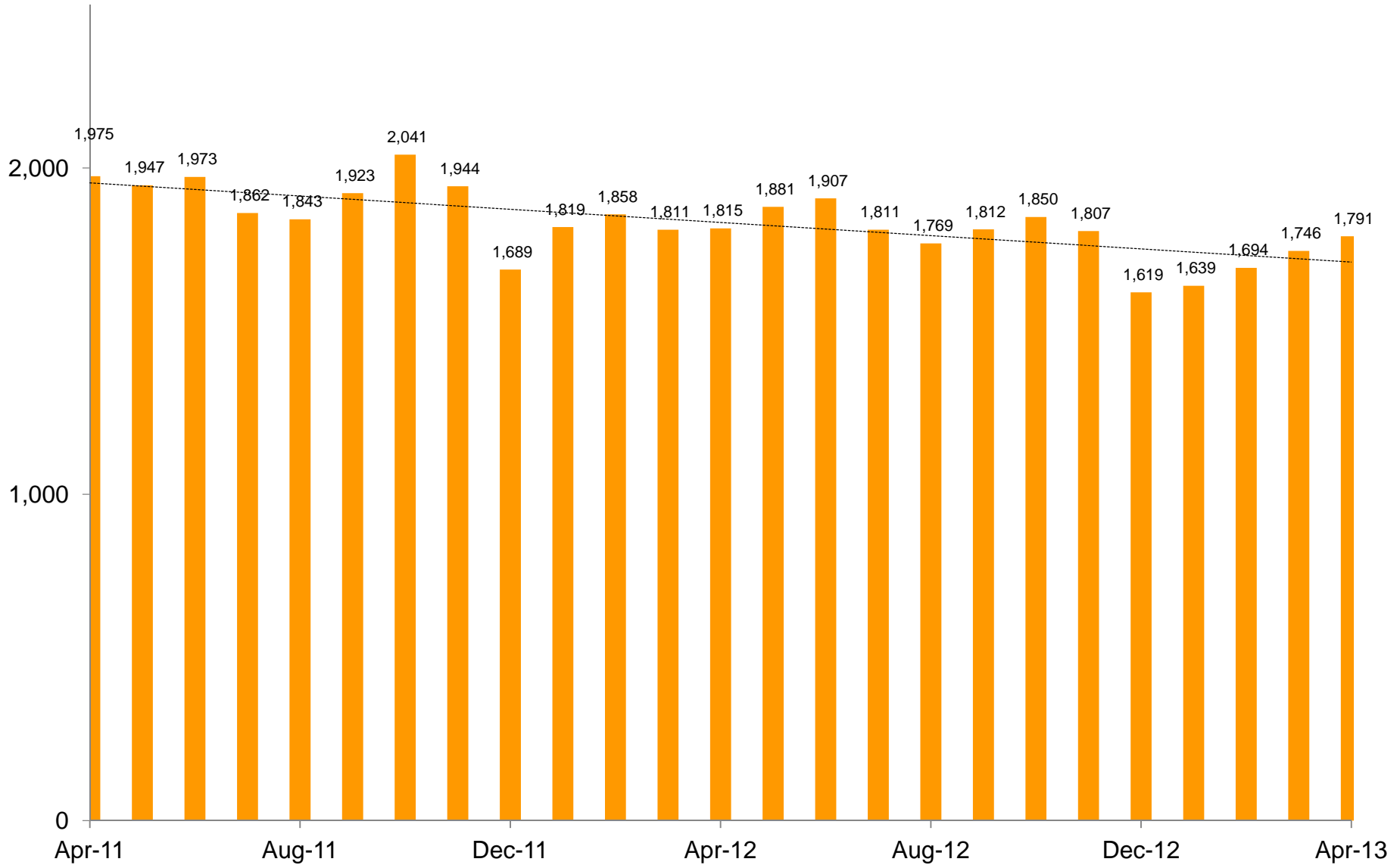
Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population



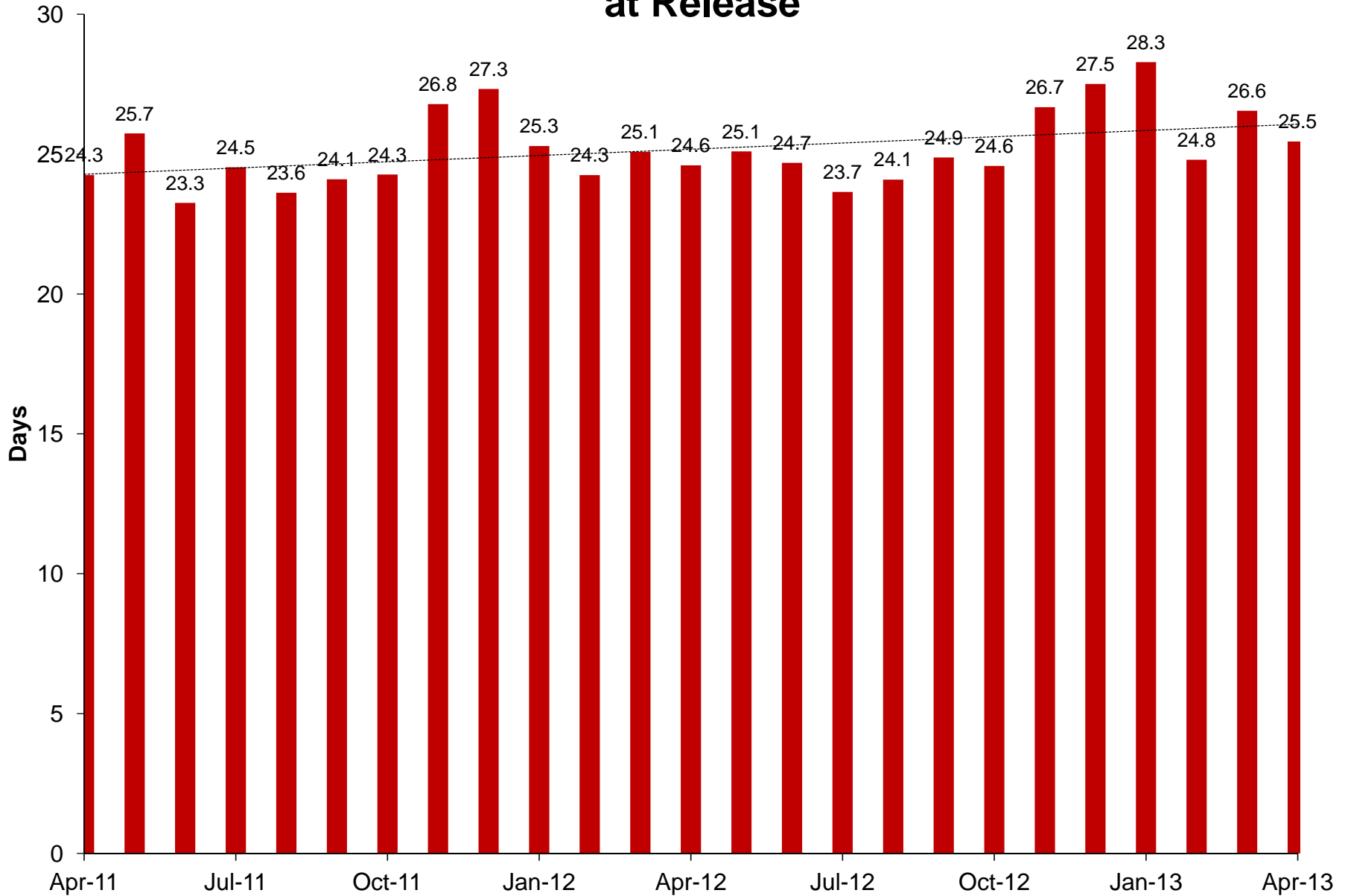
Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population



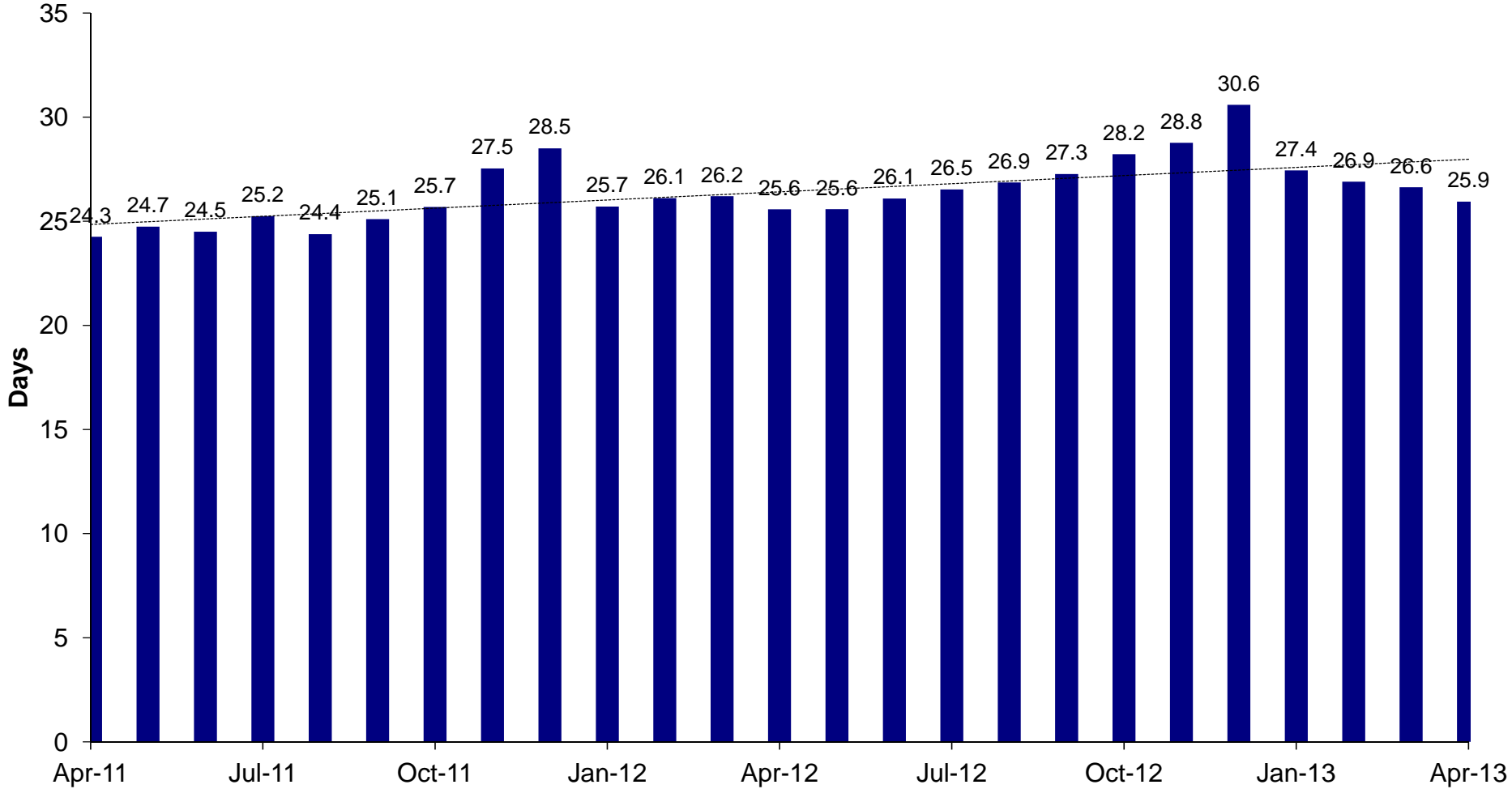
Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release

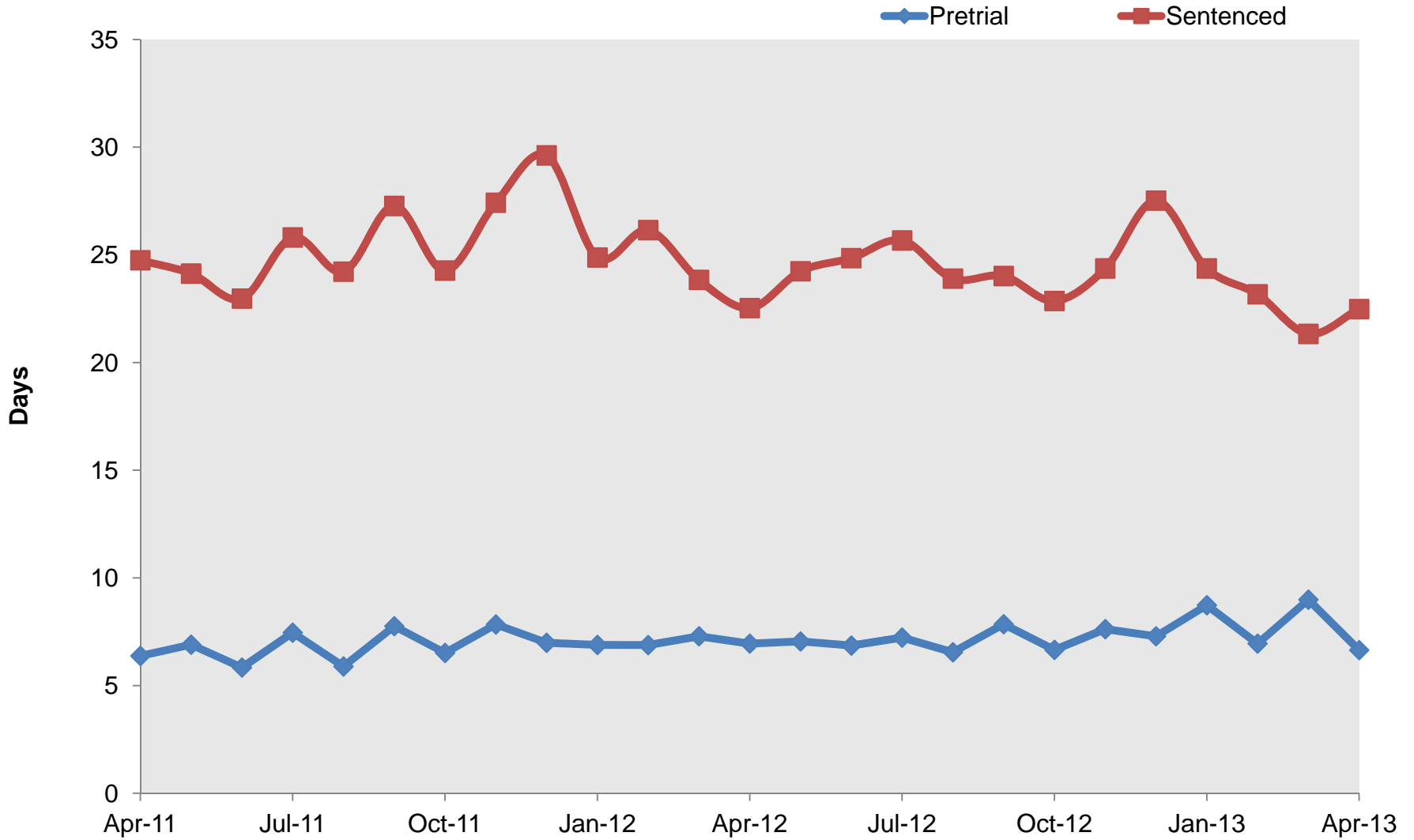


Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

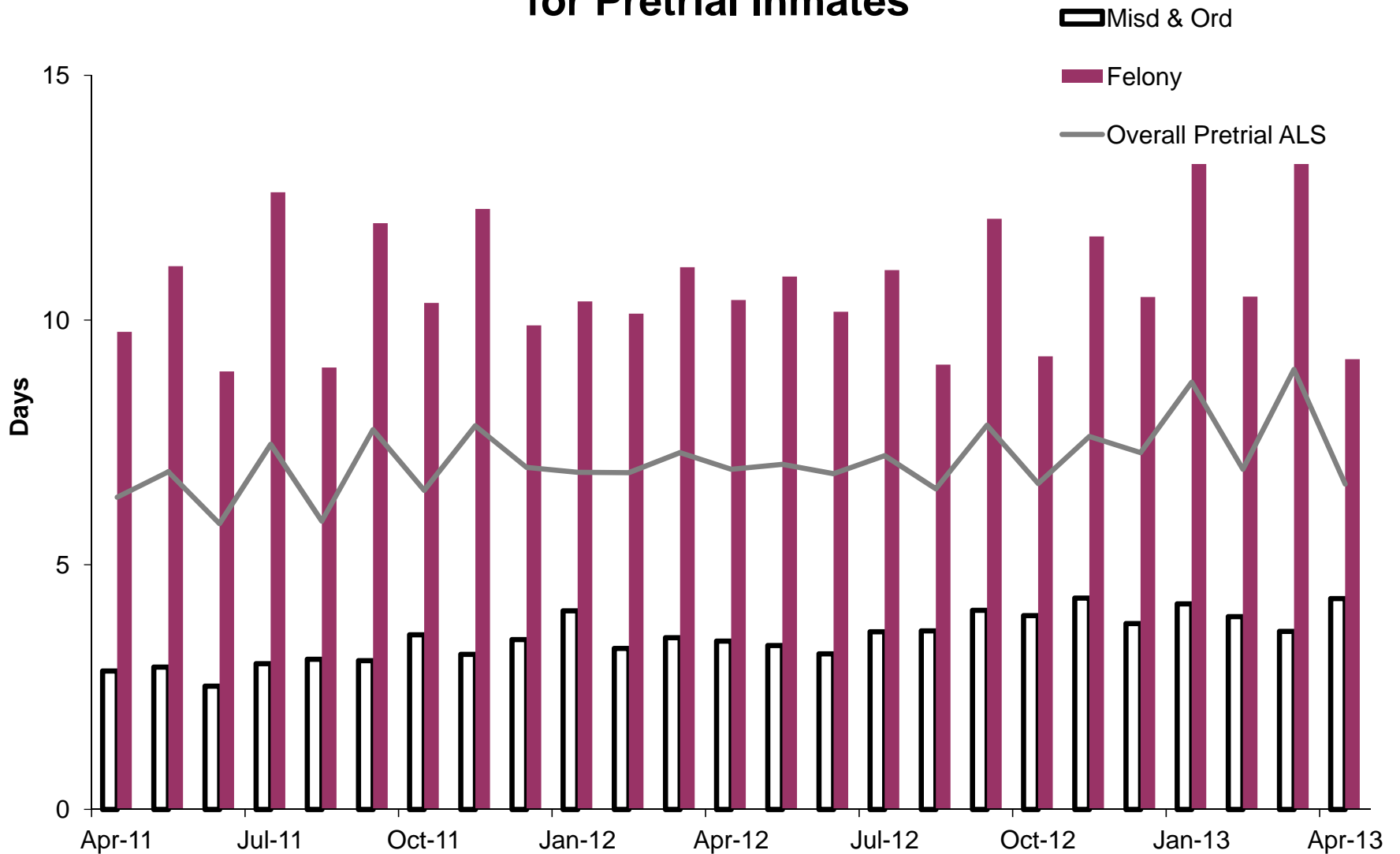

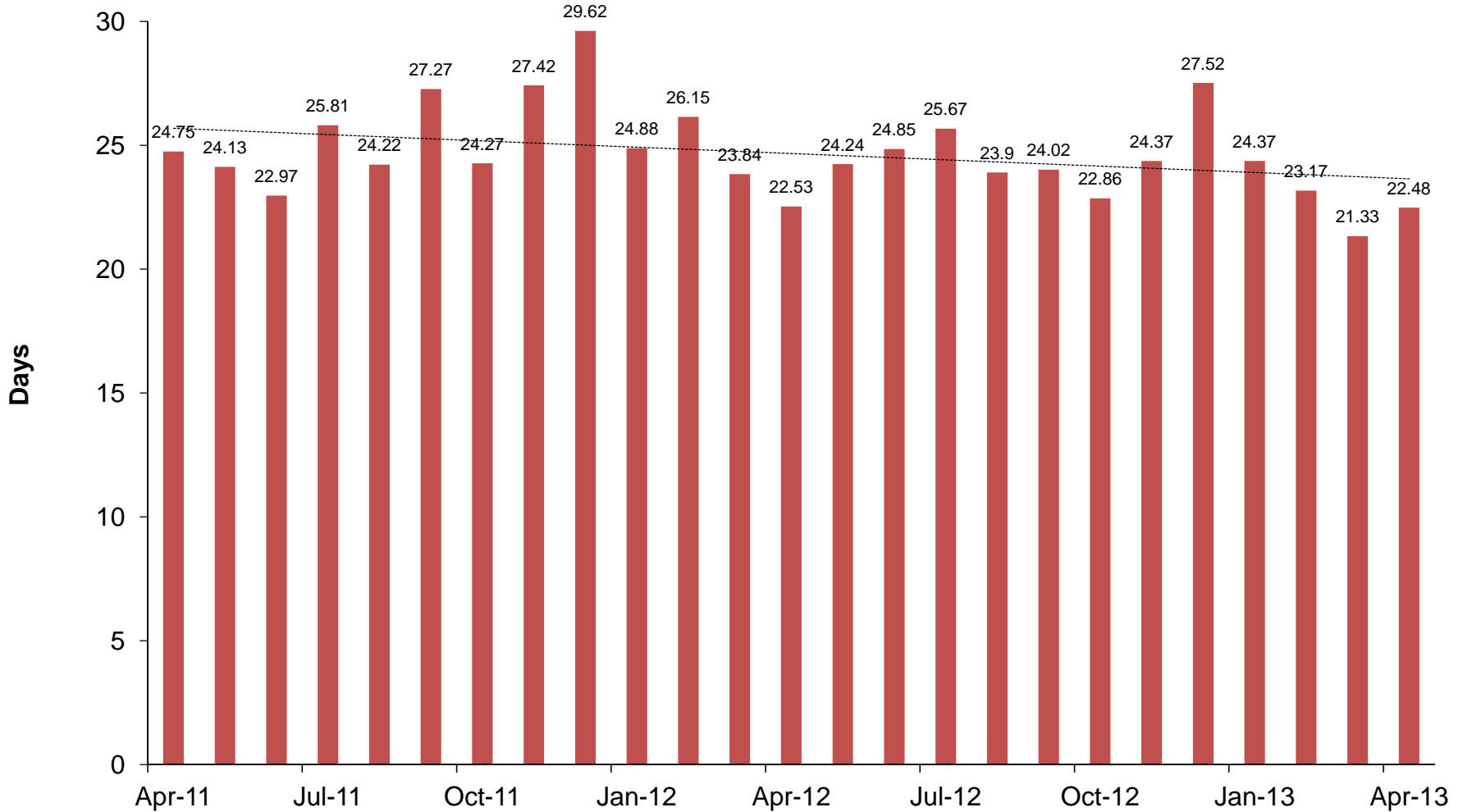
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates



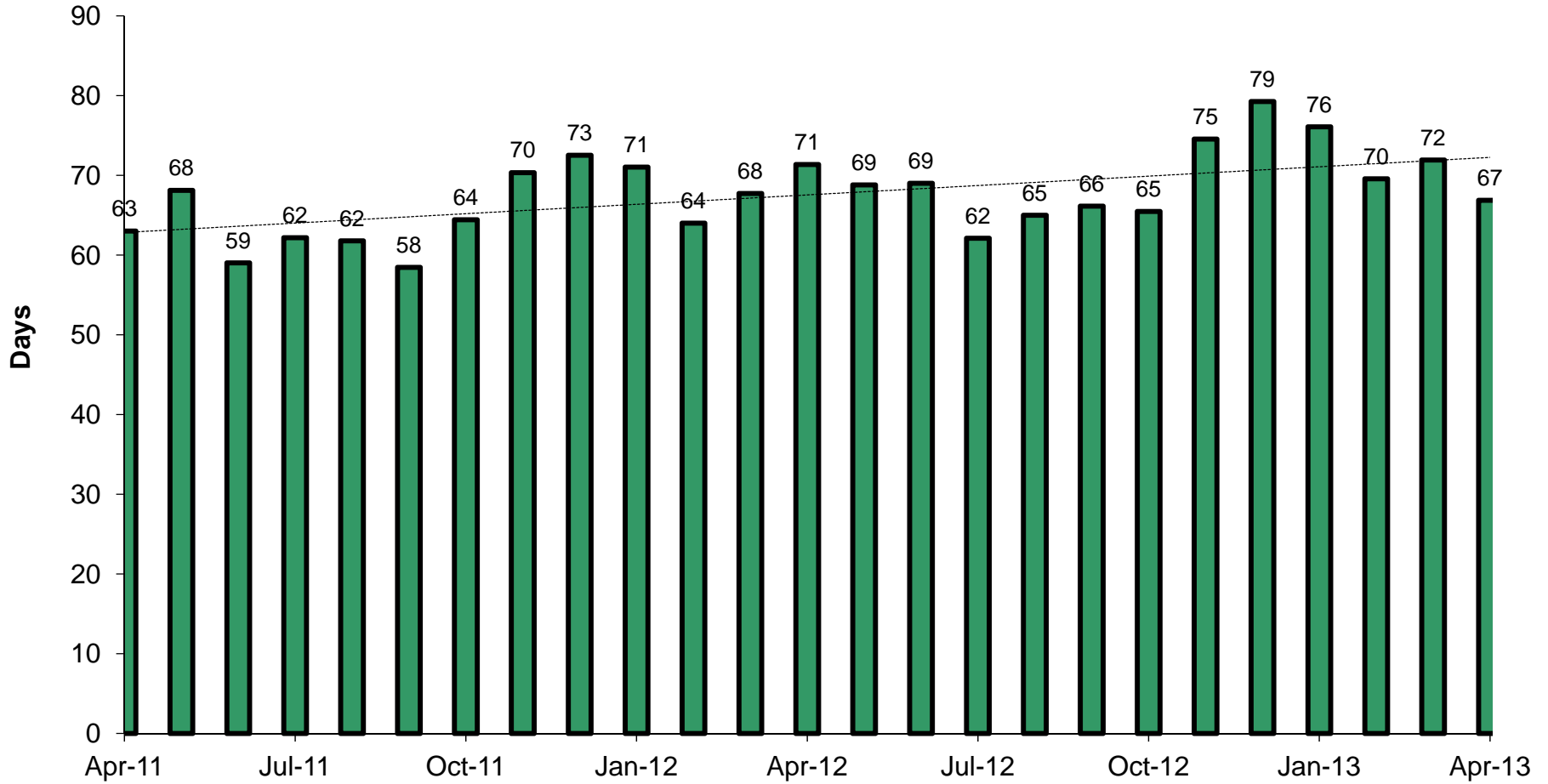
Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates

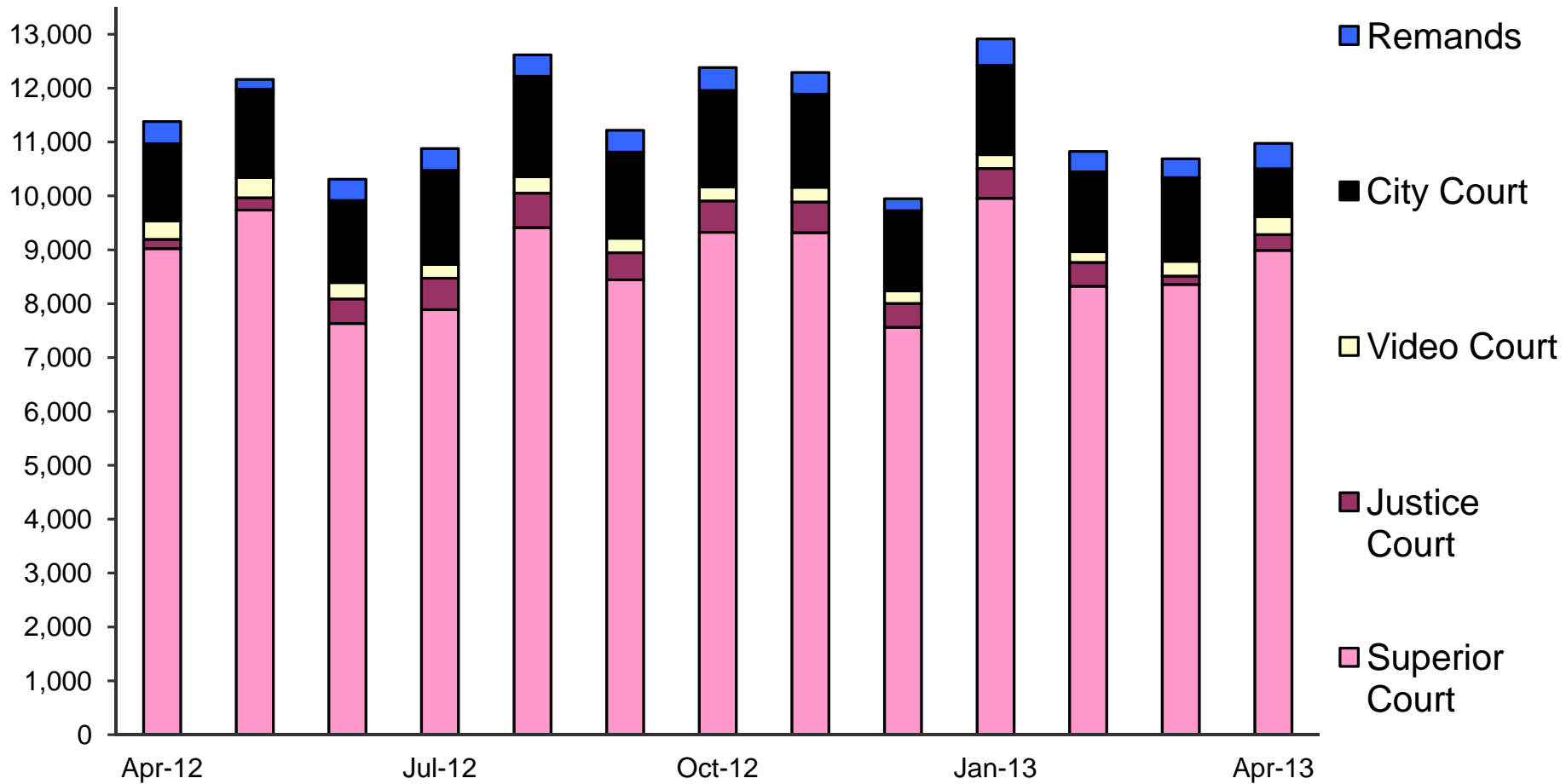


Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds

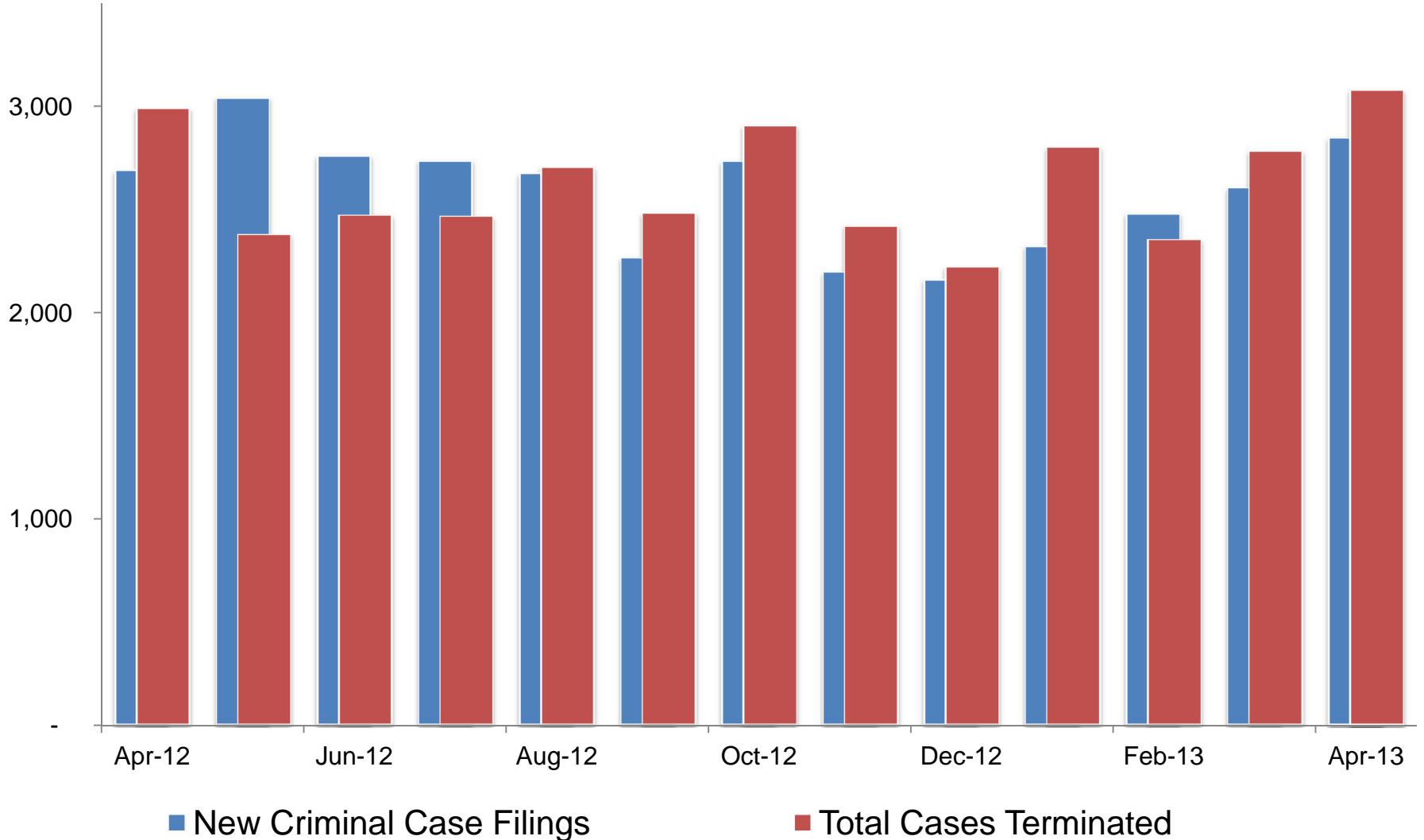

Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances

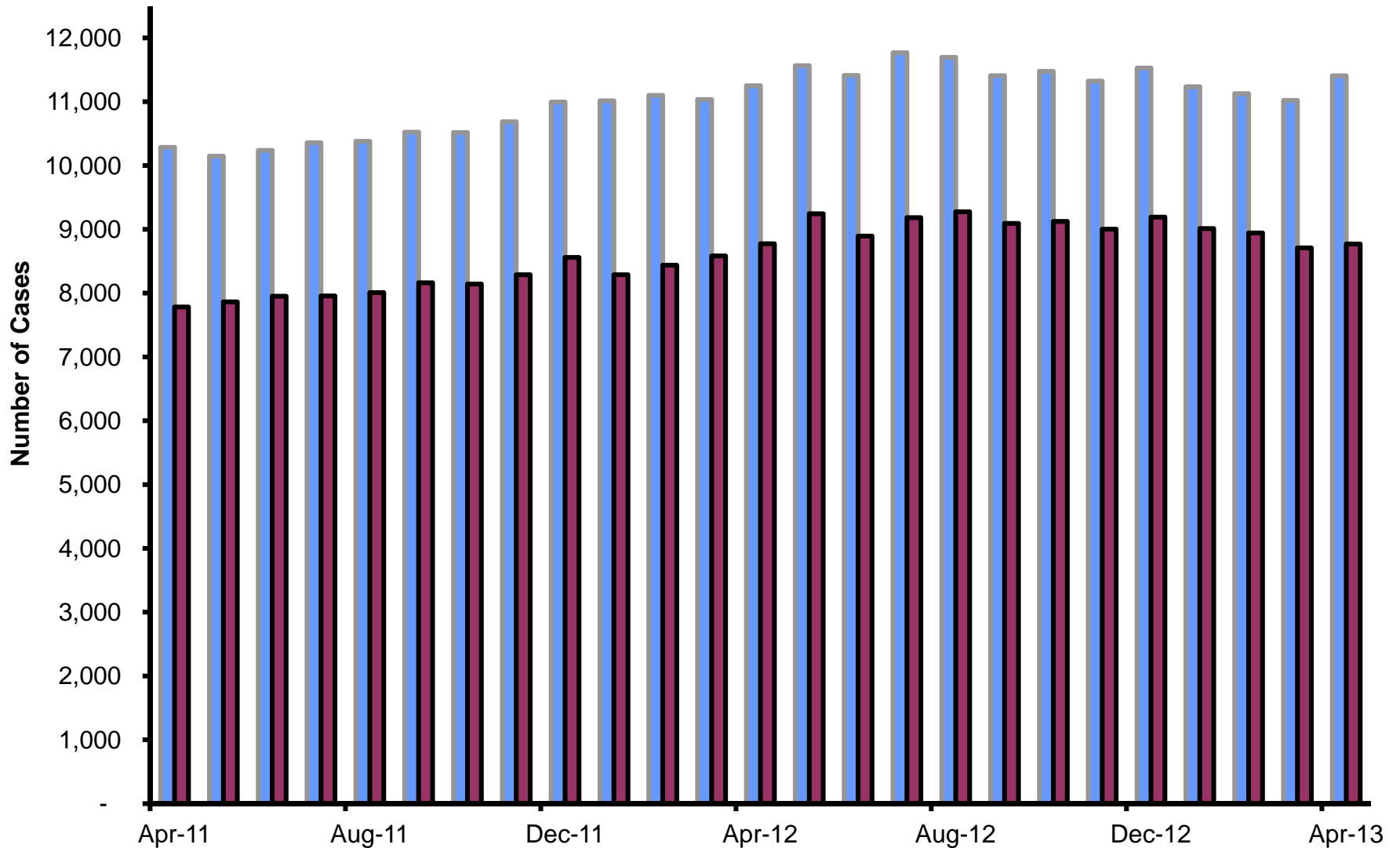


Superior Court Criminal Case Filings and Terminations

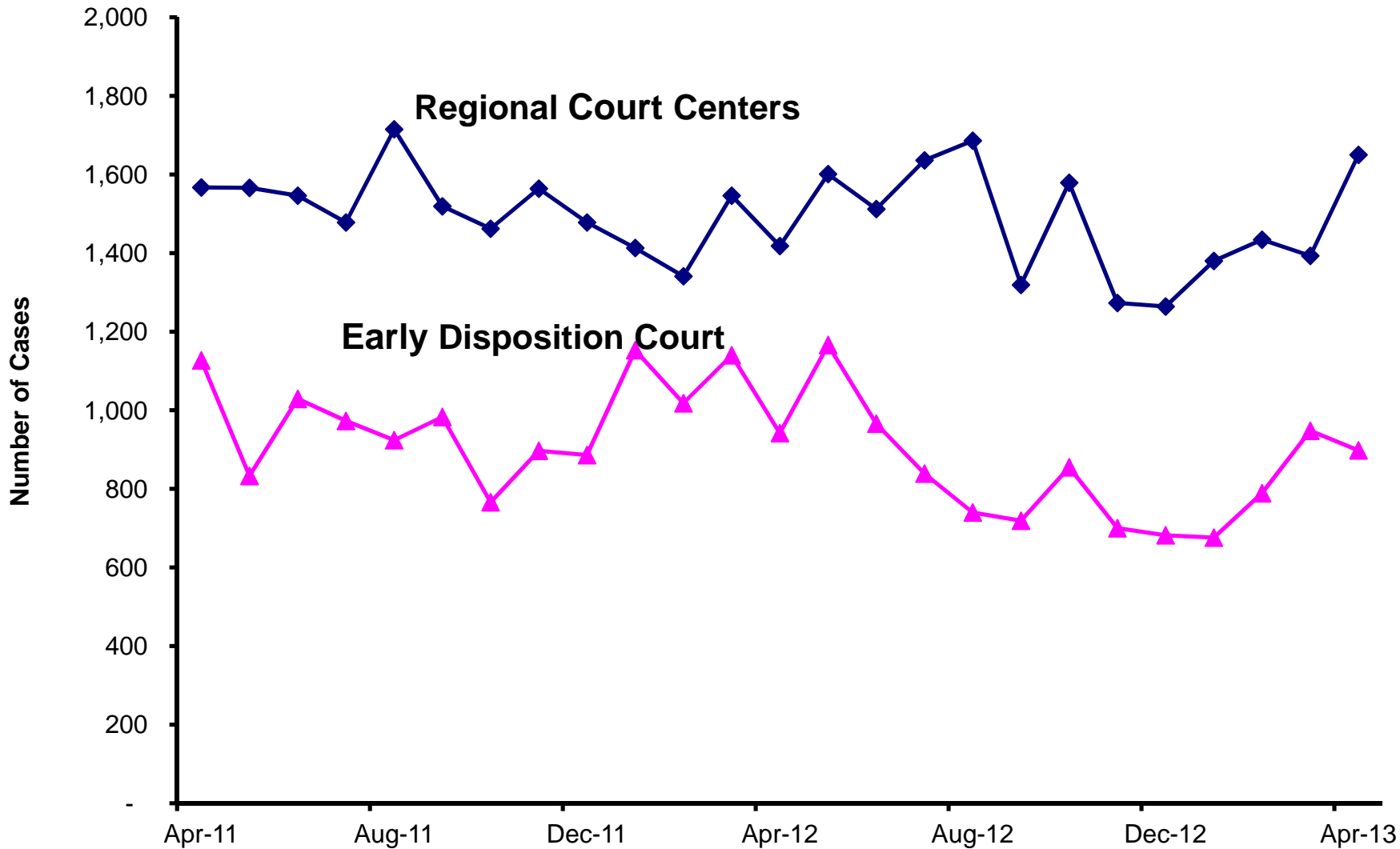


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

Direct Complaints into Superior Court

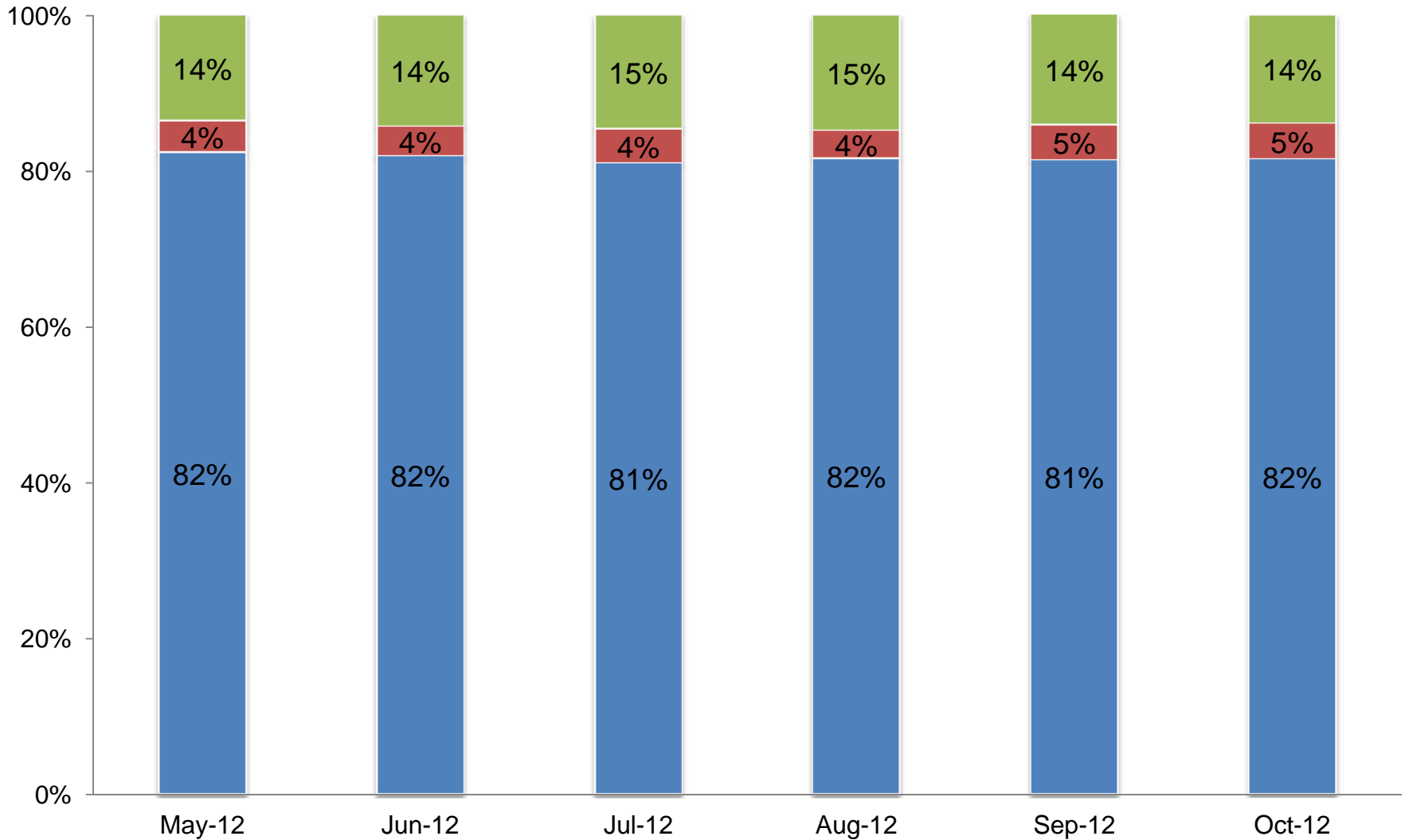


Status of Cases After 180 Days

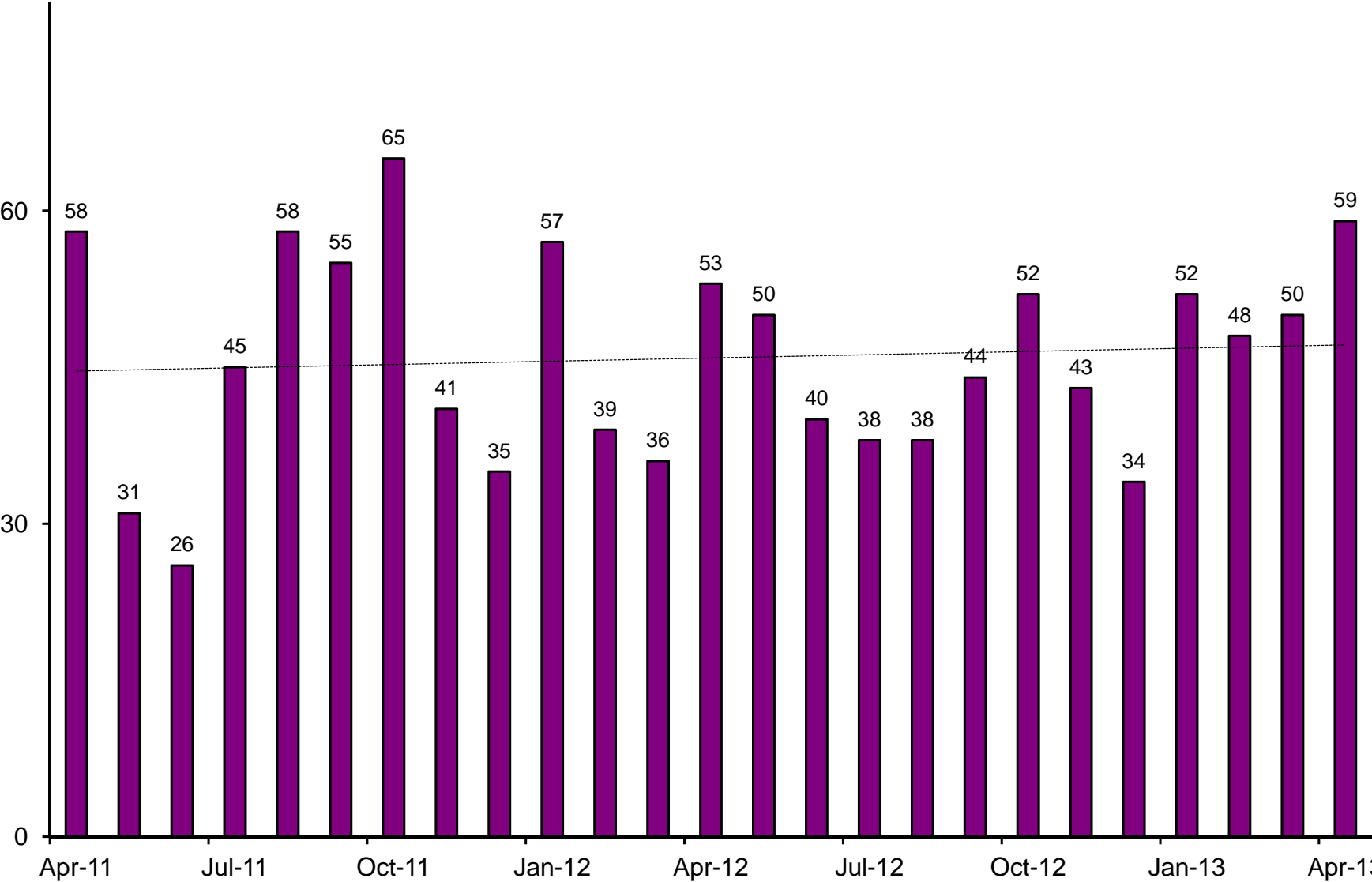

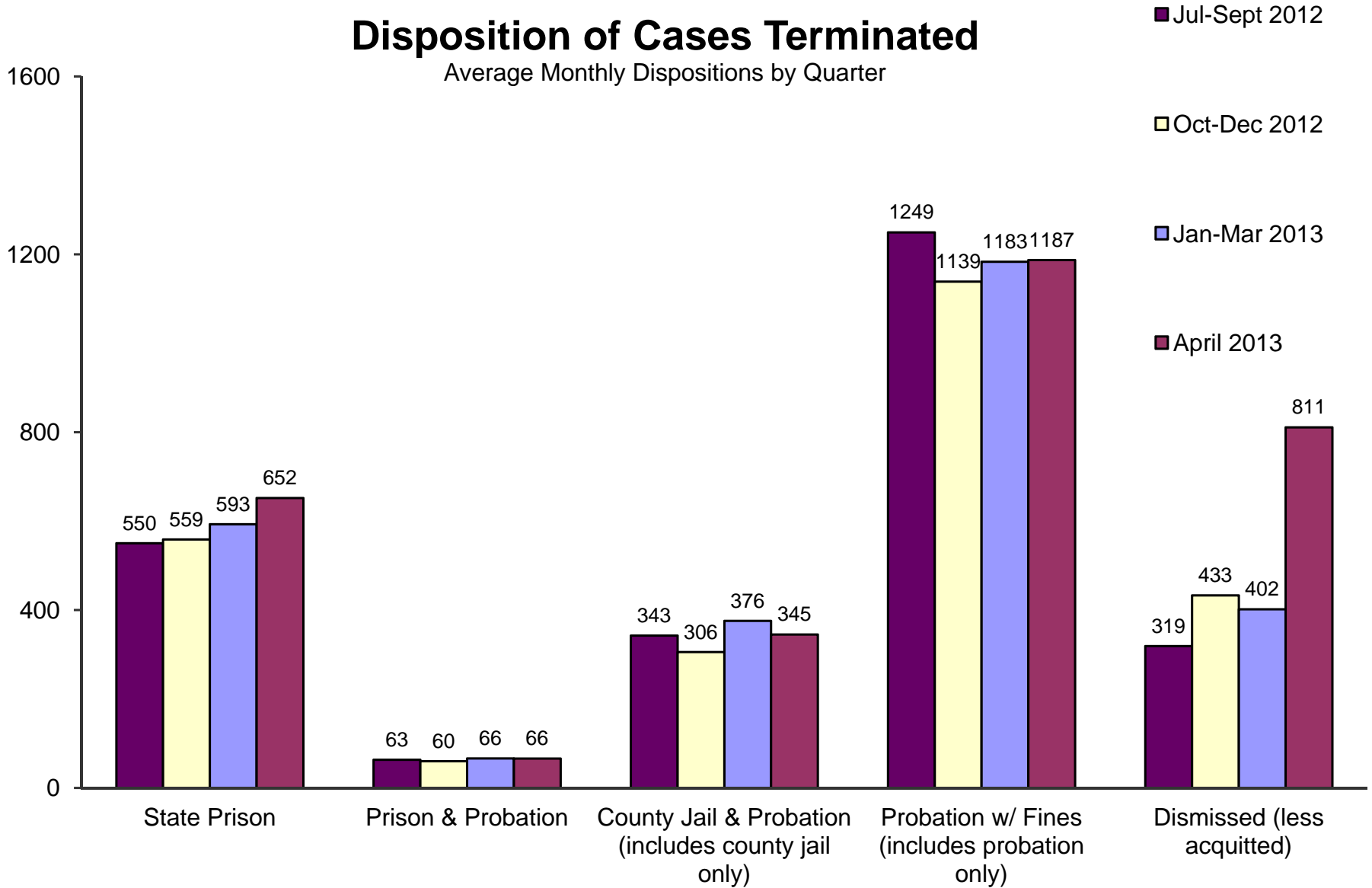


Superior Court Trials Completed

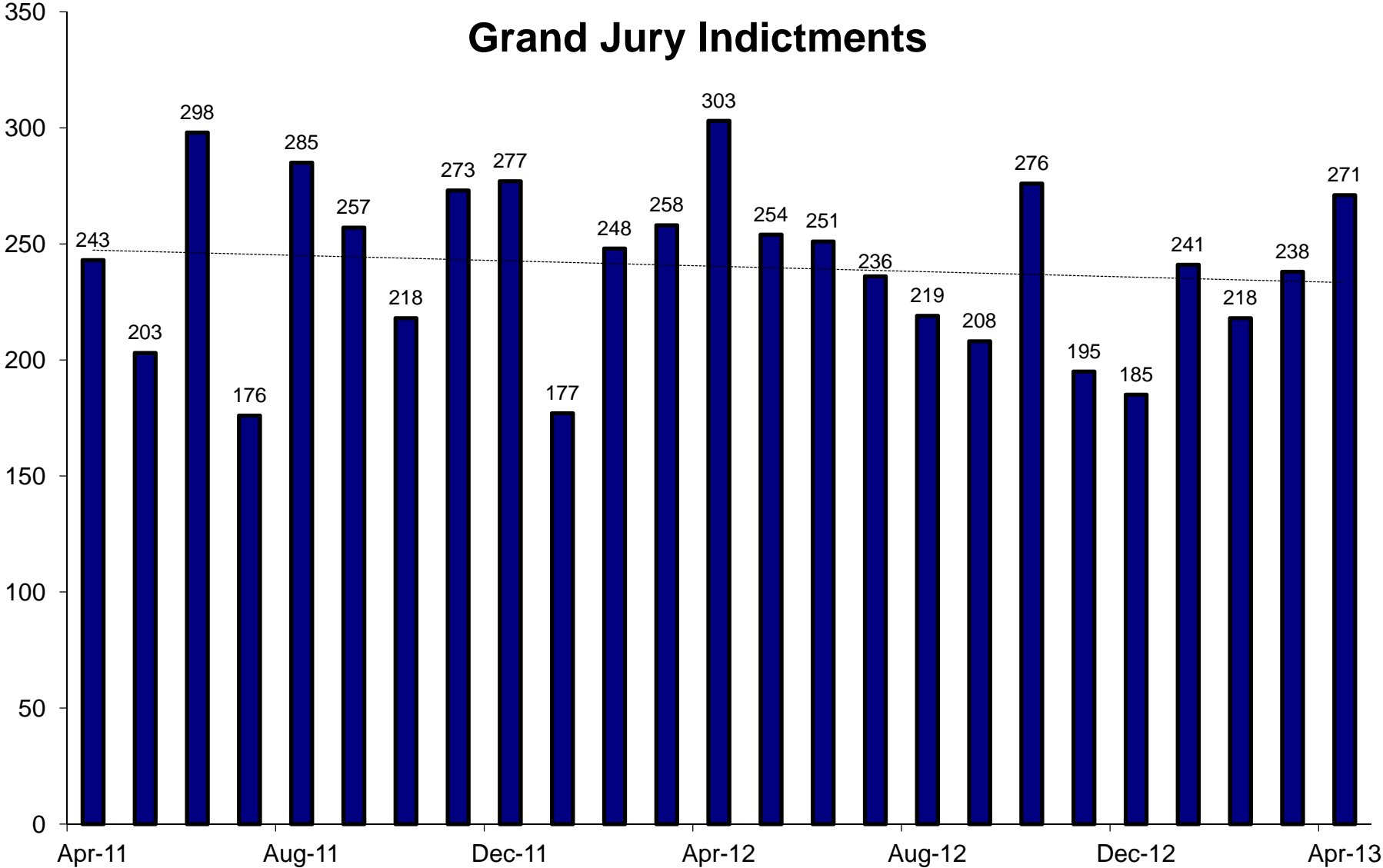


Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter

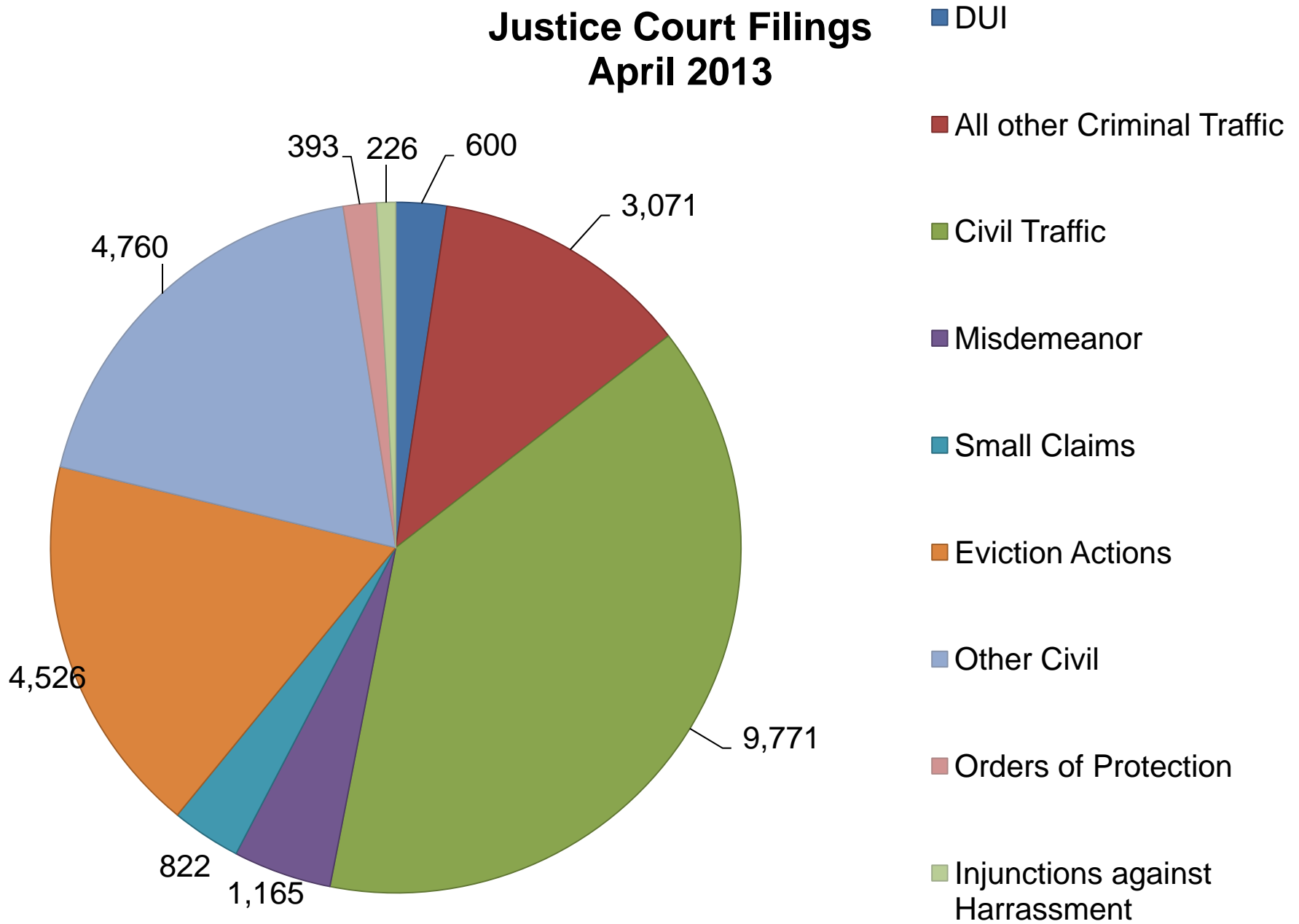


Grand Jury Indictments

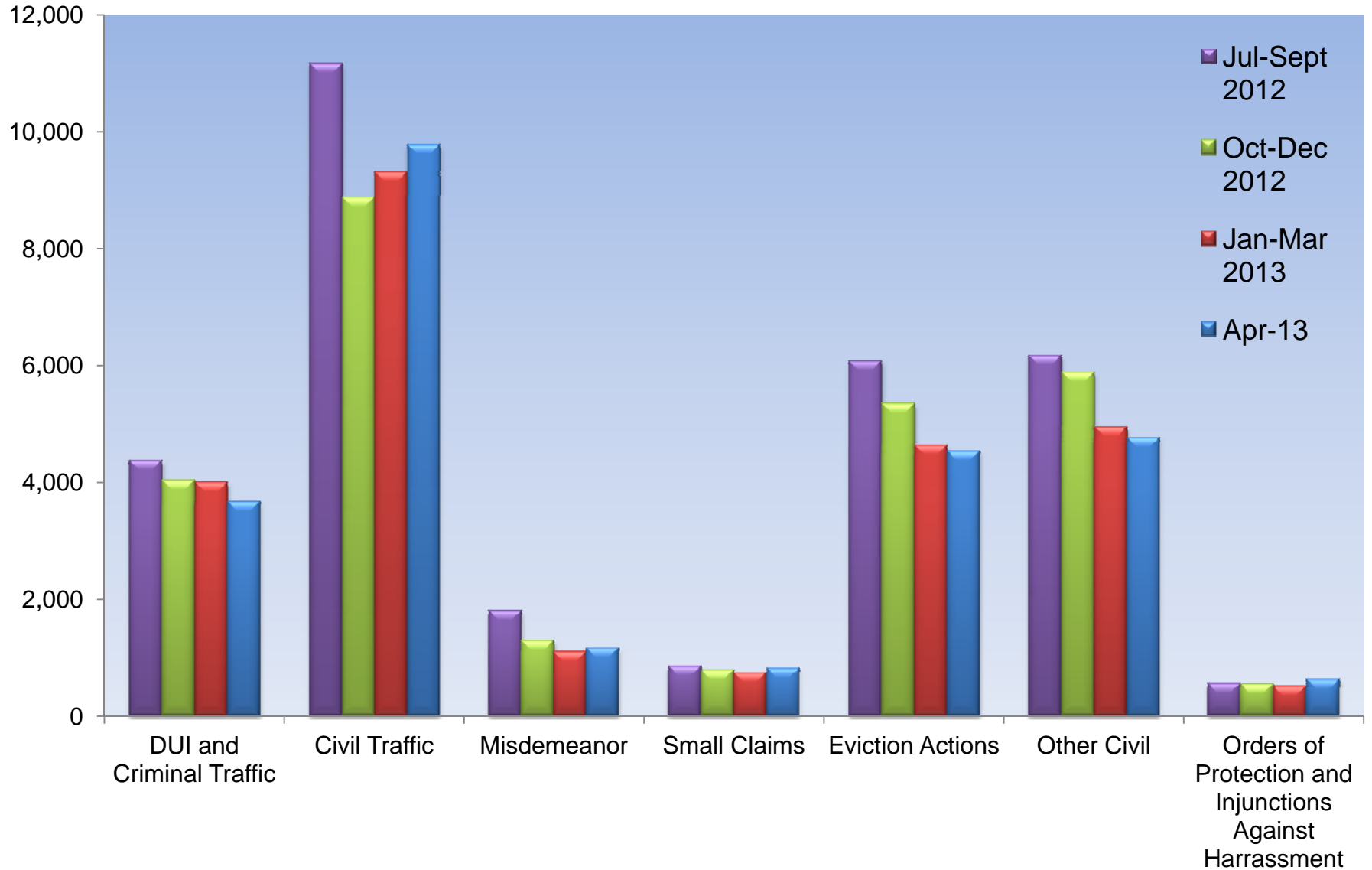

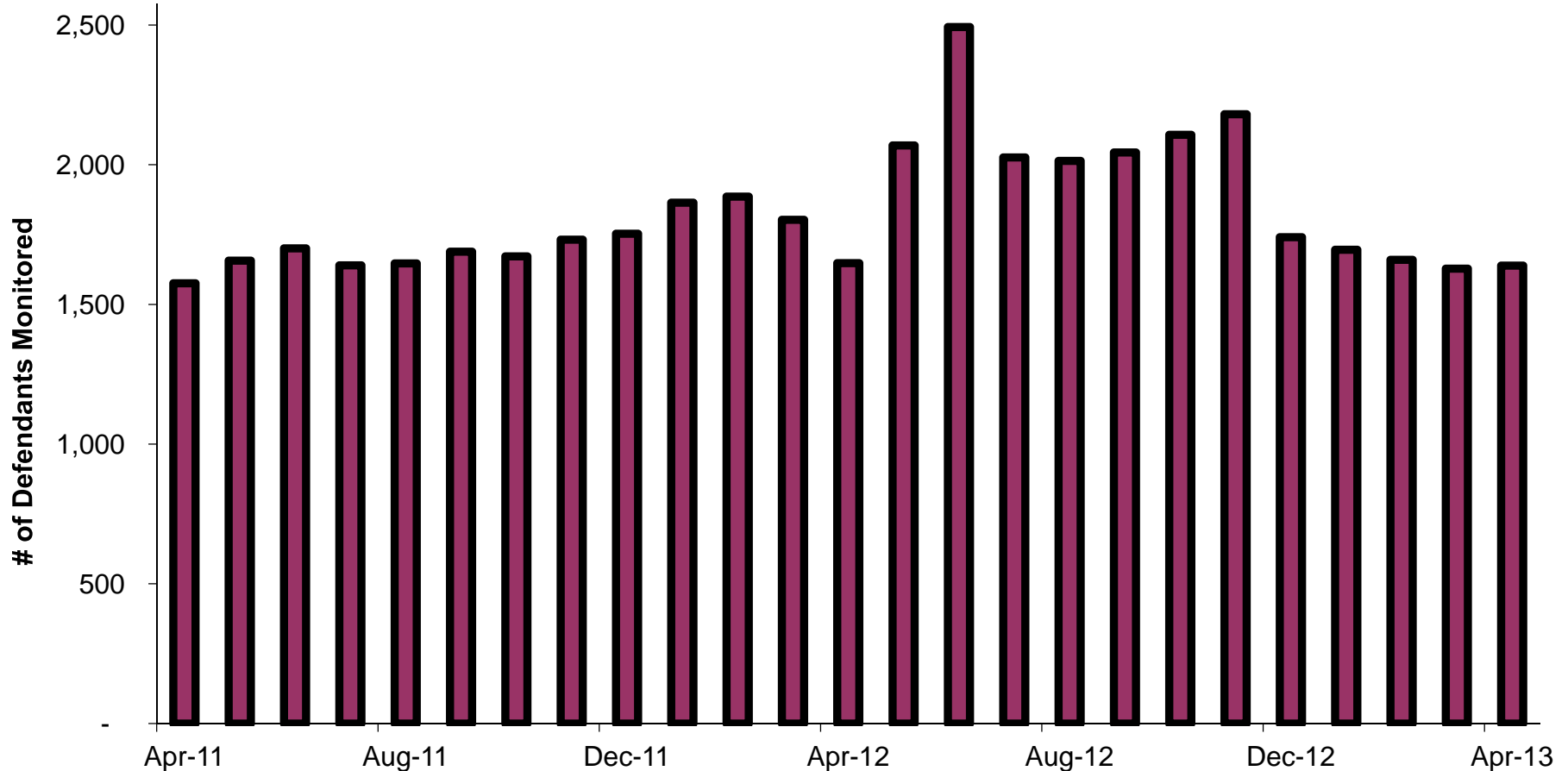
Justice Court Filings April 2013



Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average

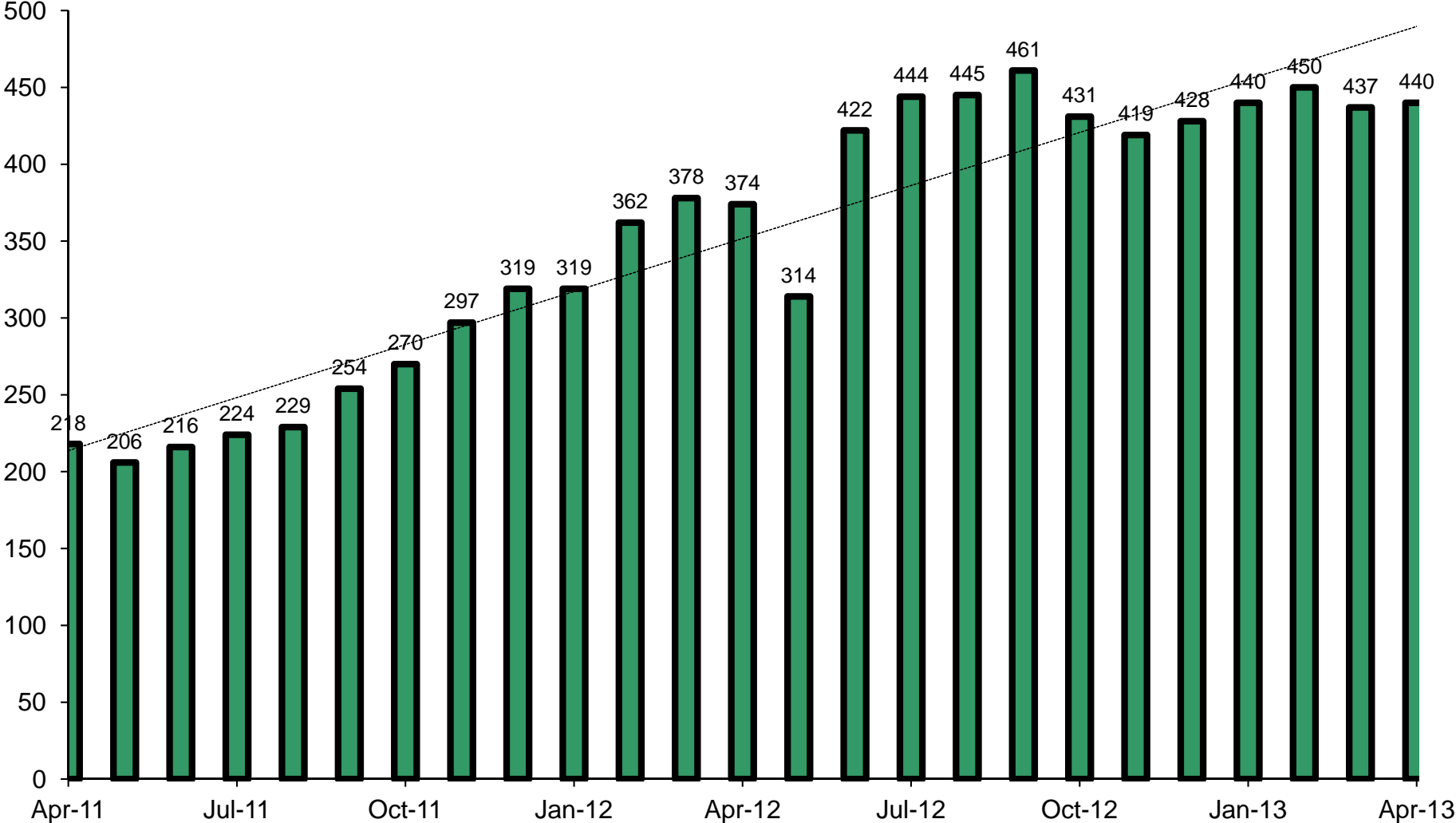


Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload

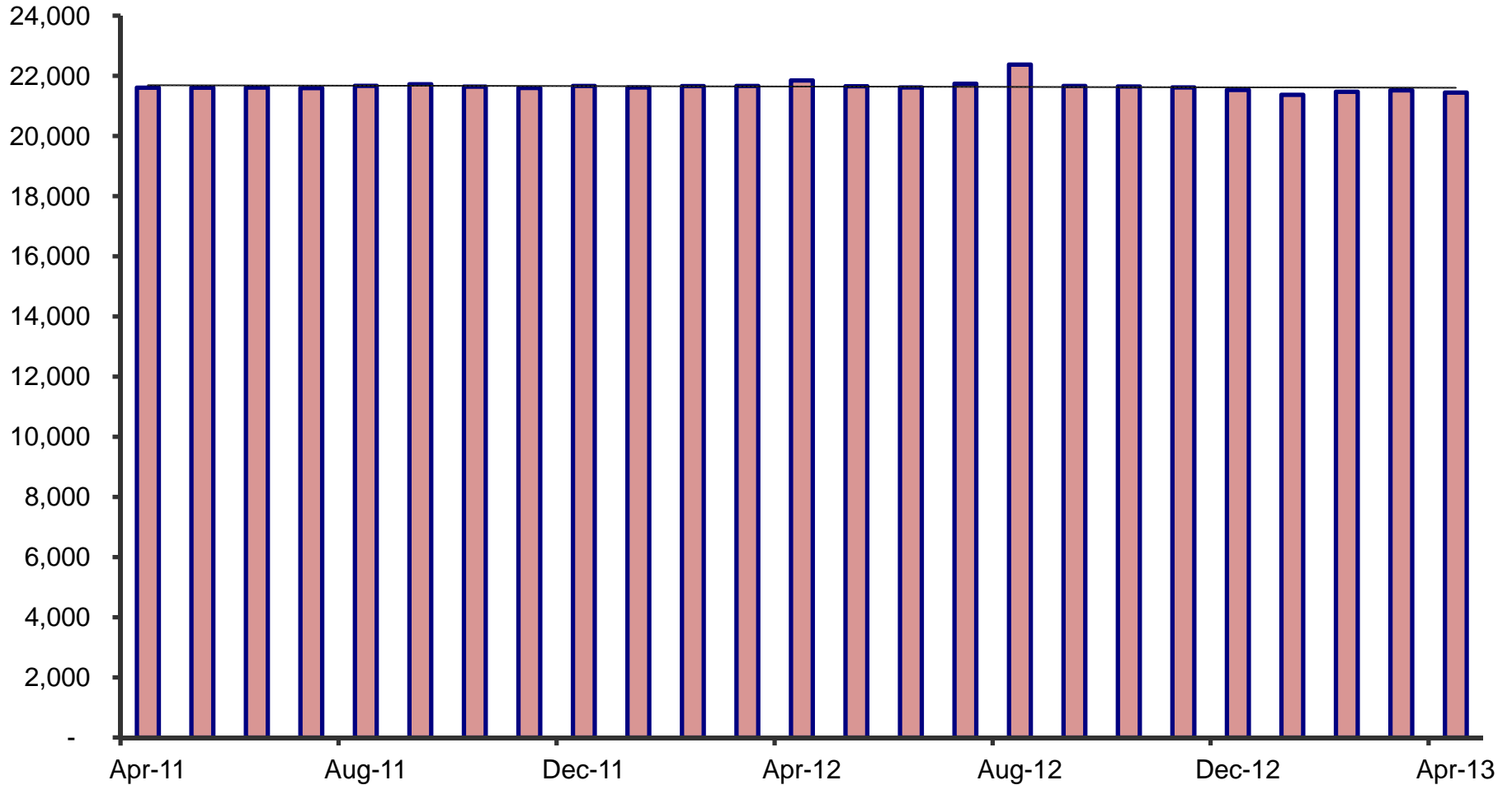

Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring

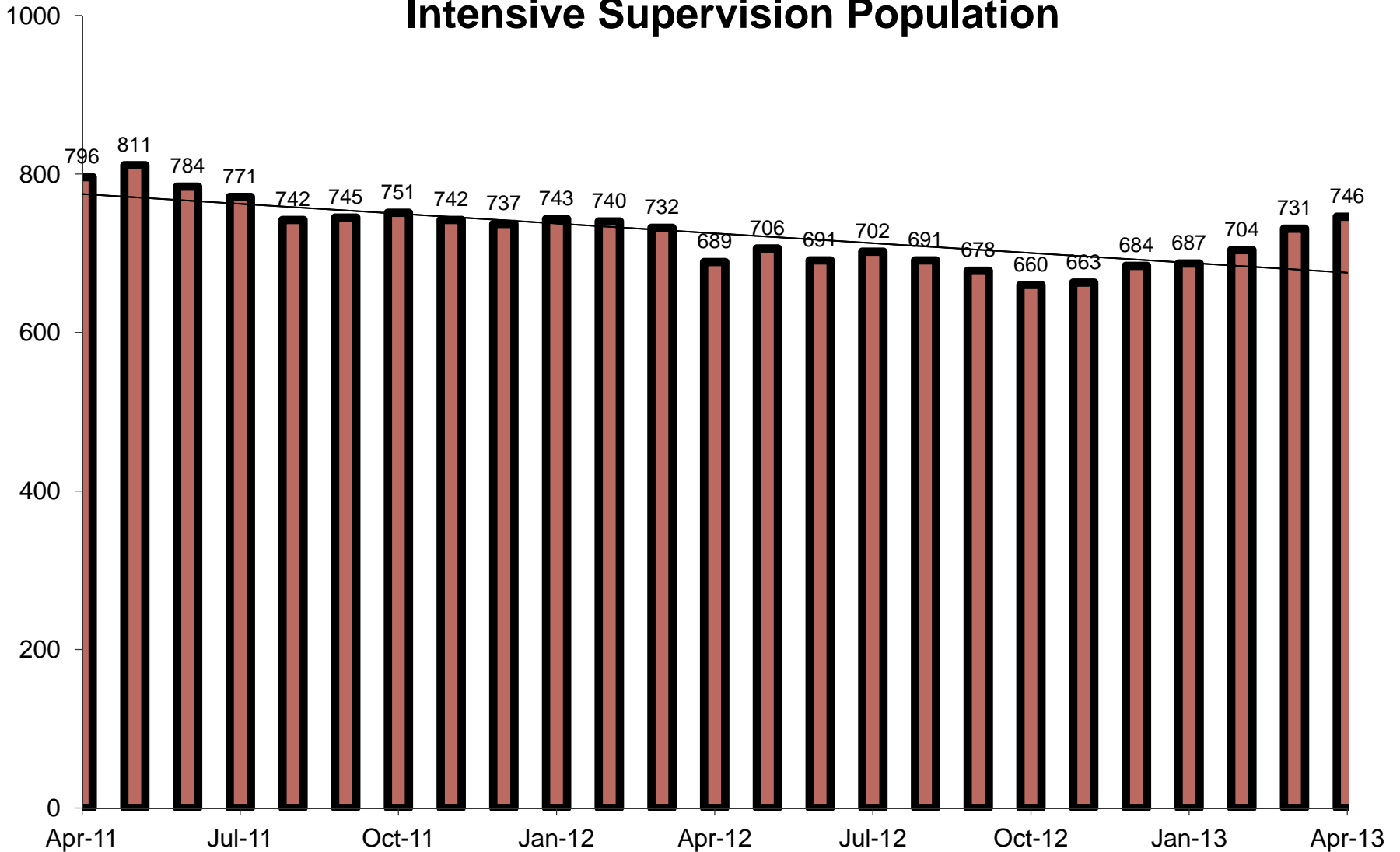


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

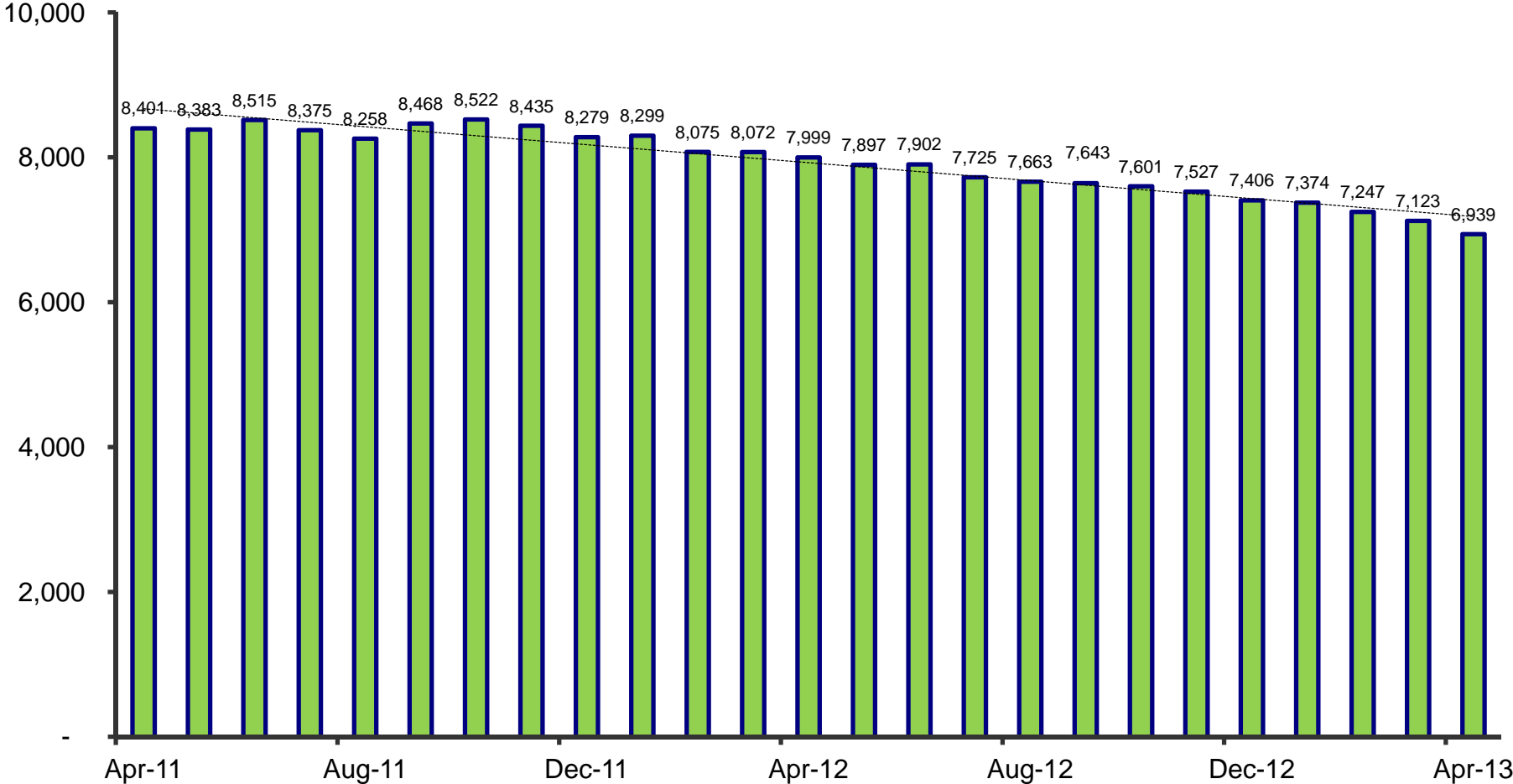

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population

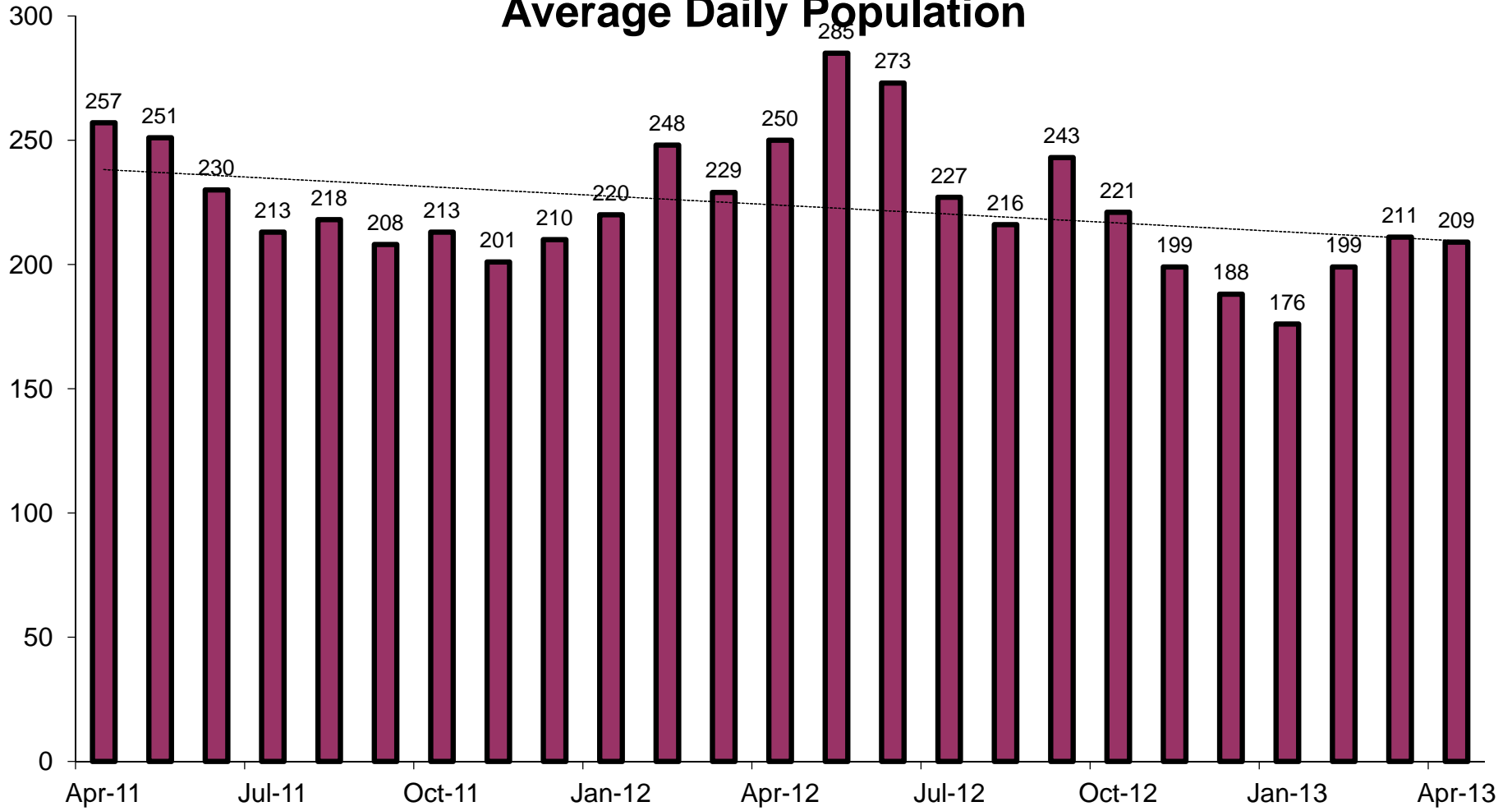


Adult Probation Unsupervised Population

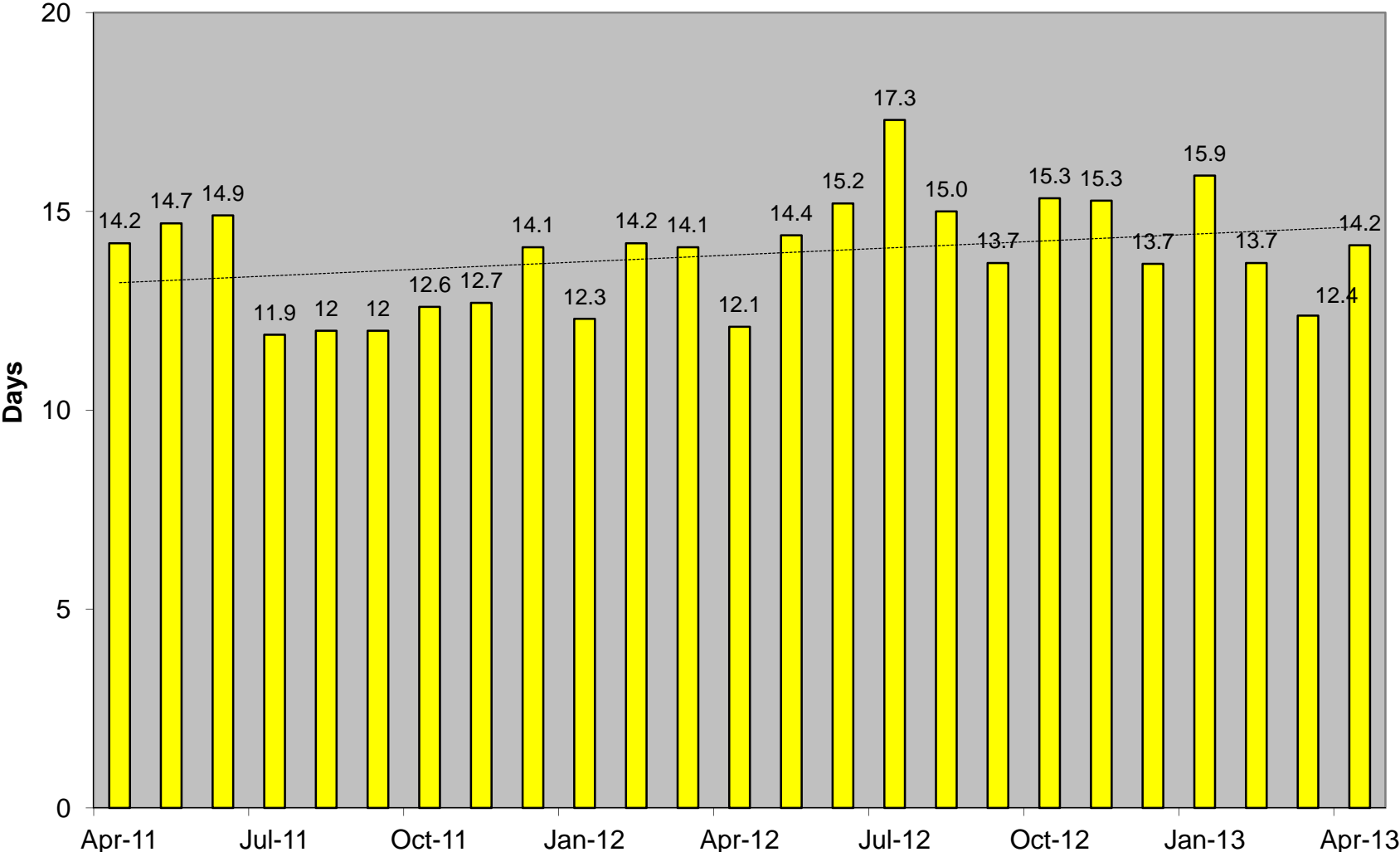
