Criminal Justice System News

Adult Incarceration: Bookings rose in August to the highest level (10,823) since May 1998 (10,925). The average daily population rose to its highest level ever. The ALOS fell over a day, to 28.1 days, compared to July's 29.4 days.

The ALOS for all populations decreased in August compared to July. Agency holds fell from 72.2 to 71.1 days; pretrial felony from 13.6 to 9.1 days; pretrial misdemeanor from 3.69 to 3.66 days; and sentenced from 33.4 to 32.5 days.

Filings & Case Processing: Superior Court filings and terminations increased from July to August. Compared to the first two months of FY05, the first two months of FY06 have seen a 22% increase in criminal filings. The active pending case inventory rose over 11,000 for the first time in August. Arraigned cases also increased from 8,746 to 8,922. After declines in July, filings increased in August in both the RCC and EDC. Filings were up in the RCC, from 1,859 to 2,130. EDC/Direct Complaints increased from 800 to 1,178.

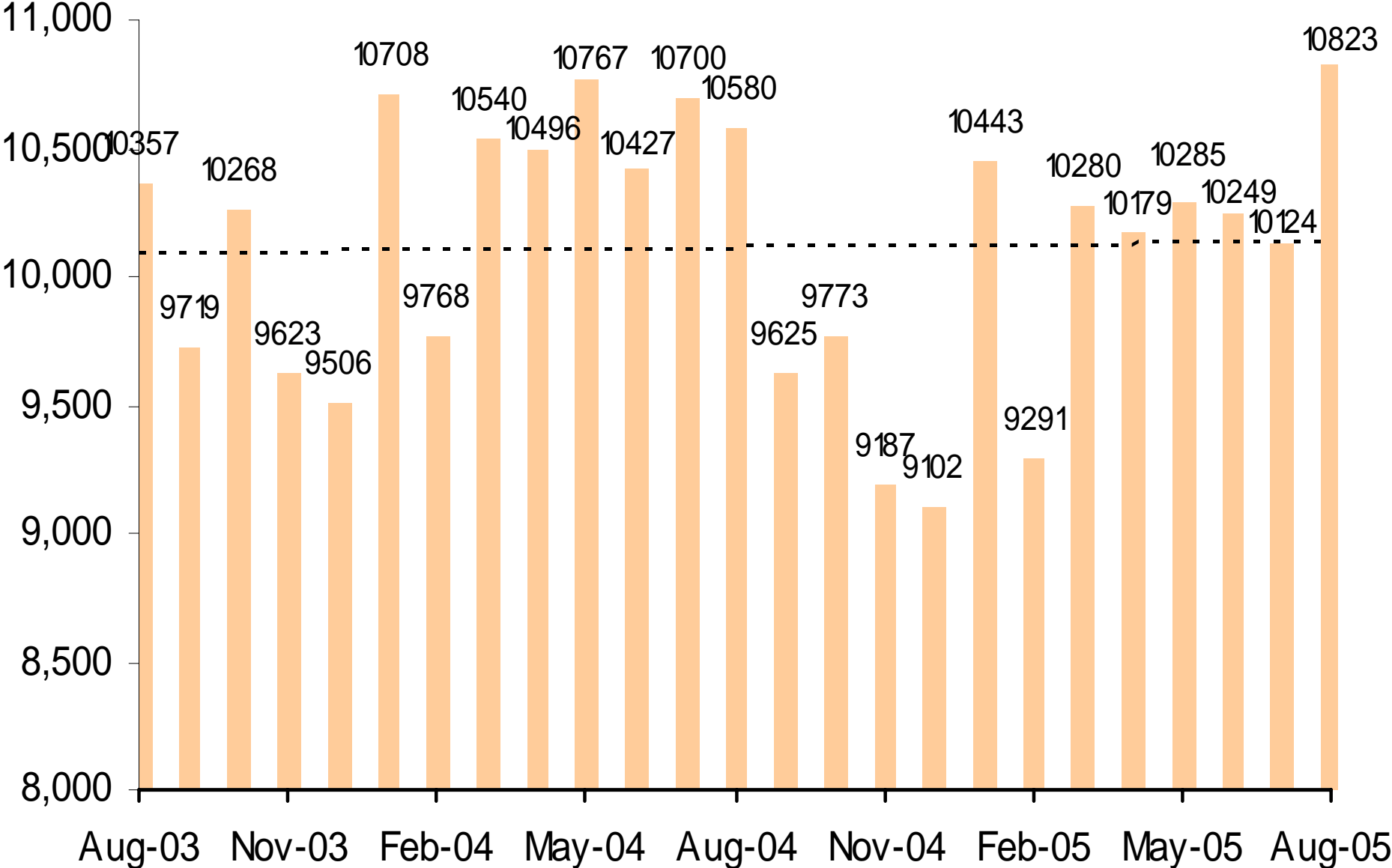
Adult Probation: All areas of pretrial supervision decreased from July to August. General fell from 765 to 720; intensive from 903 to 893; and electronic monitoring from 181 to 167. General supervision was at the lowest level since February 2003.

Levels of standard probation supervision increased from July (36,955) to August (27,021). Levels of intensive probation supervision decreased from 1,388 to 1,367.

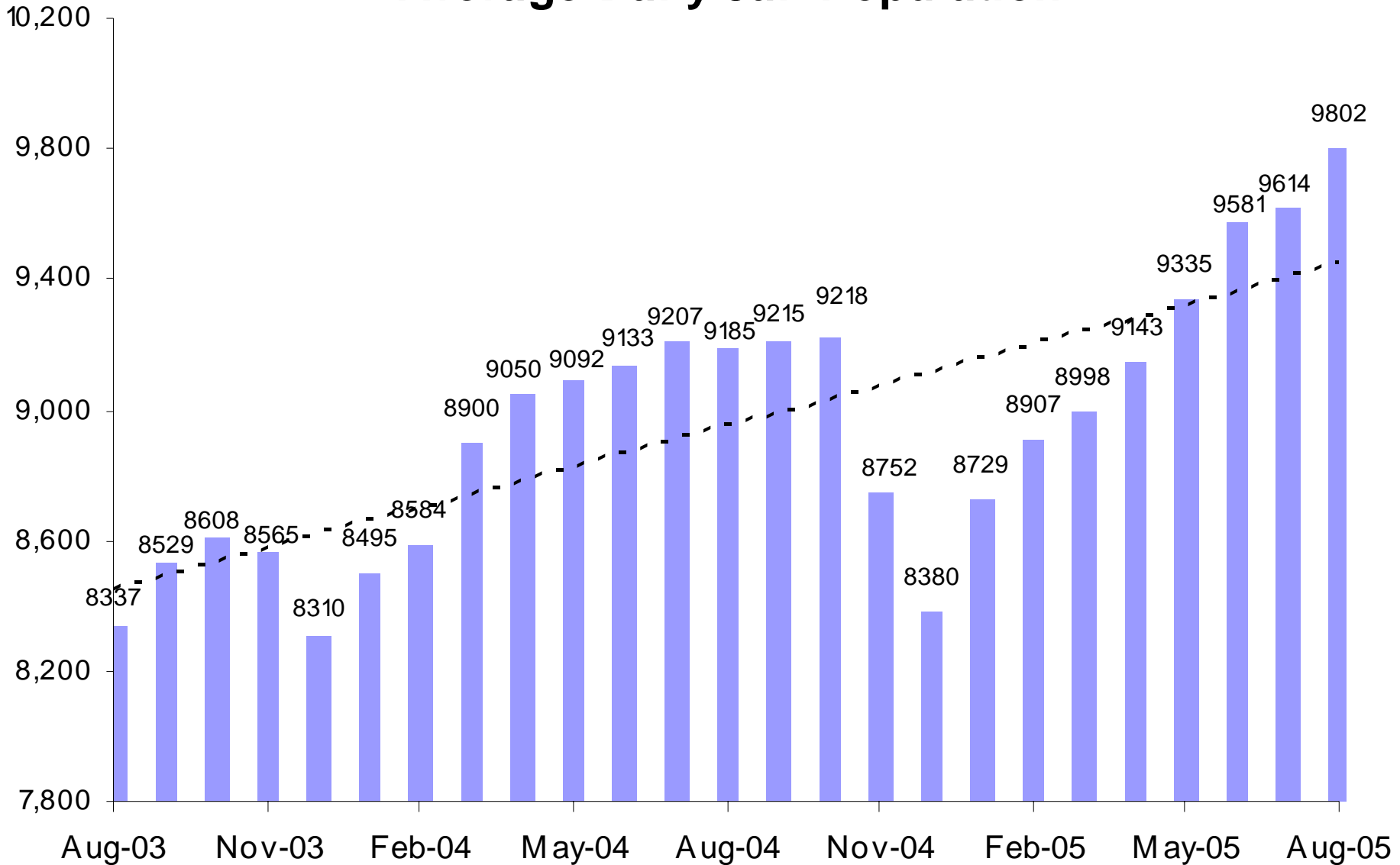
Juvenile Detention: The average daily population fell to its lowest level since January 2005, when it was at 398. The length of stay also decreased from July's 19.9 days to August's 18.0 days. Electronic monitoring increased from 52 to 60, the highest level since February 2005. Home detention fell from 243 in July to 230 in August. This is the lowest level since January 2005, when it was also 230.

A criminal justice system-wide goal is to enhance the utility and timeliness of management information on case processing, in an effort to help agencies effectively address current events. 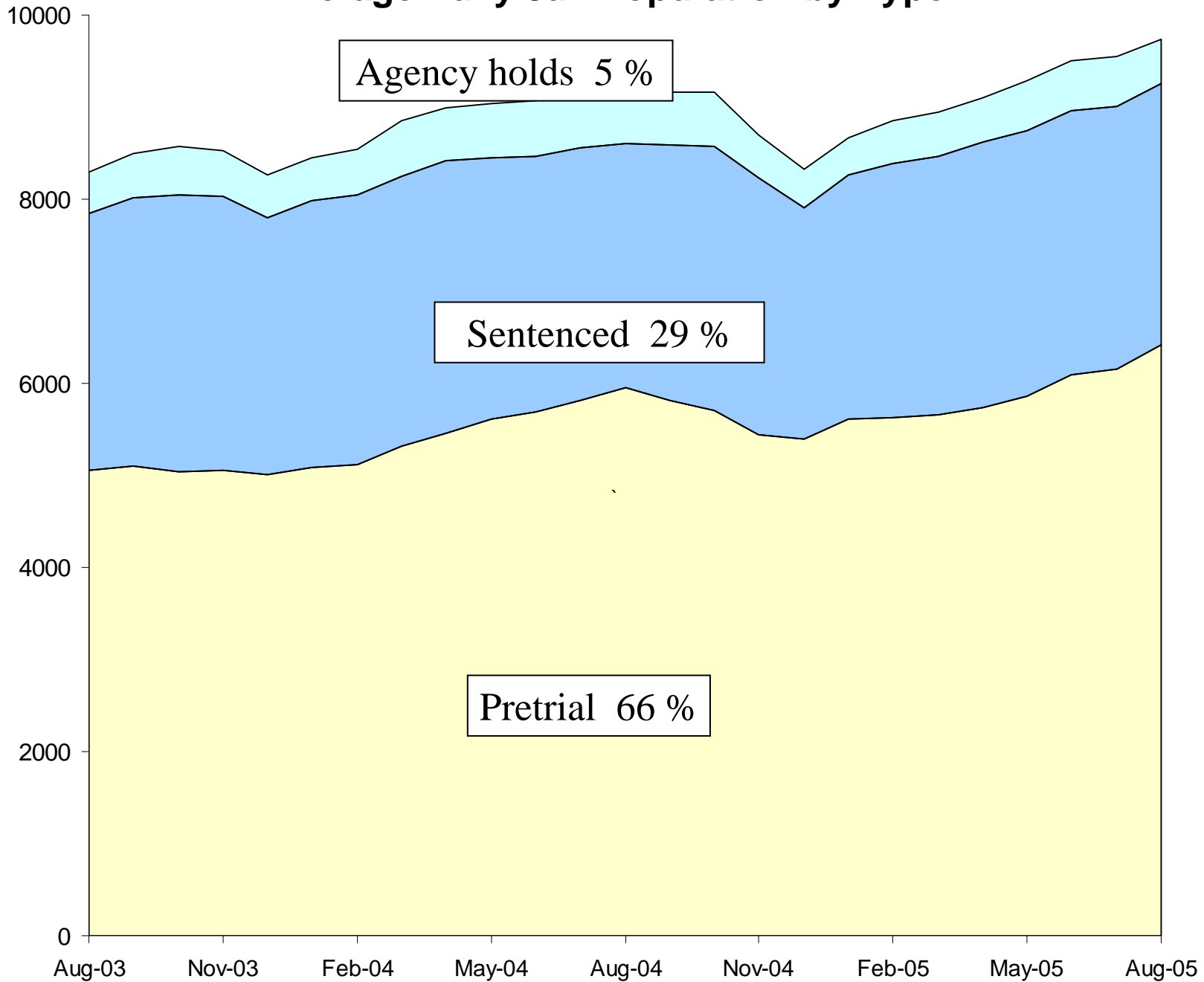
Jail Bookings

Average Daily Jail Population by Type

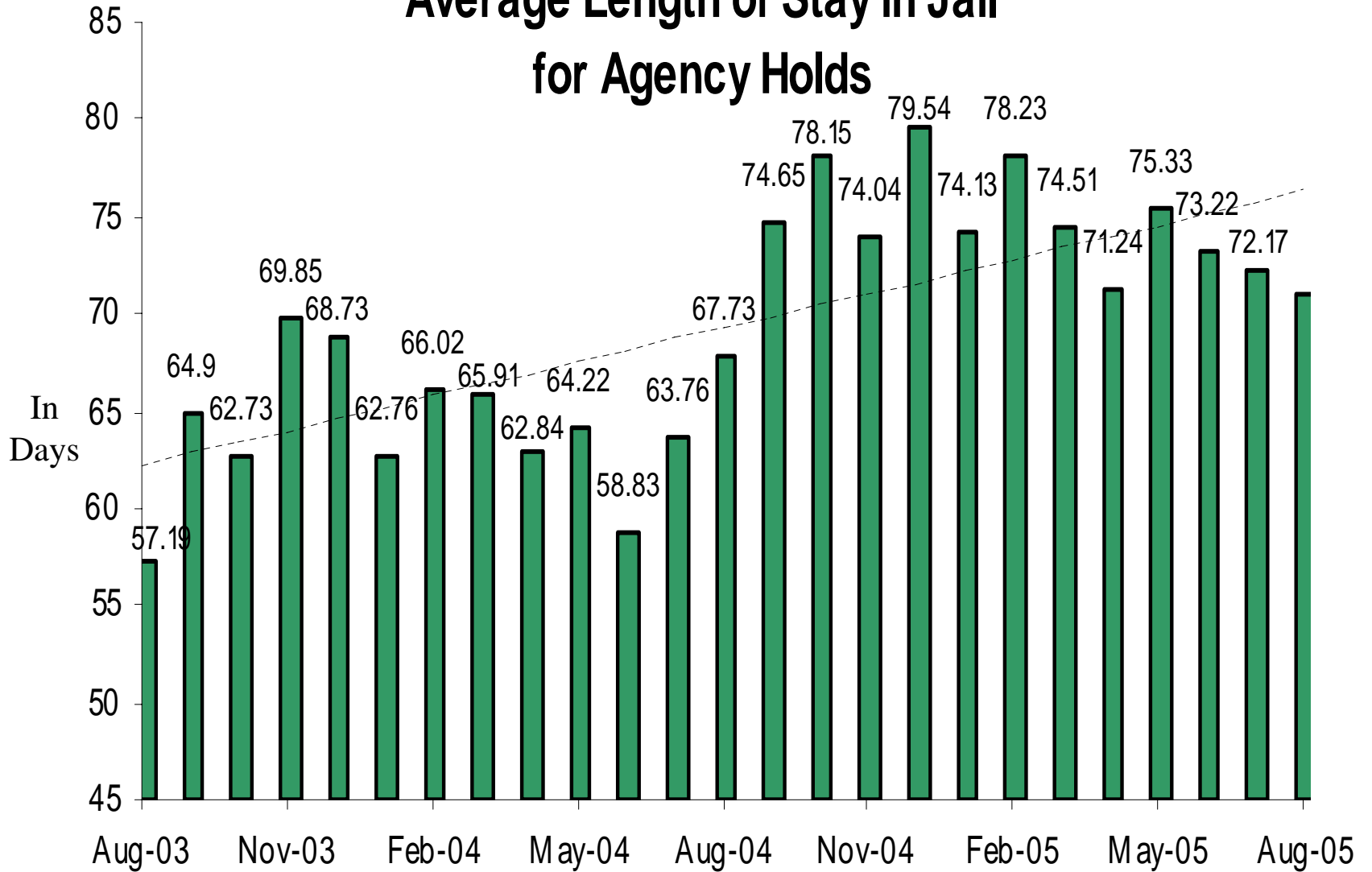

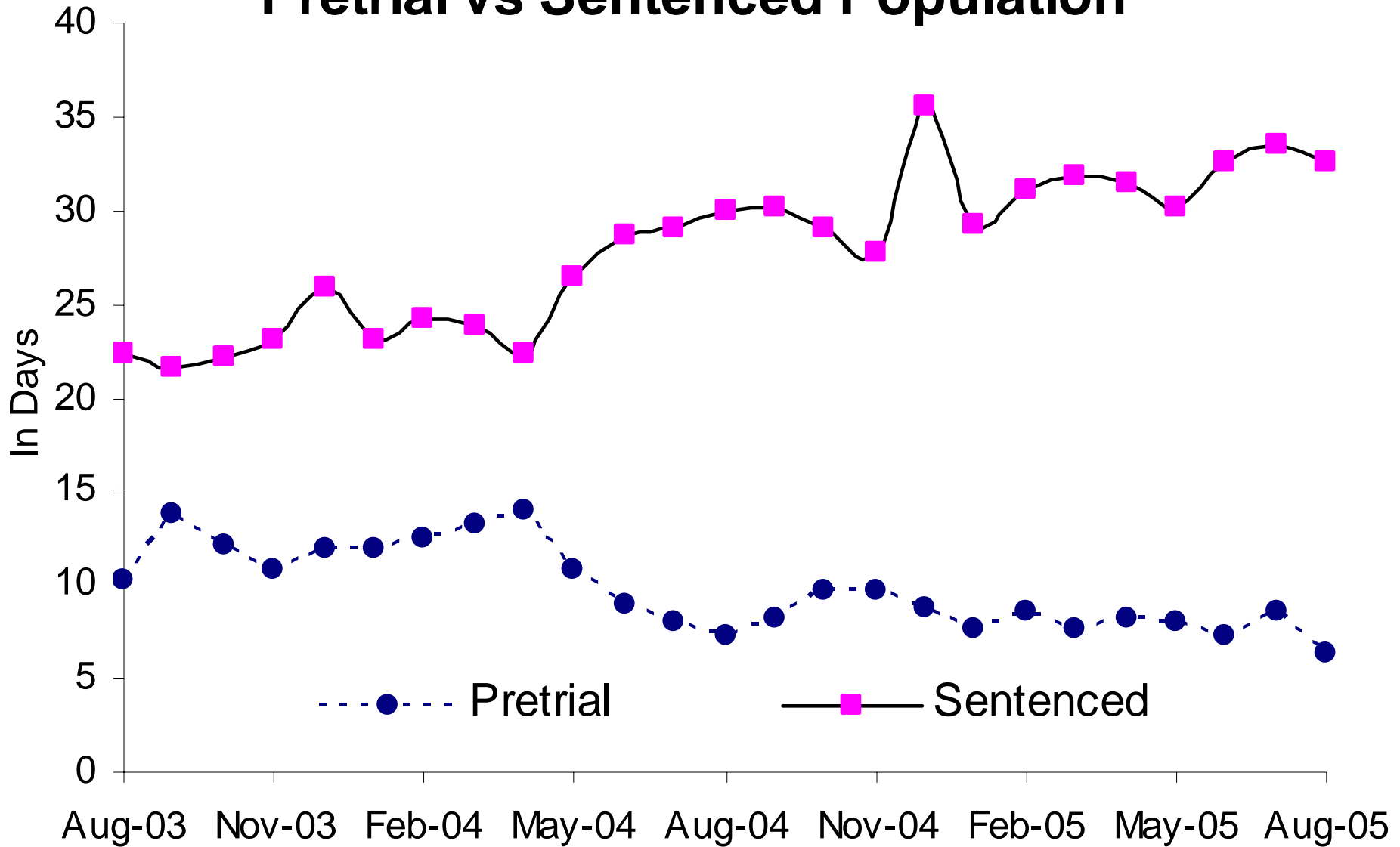

Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds

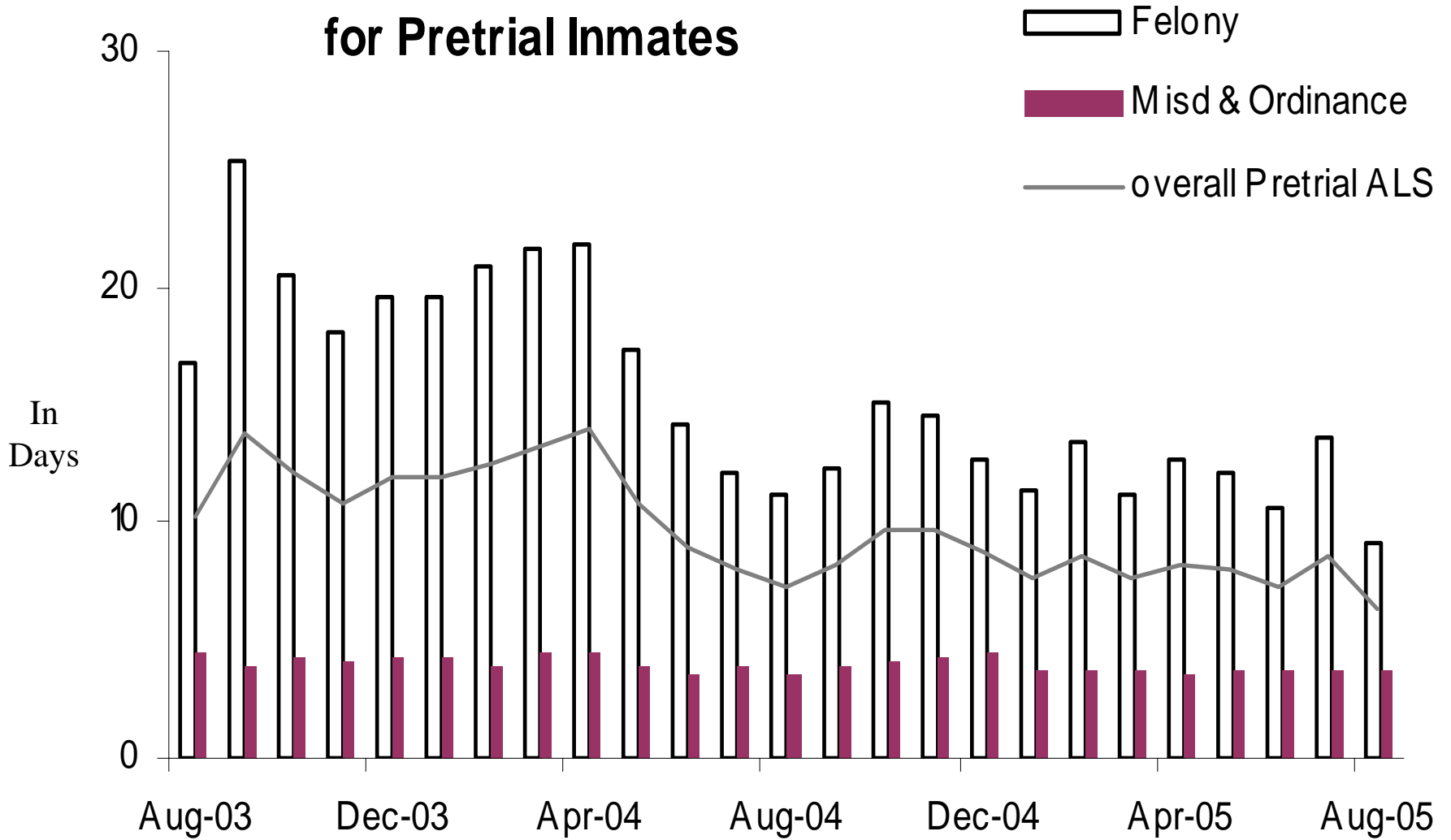

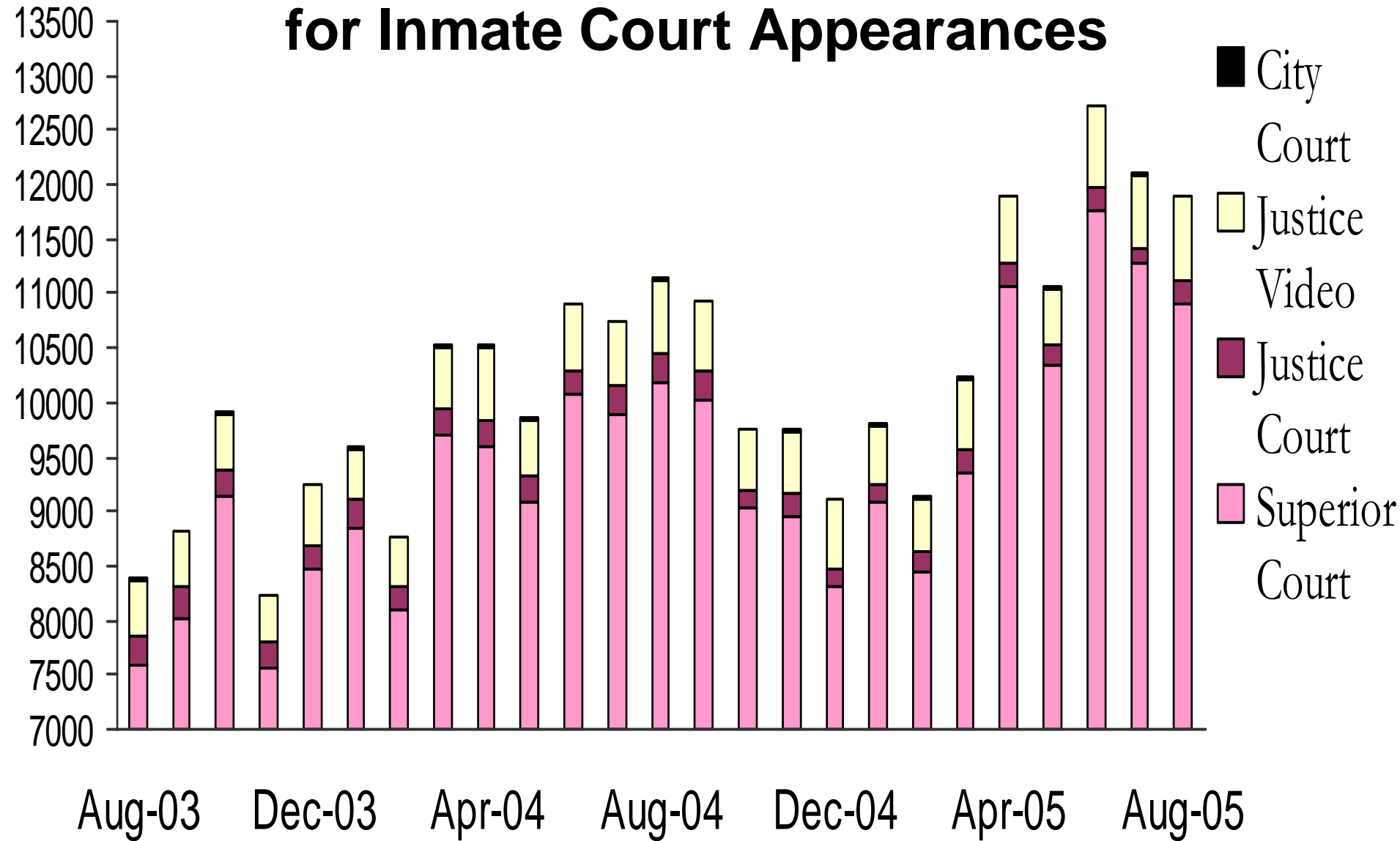
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



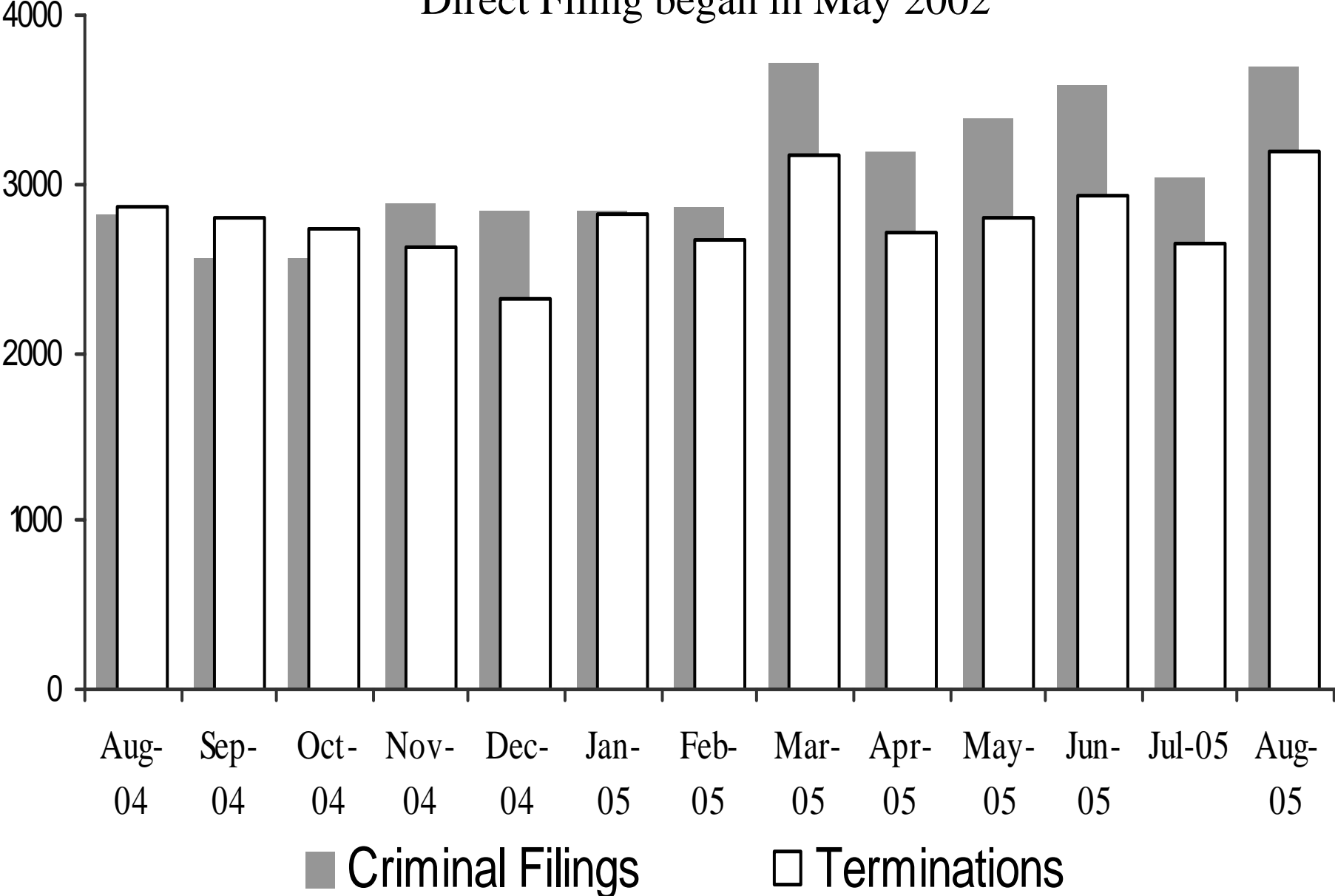
Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



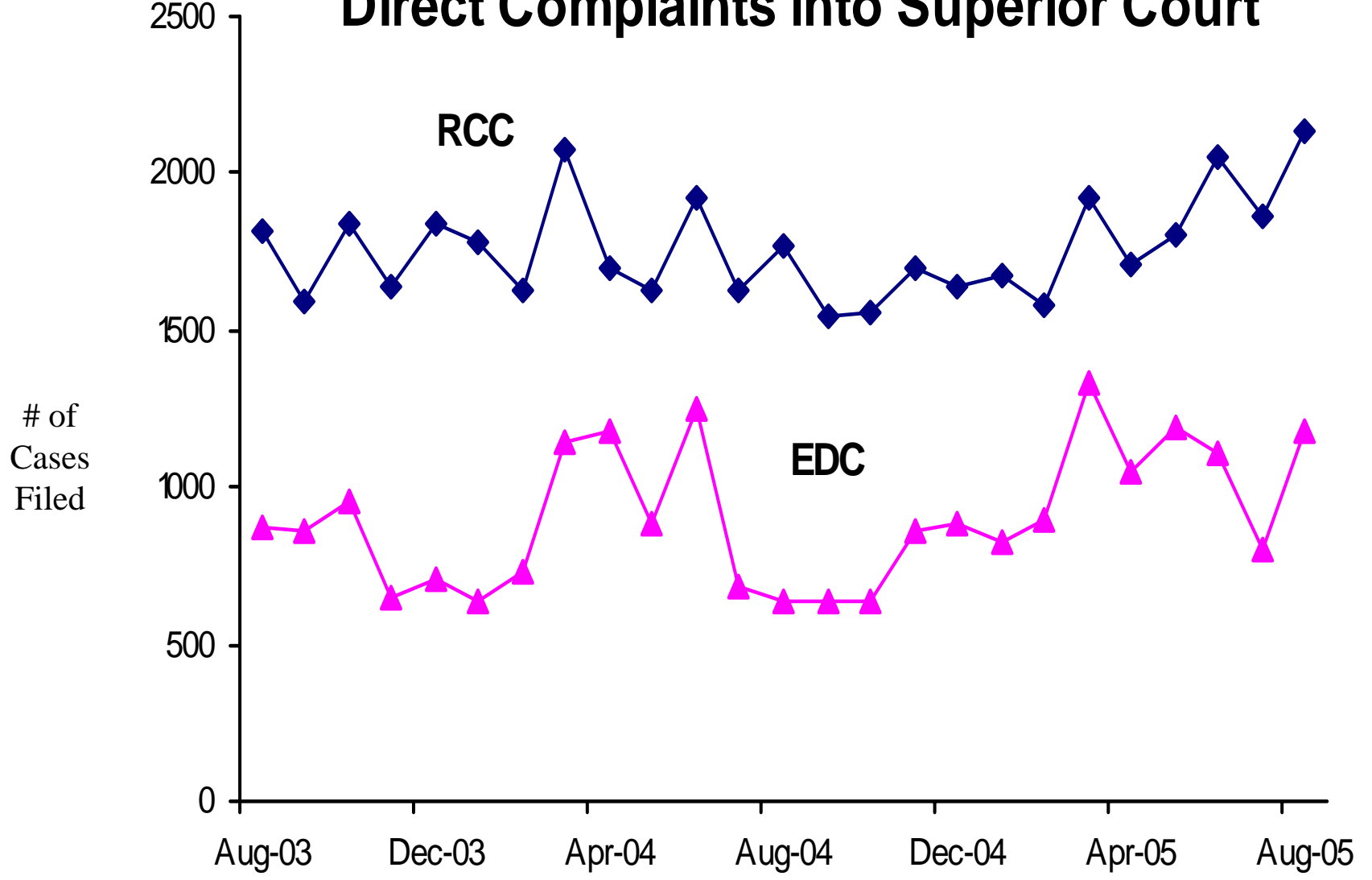
Since Direct Filing into Superior Court began May 2002, remaining transports to Justice Courts are for misdemeanor cases.

Superior Court Filings and Terminations

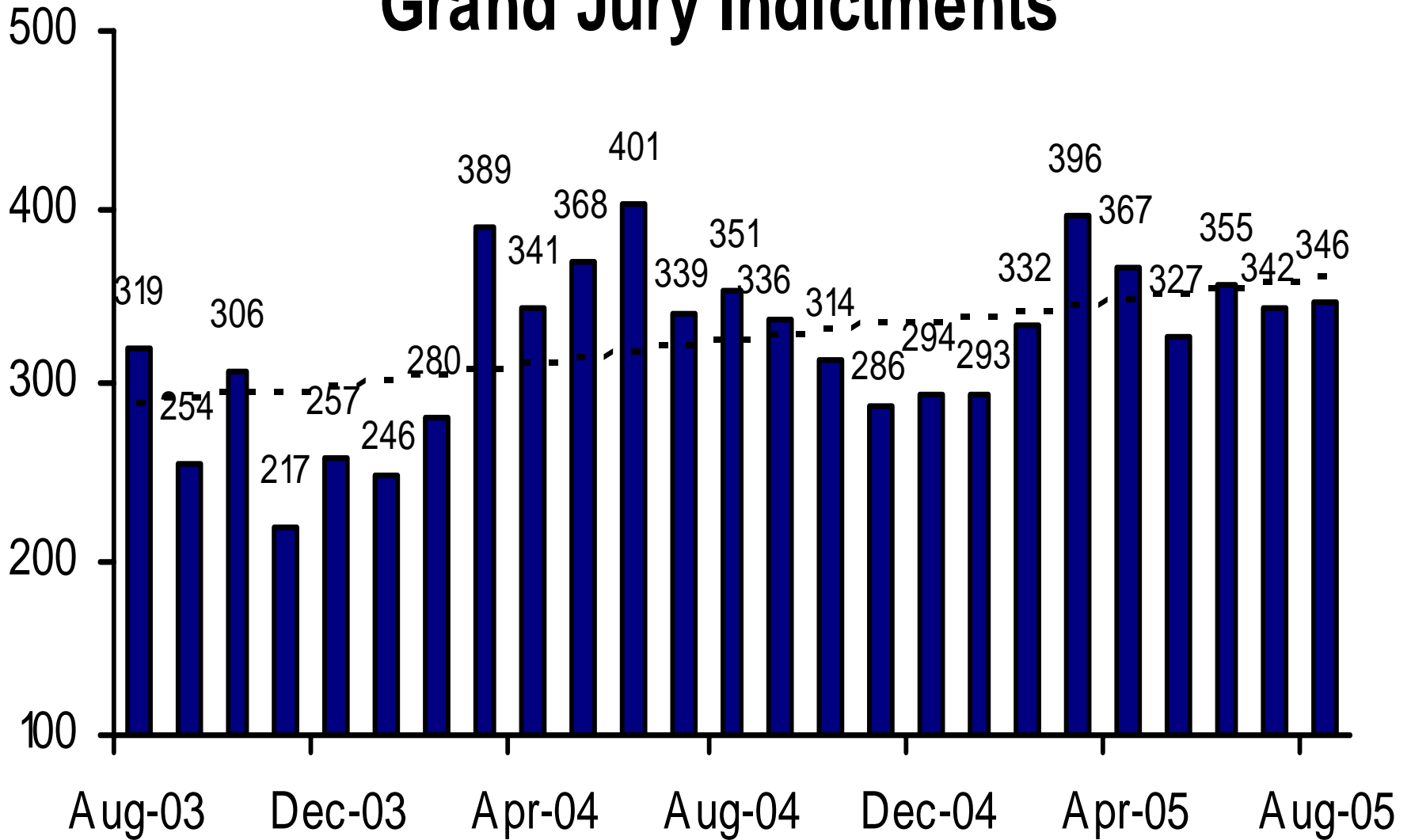
Direct Filing began in May 2002



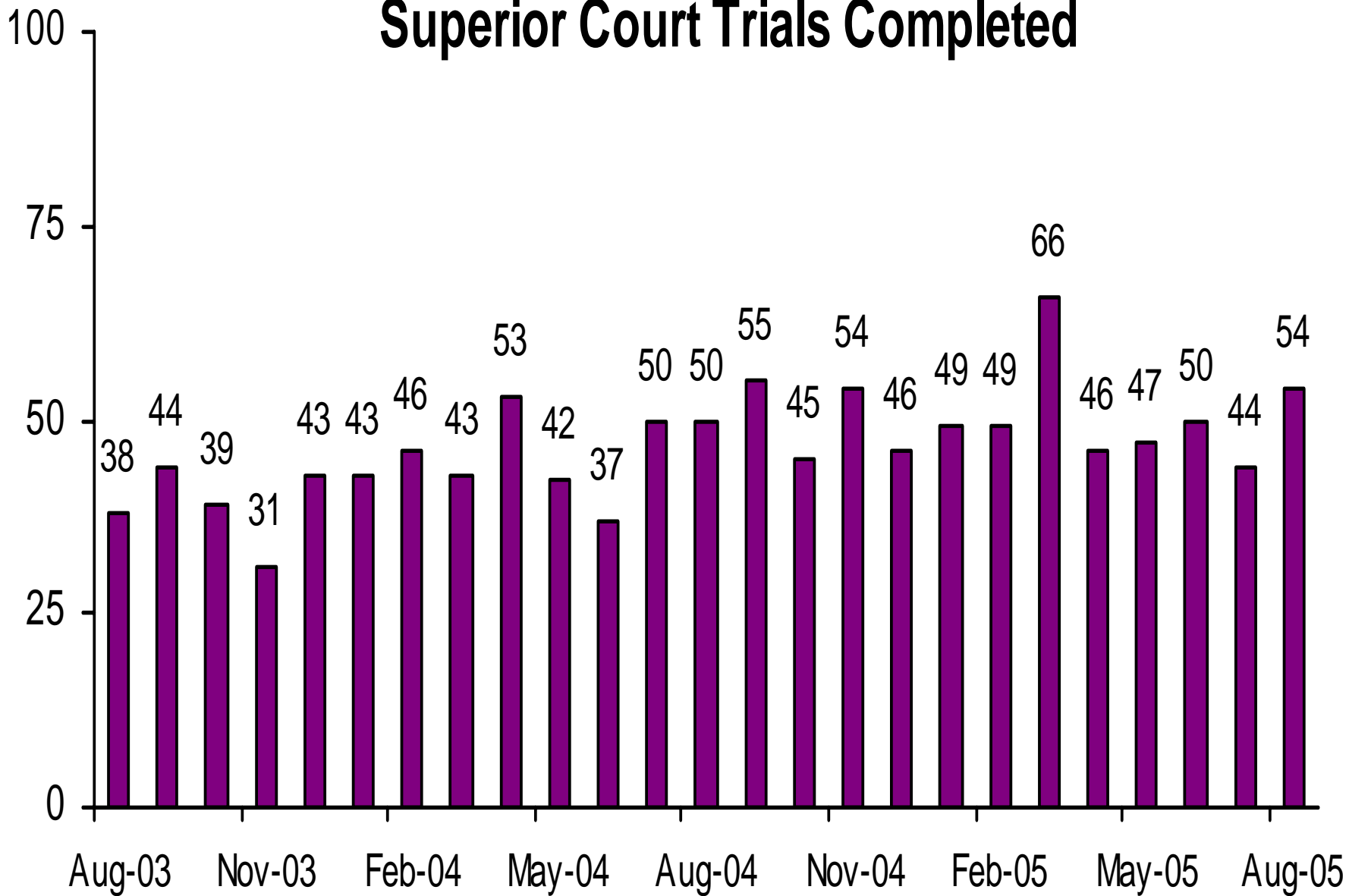
Direct Complaints into Superior Court



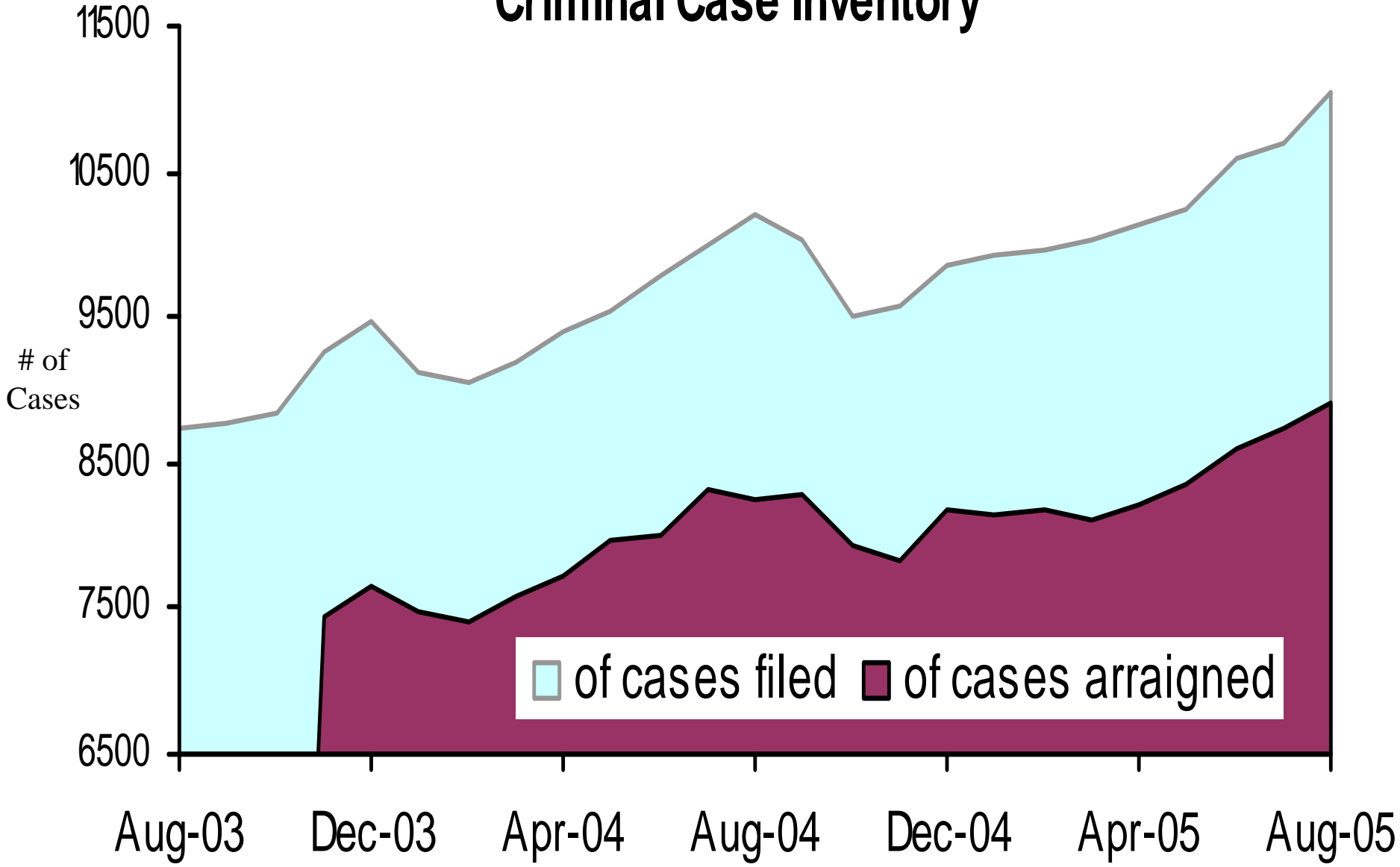
Grand Jury Indictments



Superior Court Trials Completed

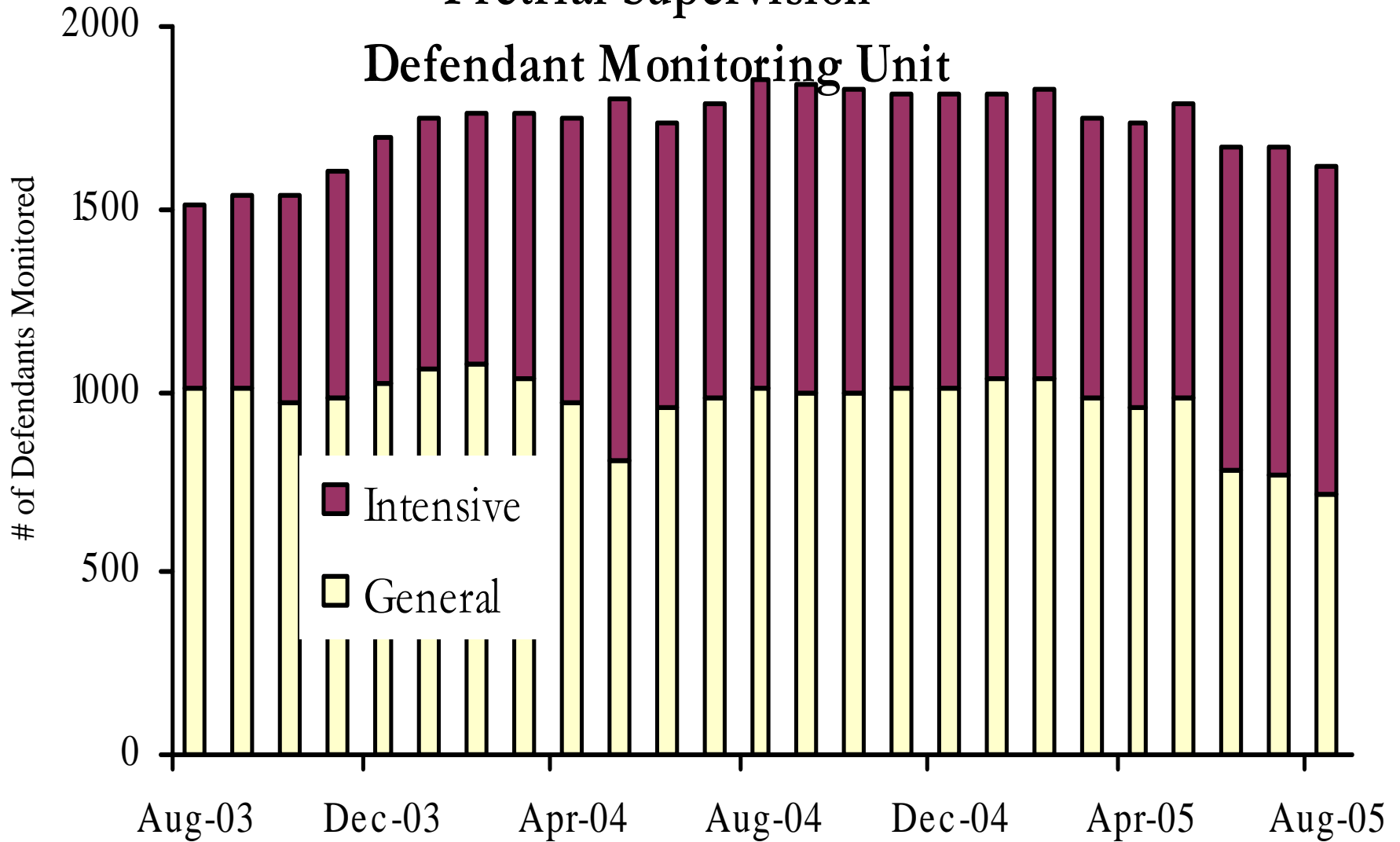


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

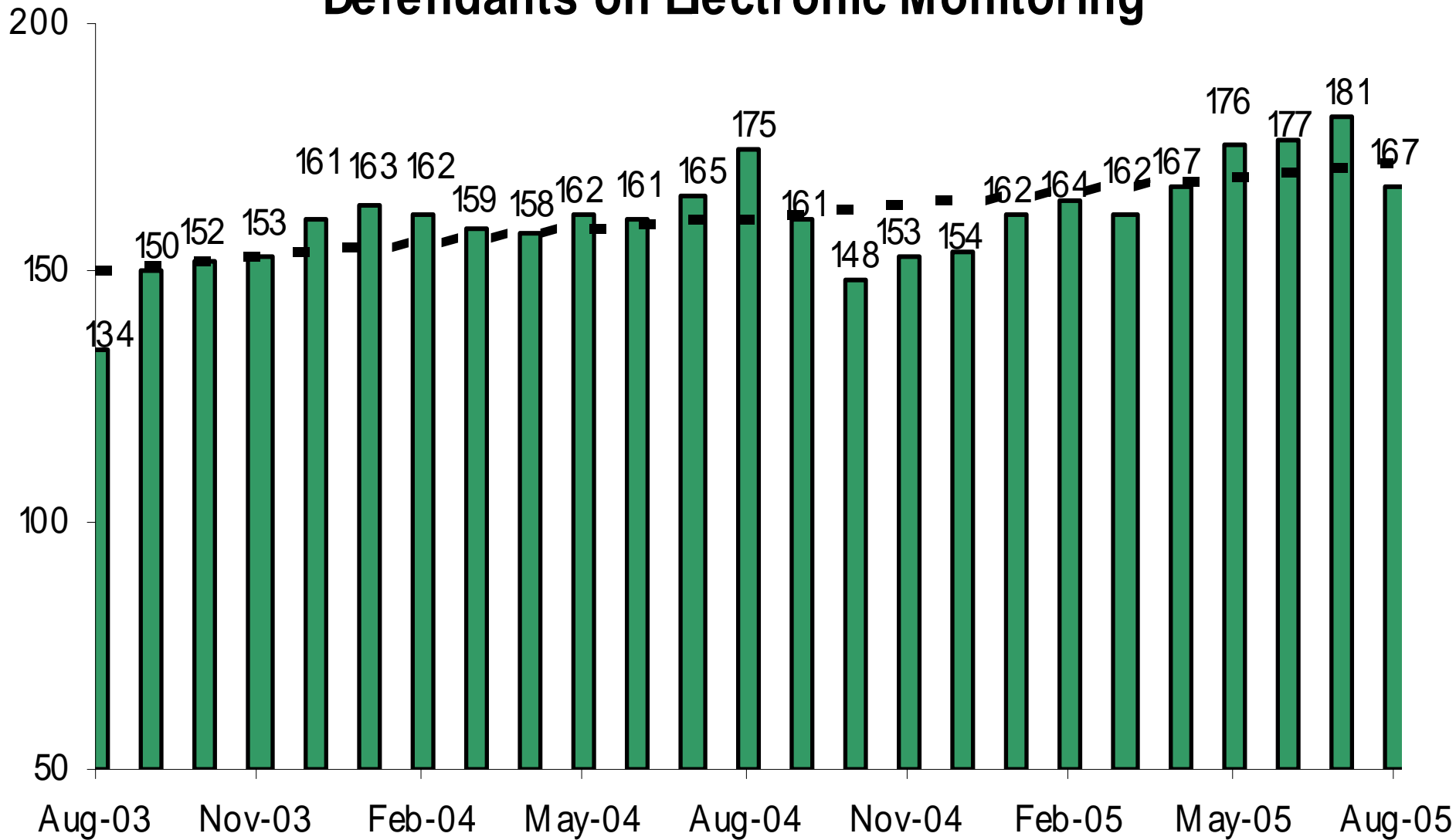


Pretrial Supervision

Defendant Monitoring Unit



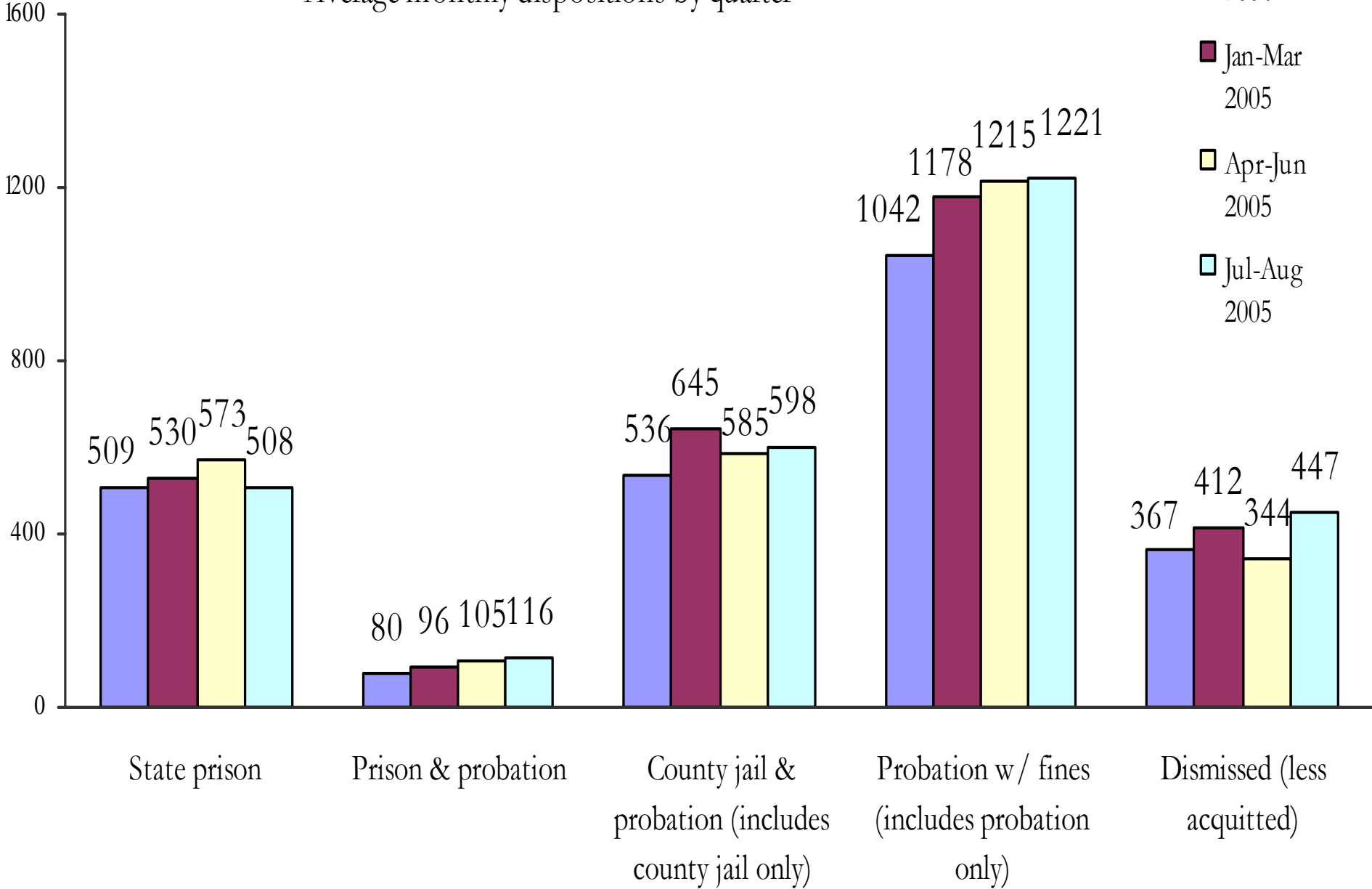
Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring



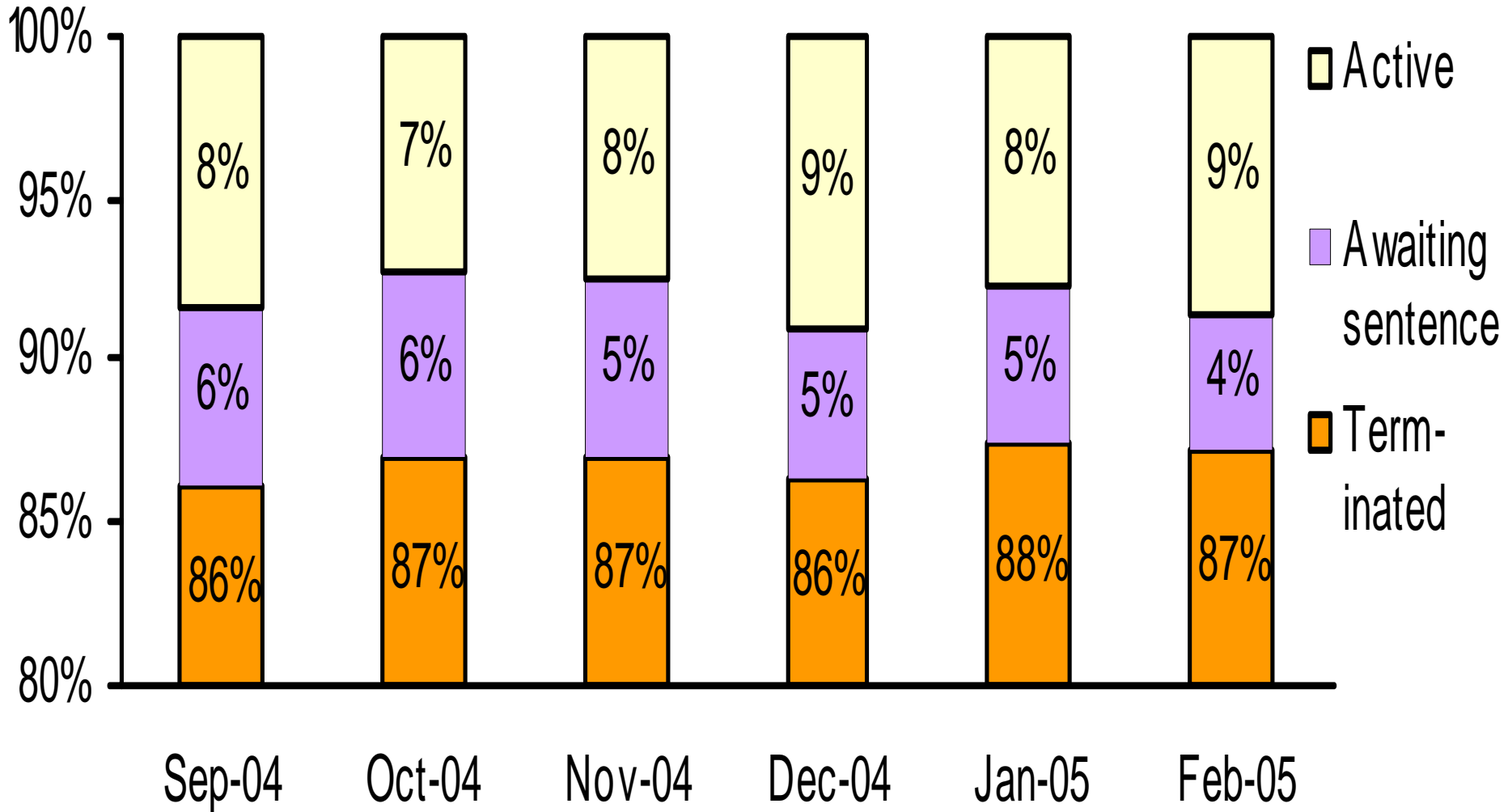
Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter

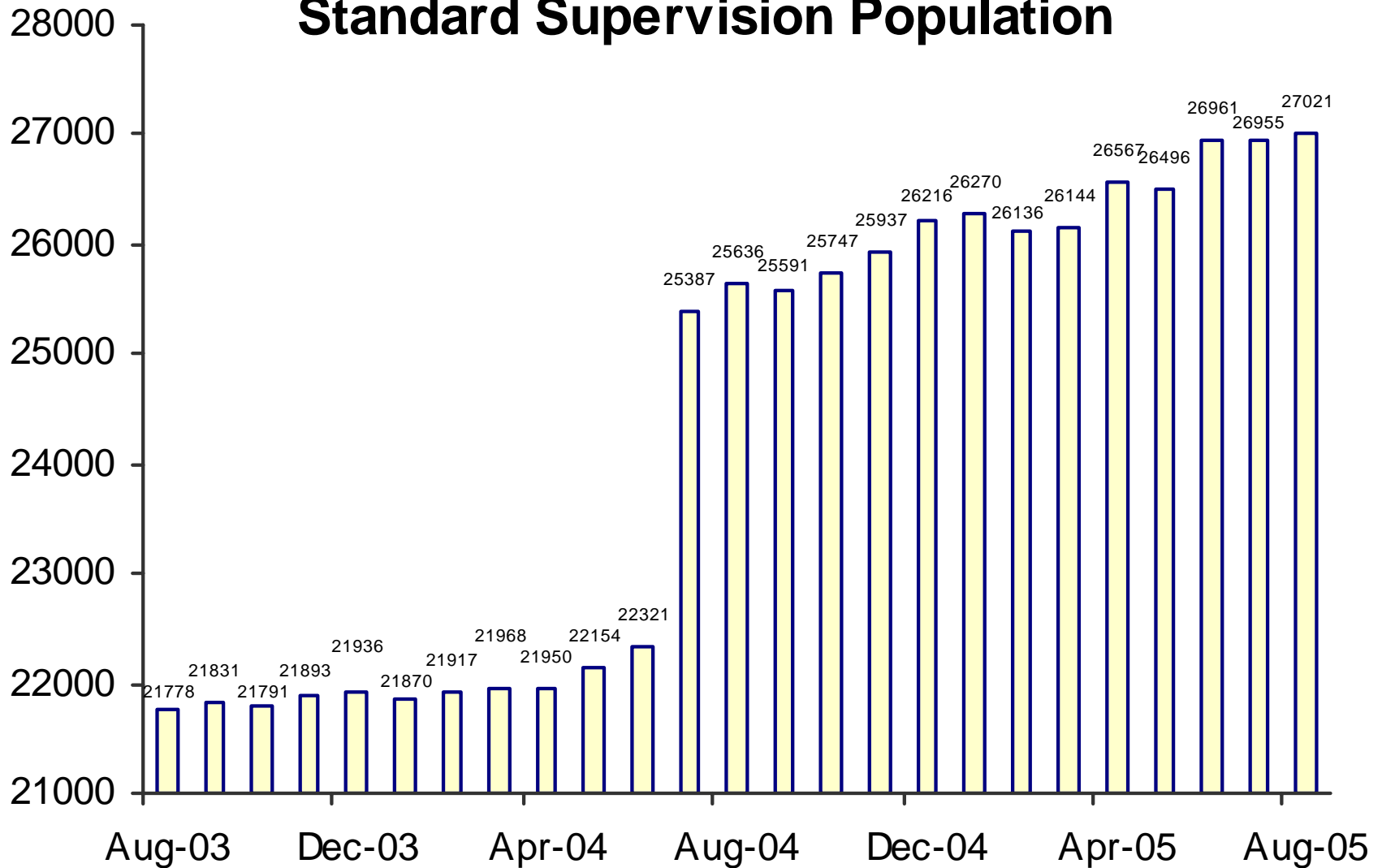

Status of Cases After 180 Days

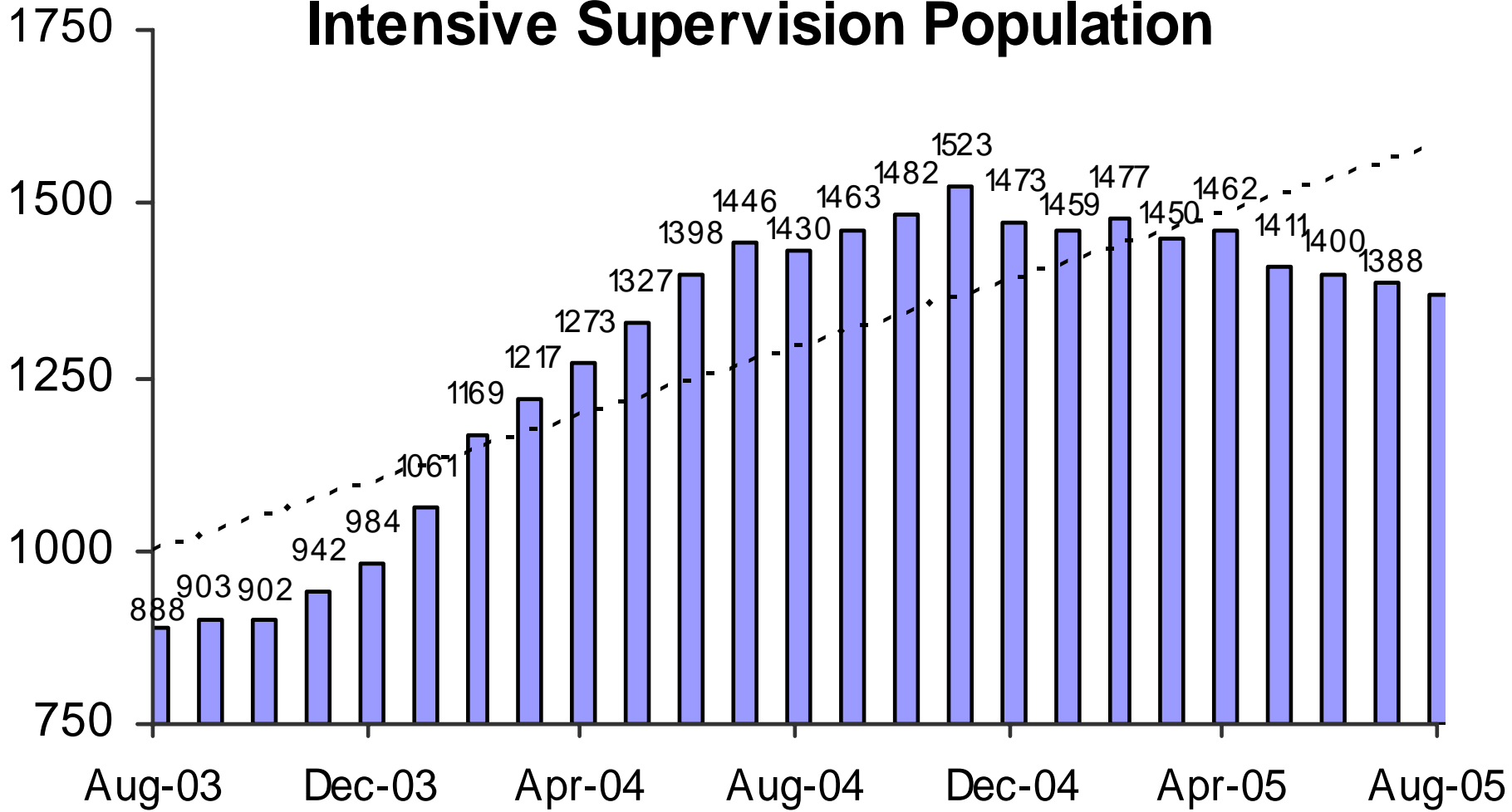


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

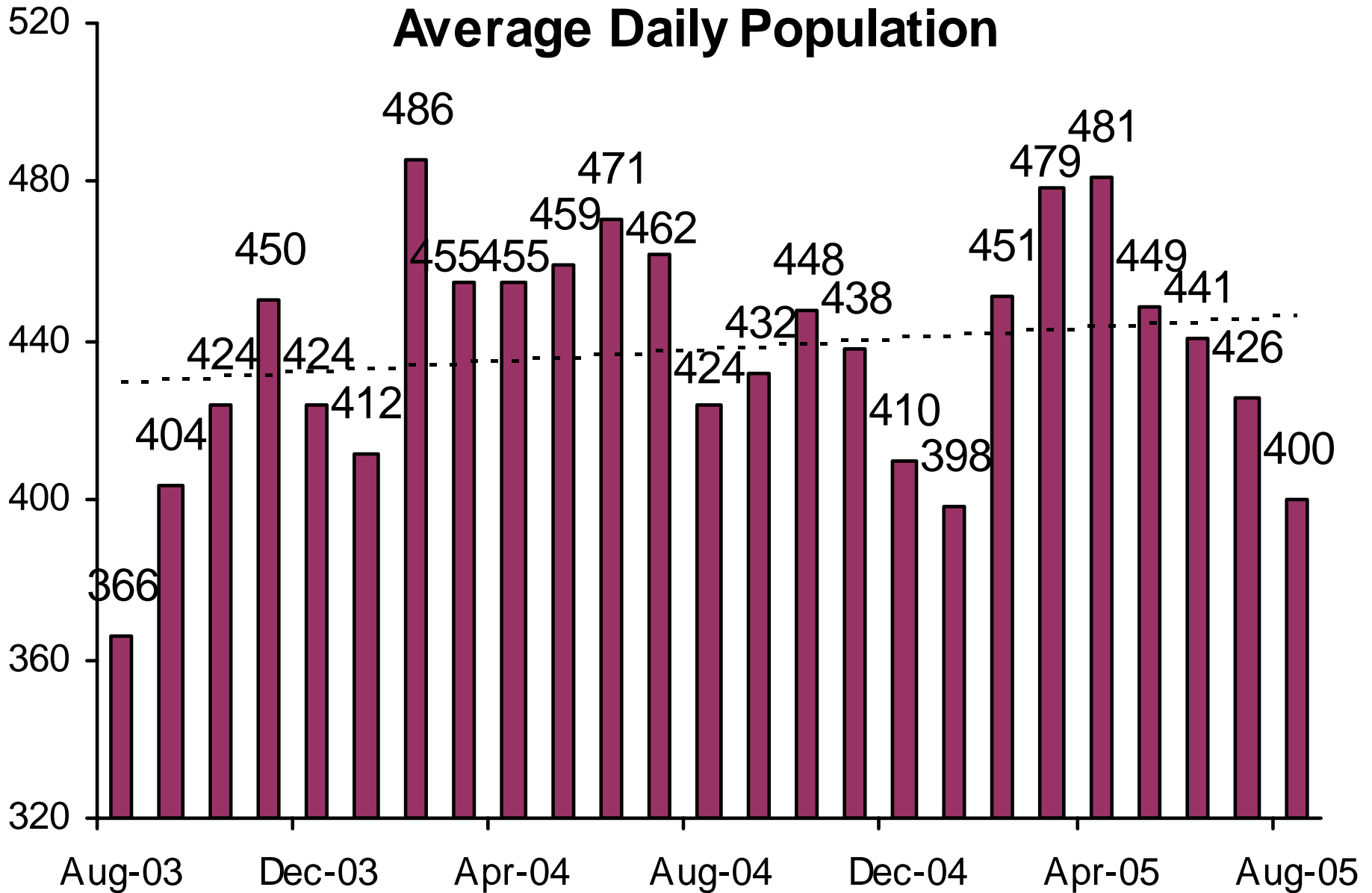

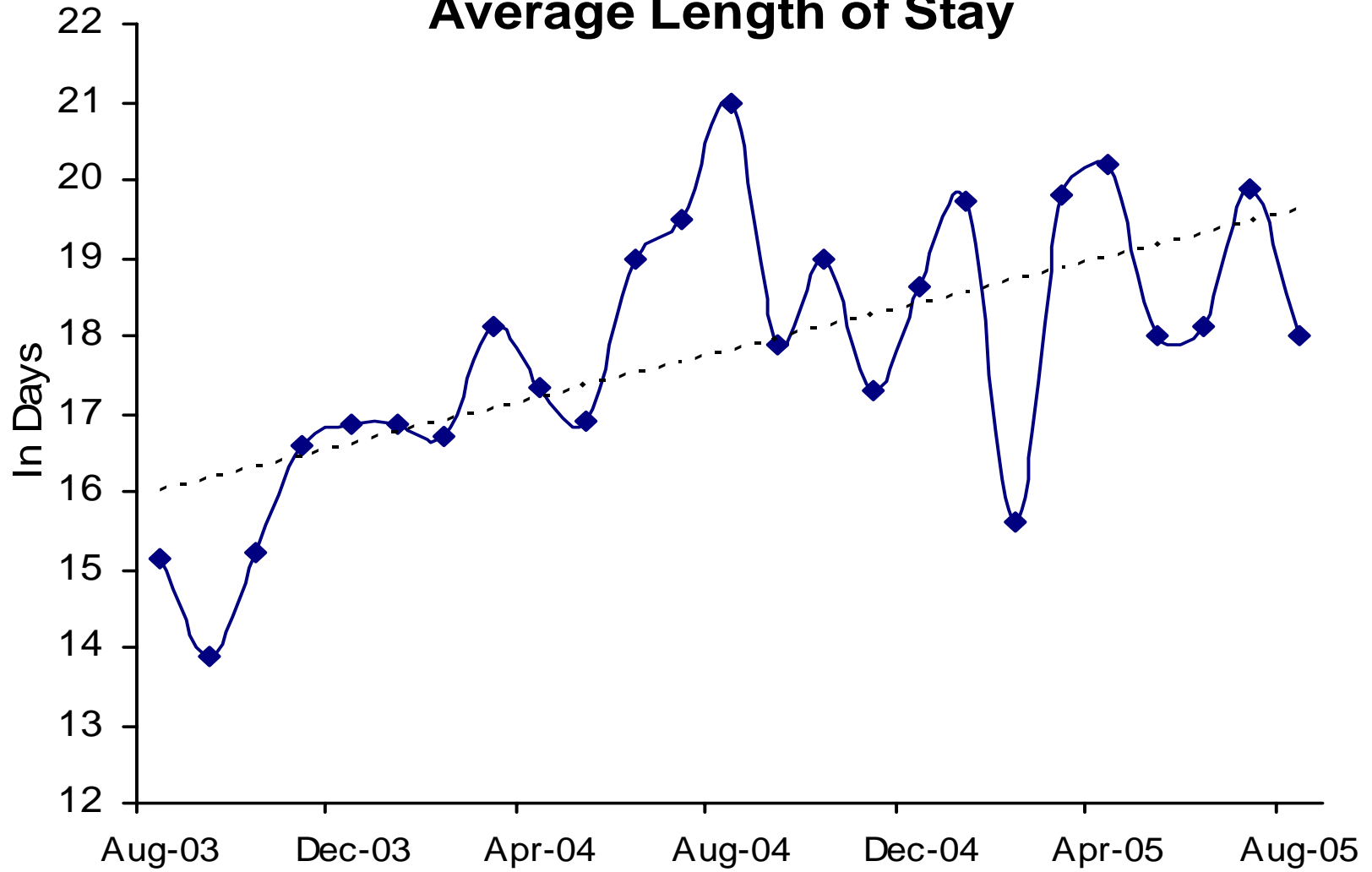
Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population



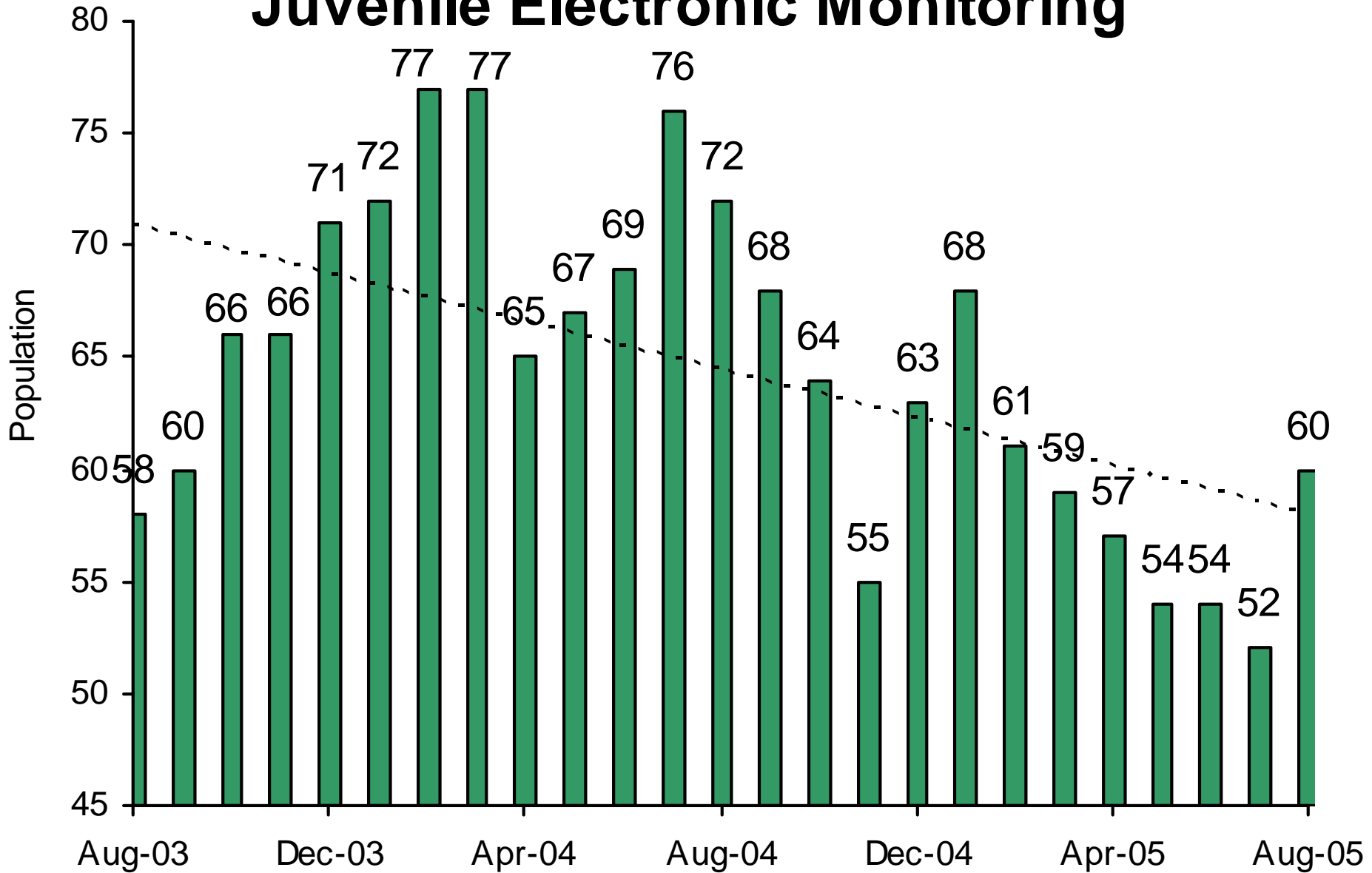
Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population
