CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes – August 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings increased** from 9,035 in July to 9,600 in August.
- **Releases increased** from 8,913 in July to 9,640 in August.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 8,238 in July to 8,285 in August.
- The **Pretrial ADP increased** from 6,342 in July to 6,376 in August.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,659 in July to 1,664 in August.
- The **Agency Hold ADP increased** from 175 in July to 179 in August.
- **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release decreased** from 26.7 in July to 26.1 in August.
- The **ALOS in days for Pretrial decreased** from 8.2 in July to 7.5 in August.
- The **ALOS in days for Sentenced decreased slightly** from 25.6 in July to 25.3 in August.
- The **ALOS in days for Agency Holds decreased** from 66.6 in July to 65.6 in August.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,981 in July to 3,013 in August.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,690 in July to 2,546 in August.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 85%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory increased** from 11,550 in July to 11,808 in August.
- **Regional Court Center filings decreased** from 1,651 in July to 1,585 in August.
- **Early Disposition Court filings decreased** from 1,115 in July to 1,097 in August.
- The **Number of Trials Completed increased** from 65 in July to 80 in August.
- The **Trial Rate** was 2.7%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings increased** from 752 in July to 825 in August.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings increased** from 3,539 in July to 3,613 in August.
- **Civil Traffic Filings increased** from 9,742 in July to 10,320 in August.
- **Eviction Action Filings increased** from 5,981 in July to 6,388 in August.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 29,583 in July to 29,508 in August.

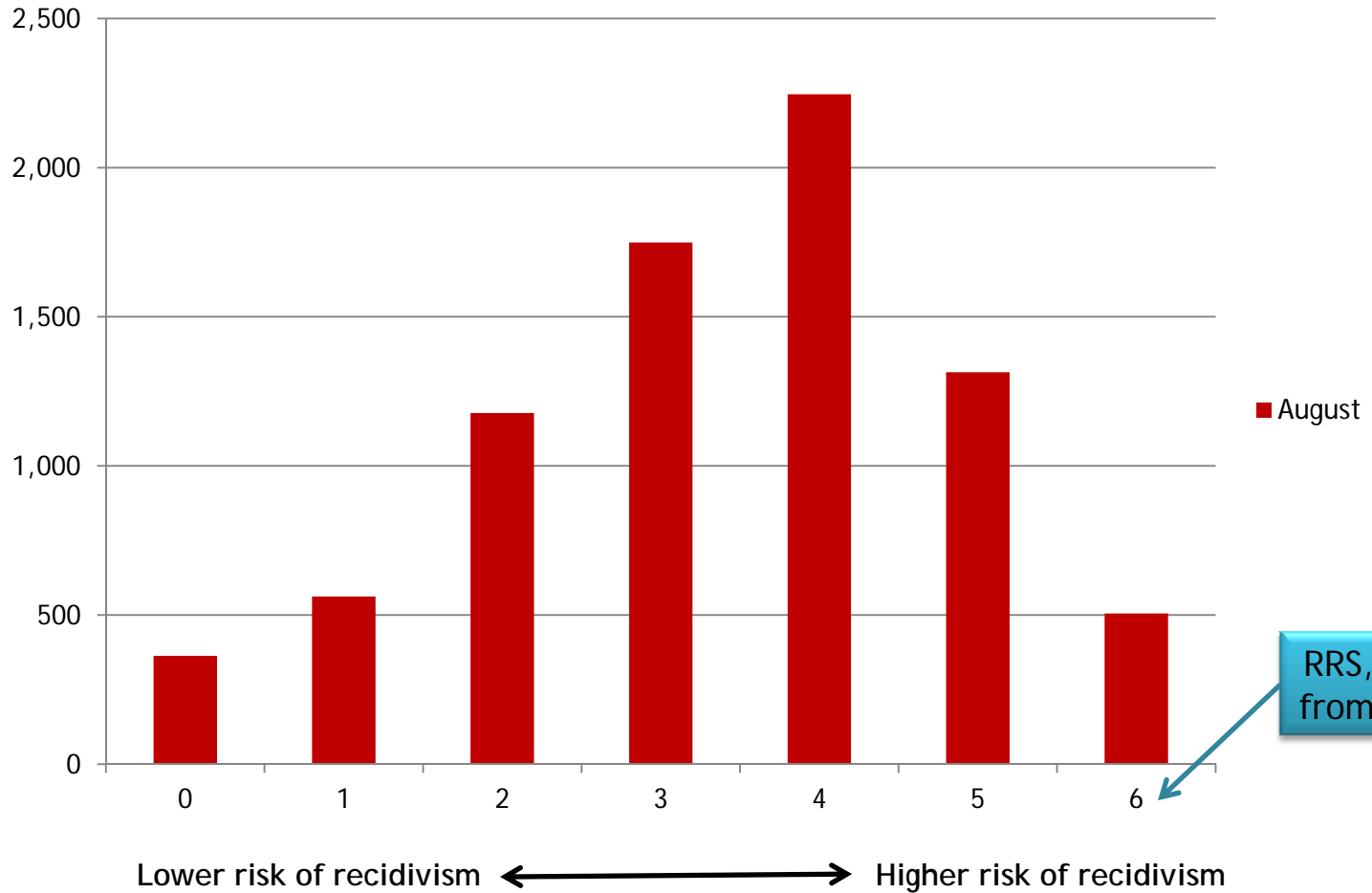
Adult Probation

- **Pretrial Standard Supervision increased** from 1,715 in July to 1,779 in August.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 462 in July to 510 in August.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision decreased** from 21,349 in July to 21,270 in August.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 815 in July to 830 in August.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 6,794 in July to 6,773 in August.

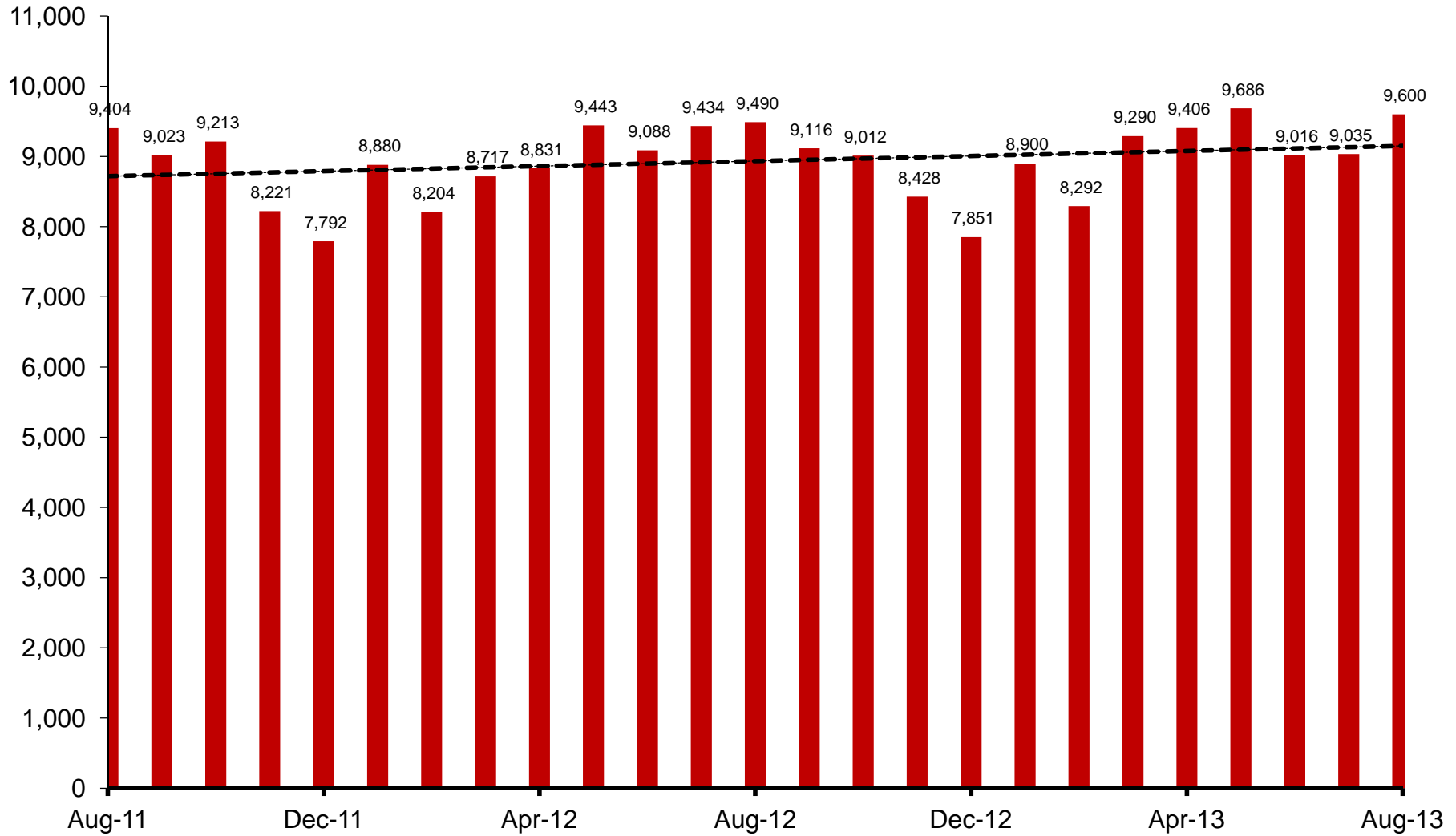

Recidivism Risk Score (RRS / "Proxy") Distribution Among Current Jail Population:

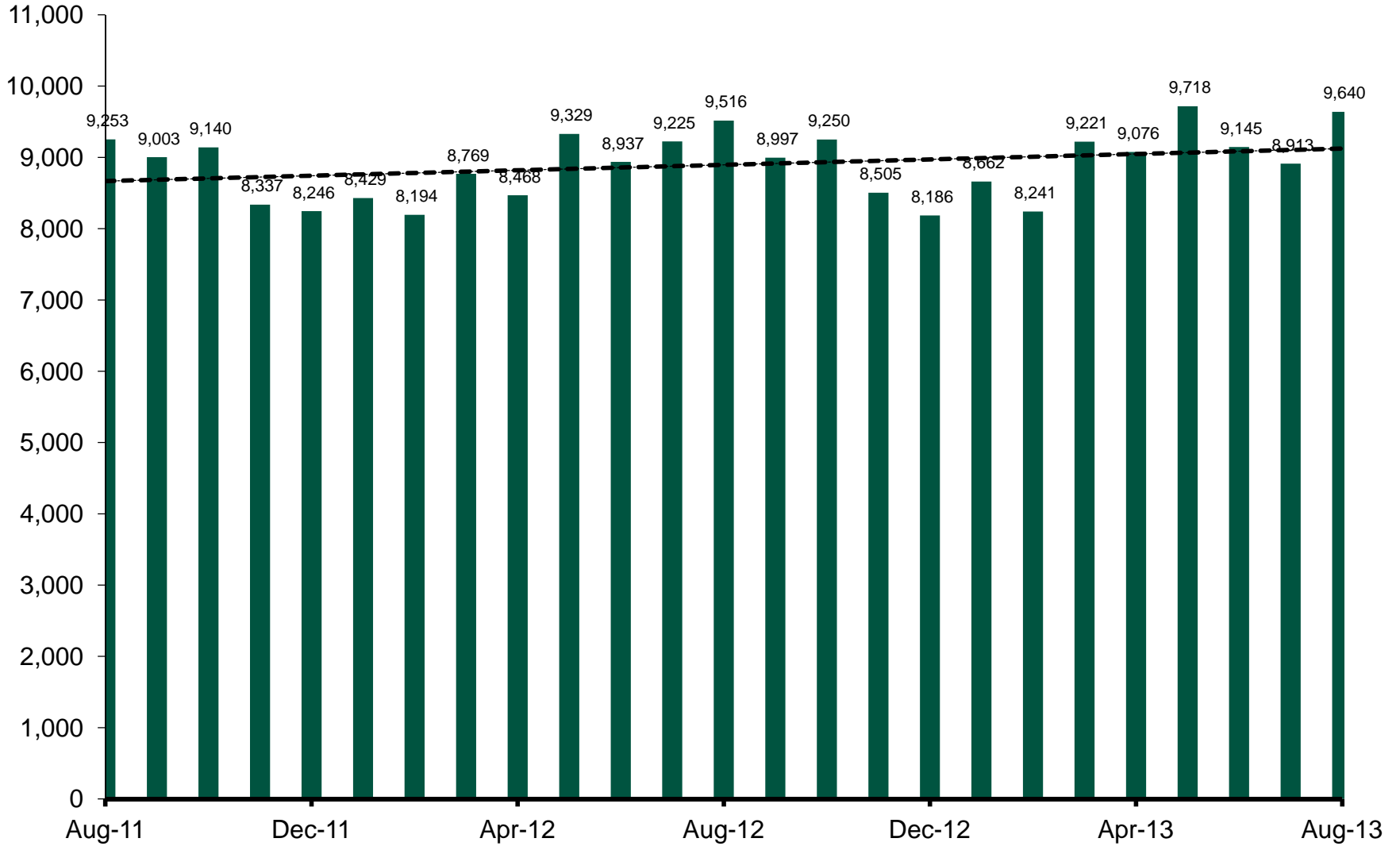

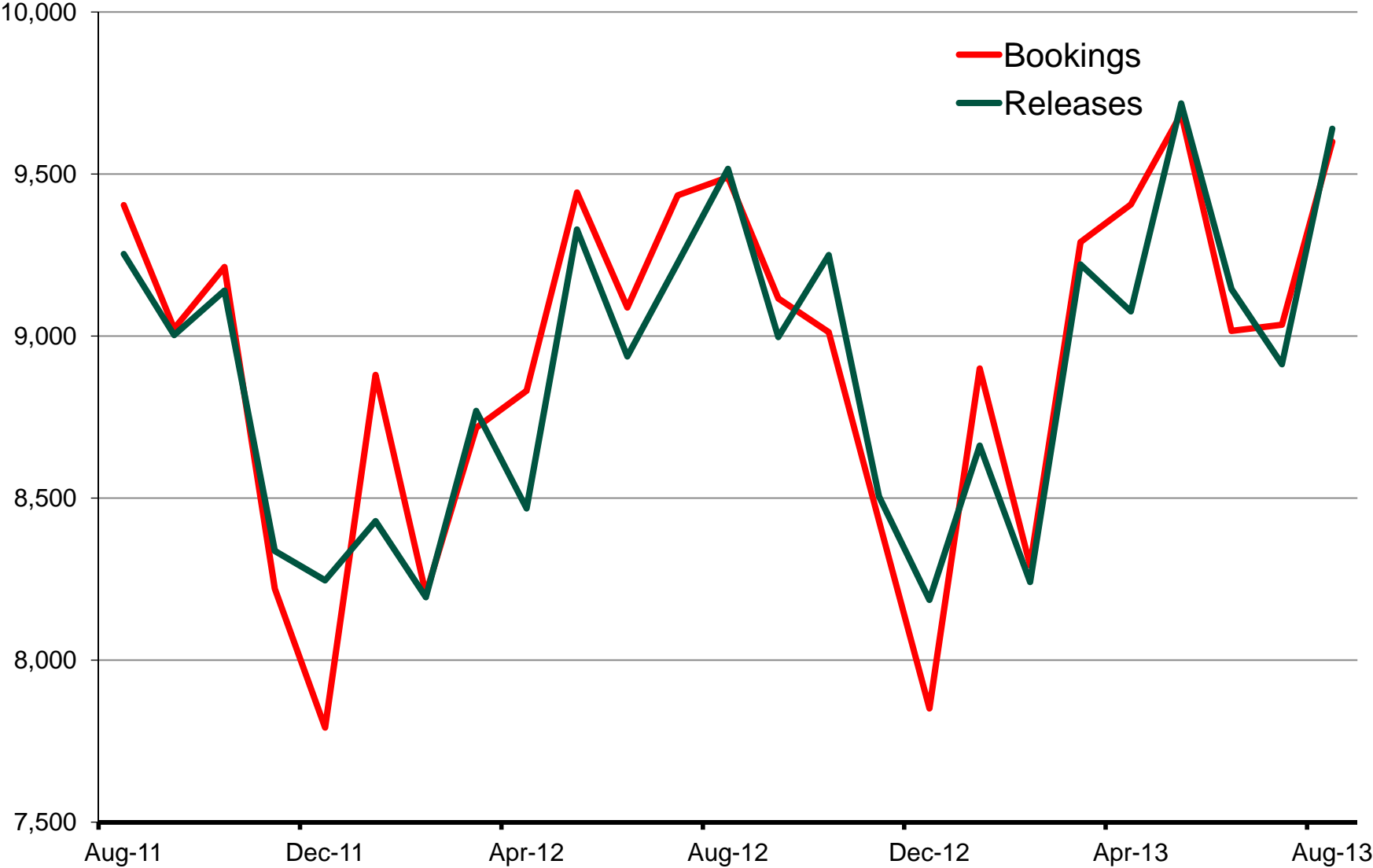

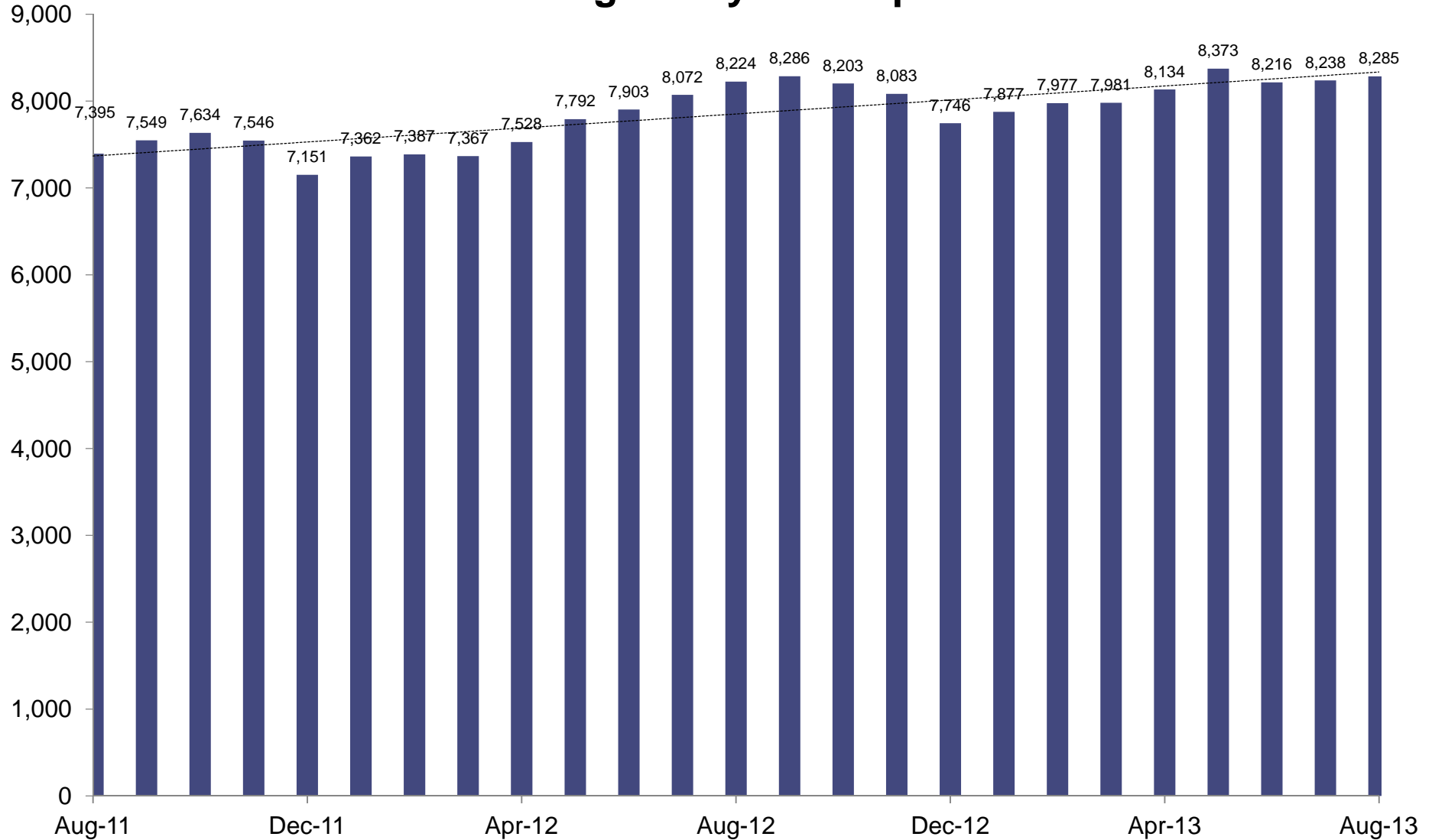
Jail Releases

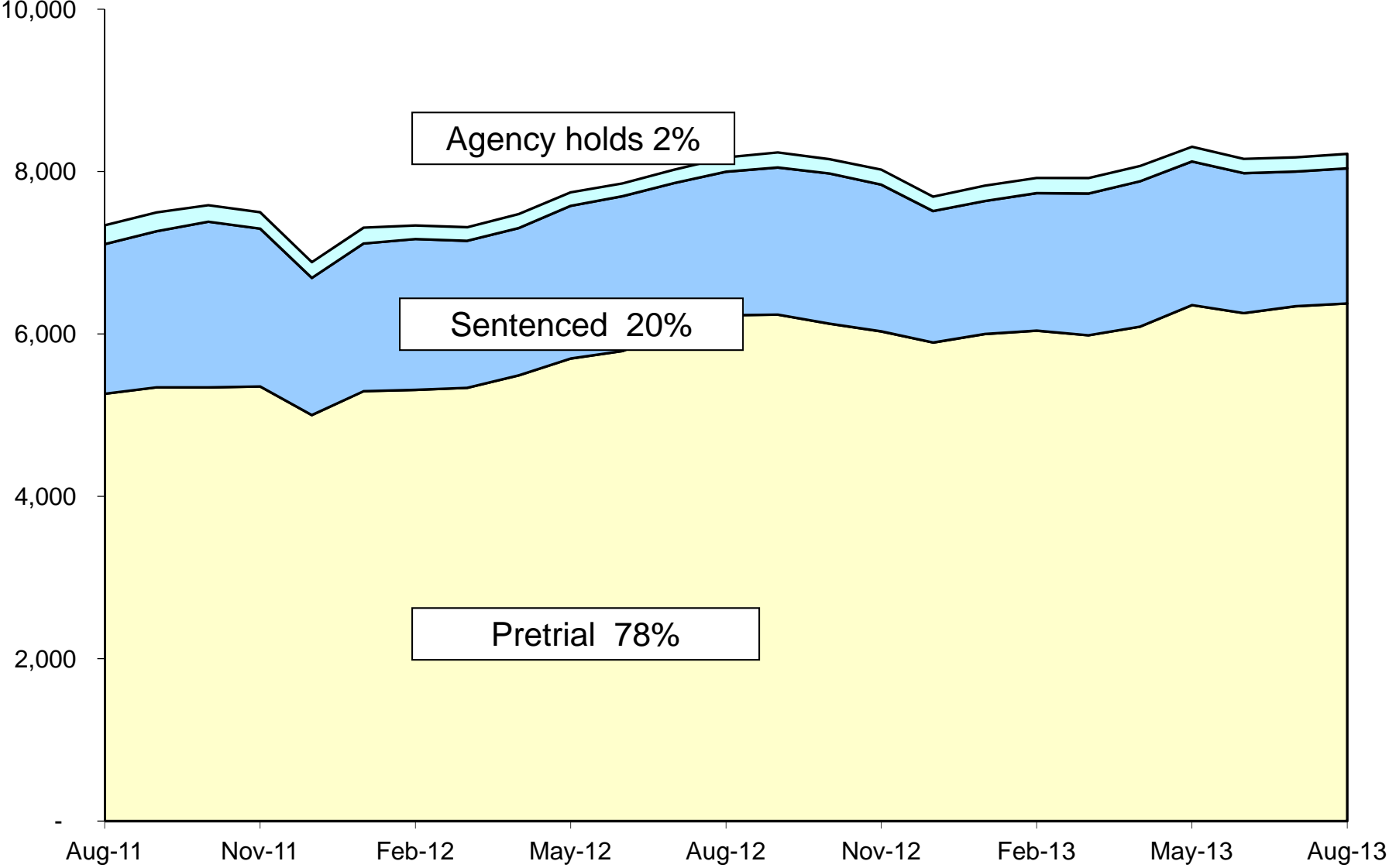


Average Daily Jail Population

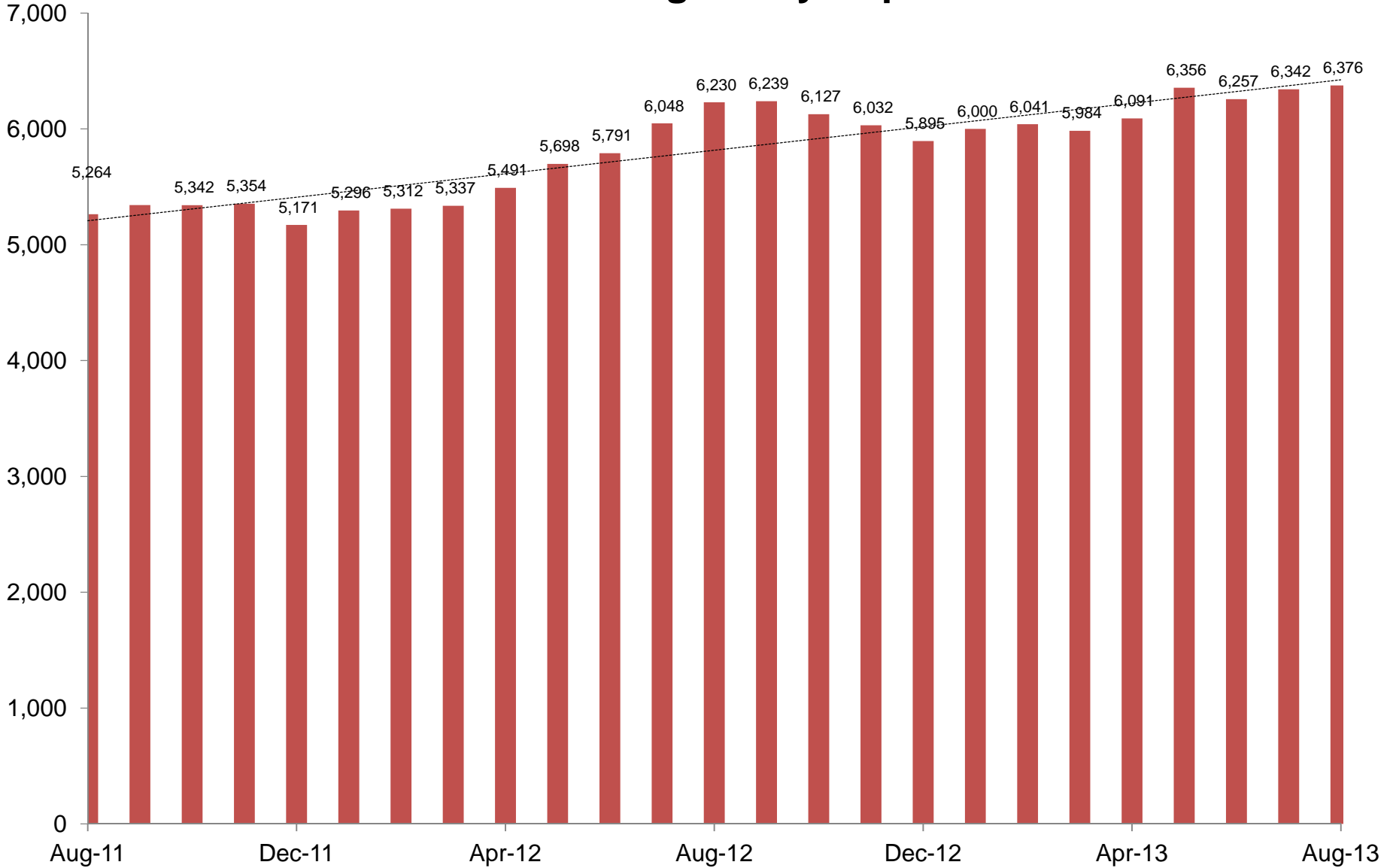

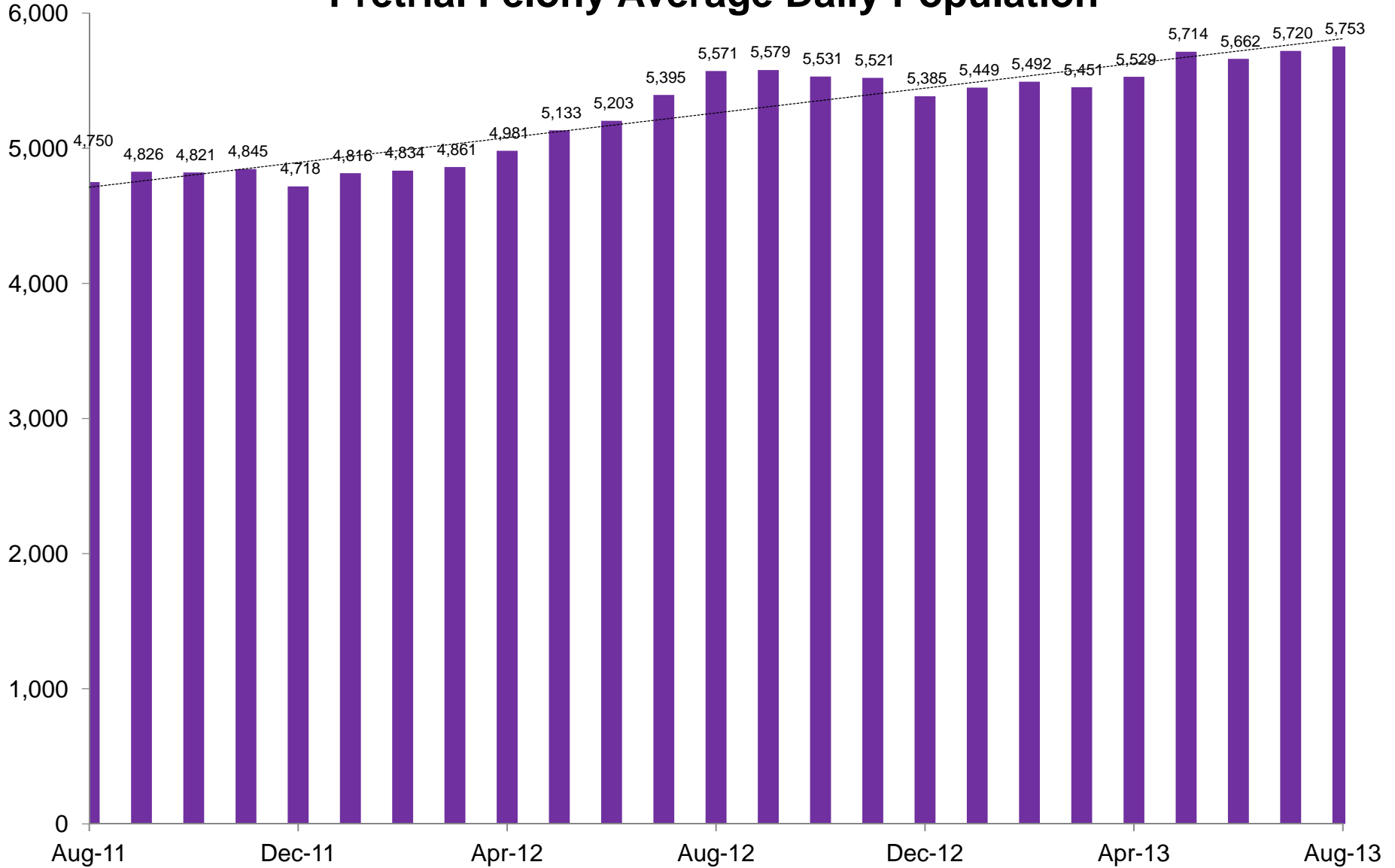
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



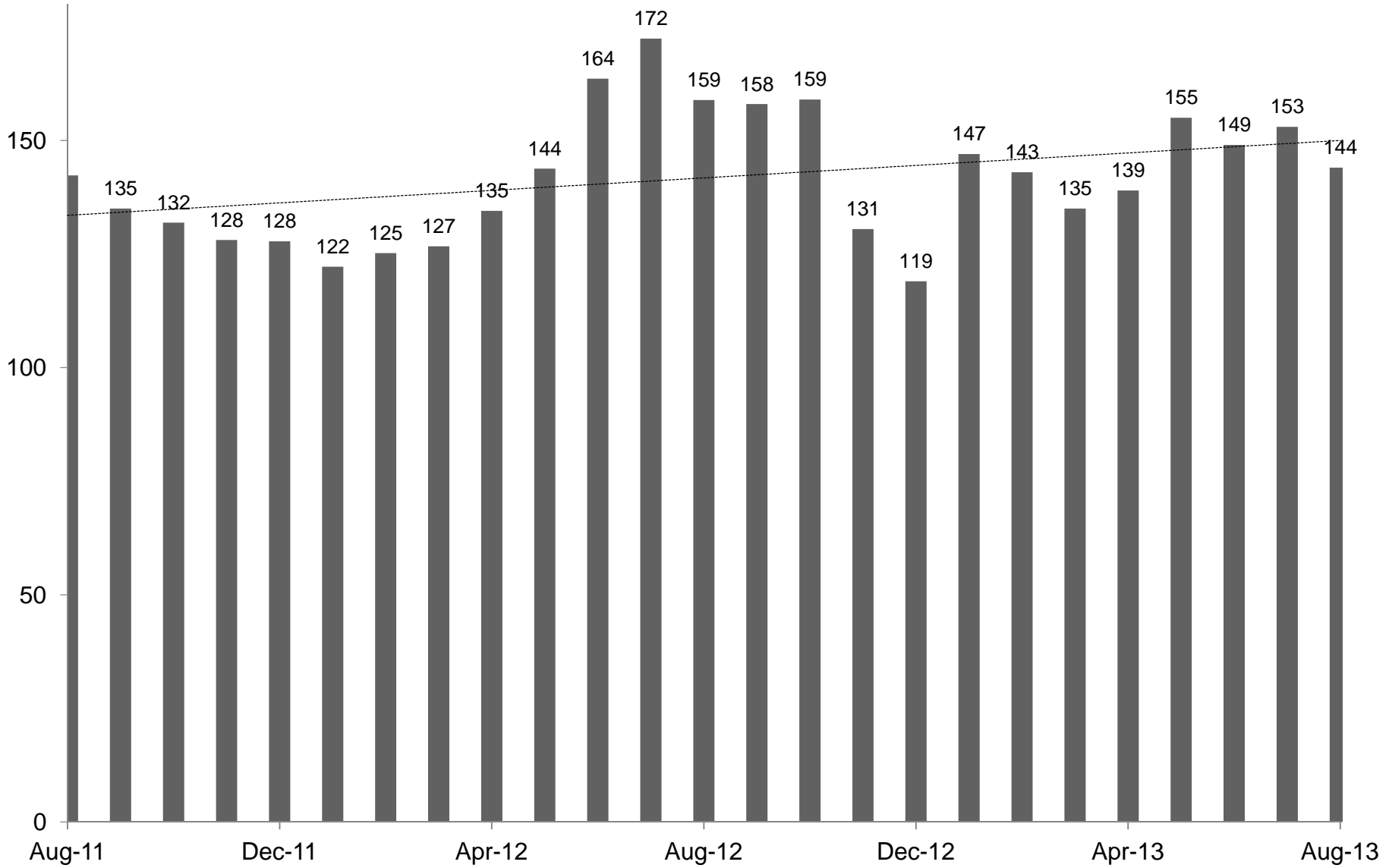
Pretrial Average Daily Population



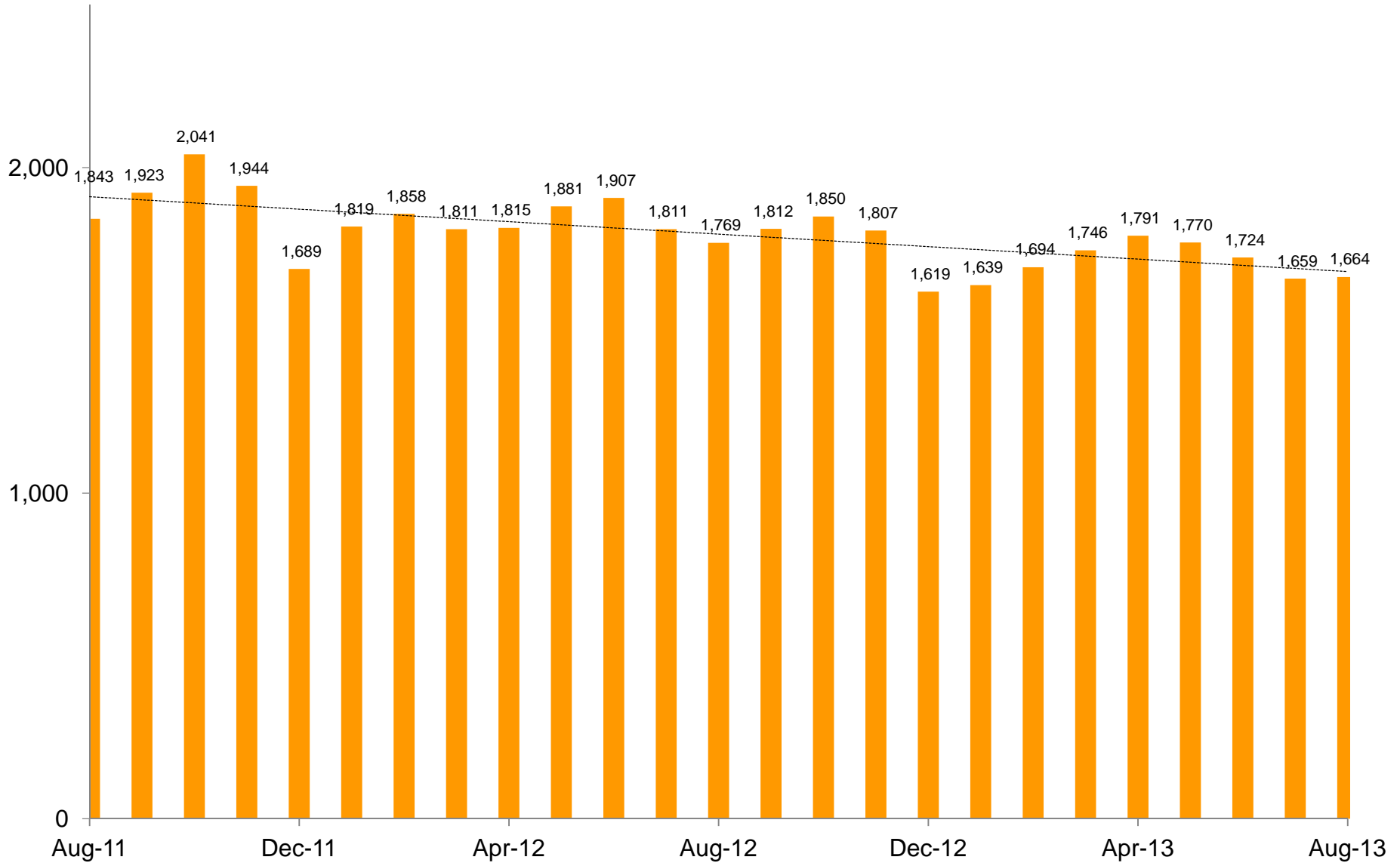
Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population



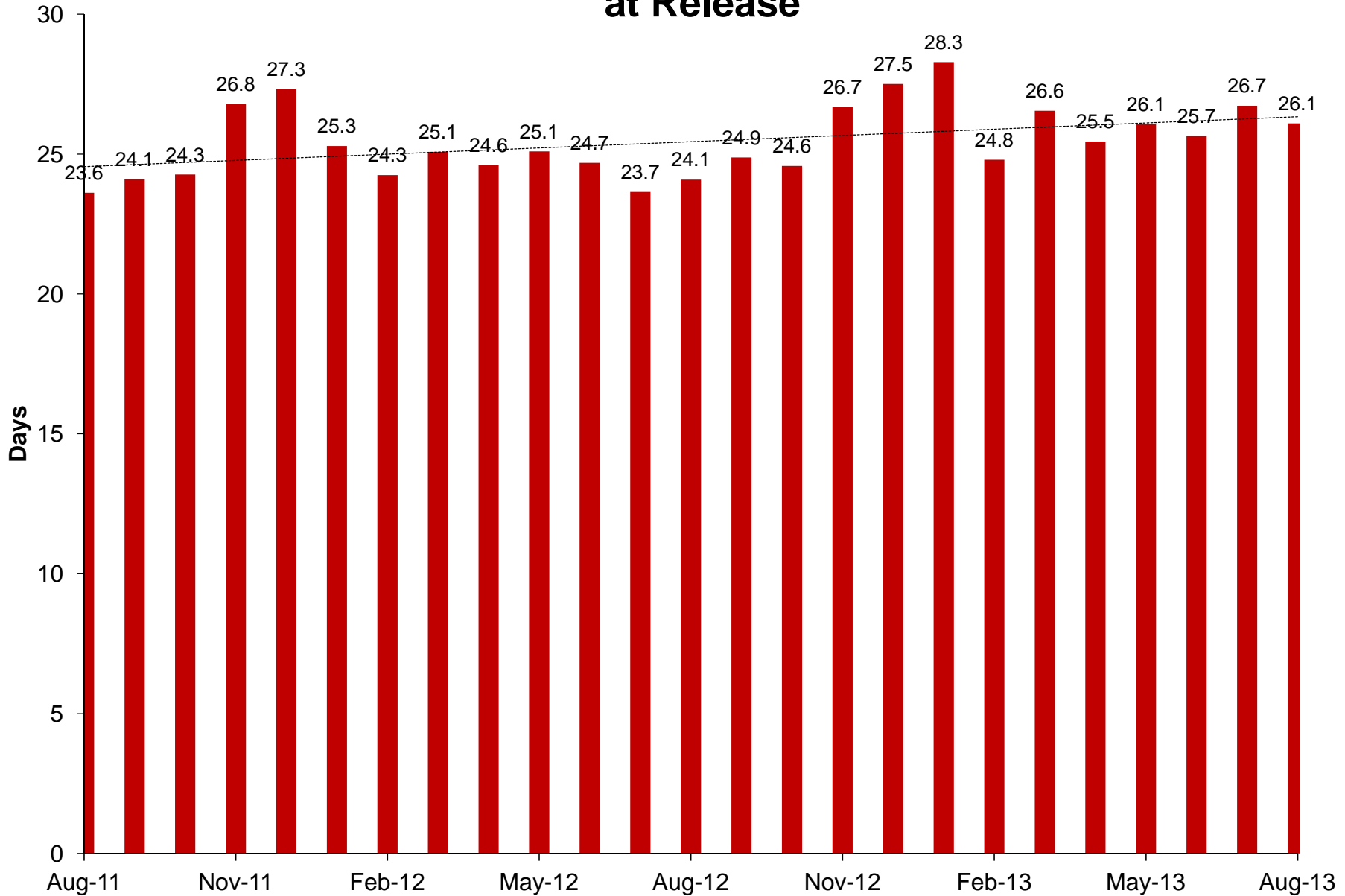
Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population



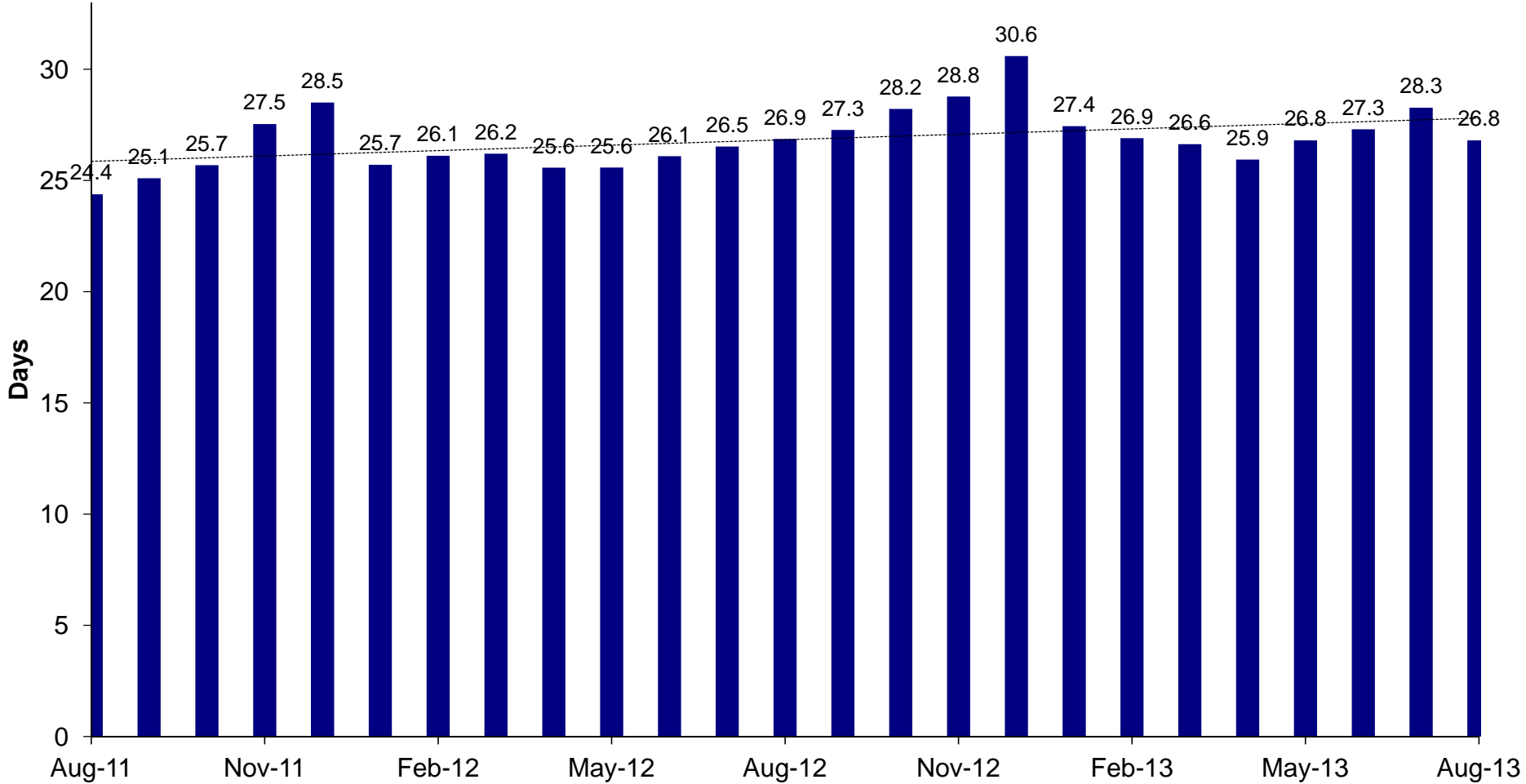
Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release

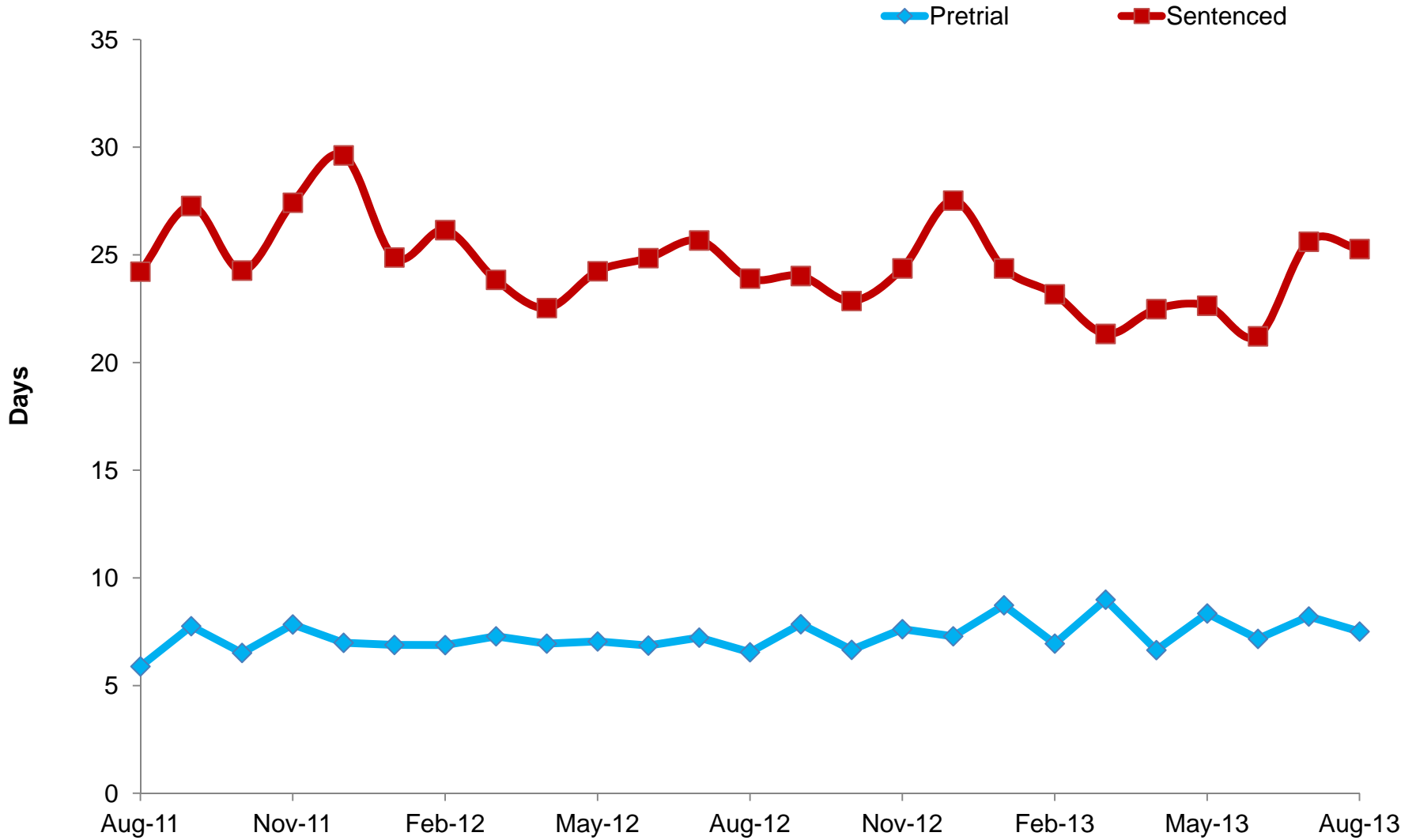


Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

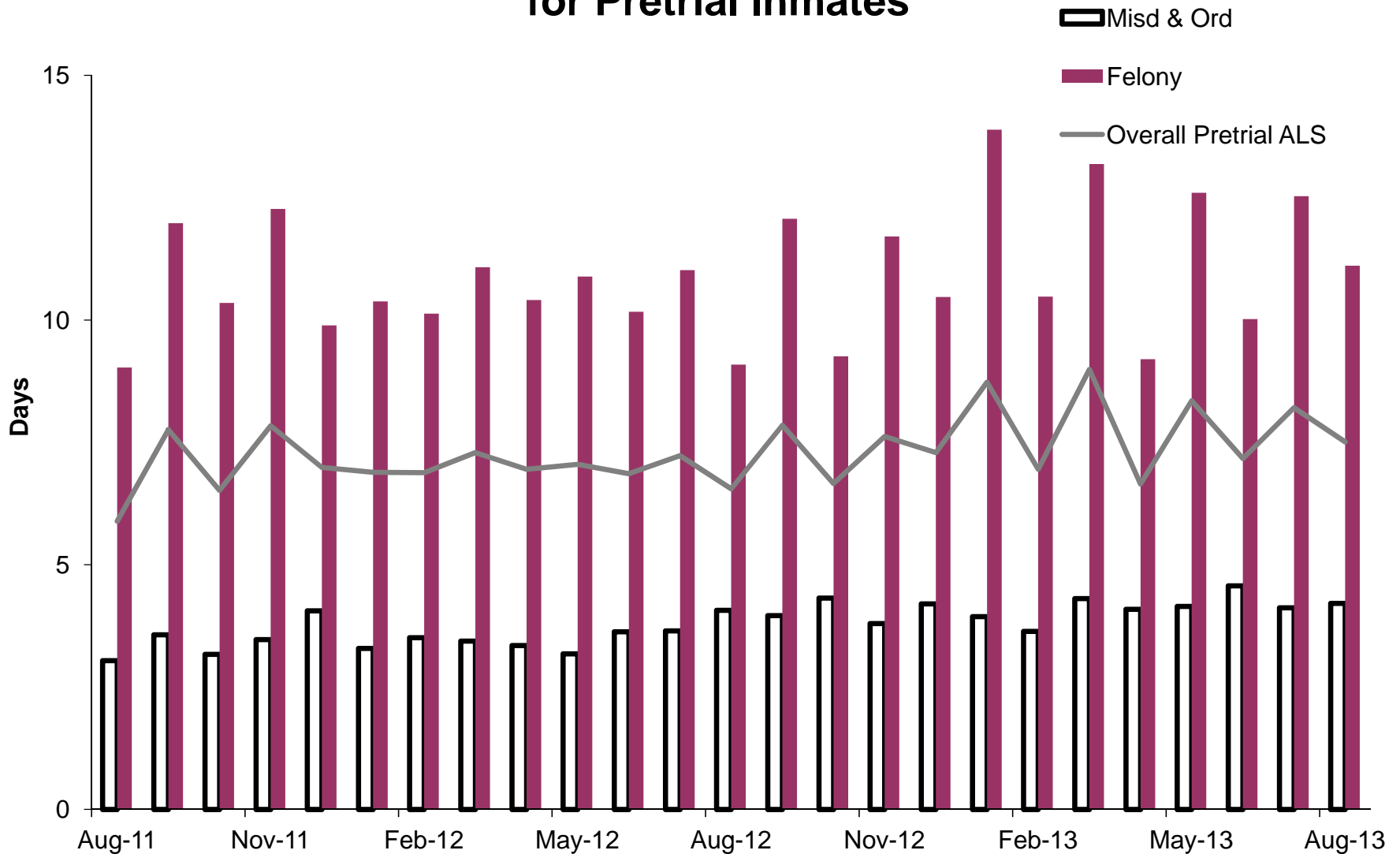

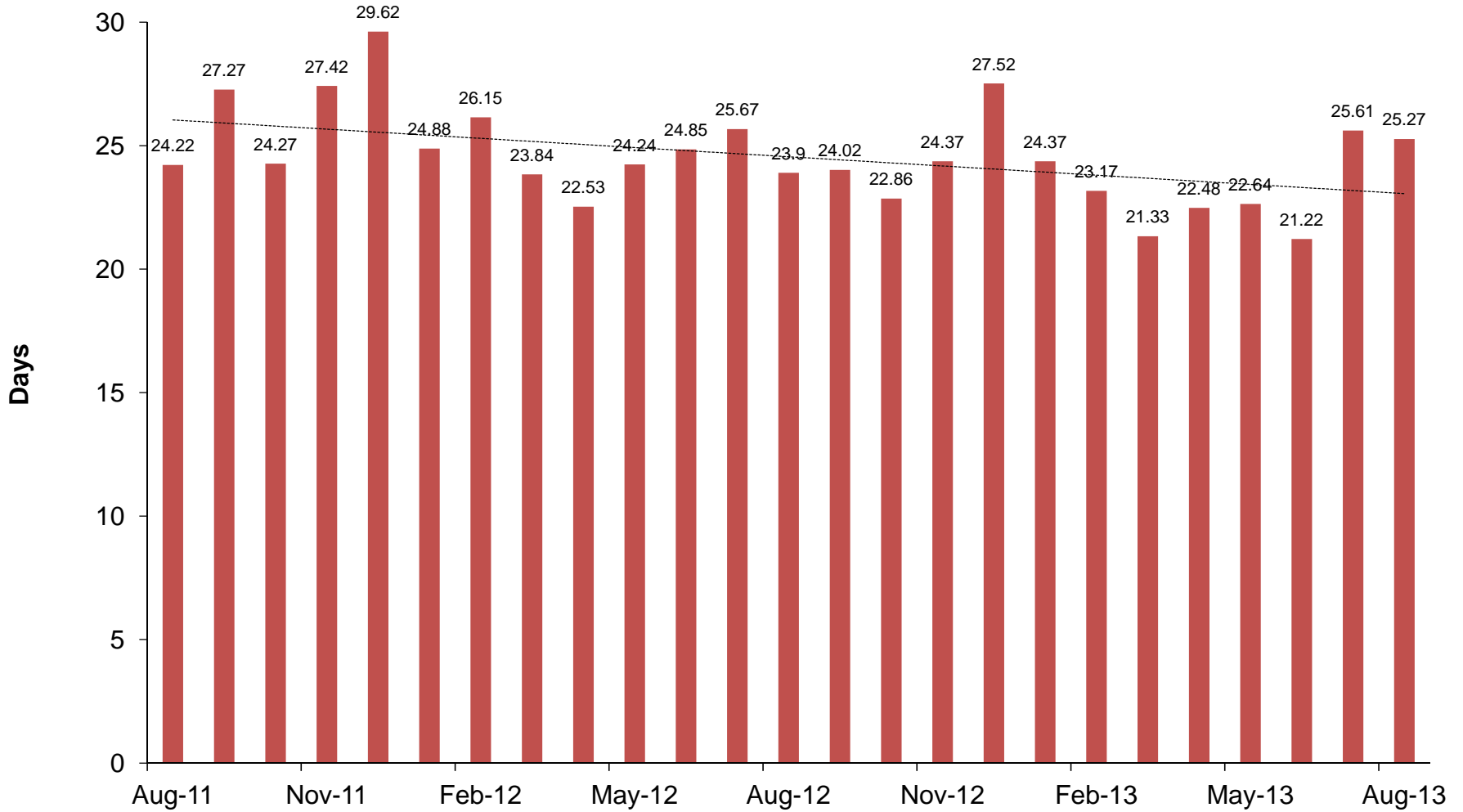
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial and Sentenced Inmates



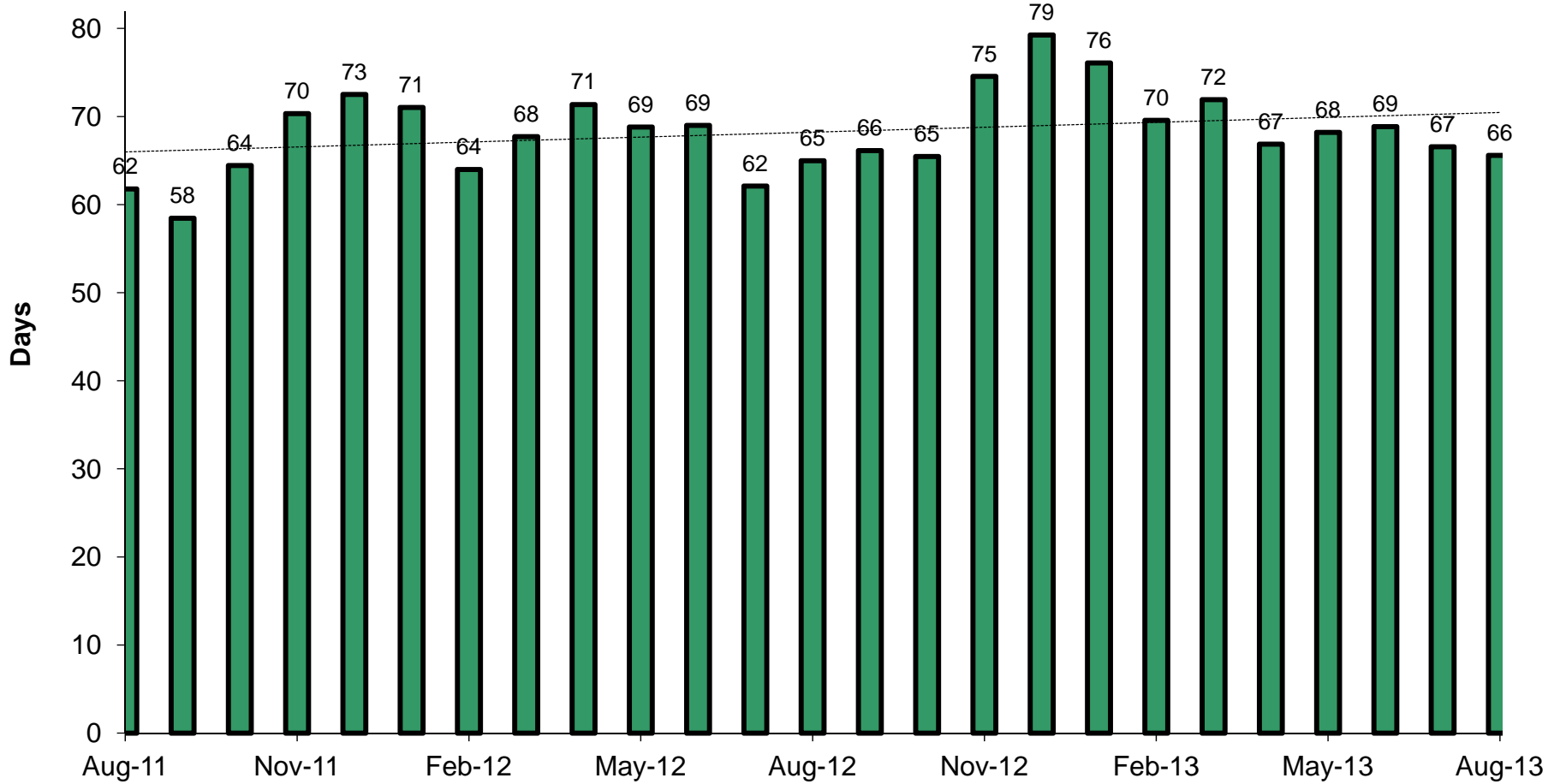
Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates

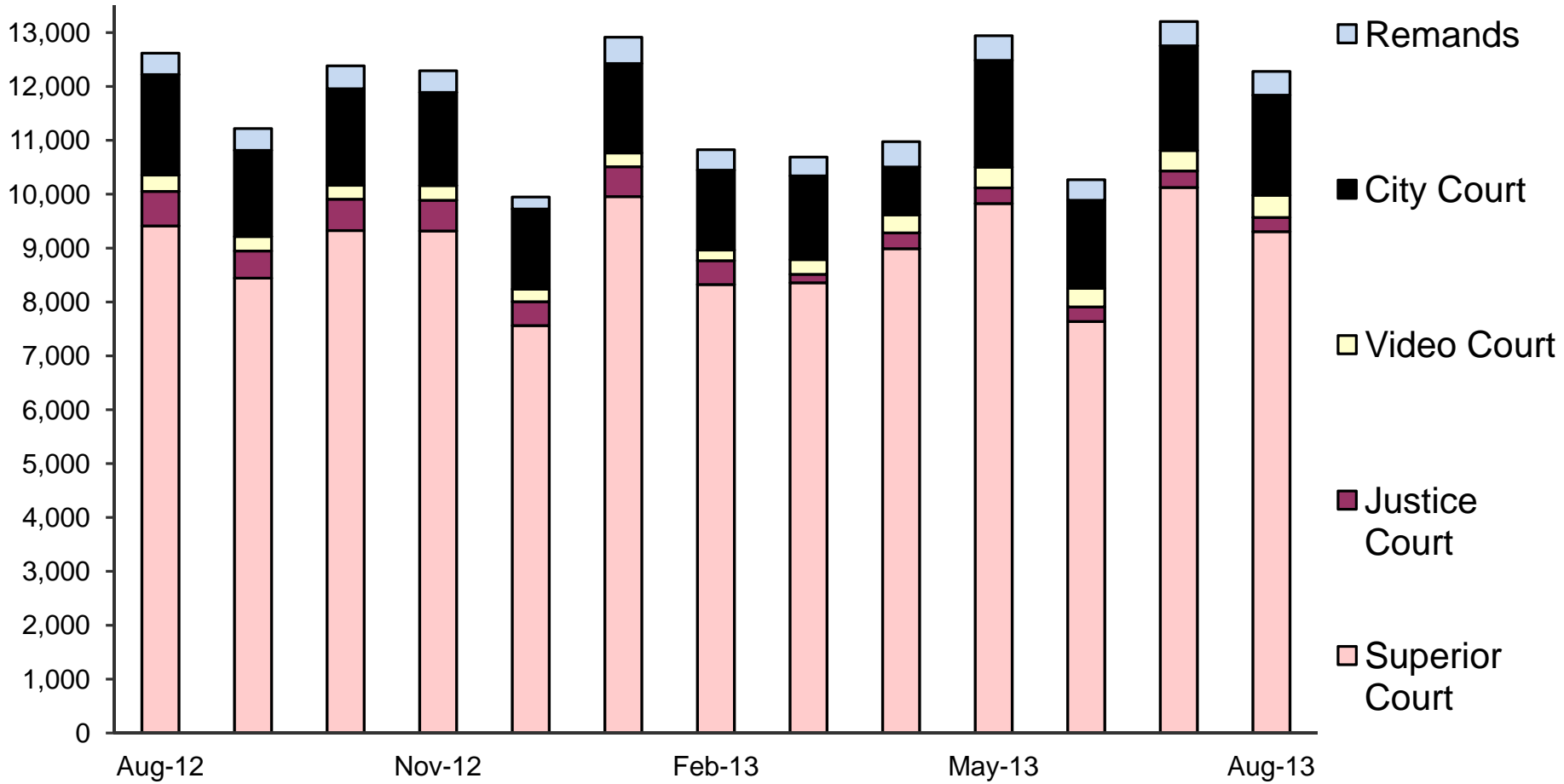


Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds

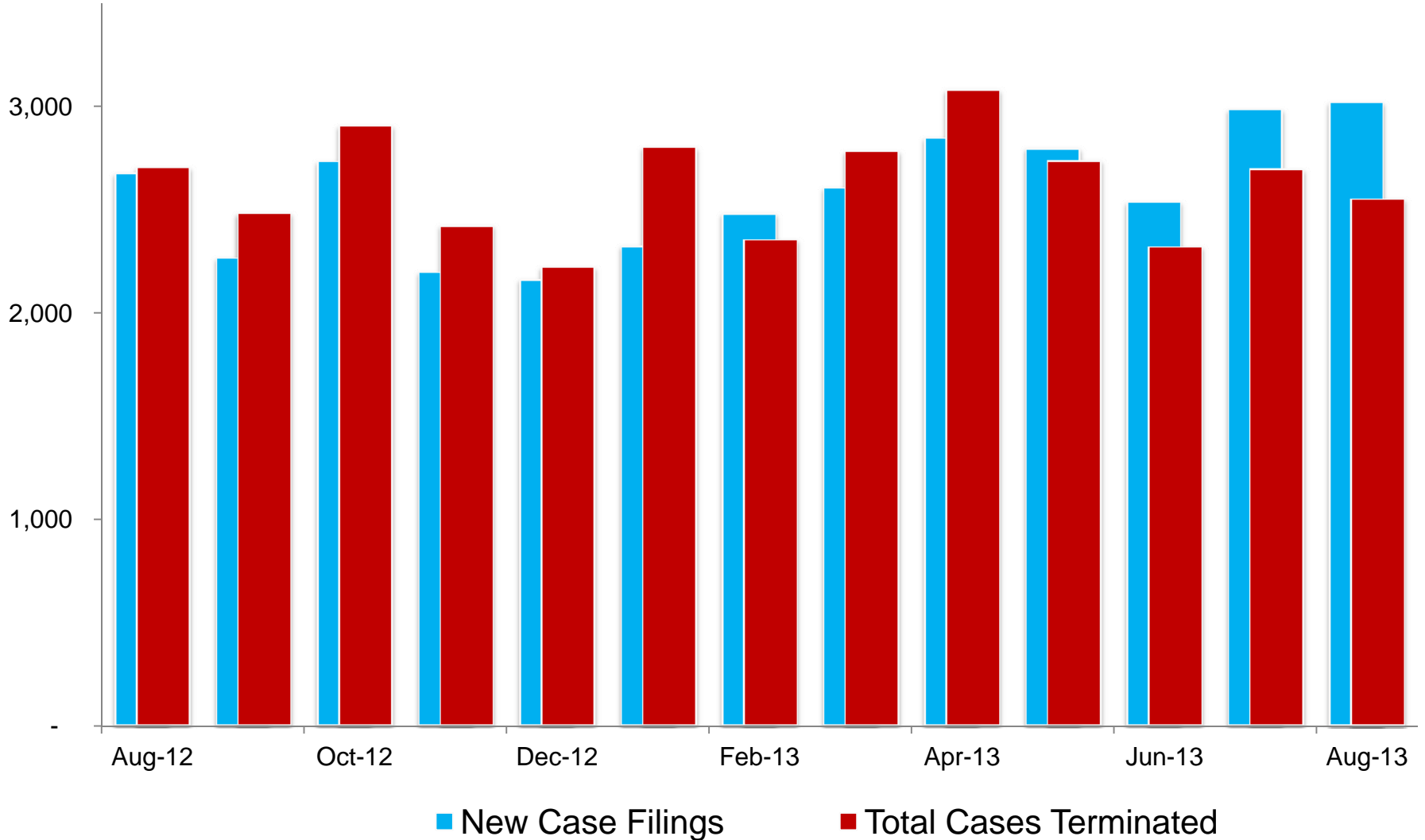

Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances

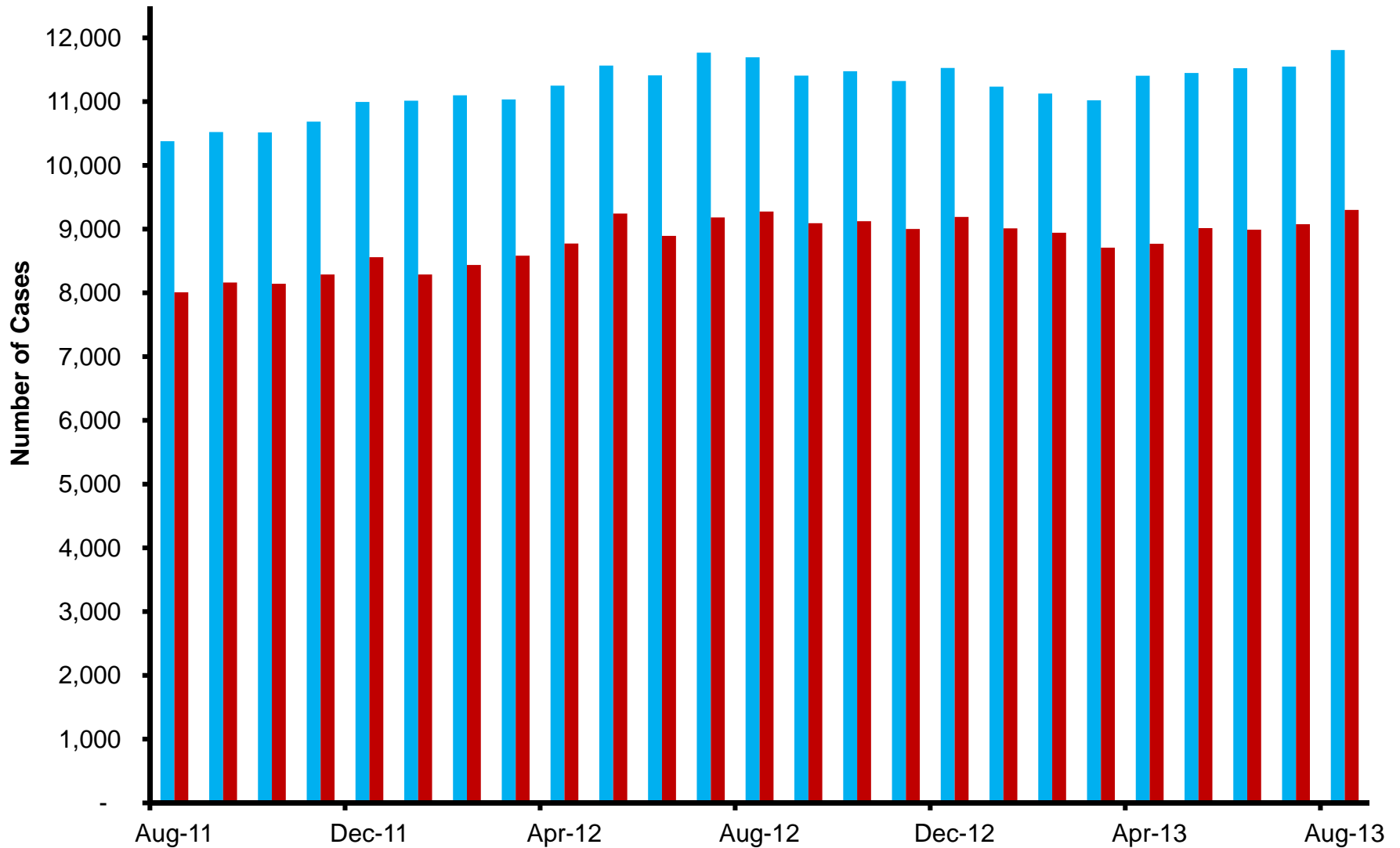

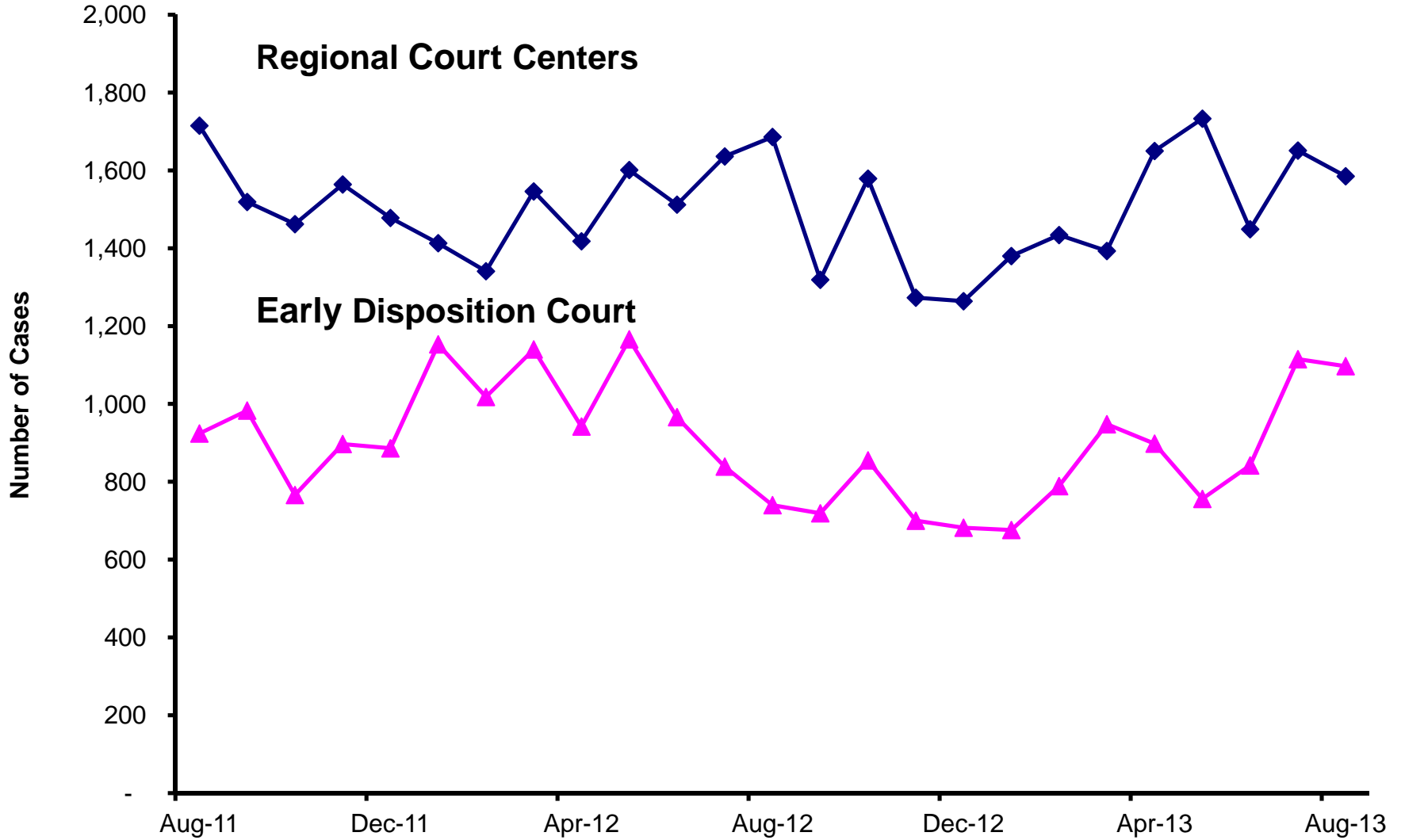


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

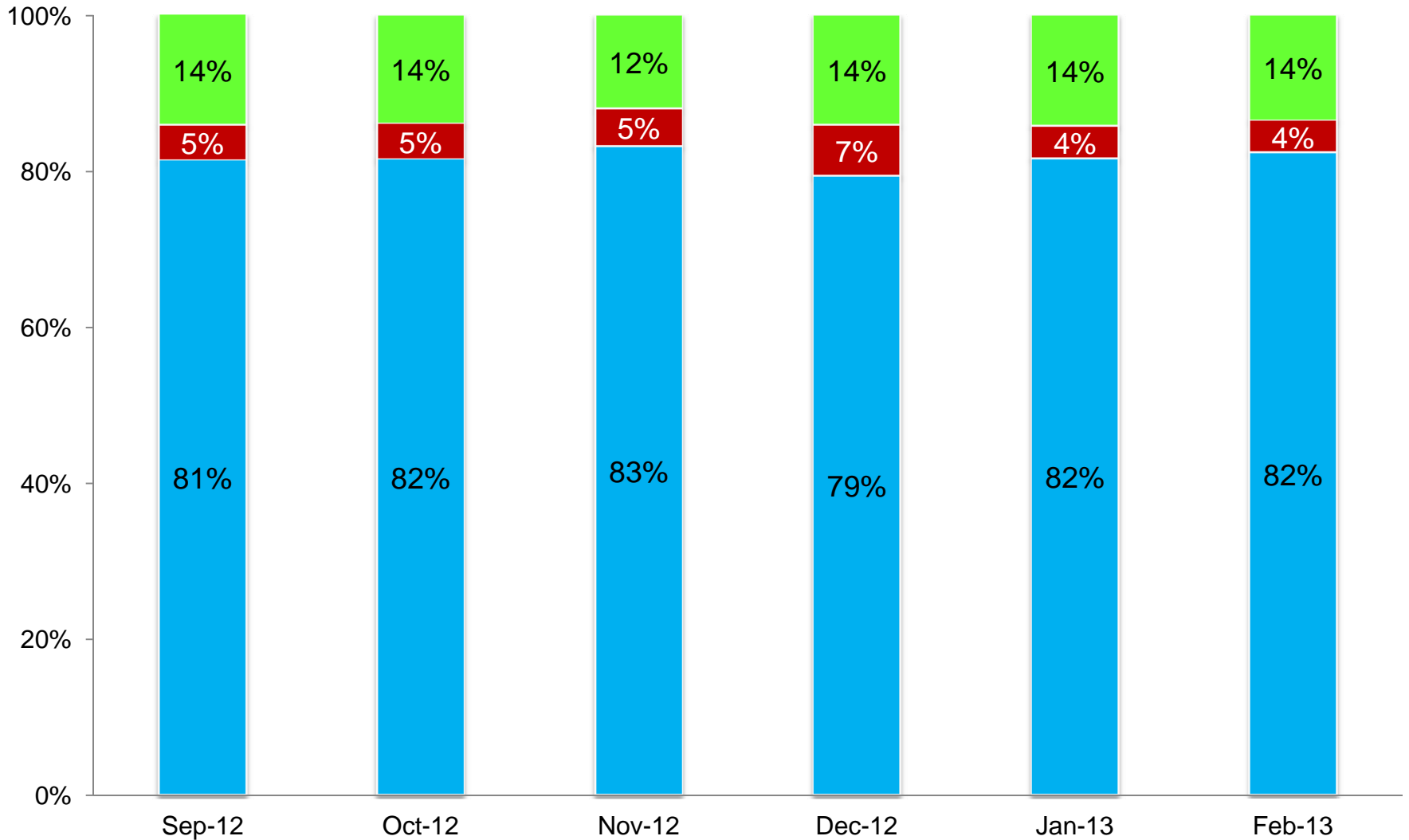


Status of Cases After 180 Days

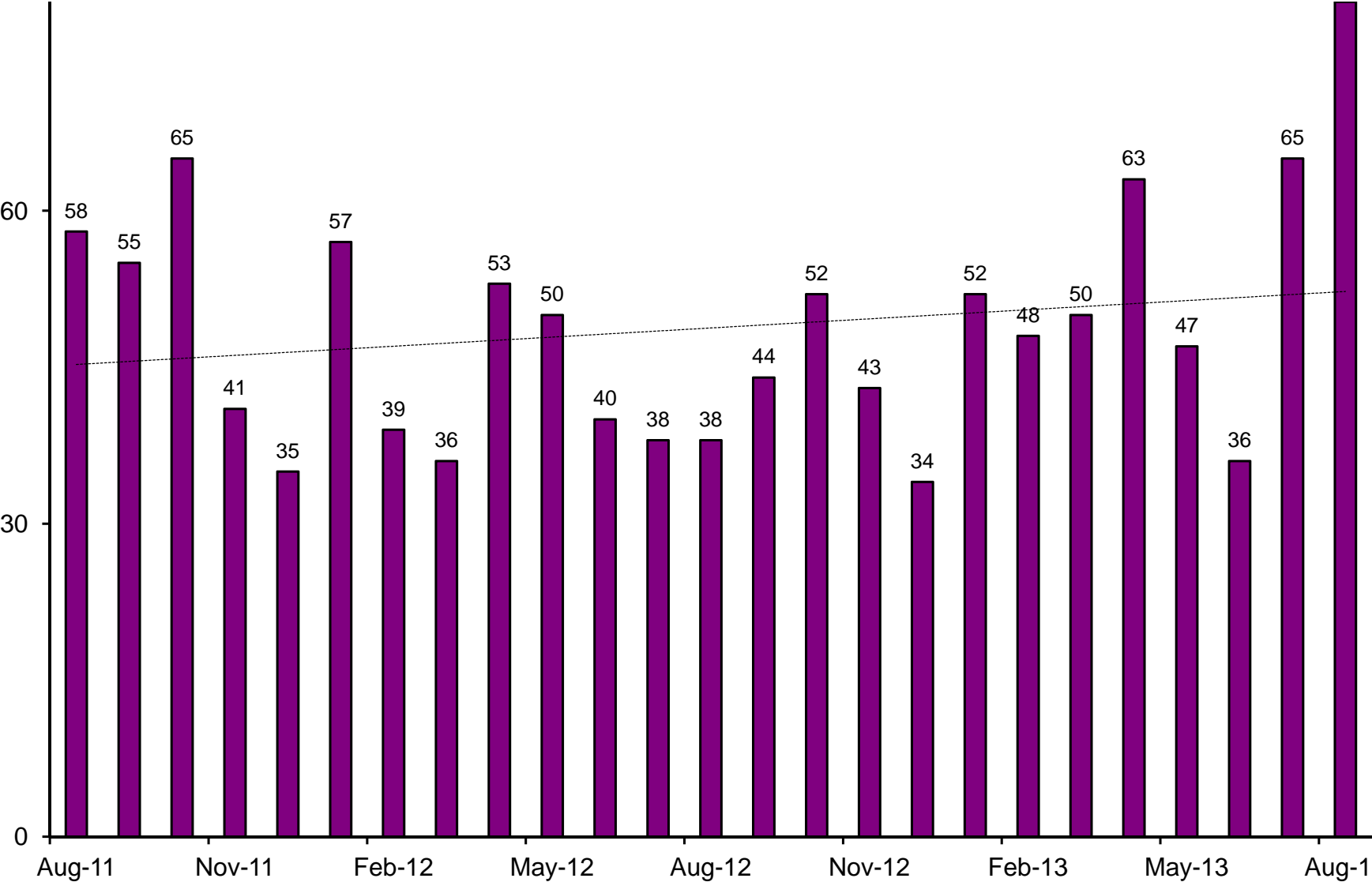

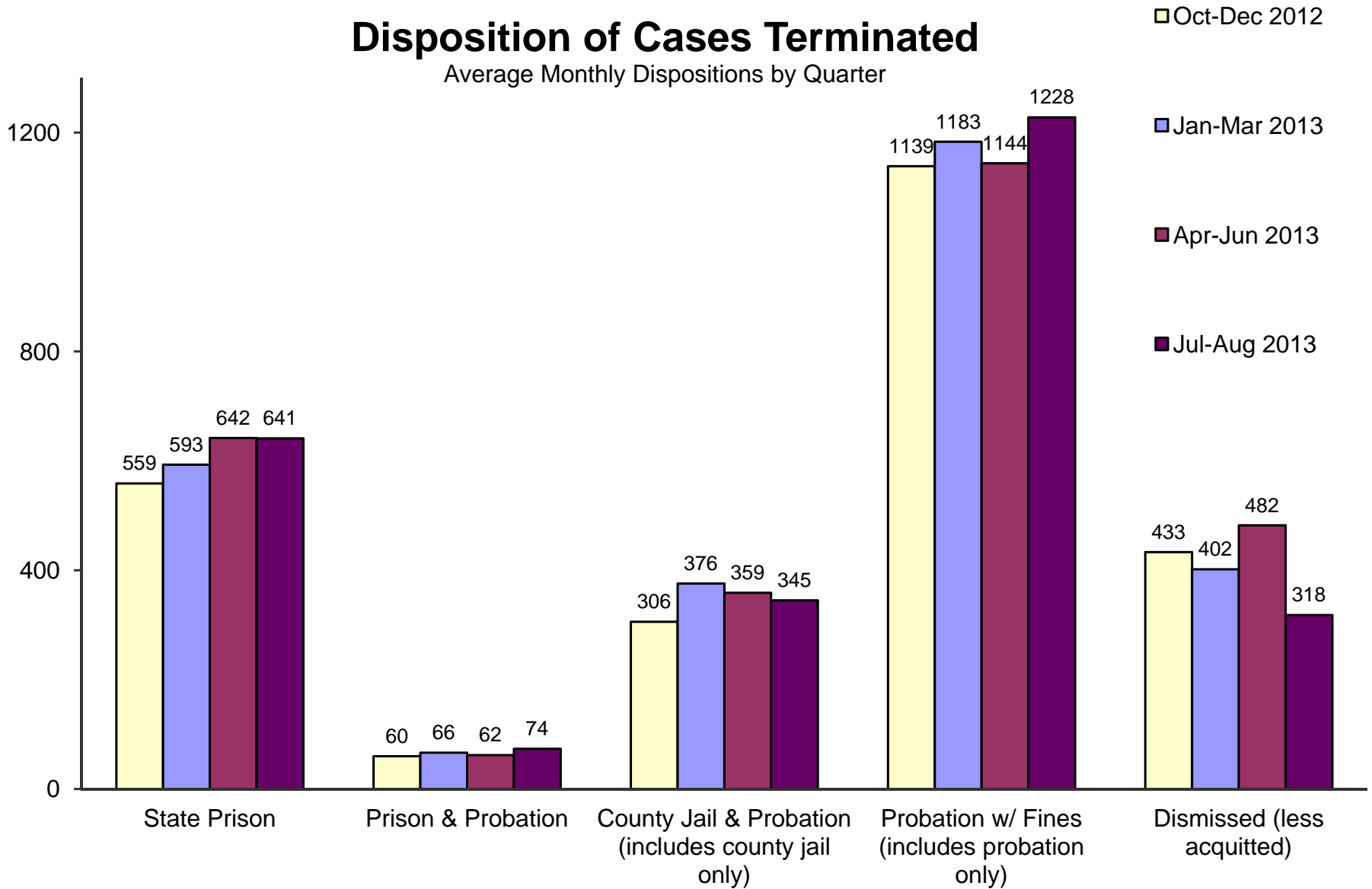


Superior Court Trials Completed

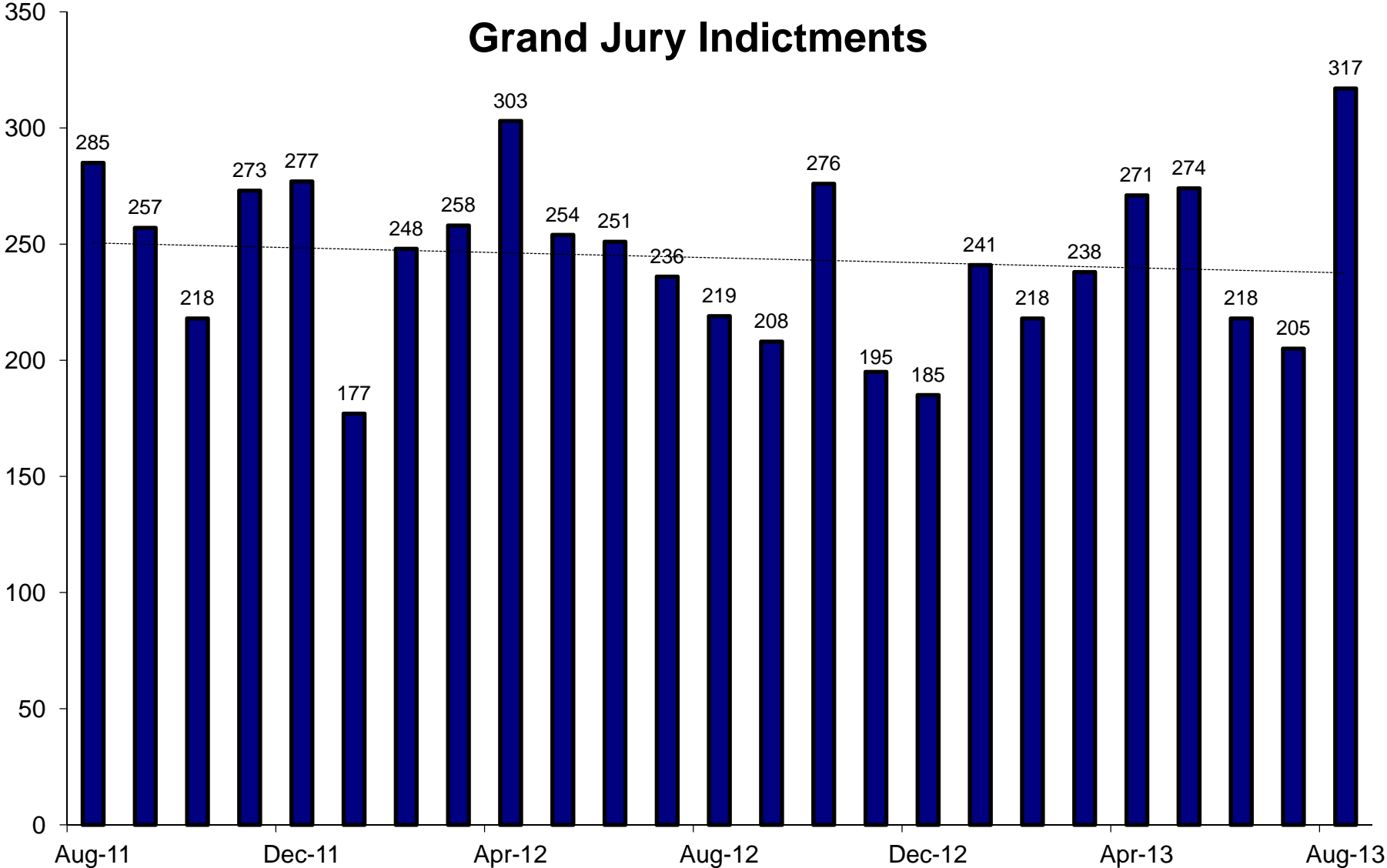


Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter

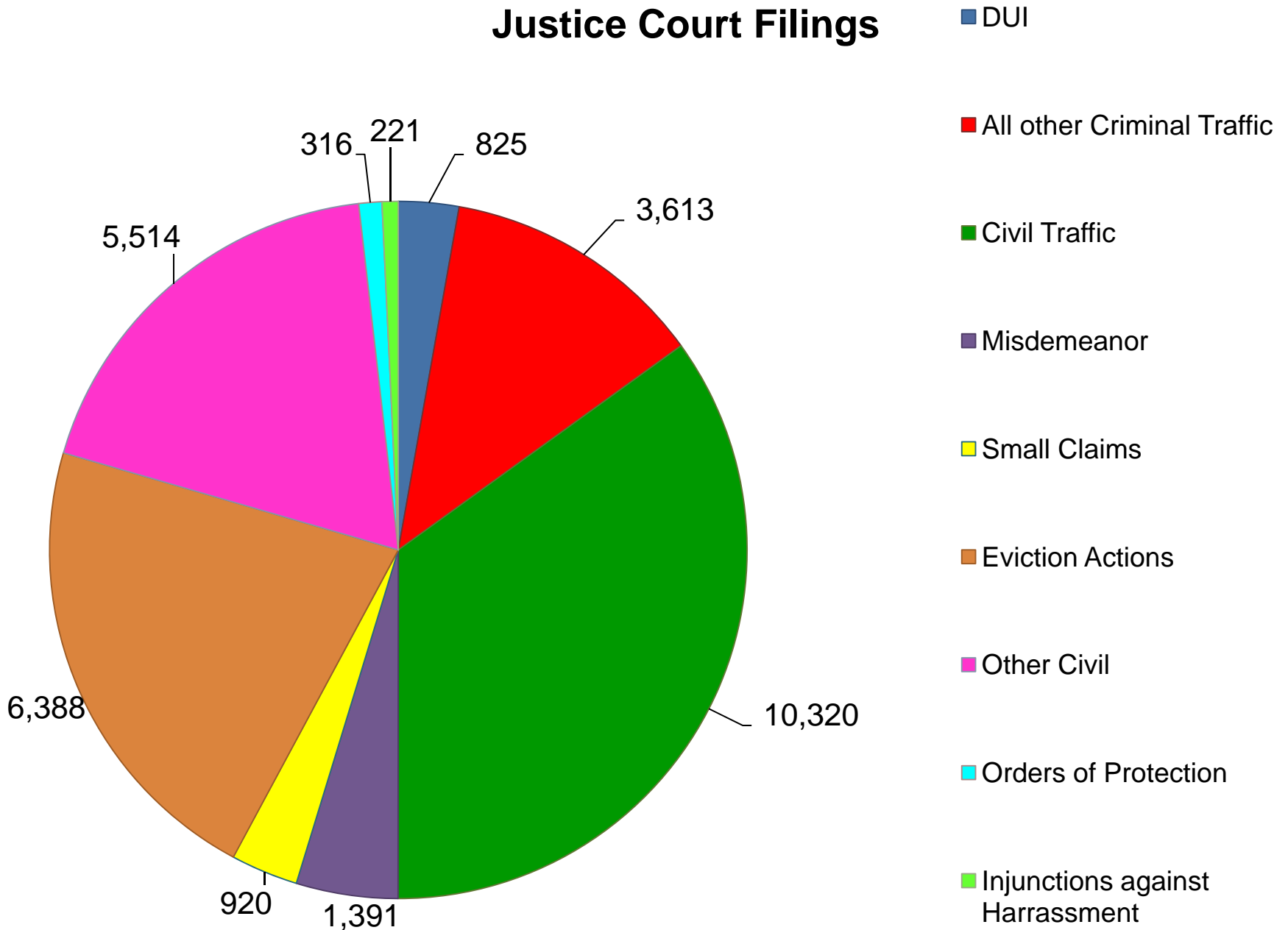


Grand Jury Indictments

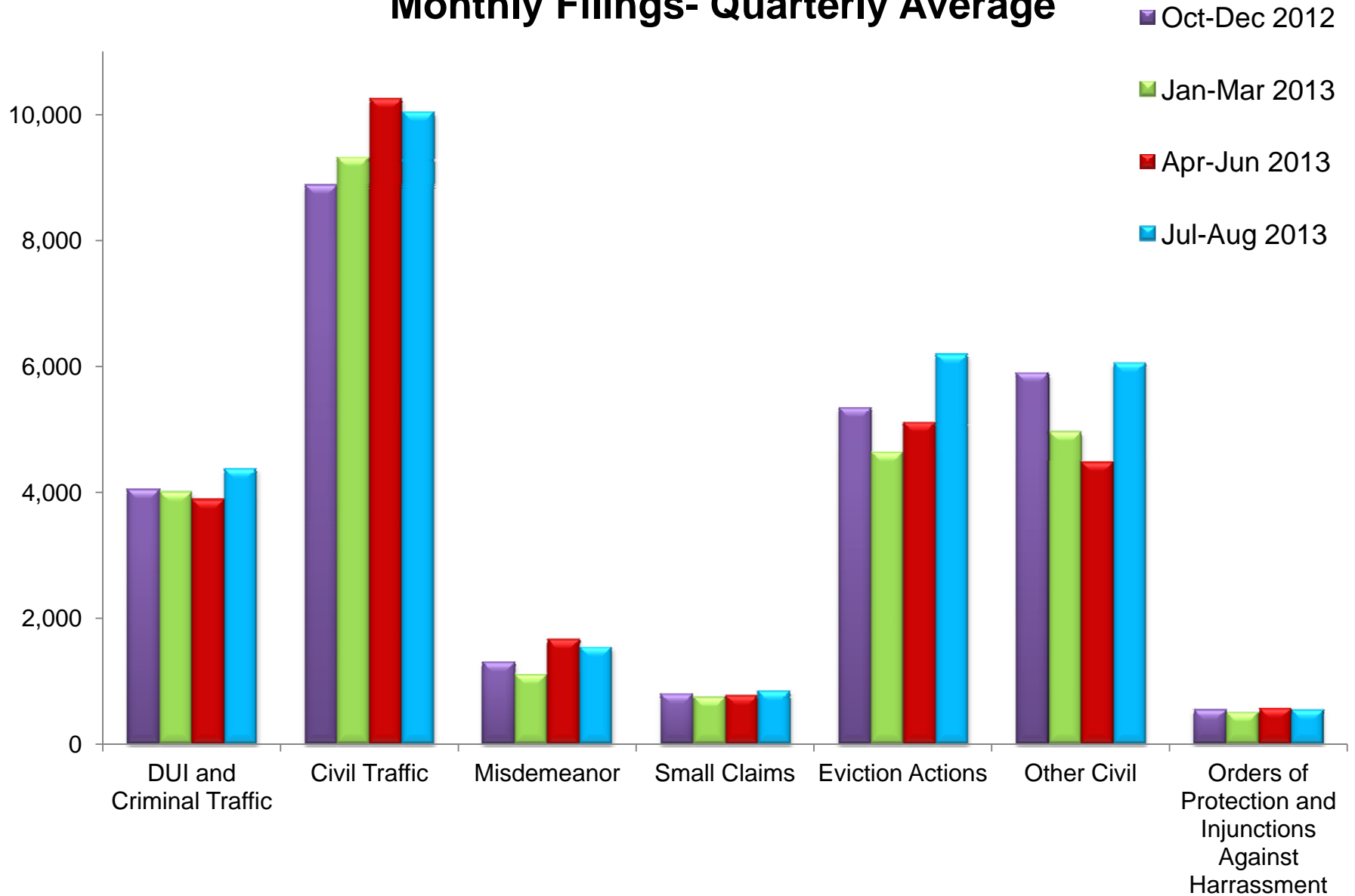

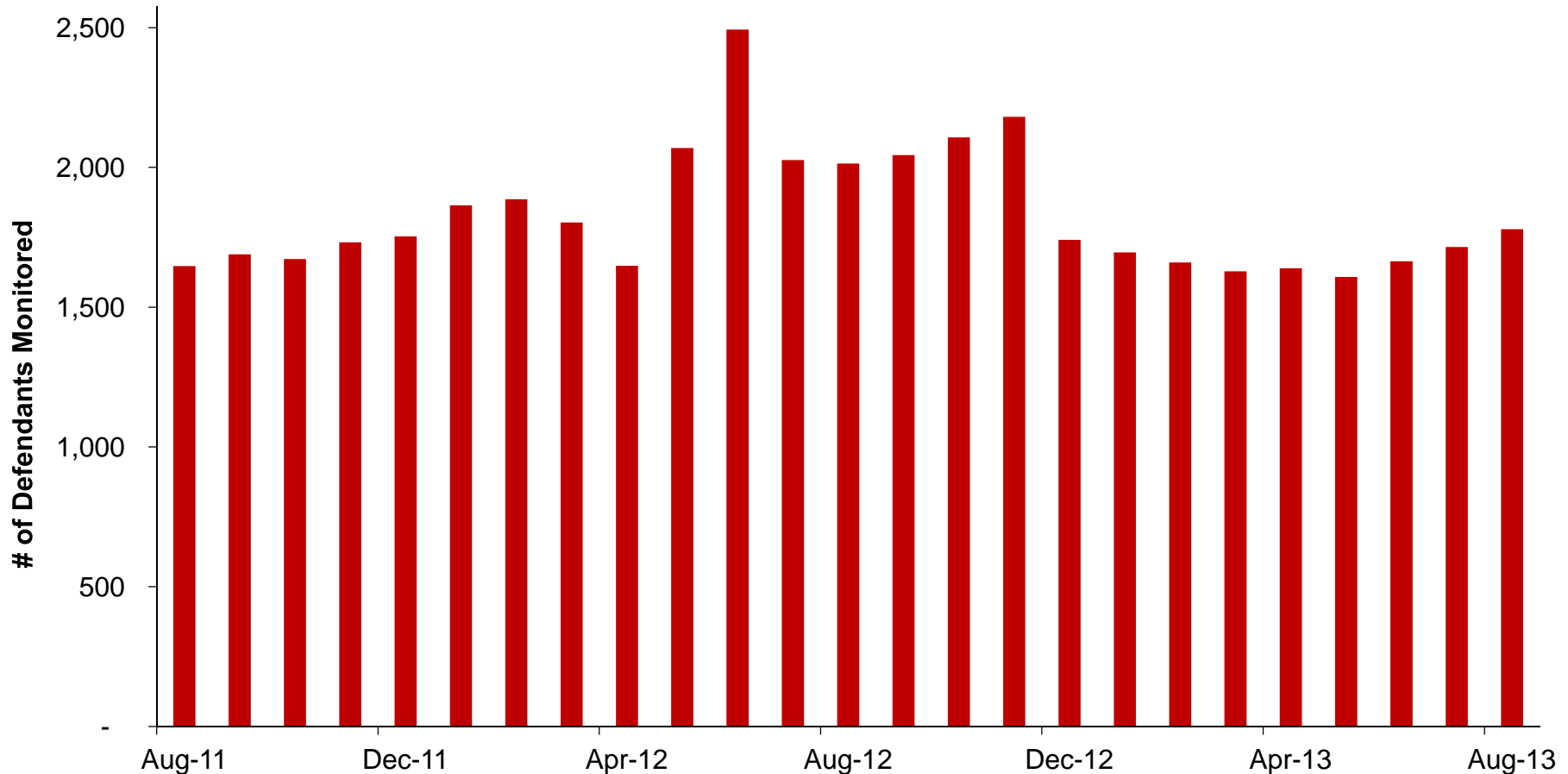

Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average

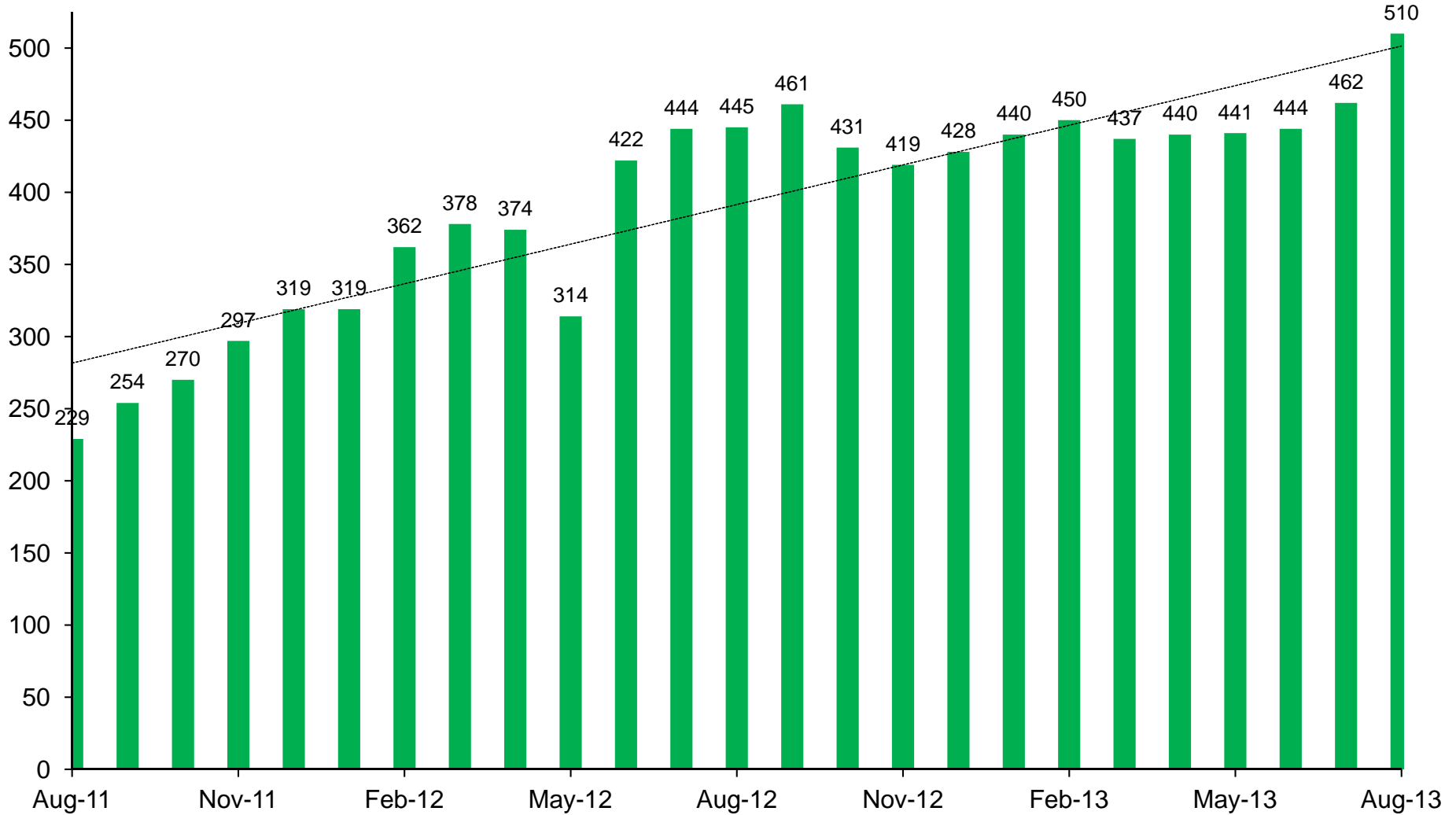


Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload

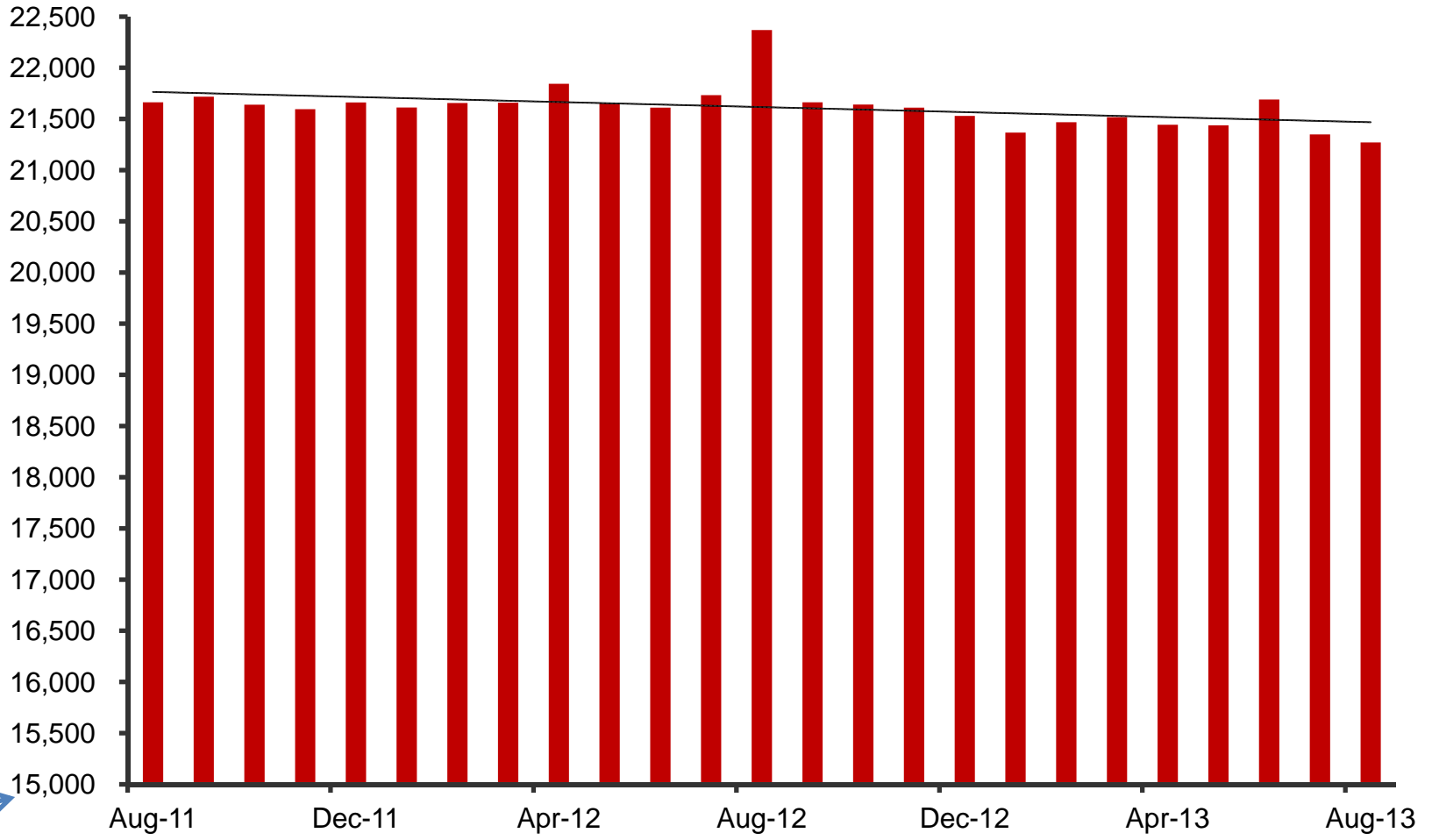

Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring



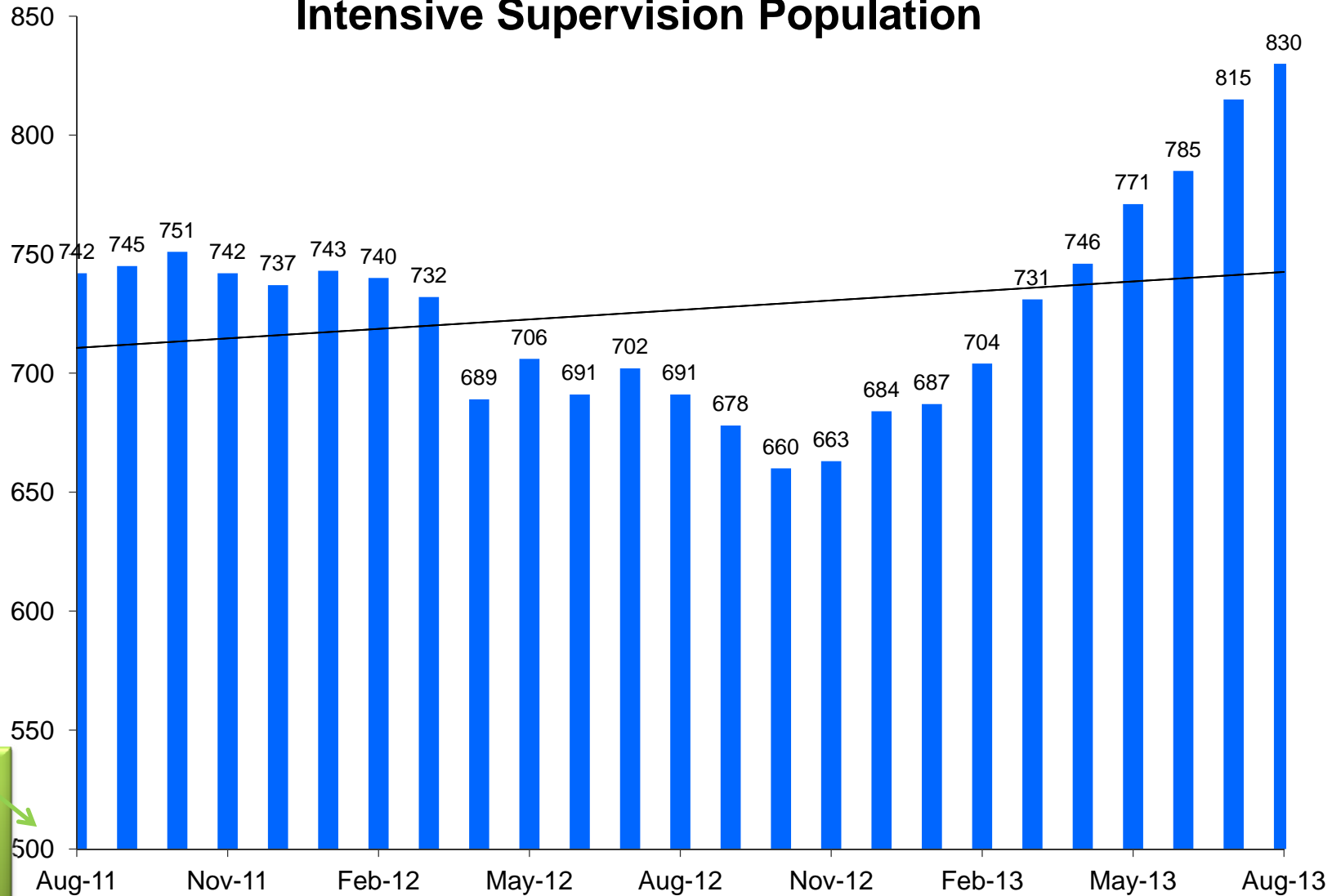
Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

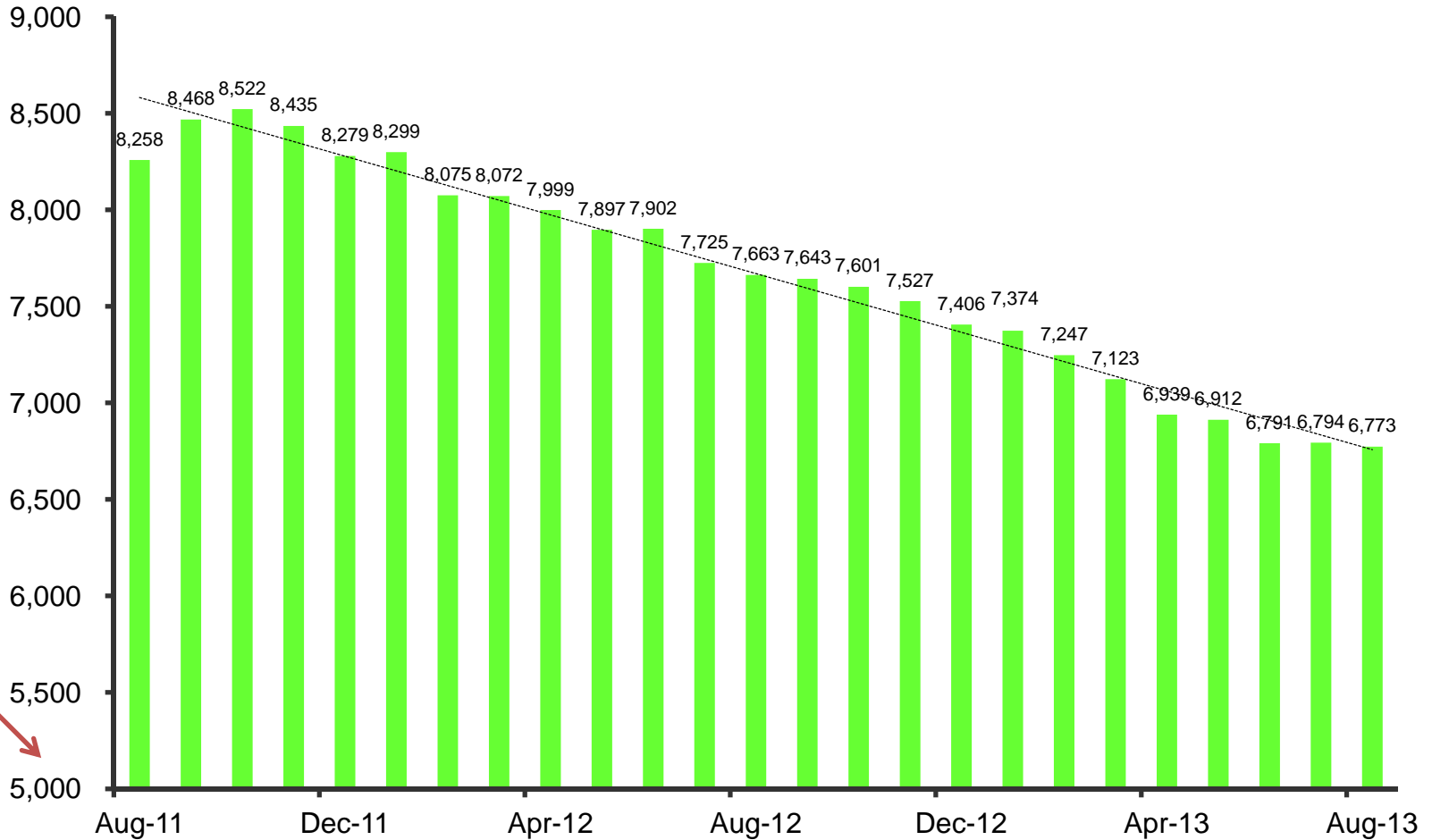

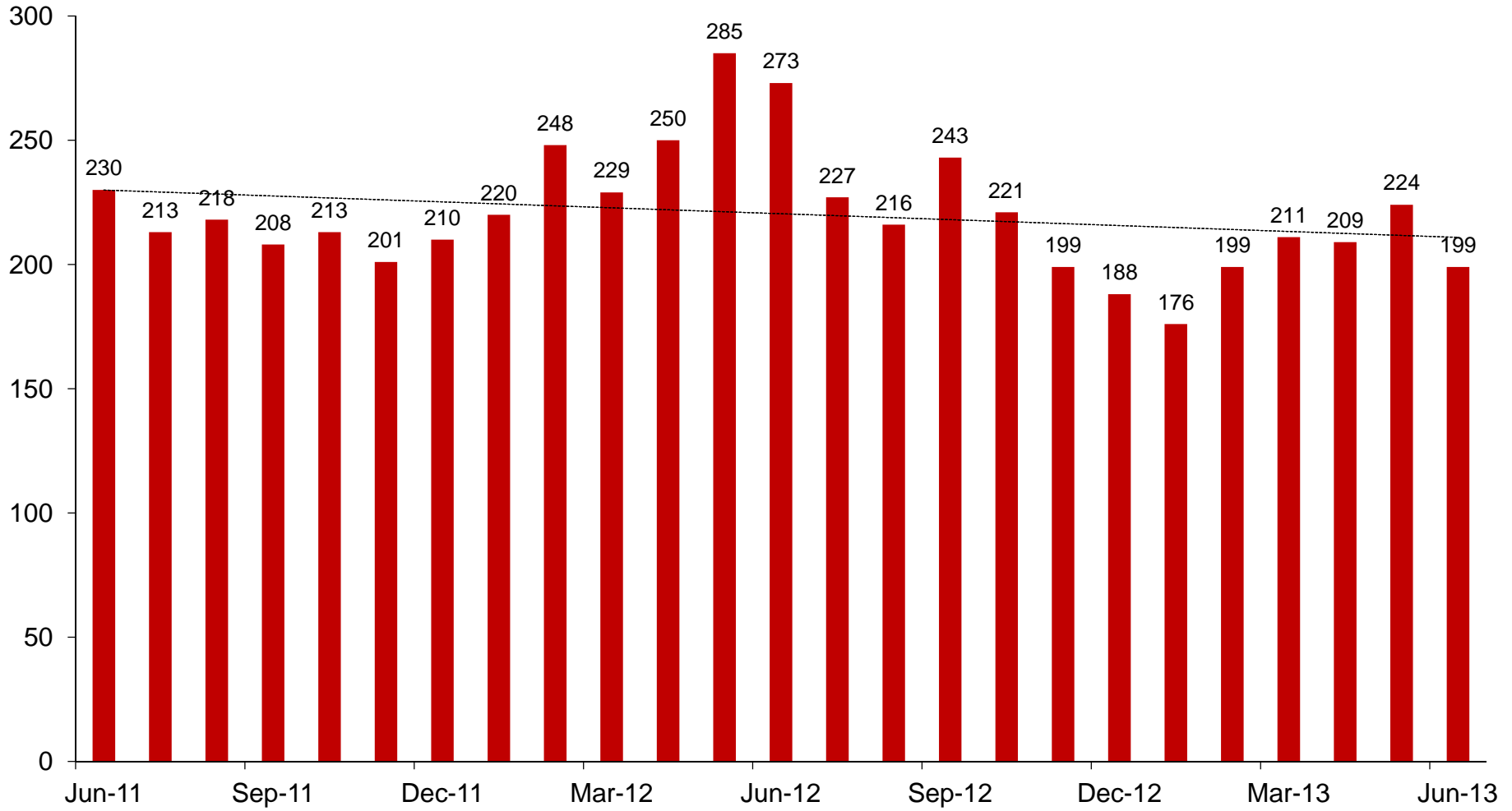

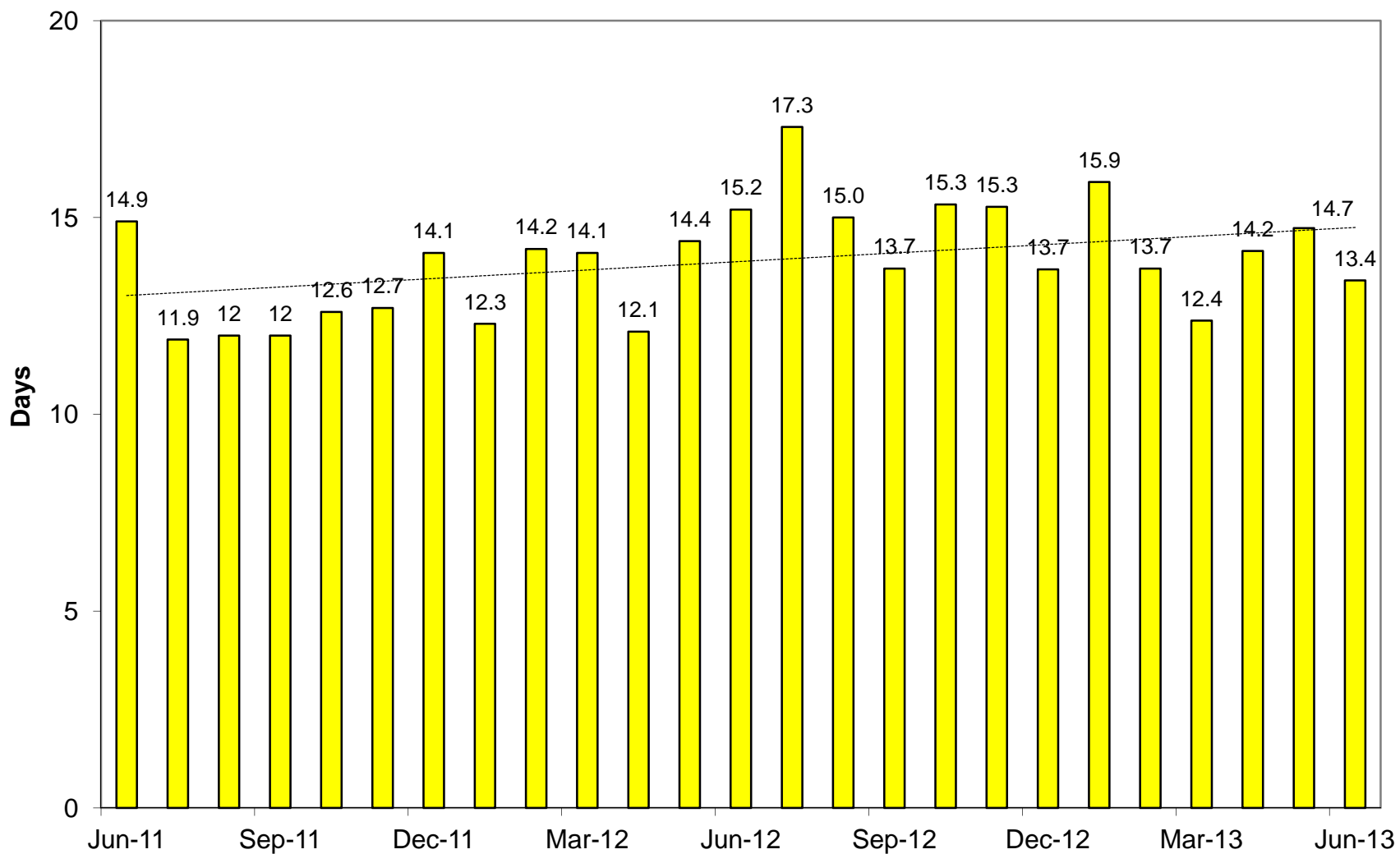
