CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM Monthly Changes –February 2013

Adult Jail Incarceration

- **Bookings decreased** from 8,900 in January to 8,292 in February.
- **Releases decreased** from 8,662 in January to 8,241 in February.
- The **Average Daily Population (ADP) increased** from 7,877 in January to 7,977 in February.
- The **Pretrial ADP increased** from 6,000 in January to 6,041 in February.
- The **Sentenced ADP increased** from 1,639 in January to 1,694 in February.
- The **Agency Hold ADP decreased** from 189 in January to 187 in February.
- The **Overall Average Length of Stay (ALOS) at release decreased** from 28.3 in Jan to 24.8 in Feb.
- The **ALOS for Pretrial decreased** from 8.7 in January to 7.0 in February.
- The **ALOS for Sentenced decreased** from 24.4 in January to 23.2 in February.
- The **ALOS for Agency Holds decreased** from 76.1 in January to 69.6 in February.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

- **New Criminal Case Filings increased** from 2,317 in January to 2,474 in February.
- **Case Terminations decreased** from 2,796 in January to 2,348 in February.
- The resulting **Clearance Rate** was 95%.
- The **Active Pending Case Inventory decreased** from 11,234 in January to 11,127 in February.
- **Regional Court Center filings increased** from 1,380 in January to 1,434 in February.
- **Early Disposition Court filings increased** from 676 in January to 789 in February.
- The **Number of Trials Completed decreased** from 52 in January to 48 in February.
- The **Trial Rate** was 1.9%.

Justice Court Filings

- **DUI Filings decreased** from 1,151 in January to 575 in February.
- All other **Criminal Traffic Filings decreased** from 4,010 in January to 2,959 in February.
- **Civil Traffic Filings decreased** from 11,011 in January to 9,117 in February.
- **Eviction Action Filings decreased** from 5,477 in January to 4,571 in February.
- **Total Filings decreased** from 28,869 in January to 23,994 in February.

Adult Probation

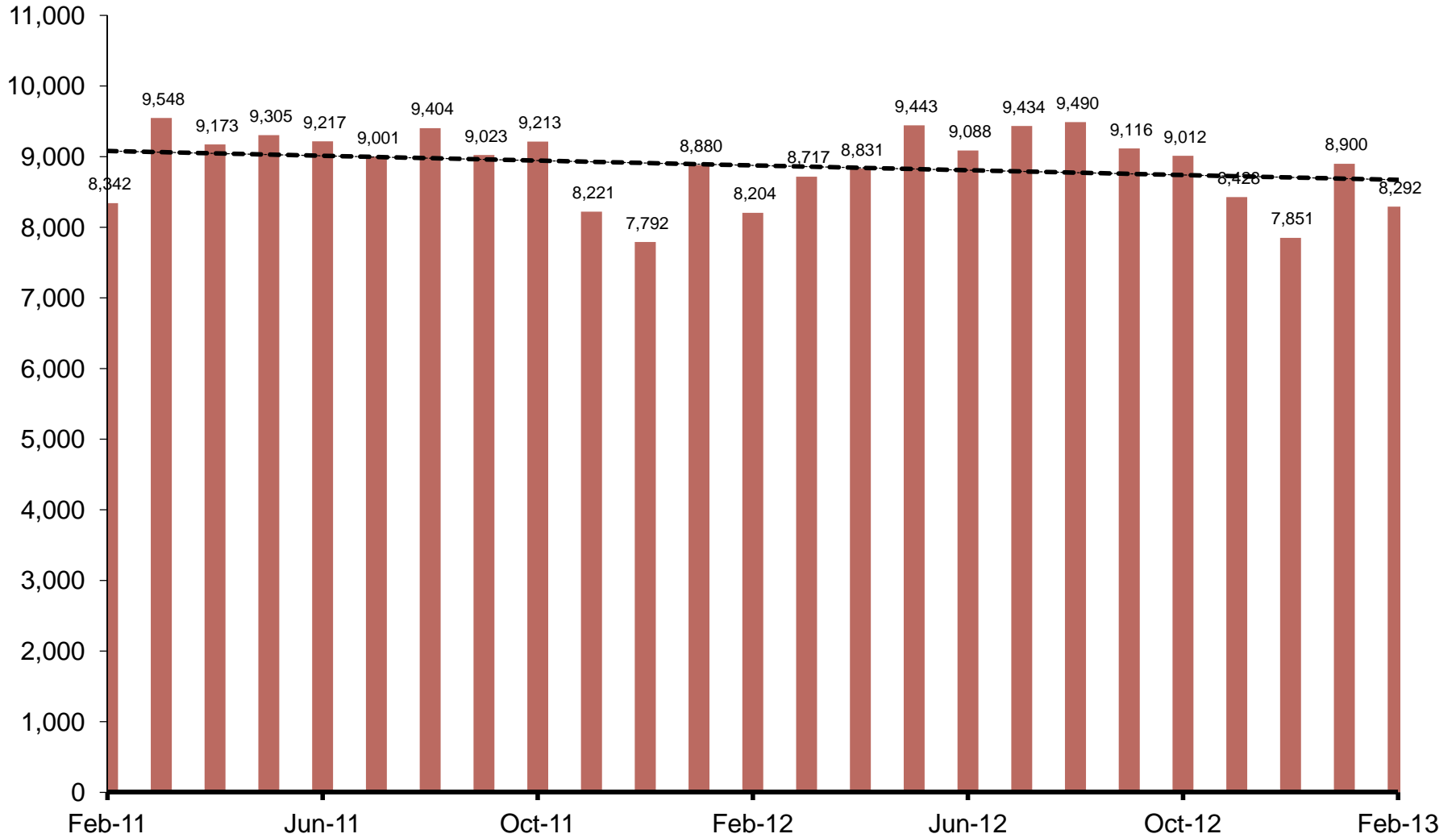
- **Pretrial Standard Supervision decreased** from 1,696 in January to 1,660 in February.
- **Electronic Monitoring increased** from 440 in January to 450 in February.
- **Adult Standard Probation Supervision increased** from 21,367 in January to 21,468 in February.
- **Adult Intensive Probation Supervision increased** from 687 in January to 704 in February.
- **Adult Unsupervised Probation Supervision decreased** from 7,374 in January to 7,247 in February.

Juvenile Detention and Probation

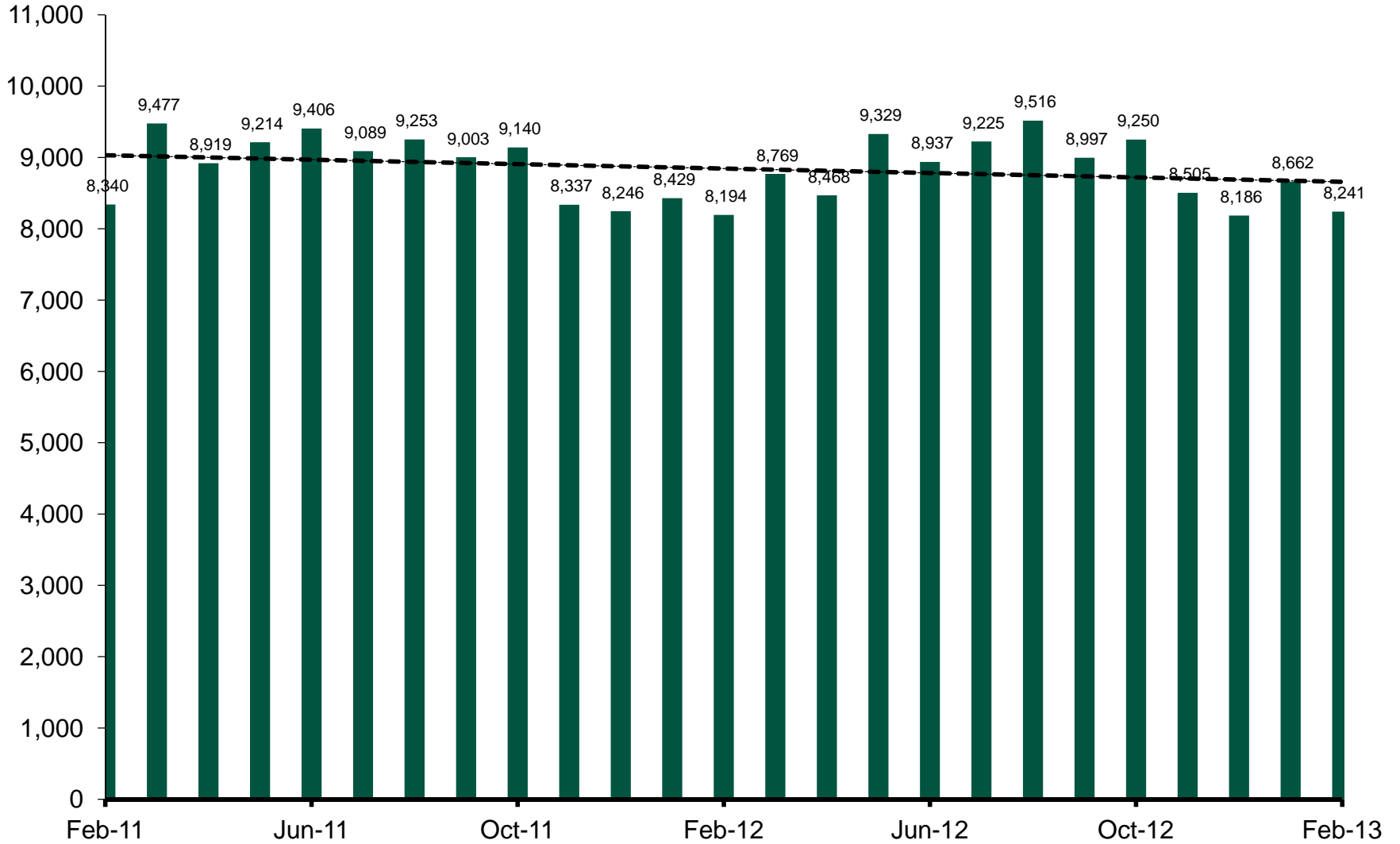
- The **Average Daily Detention Population increased** from 176 in January to 199 in February.
- The **ALOS in juvenile detention decreased** from 15.9 in January to 13.7 in February.
- **Juvenile Standard Probation increased** from 2,396 in January to 2,404 in February.
- **Juvenile Intensive Probation increased** from 212 in January to 217 in February.

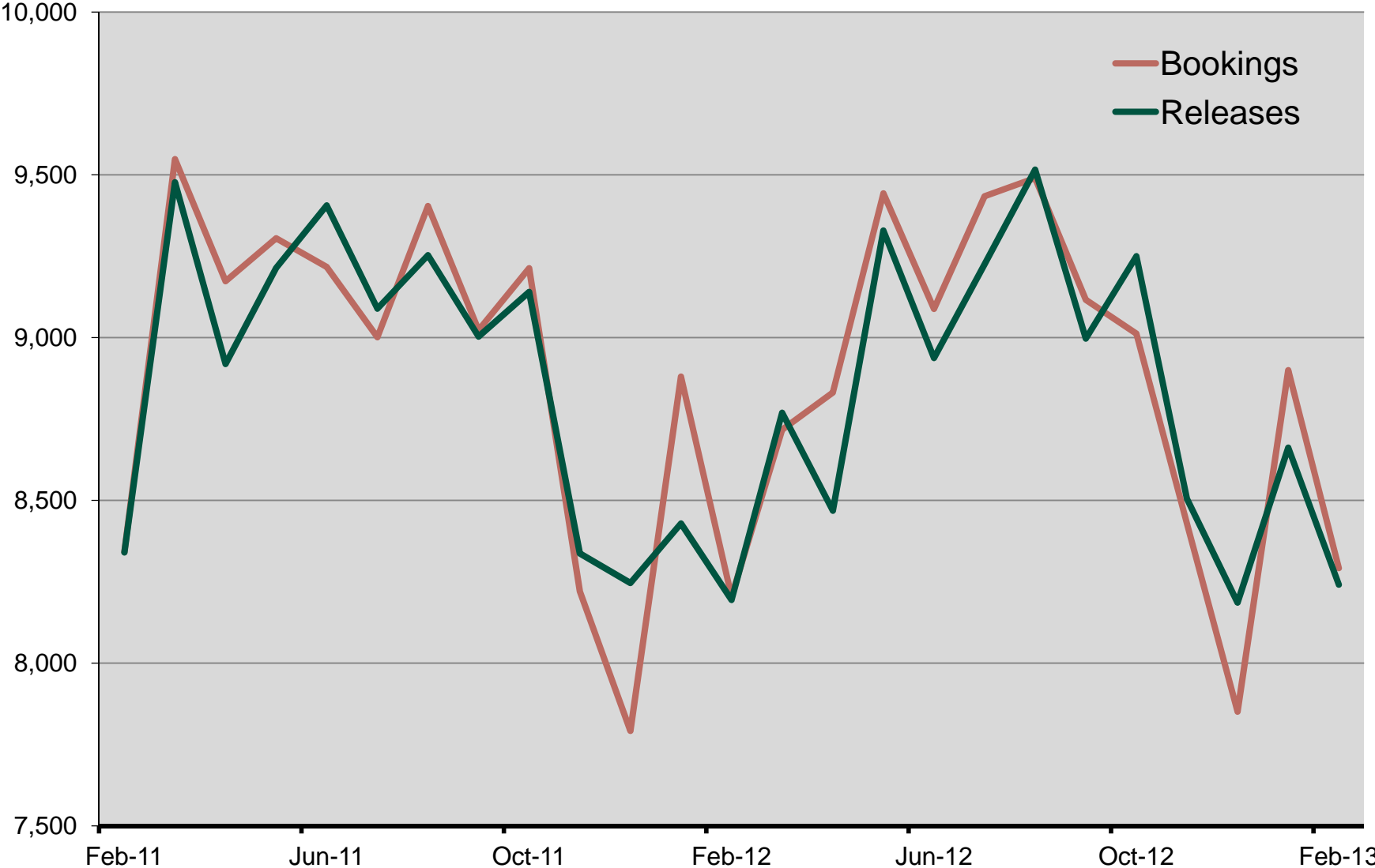

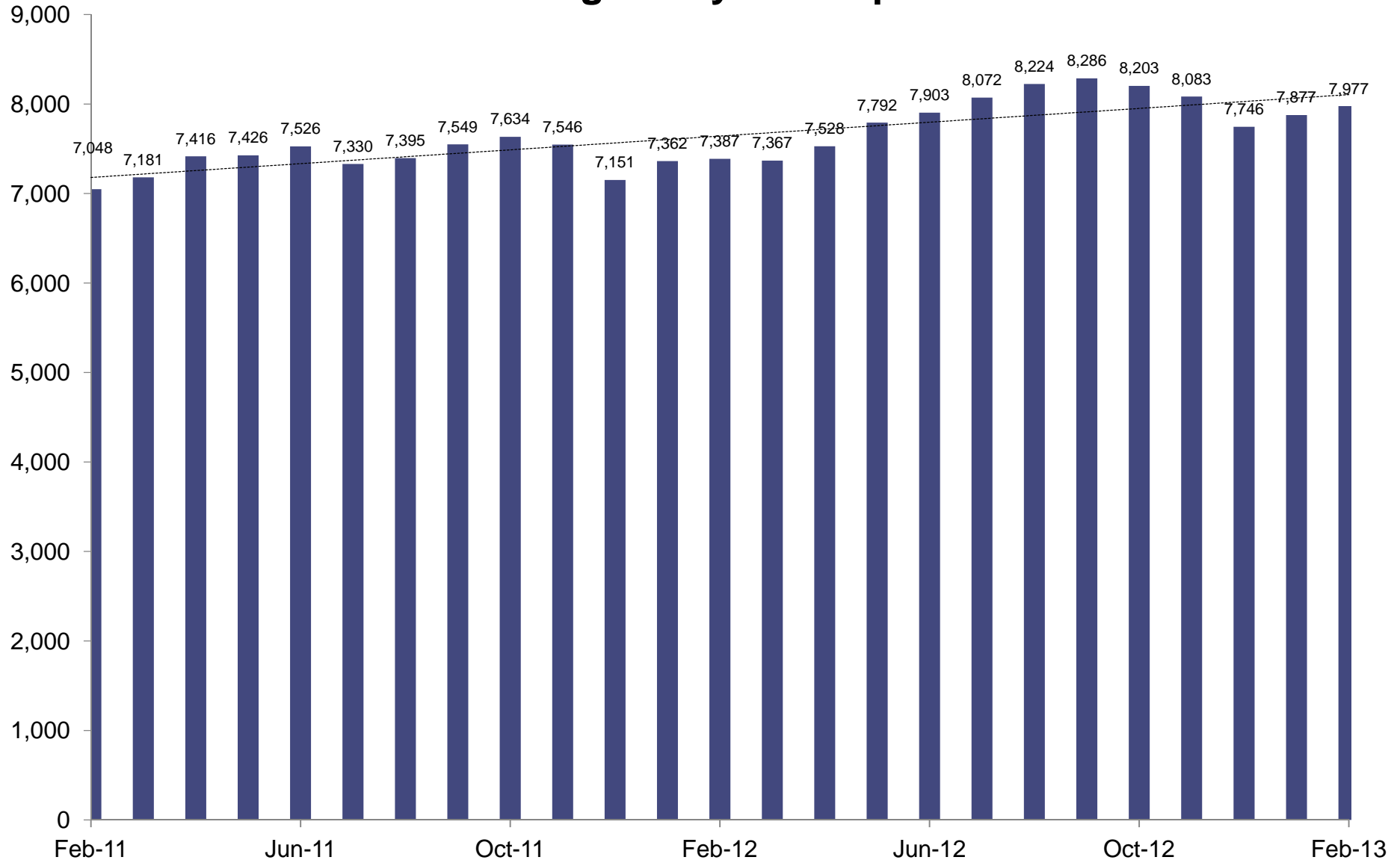
Jail Releases



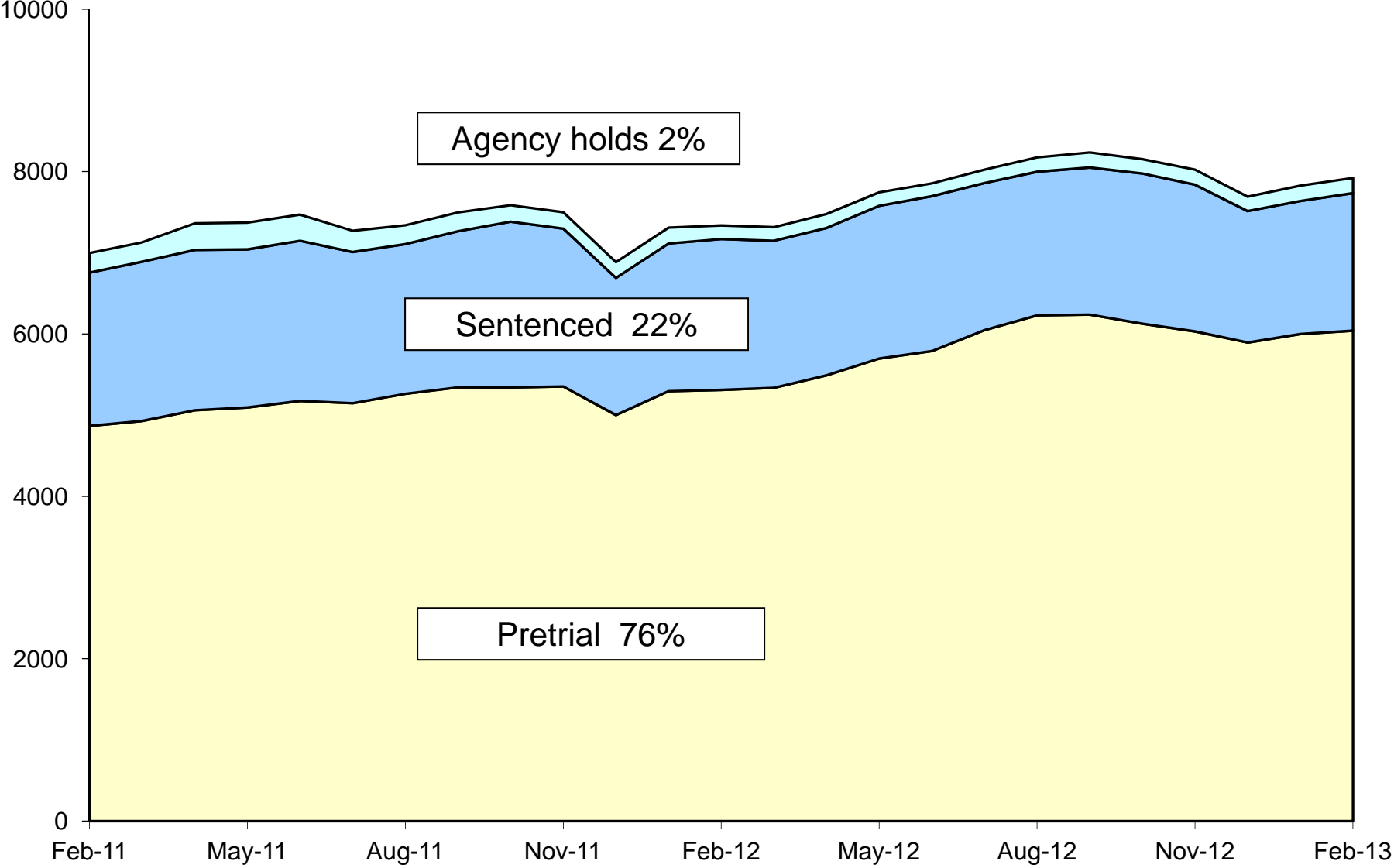
Jail Bookings and Releases



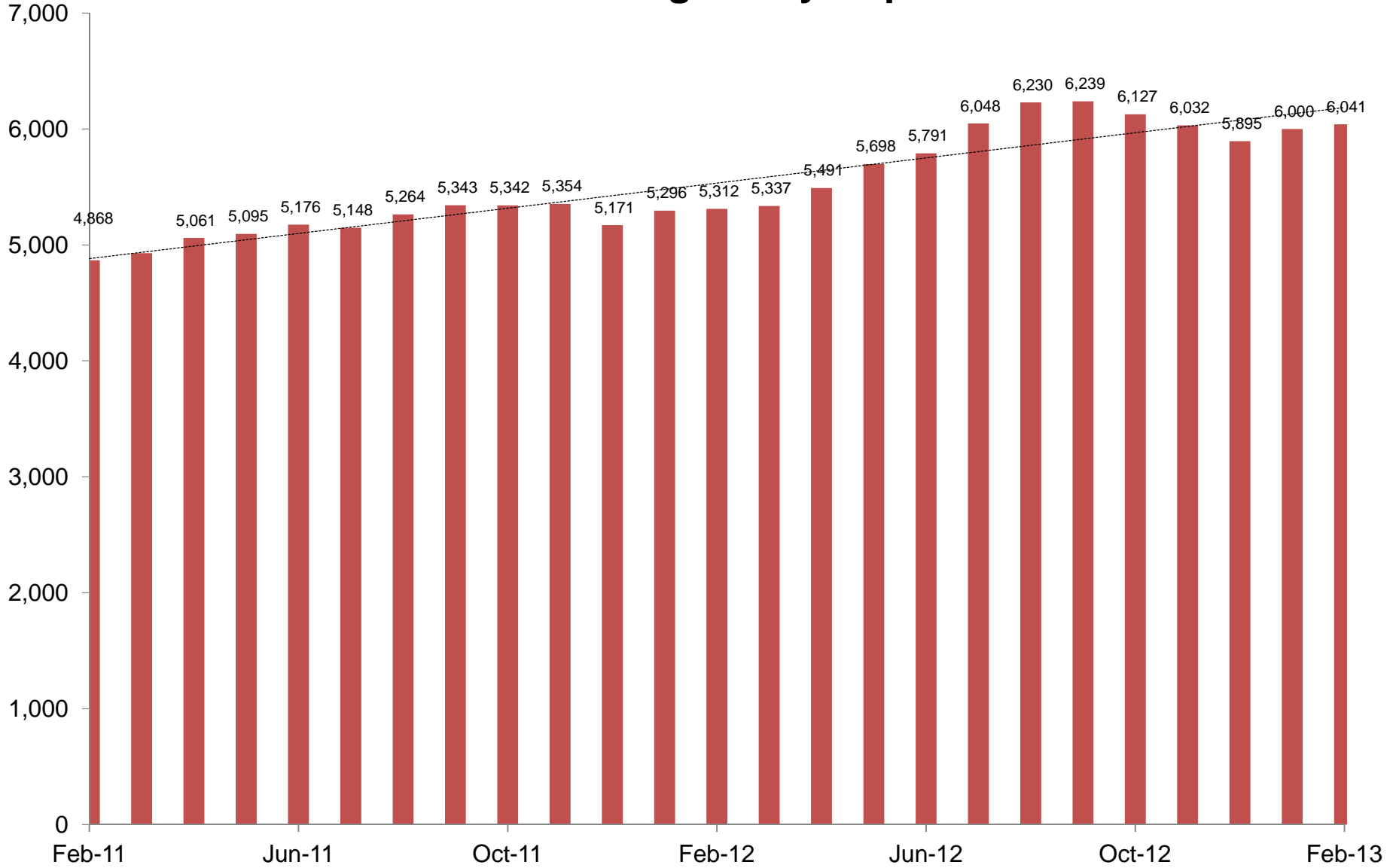
Average Daily Jail Population



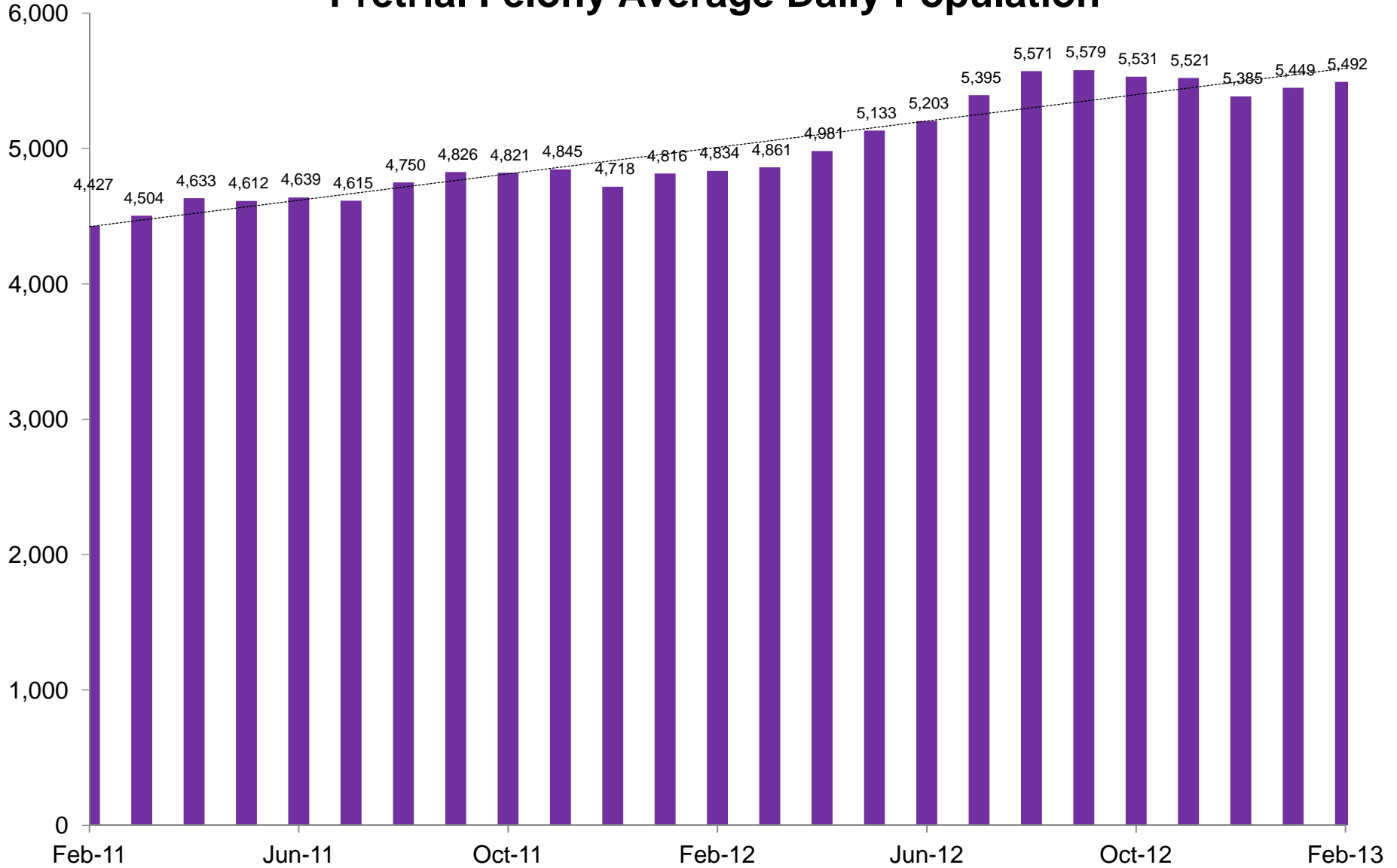
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



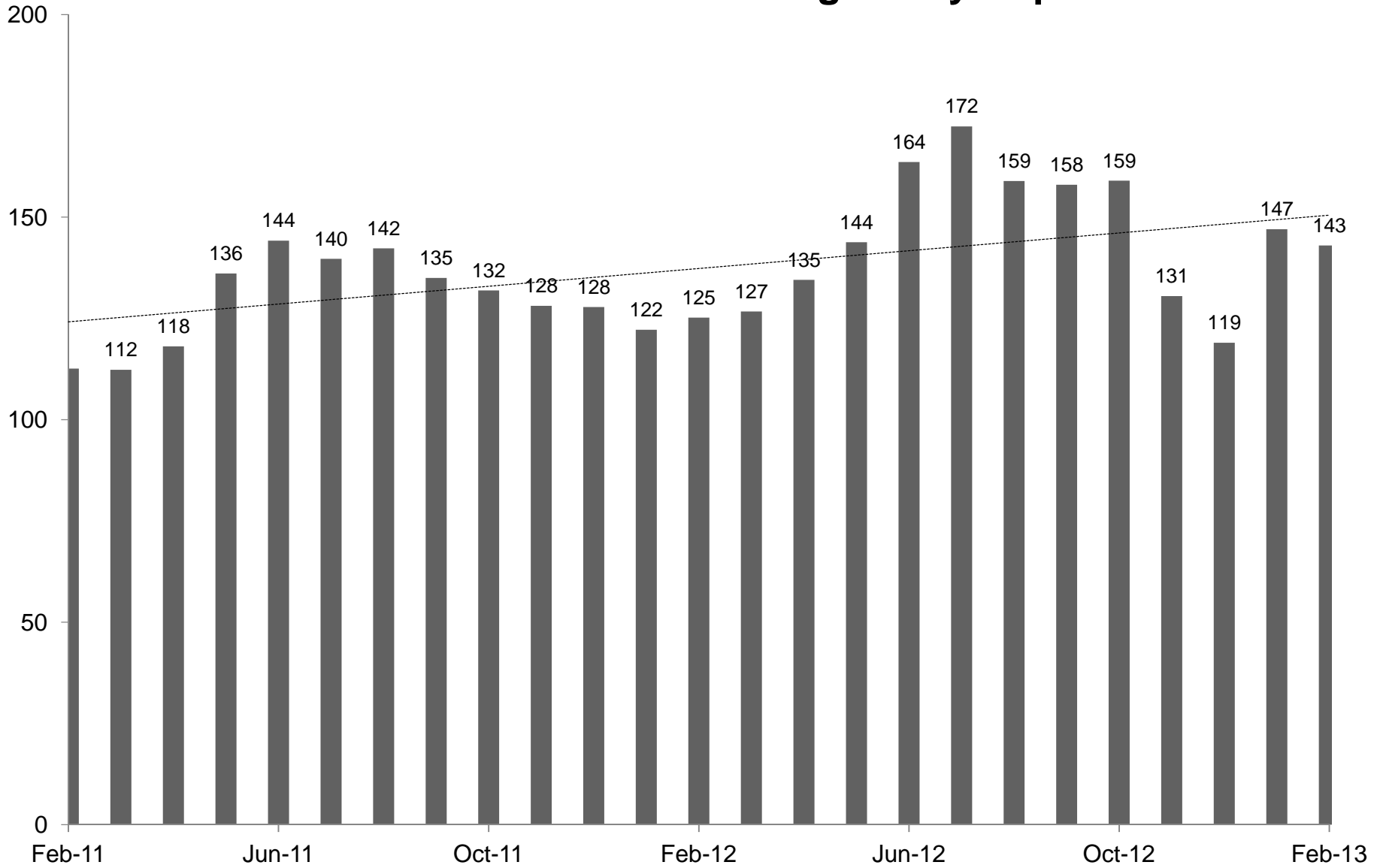
Pretrial Average Daily Population



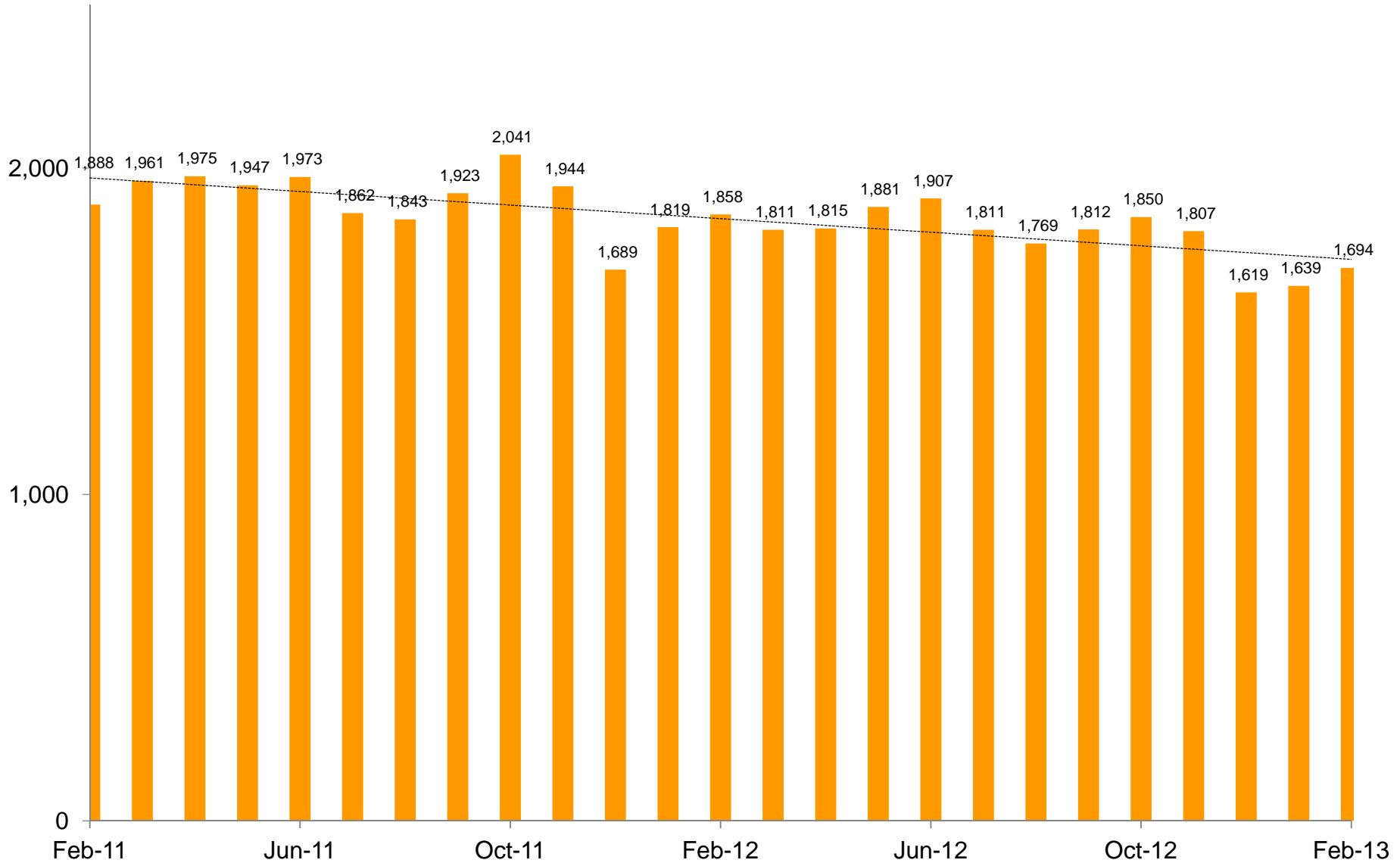
Pretrial Felony Average Daily Population



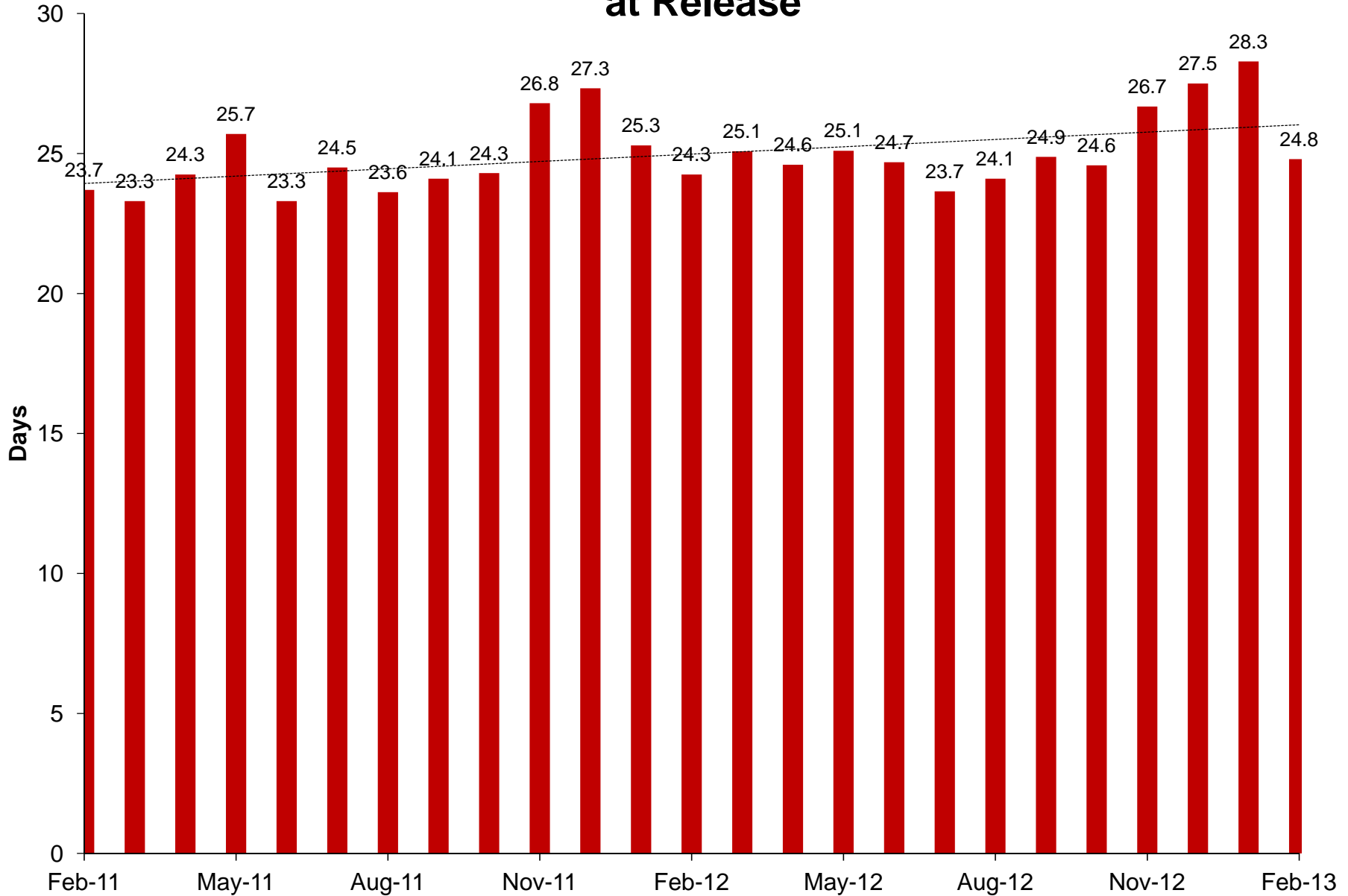
Pretrial Misdemeanor Average Daily Population



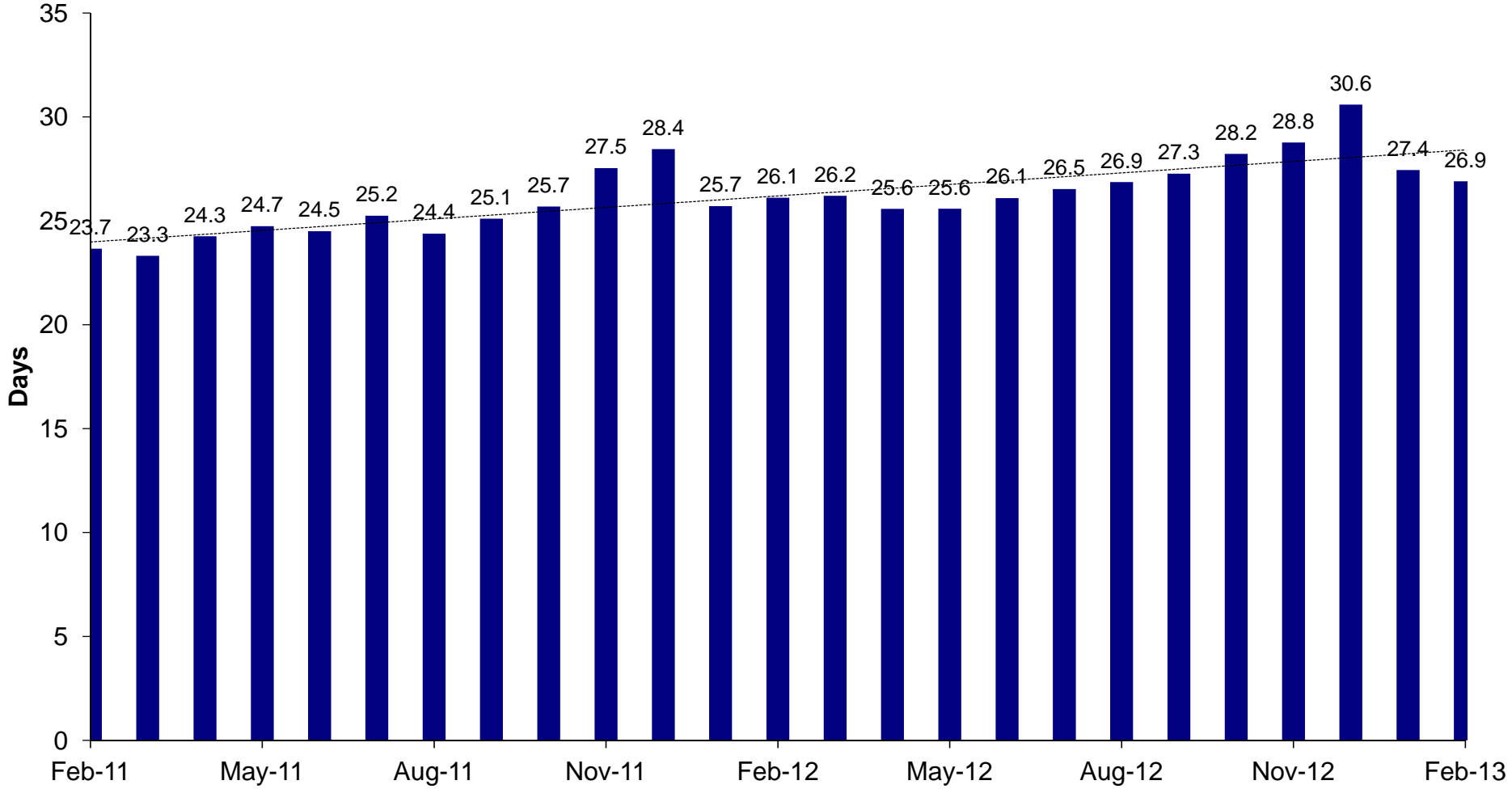
Sentenced Average Daily Population



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail at Release

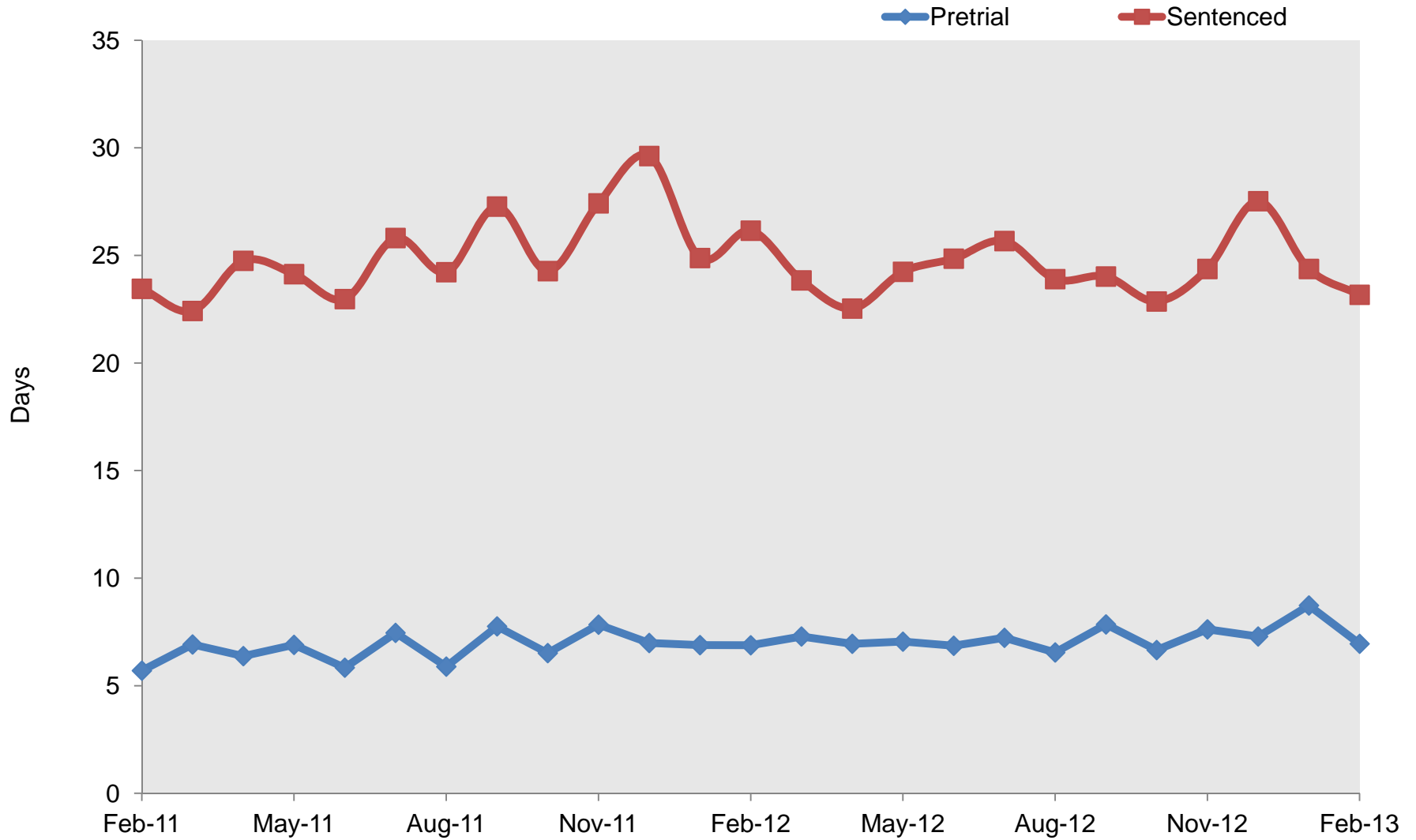


Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail In Custody*

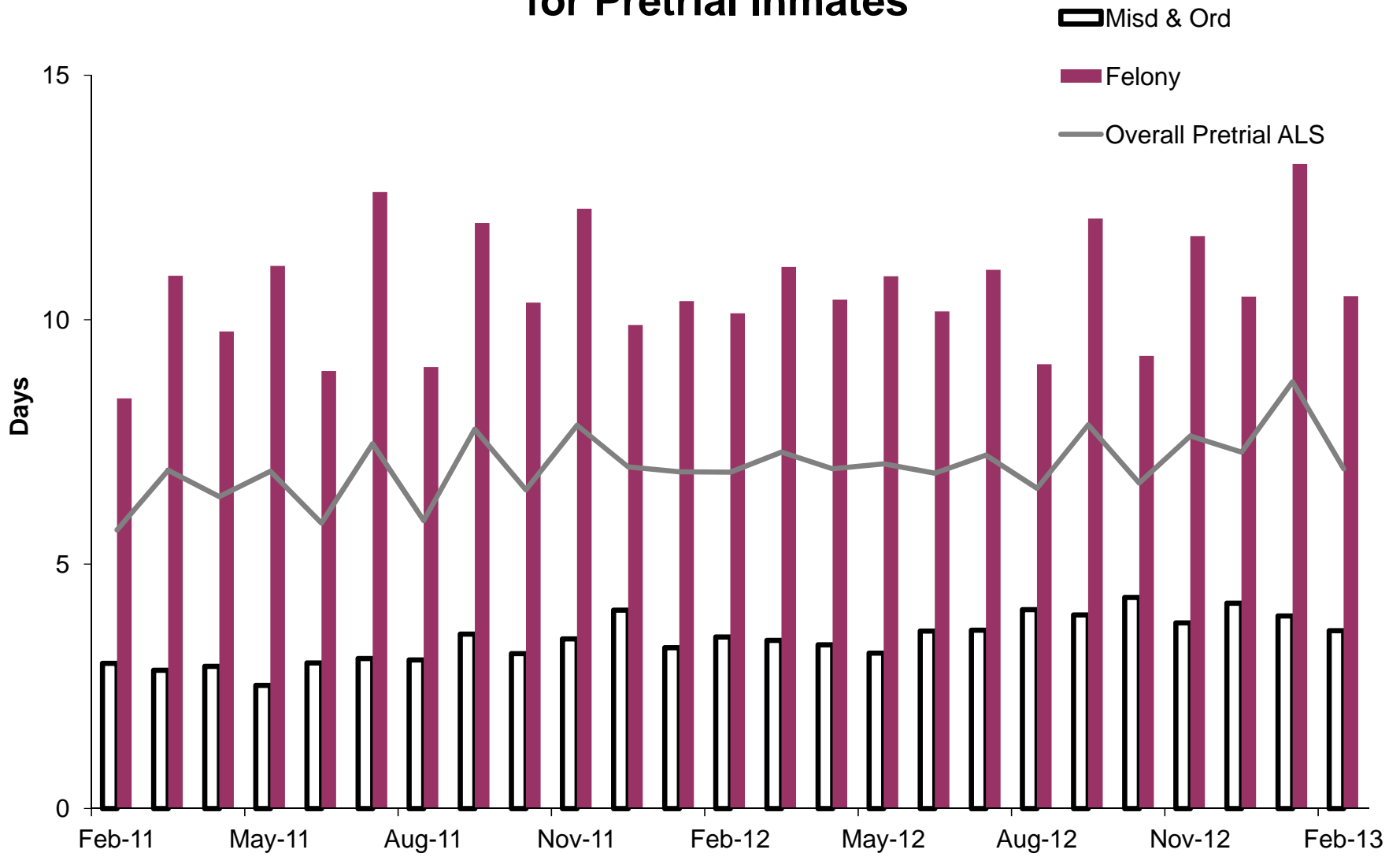

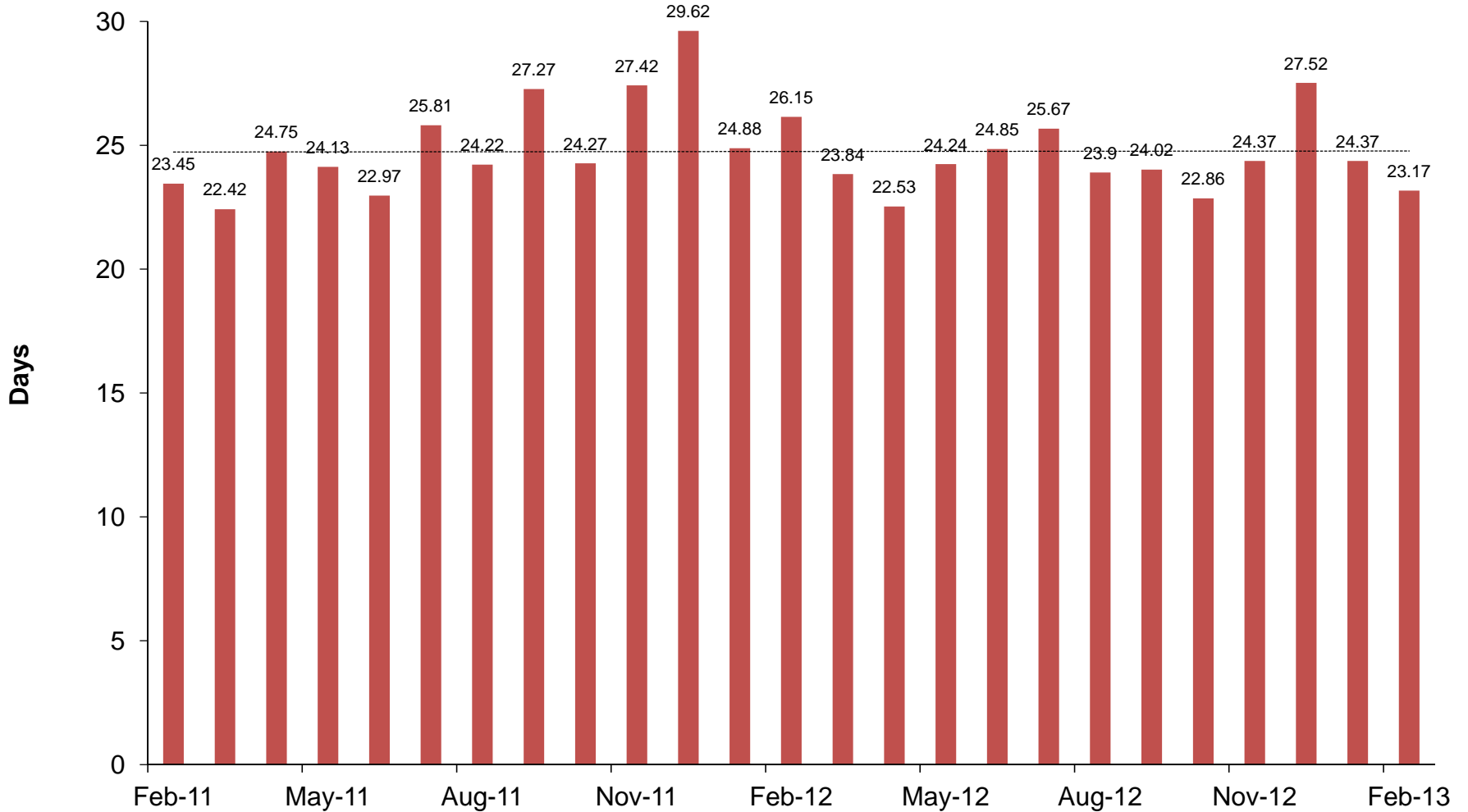
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Inmates



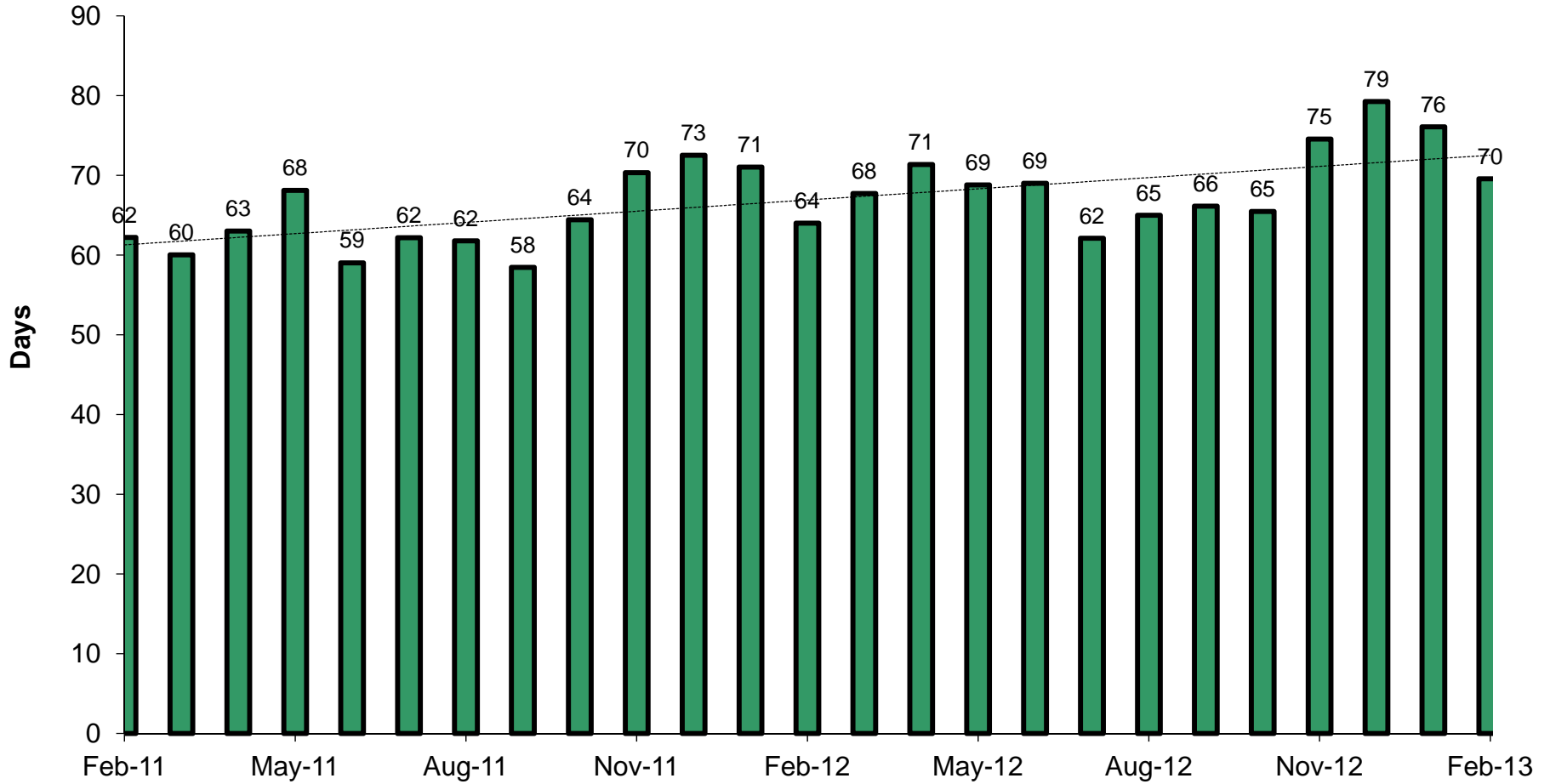
Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Sentenced Inmates

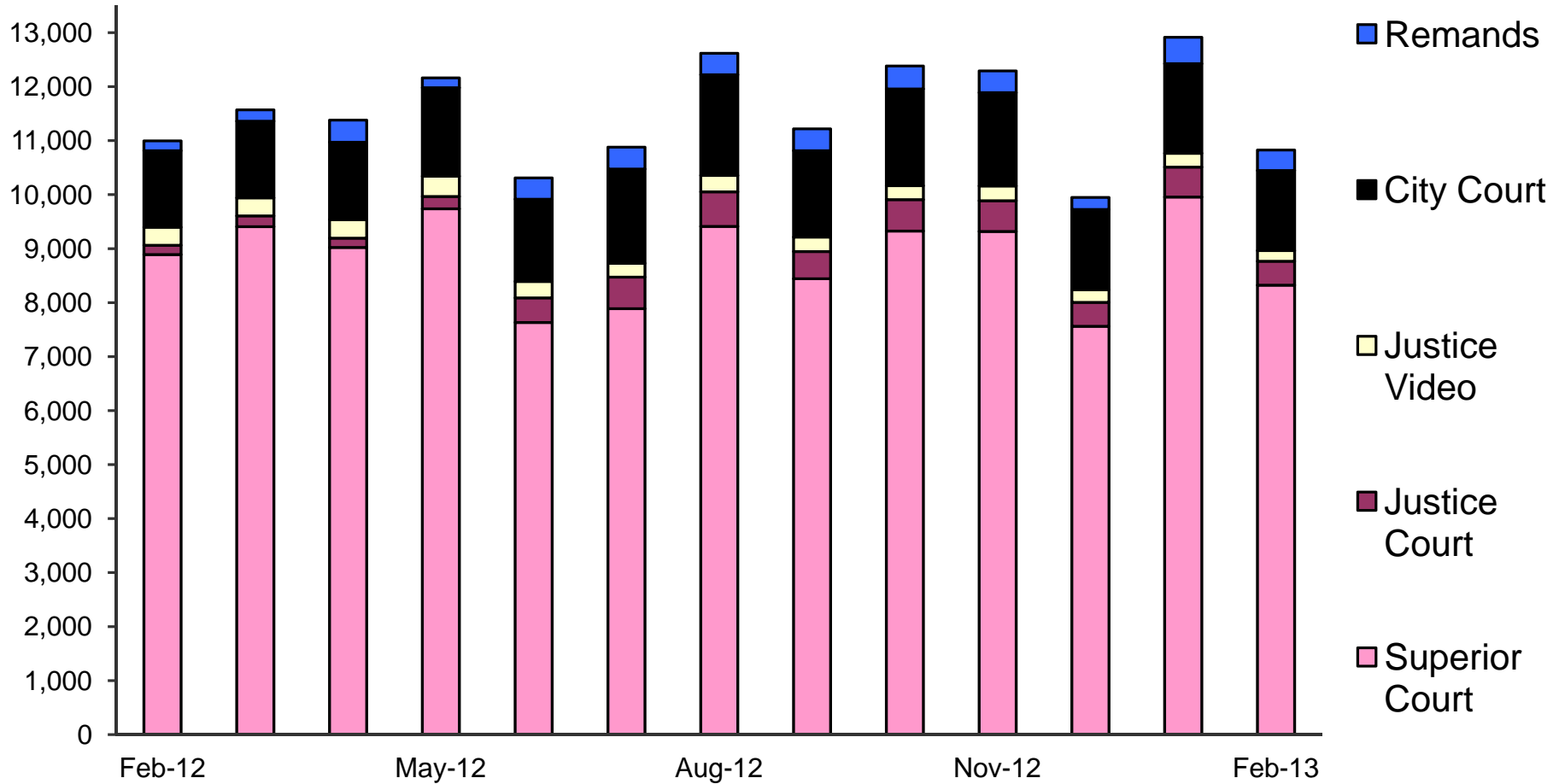


Average Length of Stay in Jail Agency Holds

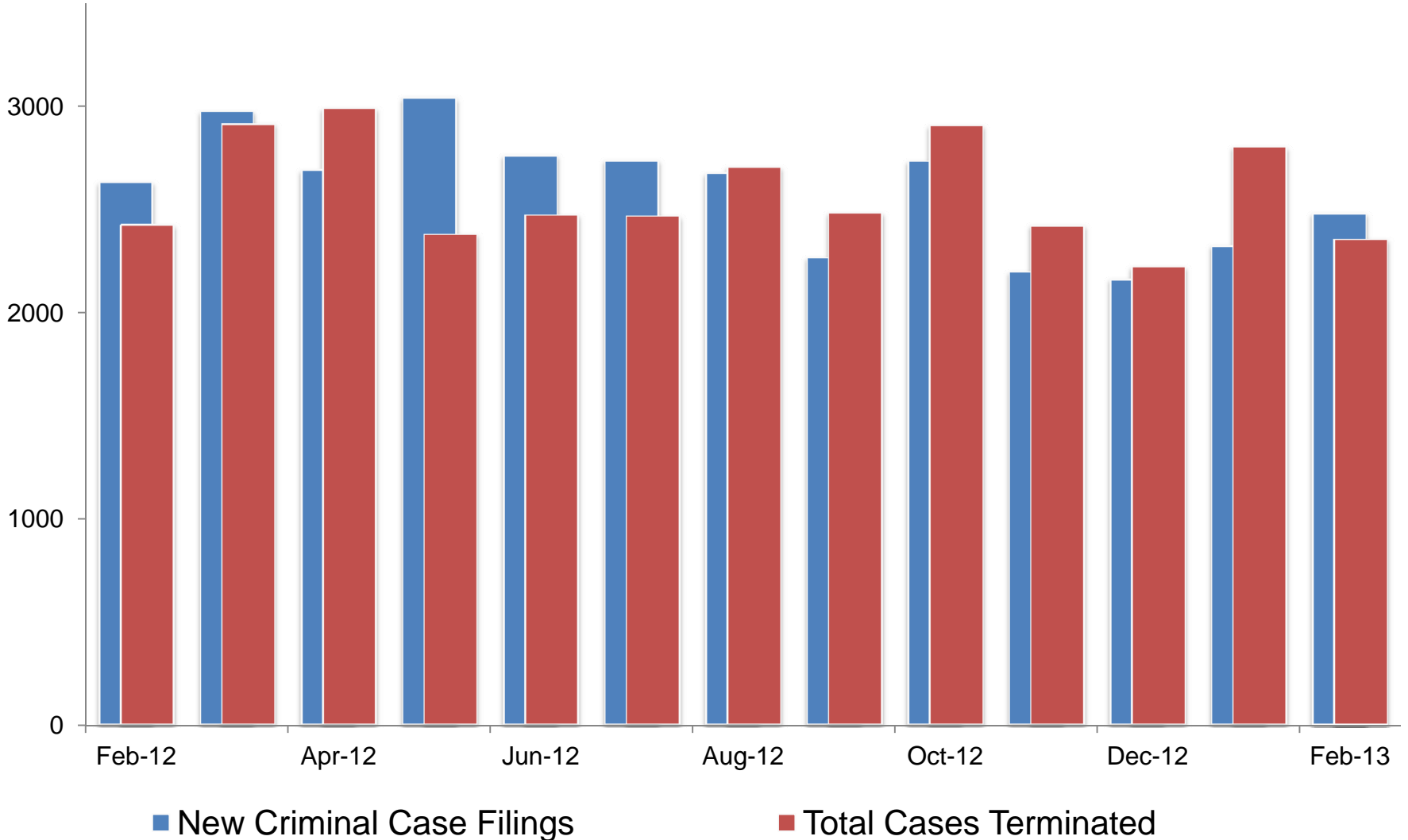

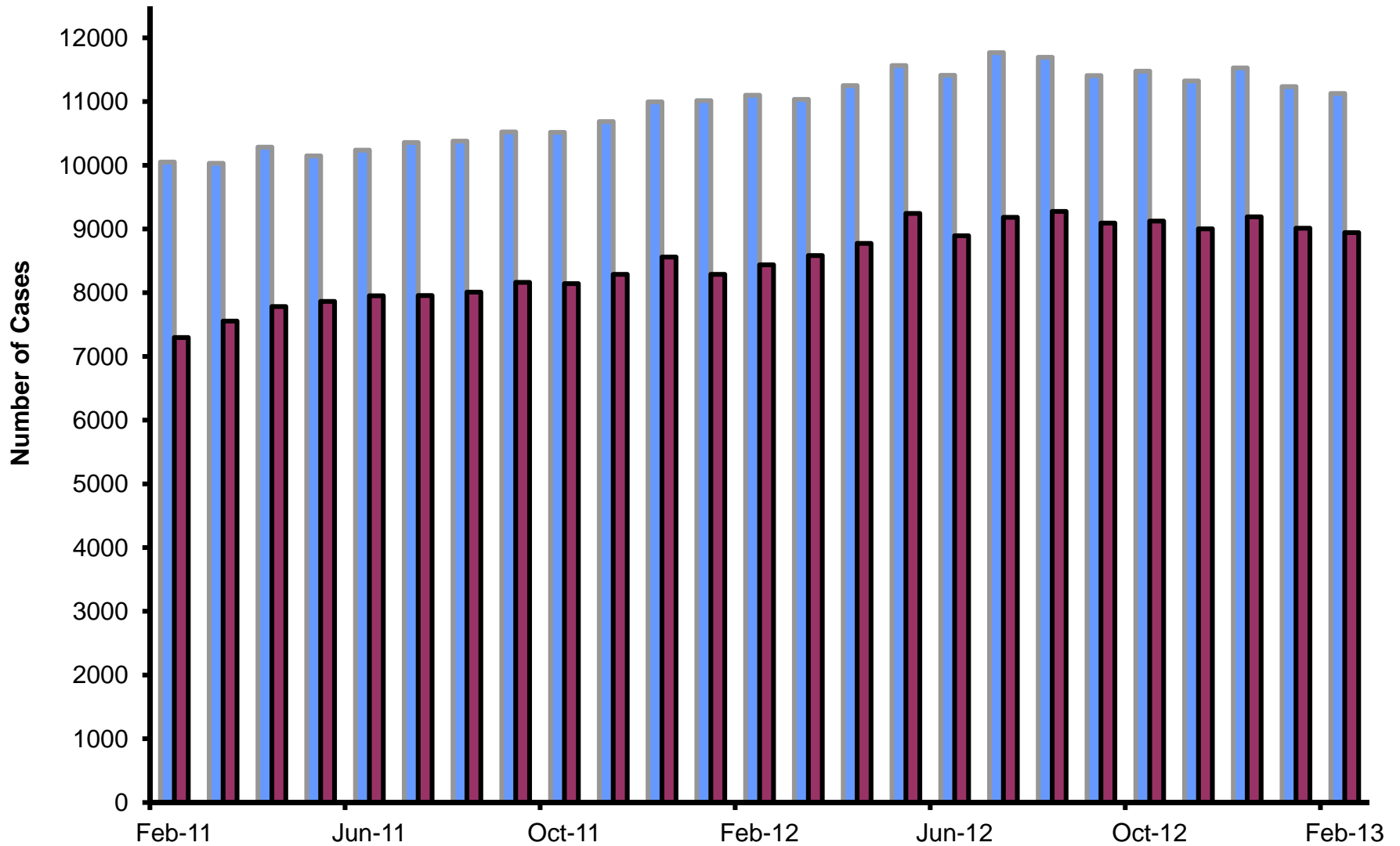

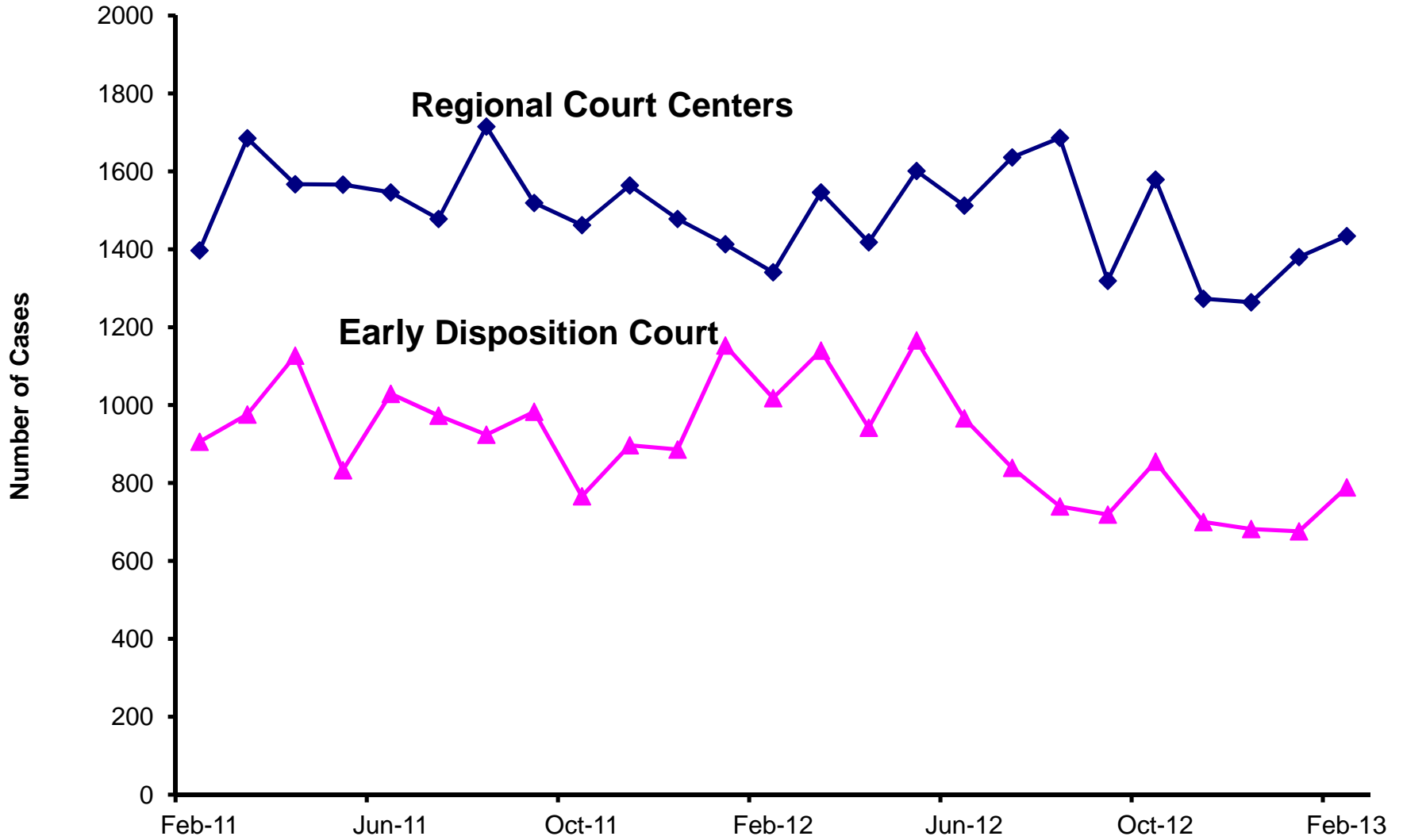


Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

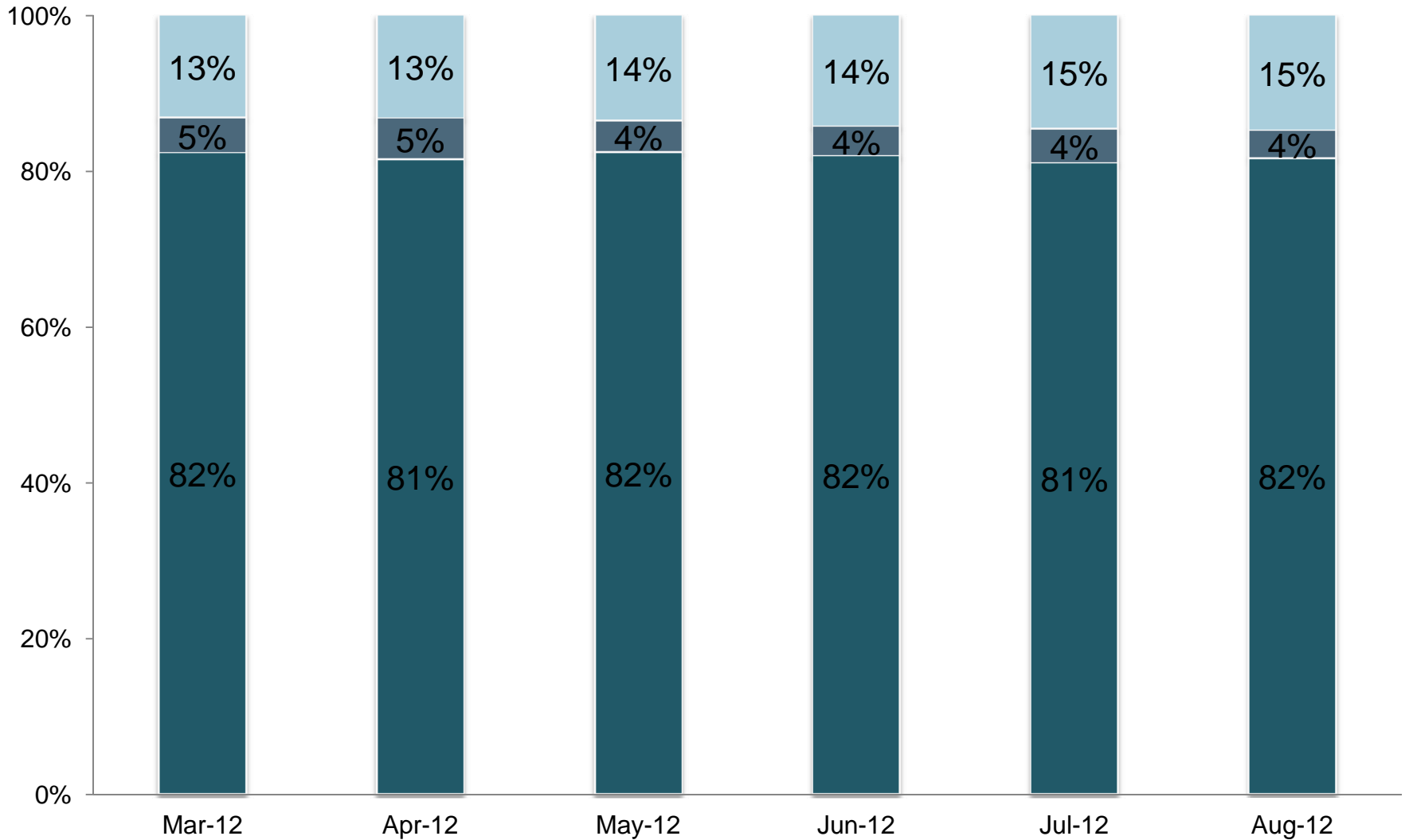


Direct Complaints into Superior Court

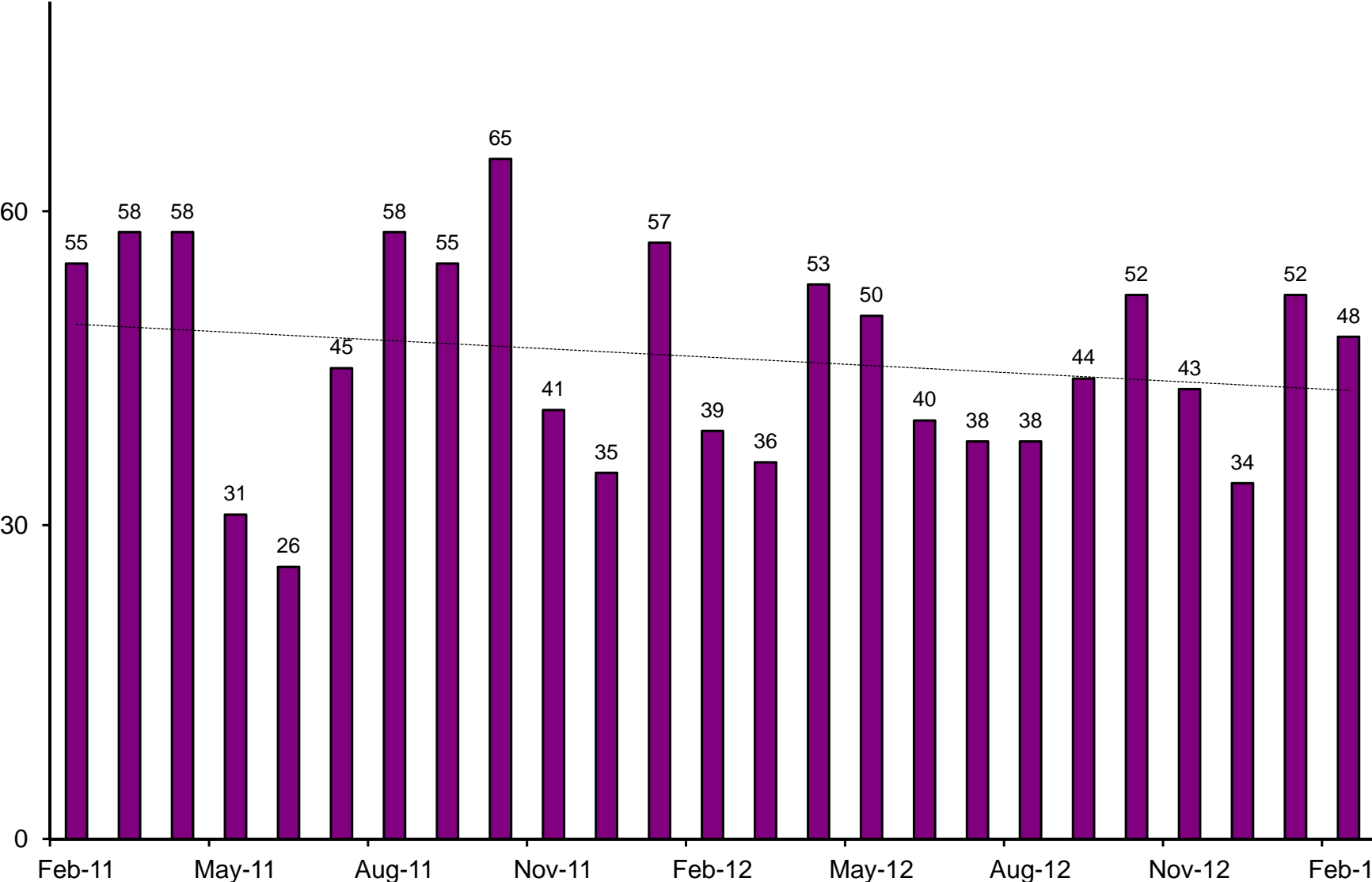


Status of Cases After 180 Days

■ Active ■ Awaiting sentence ■ Terminated

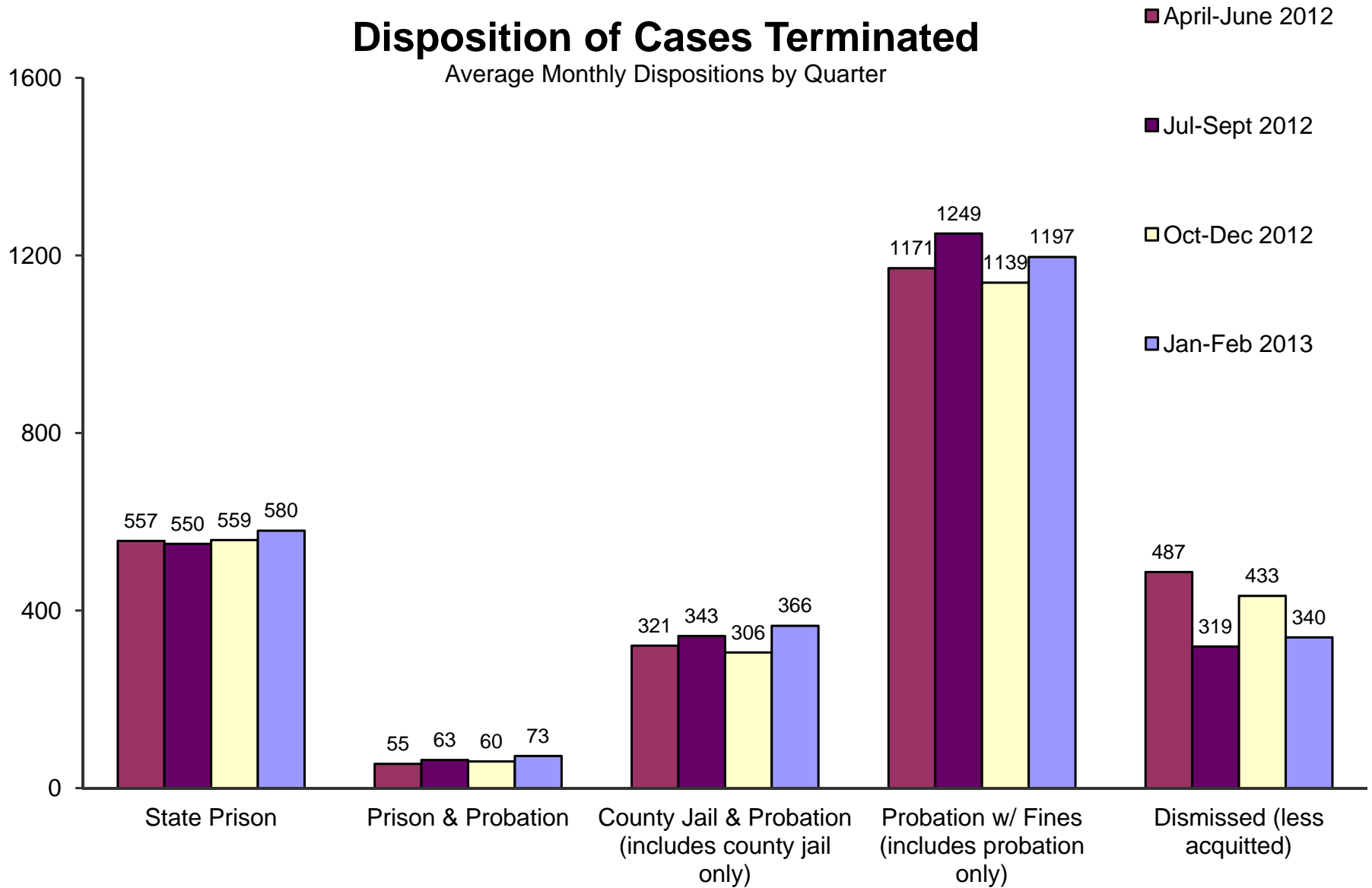


Superior Court Trials Completed

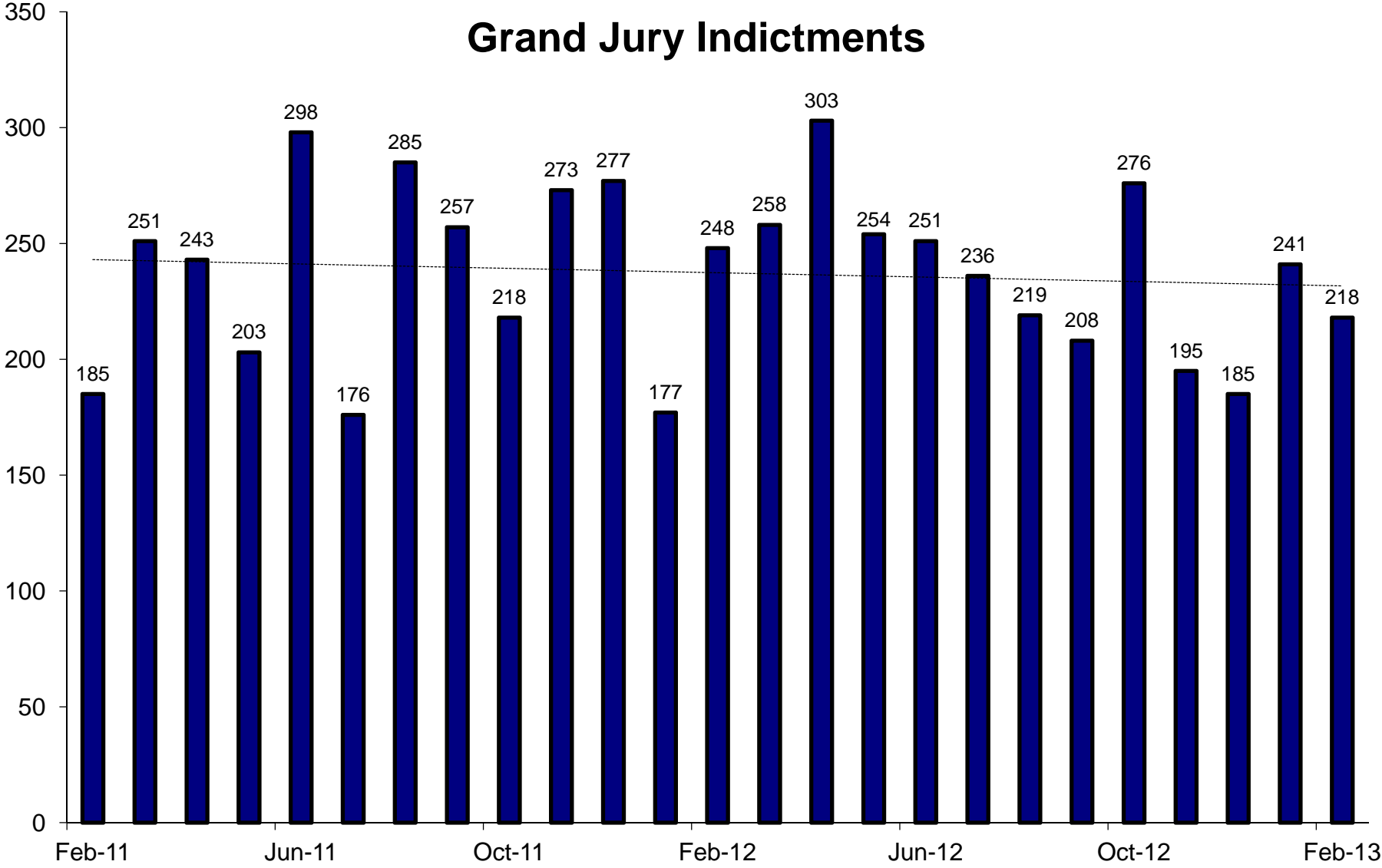


Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average Monthly Dispositions by Quarter

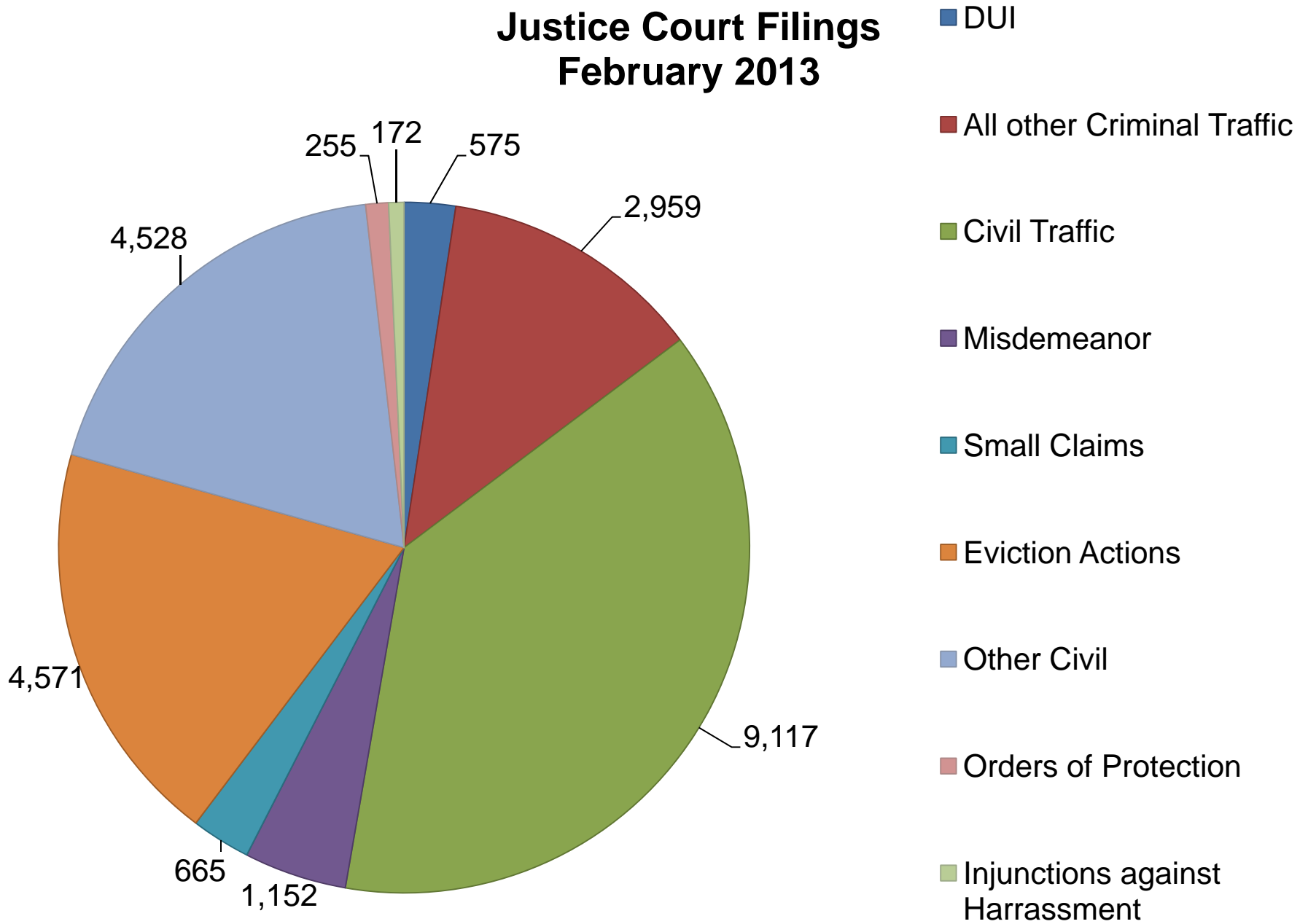


Grand Jury Indictments

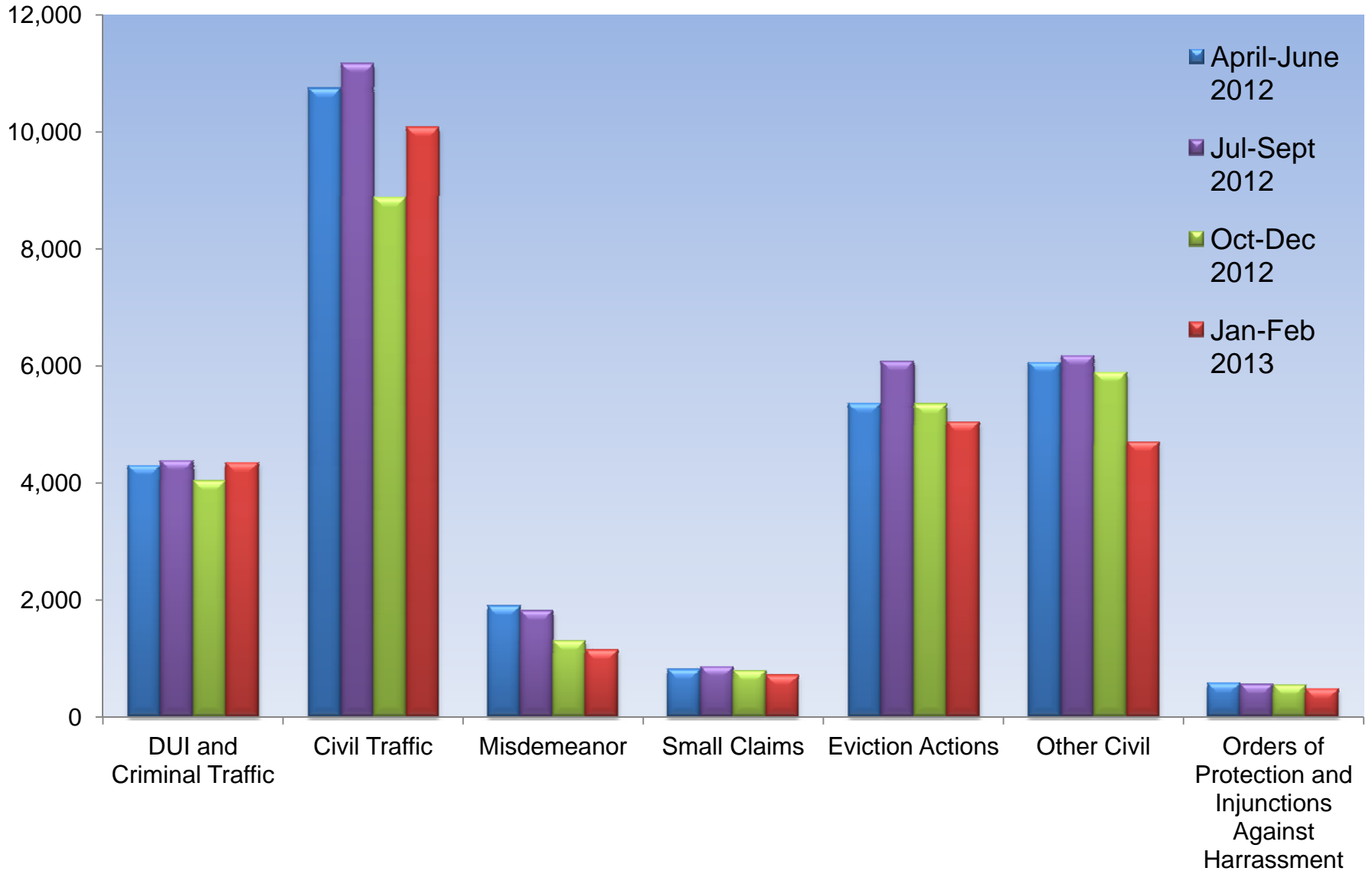

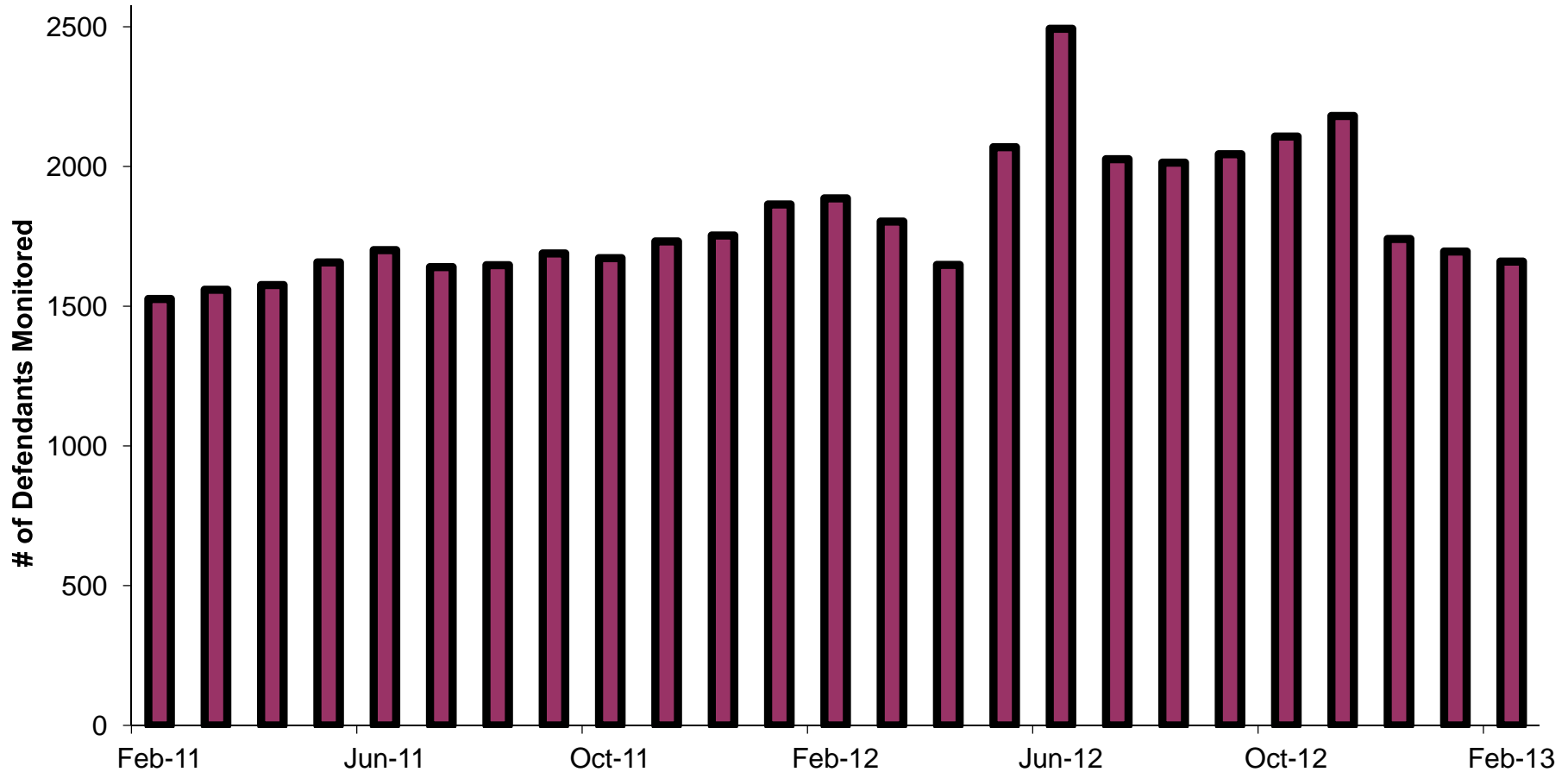
Justice Court Filings February 2013



Justice Court Monthly Filings- Quarterly Average

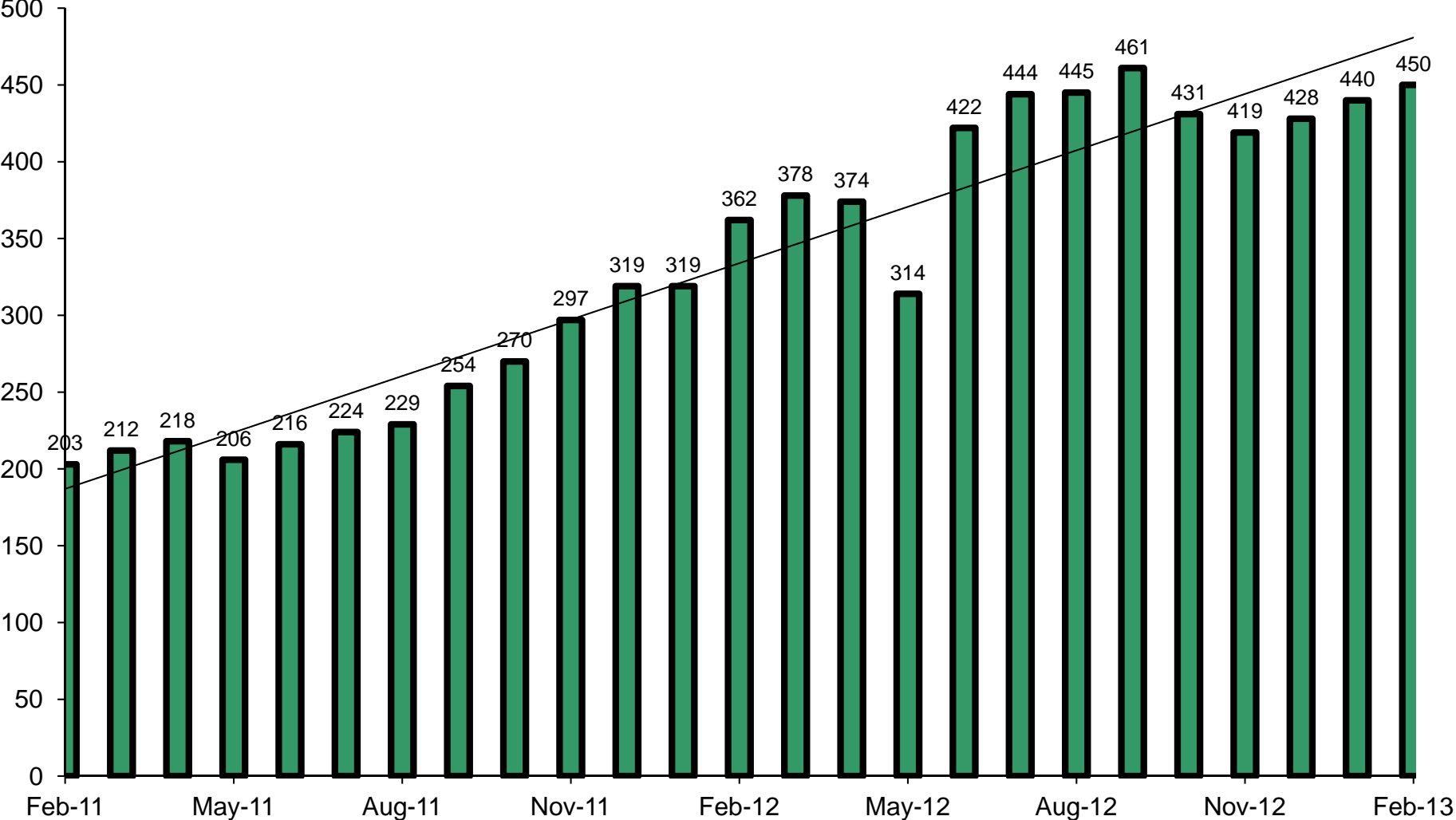


Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit Average Daily Standard Caseload

Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring

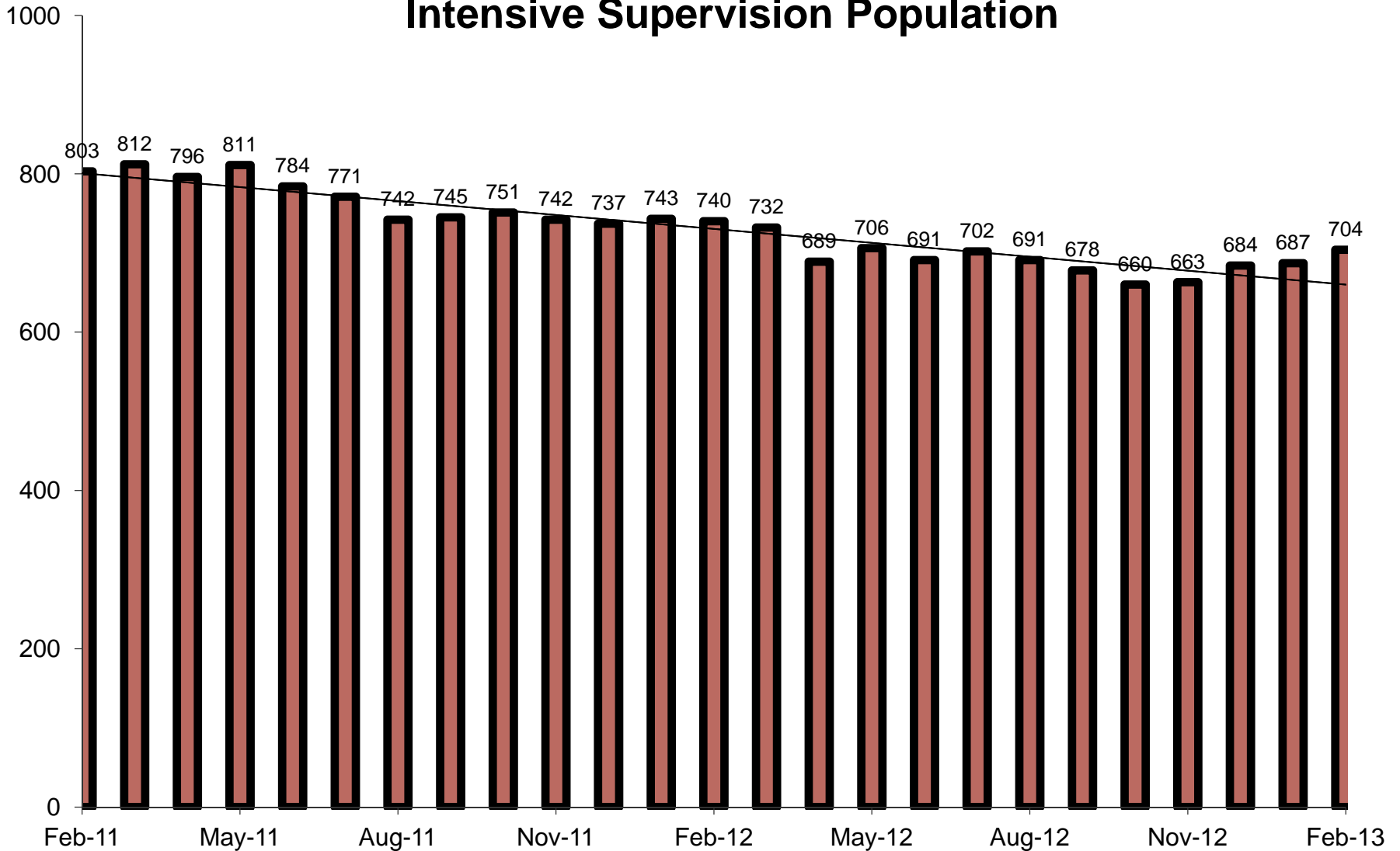


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

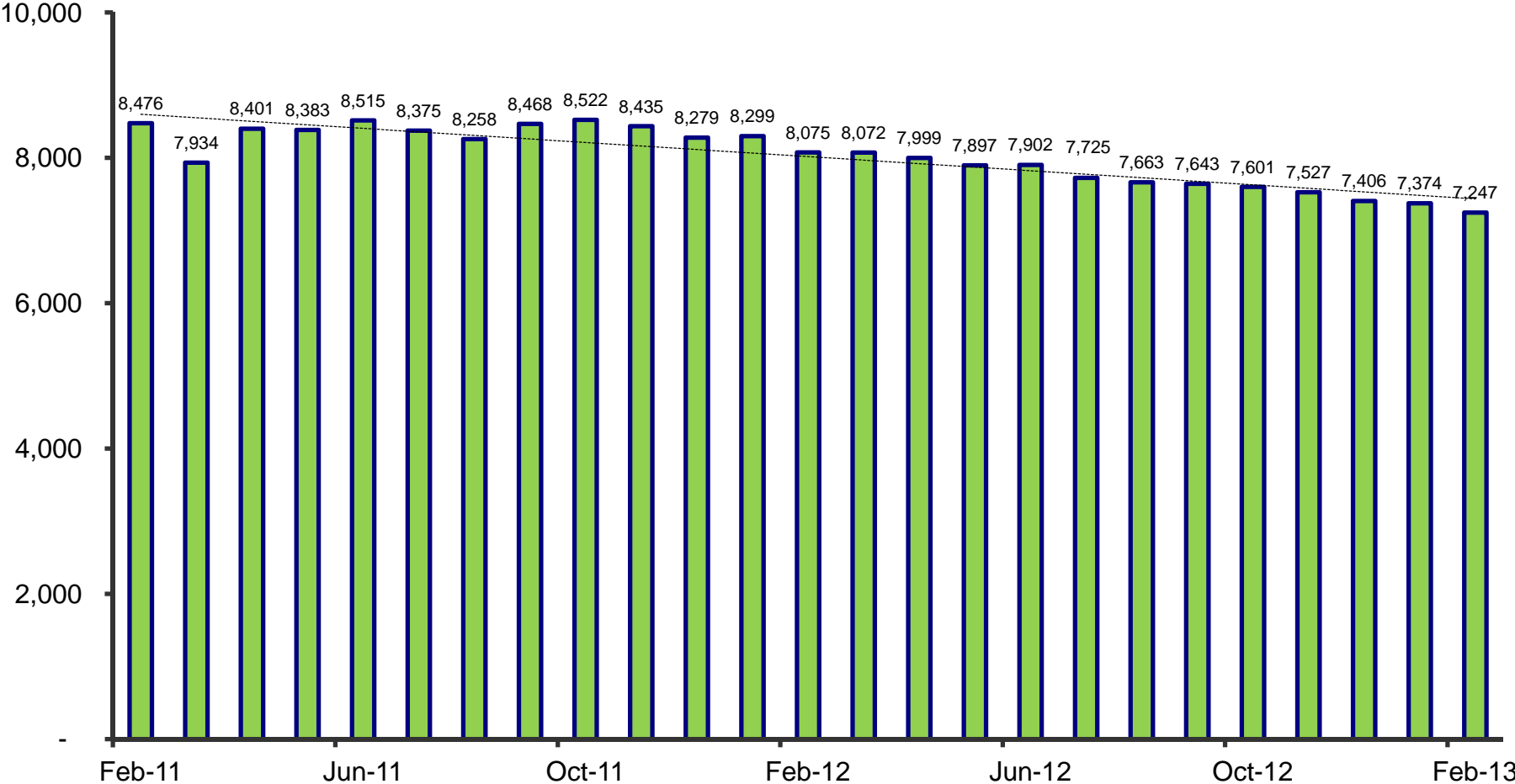

Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population

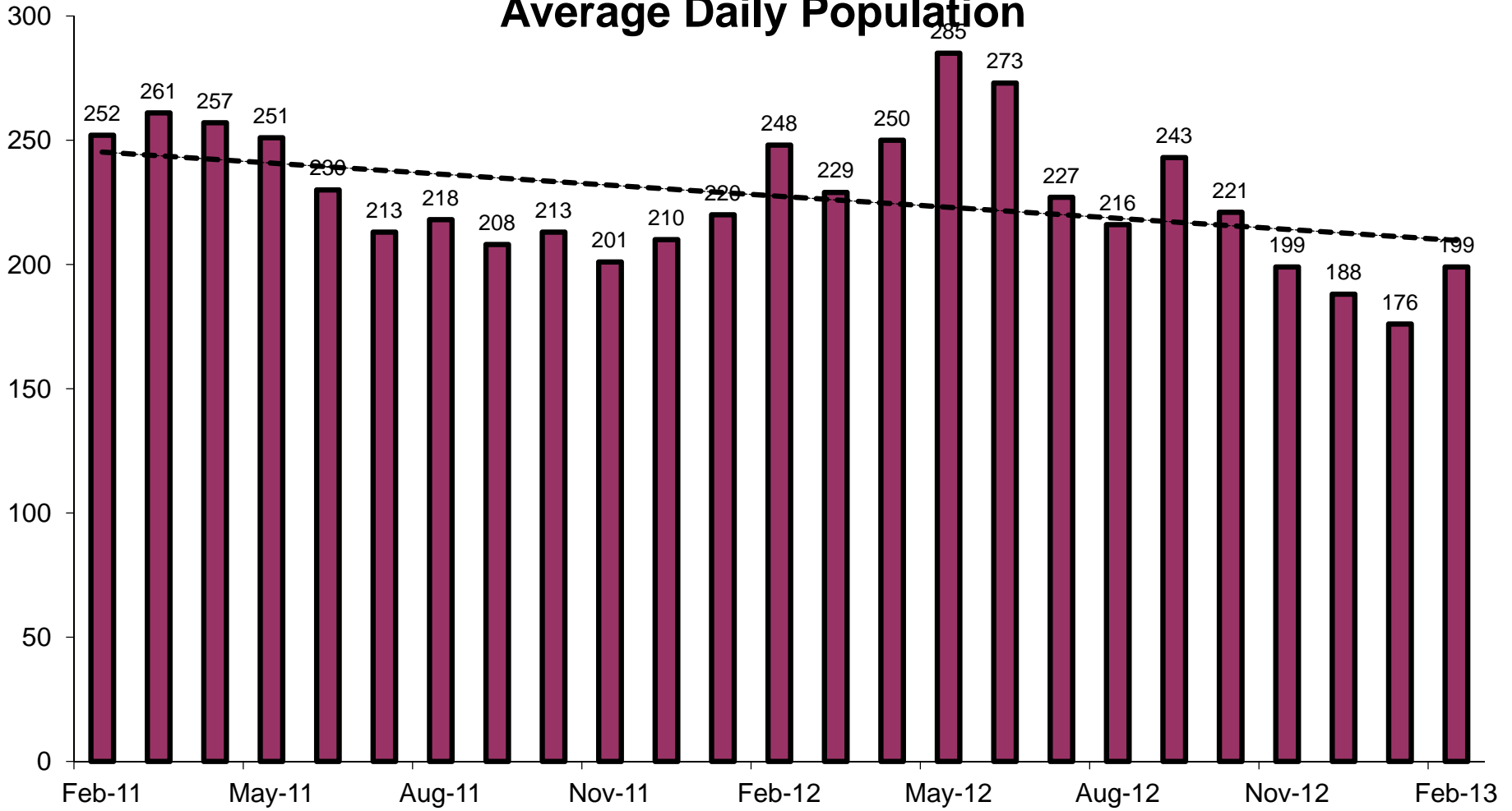


Adult Probation Unsupervised Population

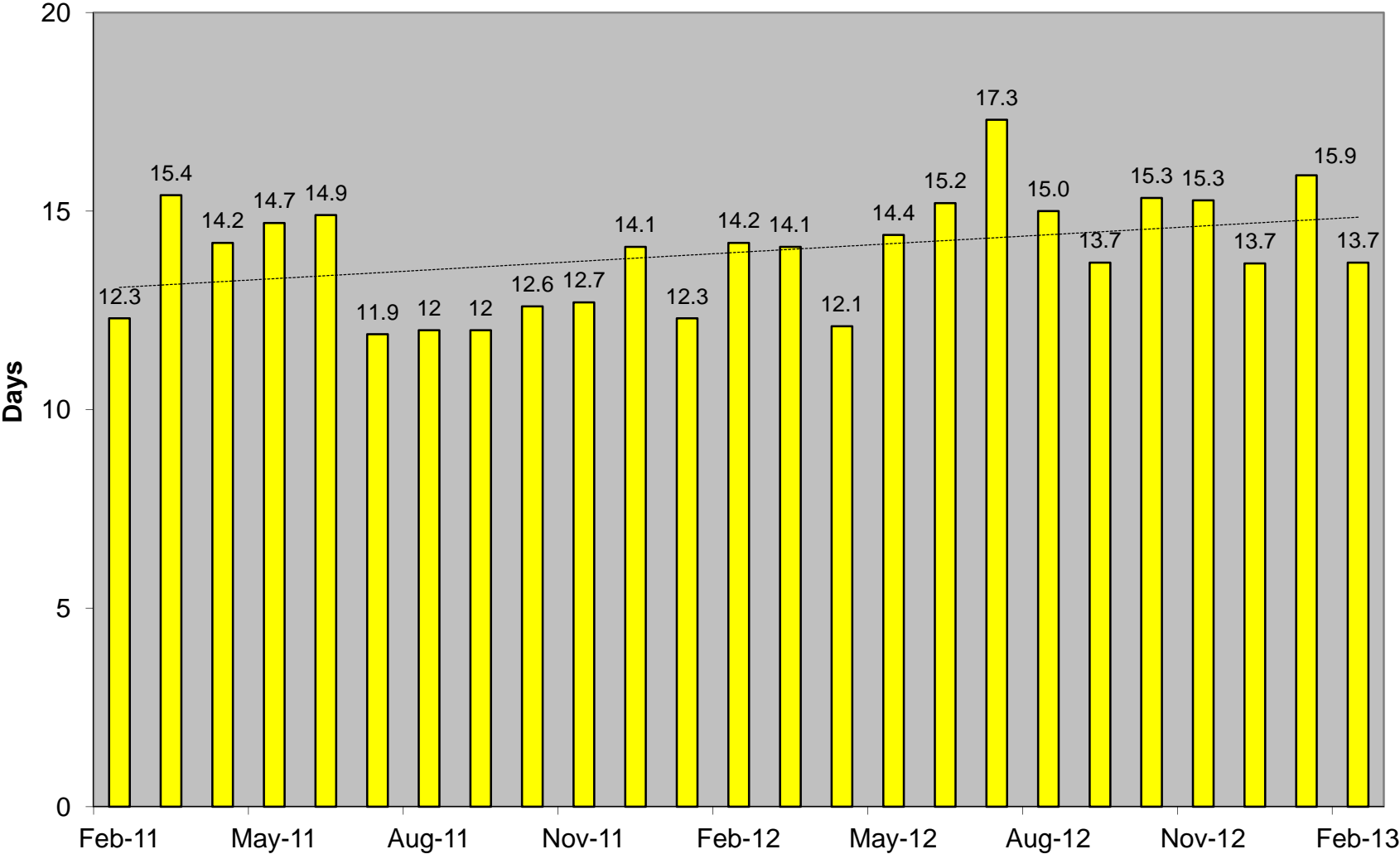
