CRIMINAL JUSTICE SYSTEM NEWS – JUNE 2007

Adult Incarceration

Bookings increased from May's 11,342 to June's 11,470 (the most bookings ever). **Releases increased slightly**, from 11,168 to 11,181. The **Average Daily Population increased** from 9,264 to 9,532. However, comparing FY06 to FY07, ADP is down 8.1%. The **pretrial population increased** in June (6,446) compared to May (6,162); this is the largest pretrial population since November 2005 (6,508). The percentage of pretrial inmates compared to sentenced and agency holds has been increasing and was at 68% in June, the highest ever. The **sentenced and agency hold populations declined**: sentenced from 2,703 to 2,689 and agency holds from 352 to 342.

Overall ALOS decreased from 25.3 to 24.9 days. Comparing FY06 to FY07, ALOS is down 9.9%. **The ALOS for sentenced and agency holds decreased**: sentenced from 26.0 to 24.8 days (the lowest sentenced ALOS since April 2004 – 22.3 days) and agency holds from 61.1 to 57.9 days (the lowest agency hold ALOS since August 2003 – 57.2 days). **Pretrial ALOS increased** from 6.2 to 9.0 days; this is the highest pretrial ALOS since February 2006 (9.3 days).

Transportation numbers for Superior Court inmates fell from May's high of 14,519 to June's 13,960. However, this is still an increase over the average 12,182 inmates transported each month the first five months of 2007.

Superior Court Filings & Case Processing

Criminal filings decreased from May's all-time high of 3,802 to June's 3,735. **Terminations increased** from 2,828 to 2,996. The resulting clearance rate was 80.2%. **The active pending case inventory increased**, as it has every month since January, from 10,905 in May to 11,107 in June (most since December 2005 – 11,132). **Filings into RCC and EDC decreased in June compared to May**: RCC filings from 2,375 to 2,350, EDC filings from 1,217 to 1,122. **The number of trials decreased** from 80 in May to 68 in June. **The trial rate also decreased**, from 2.1% to 1.8%.

Comparing FY06 to FY07 data, criminal filings actually fell 1.0%. However, Maricopa County Superior Court held over 1,000 trials for the first time (1,003 in FY07 compared to 817 in FY06; the most ever was 922 in FY99). Additionally, the trial rate is up 23.8% when comparing the two fiscal years.

Justice Court Filings

All justice court filings, except for forcible detainers, decreased slightly from May to June. Forcible detainers increased from 5,233 to 5,679. Overall, June's total filings were 34,380 compared to May's 37,564.

Adult Probation

Pretrial general and intensive supervision increased from May to June: general from 624 to 696; intensive from 951 to 1,028. **Electronic monitoring decreased** slightly from 244 to 242. Comparing FY06 to FY07, levels of general supervision decreased 3.5%; levels of intensive supervision remained the same; and levels of electronic monitoring increased 27.4%.

Levels of standard probation supervision increased from 30,197 to 30,226 while **levels of intensive probation supervision remained nearly the same** at 1,179. Comparing FY06 to FY07, standard probation supervision levels increased 8.0% while intensive levels decreased 4.8%.

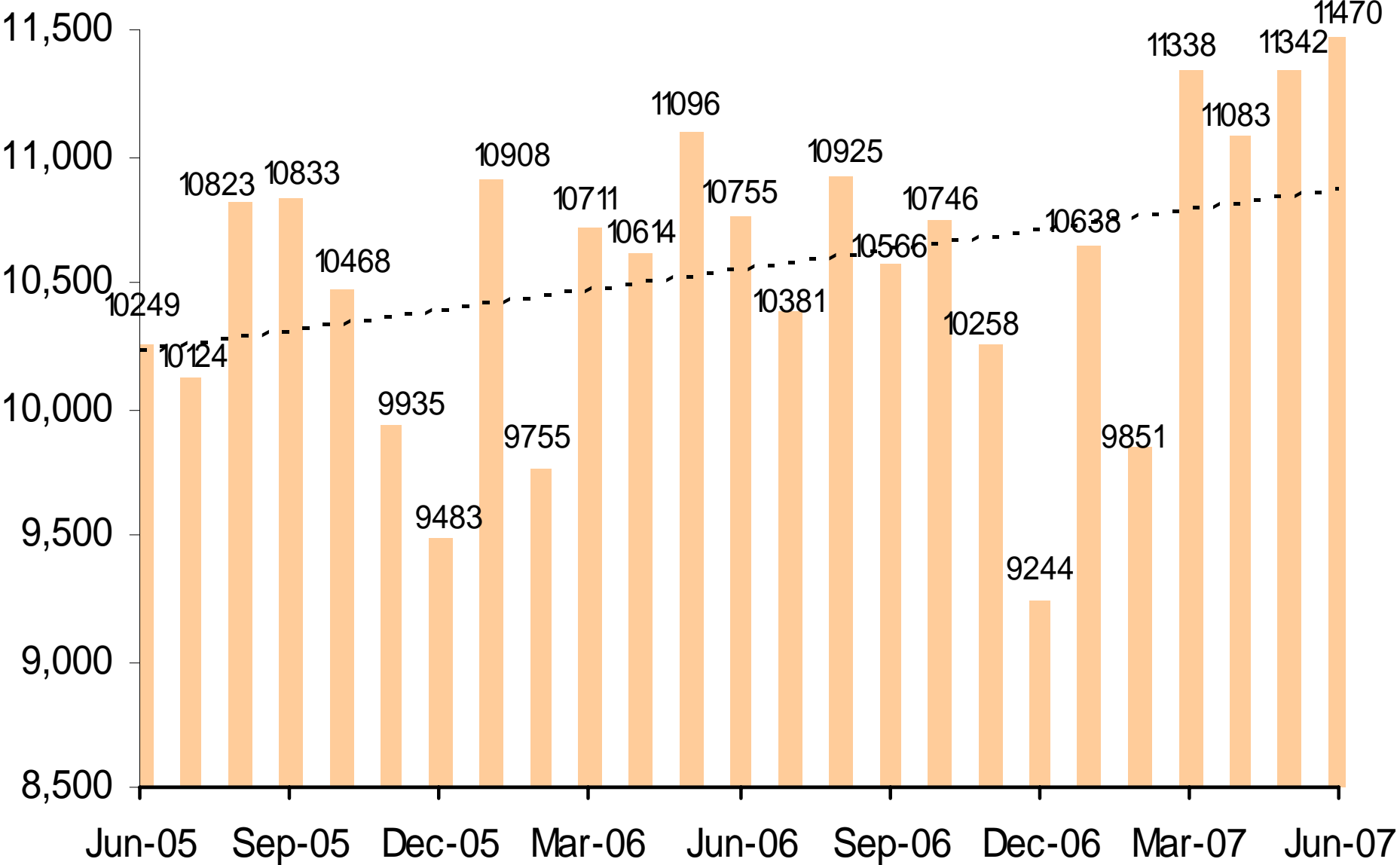
Juvenile Detention and Probation

The **Average Daily Detention Population decreased** from 395 in May to 386 in June. ADP is down 6.9% when comparing FY06 to FY07. **ALOS decreased slightly** from 15.6 to 15.3 days. ALOS is down 10.8% when comparing FY06 to FY07. **Electronic Monitoring decreased by one** to June's 159. **Home detention increased** from 262 in May to 266 in June.

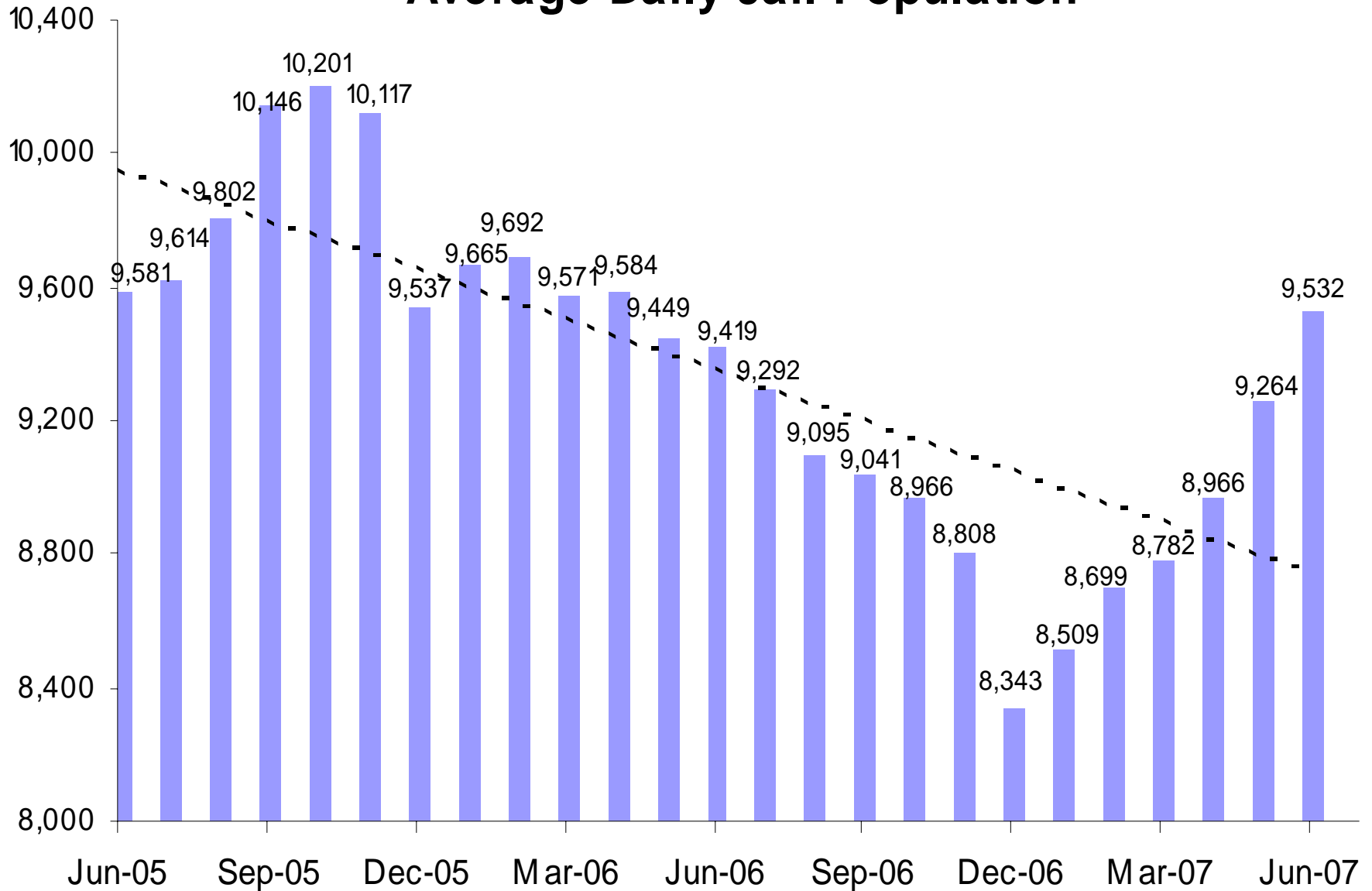
Levels of juvenile standard and intensive probation decreased: standard from 4,385 to 4,371 and intensive from 532 to 511. From FY06 to FY07, standard probation numbers increased 5.6% while intensive decreased 1.5%.

A criminal justice system-wide goal is to enhance the utility and timeliness of management information on case processing, in an effort to help agencies effectively address current events. 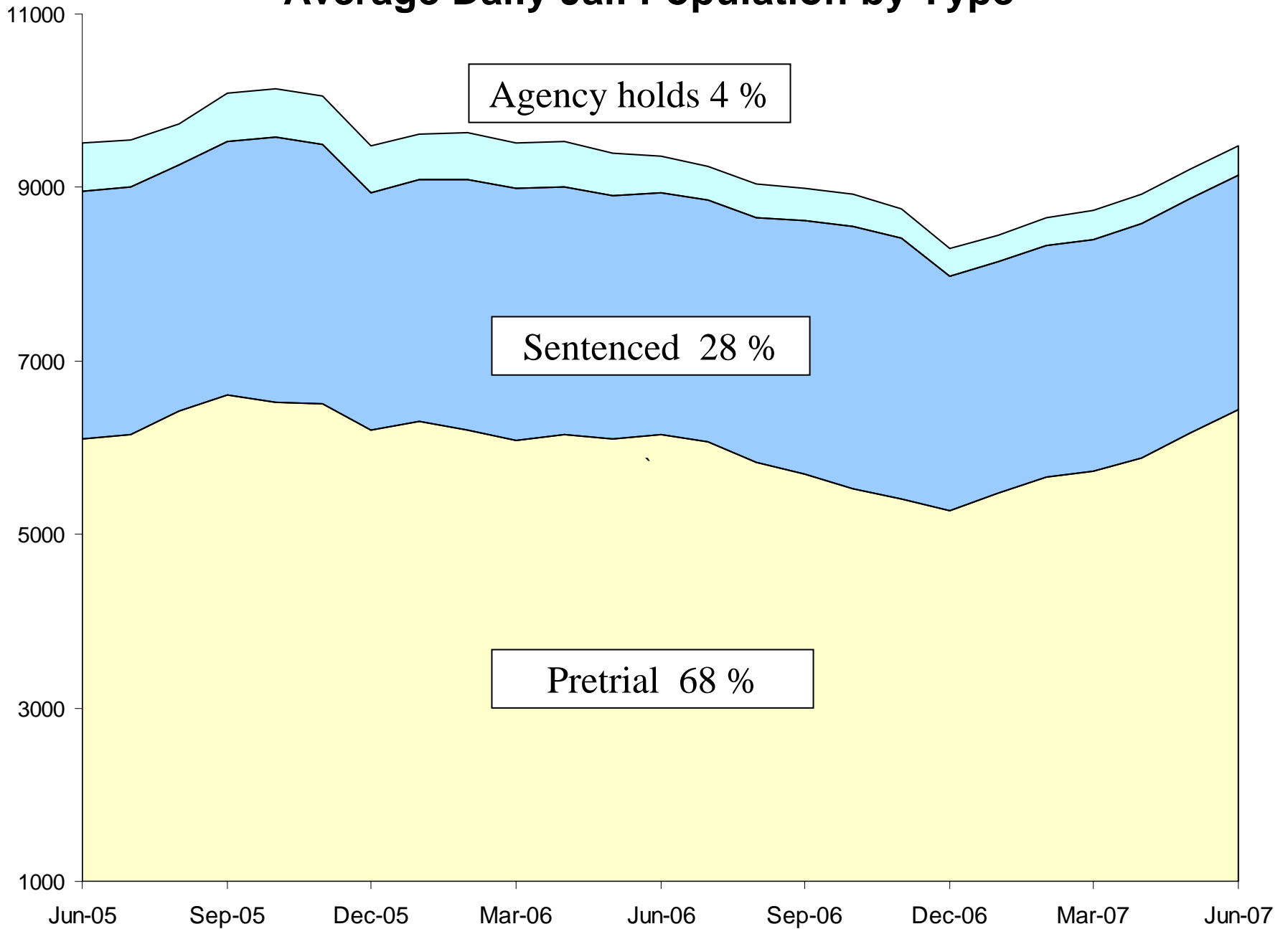
Jail Bookings



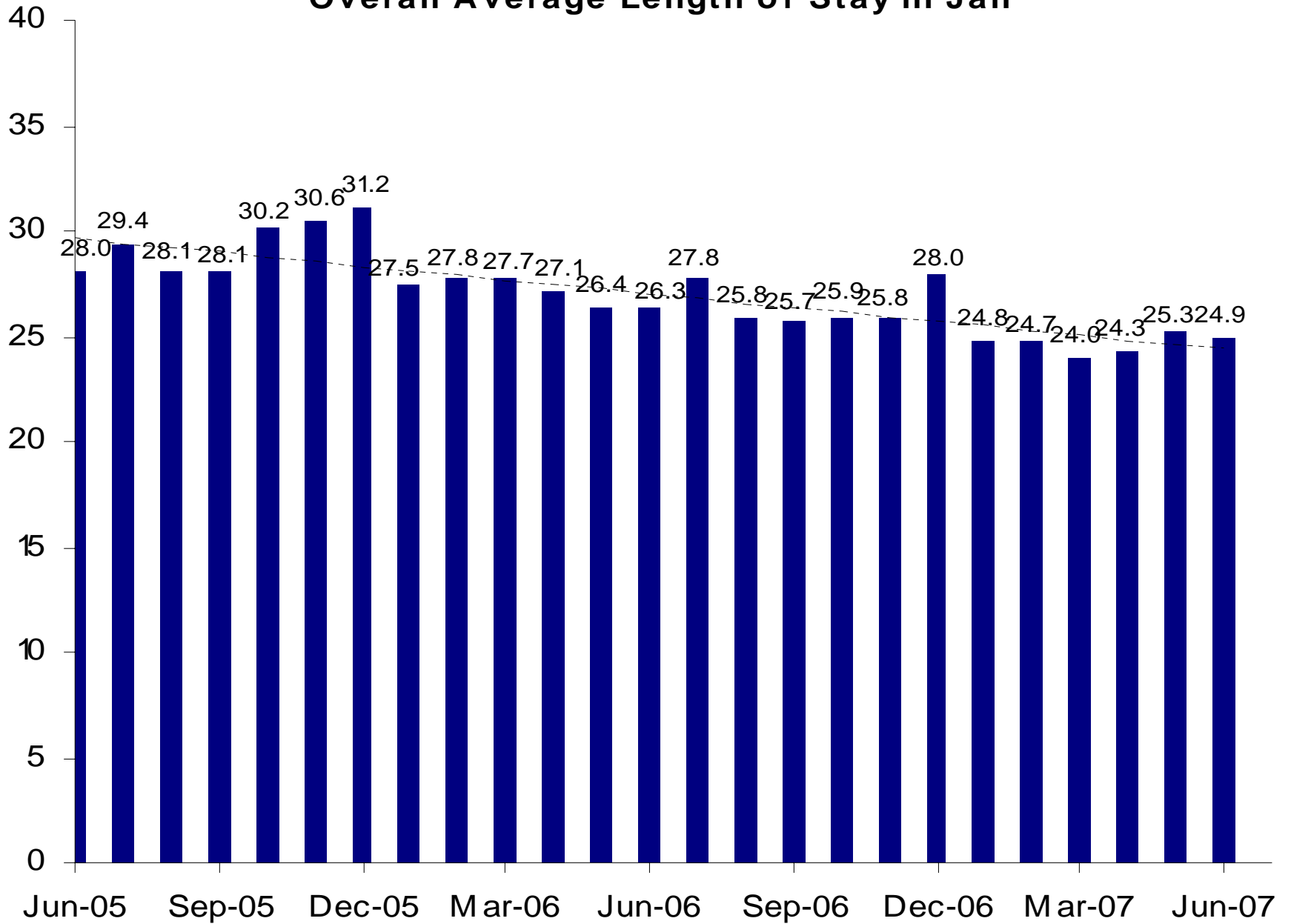
Average Daily Jail Population



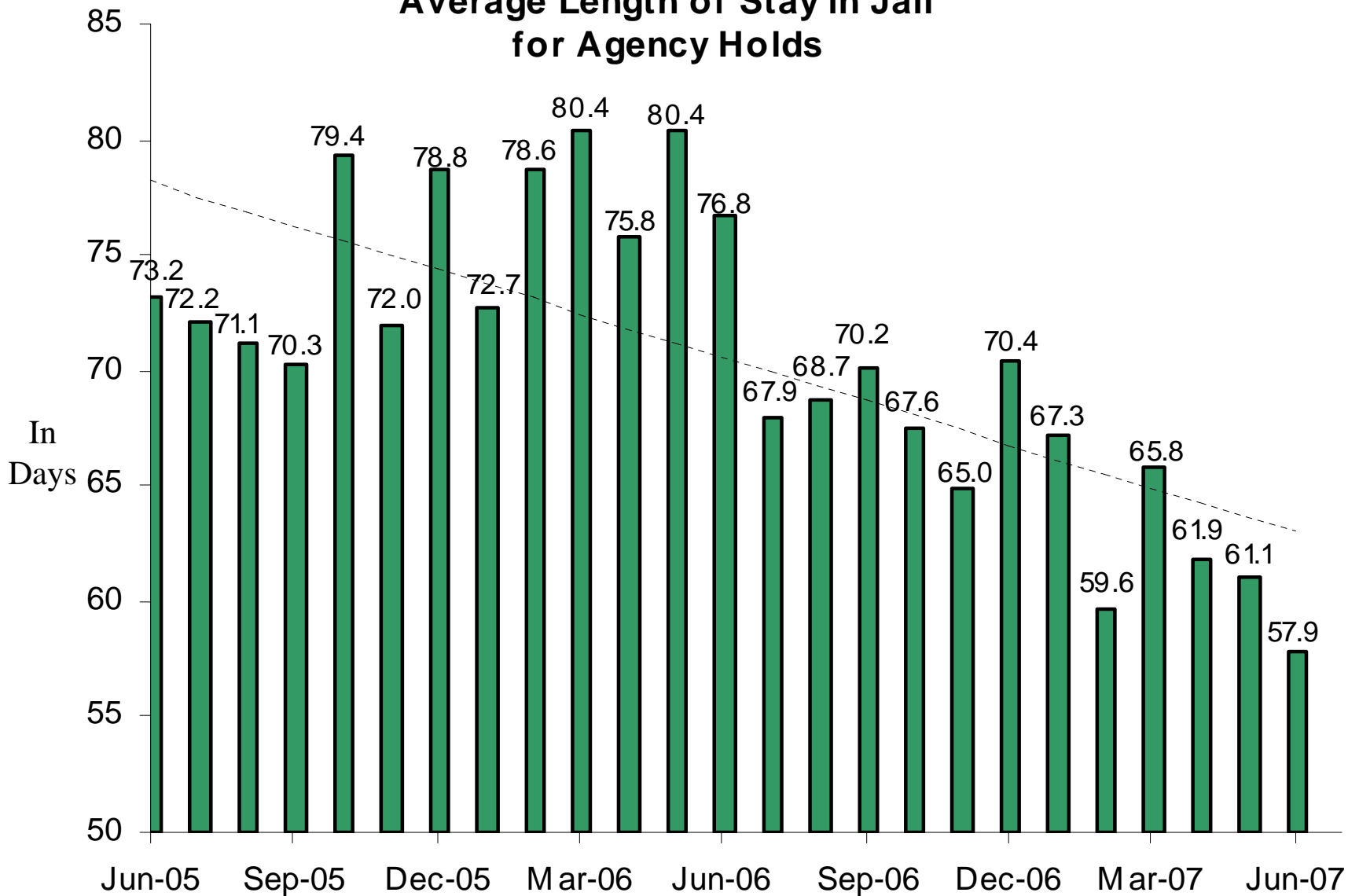
Average Daily Jail Population by Type



Overall Average Length of Stay in Jail

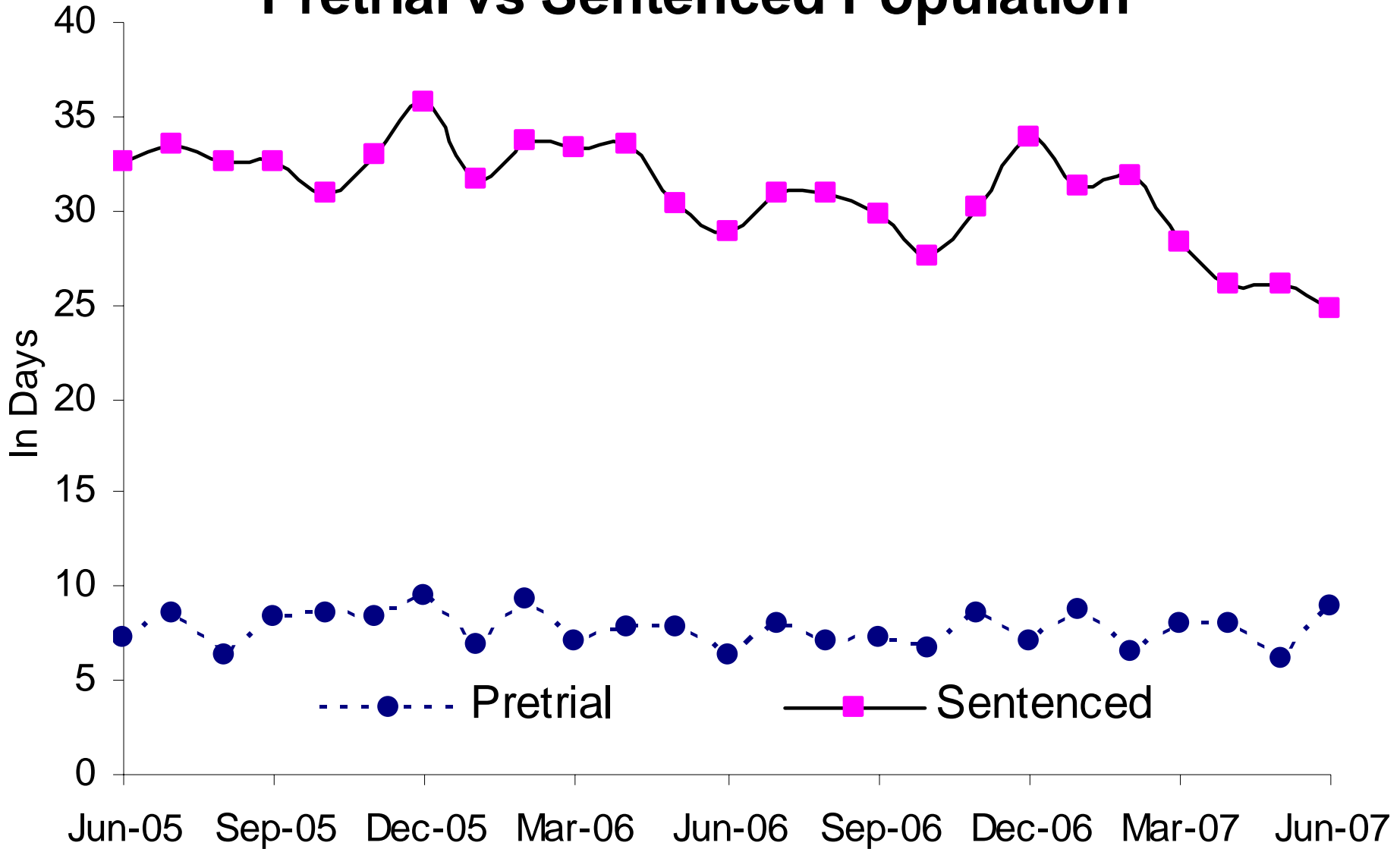


Average Length of Stay in Jail for Agency Holds

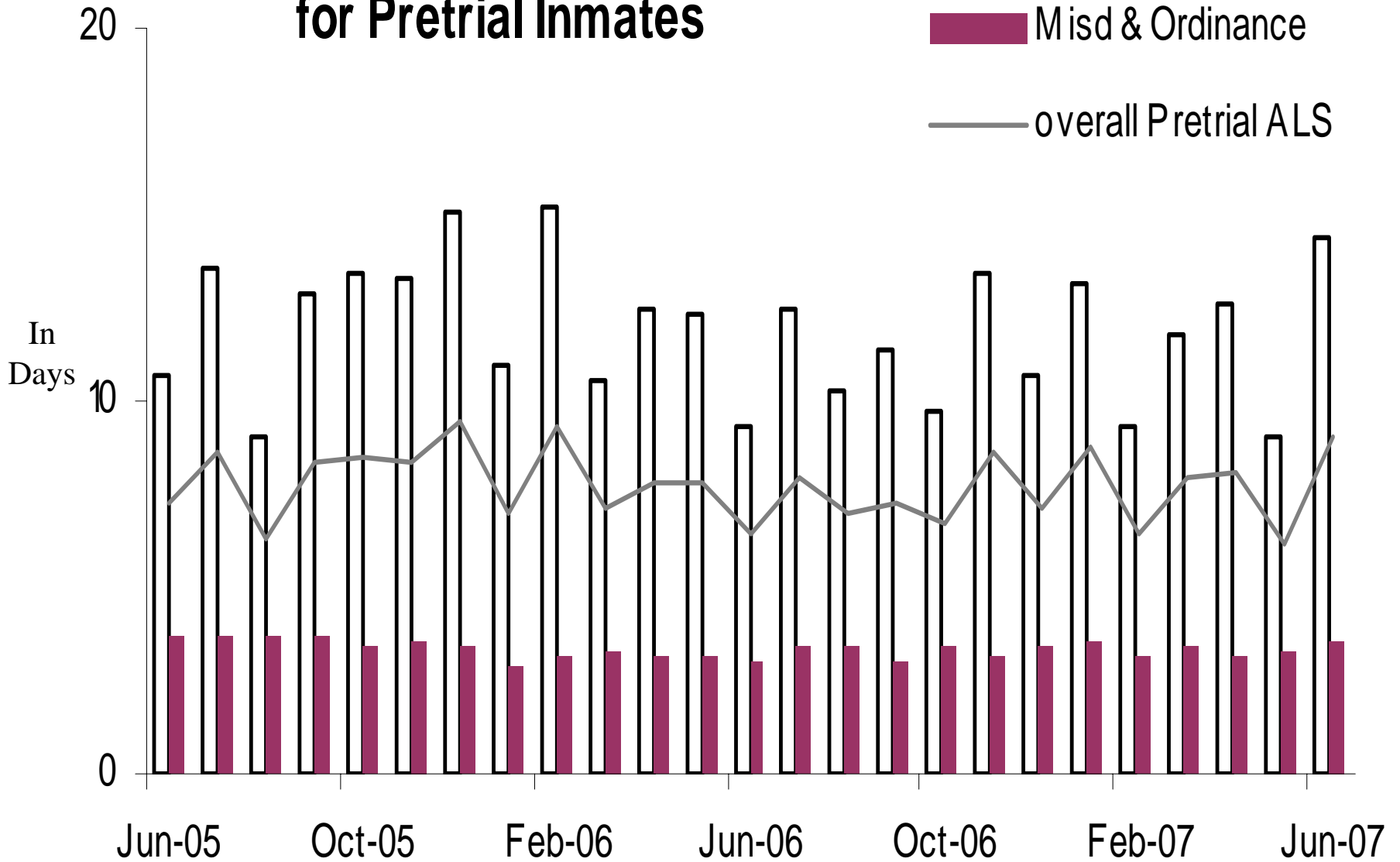

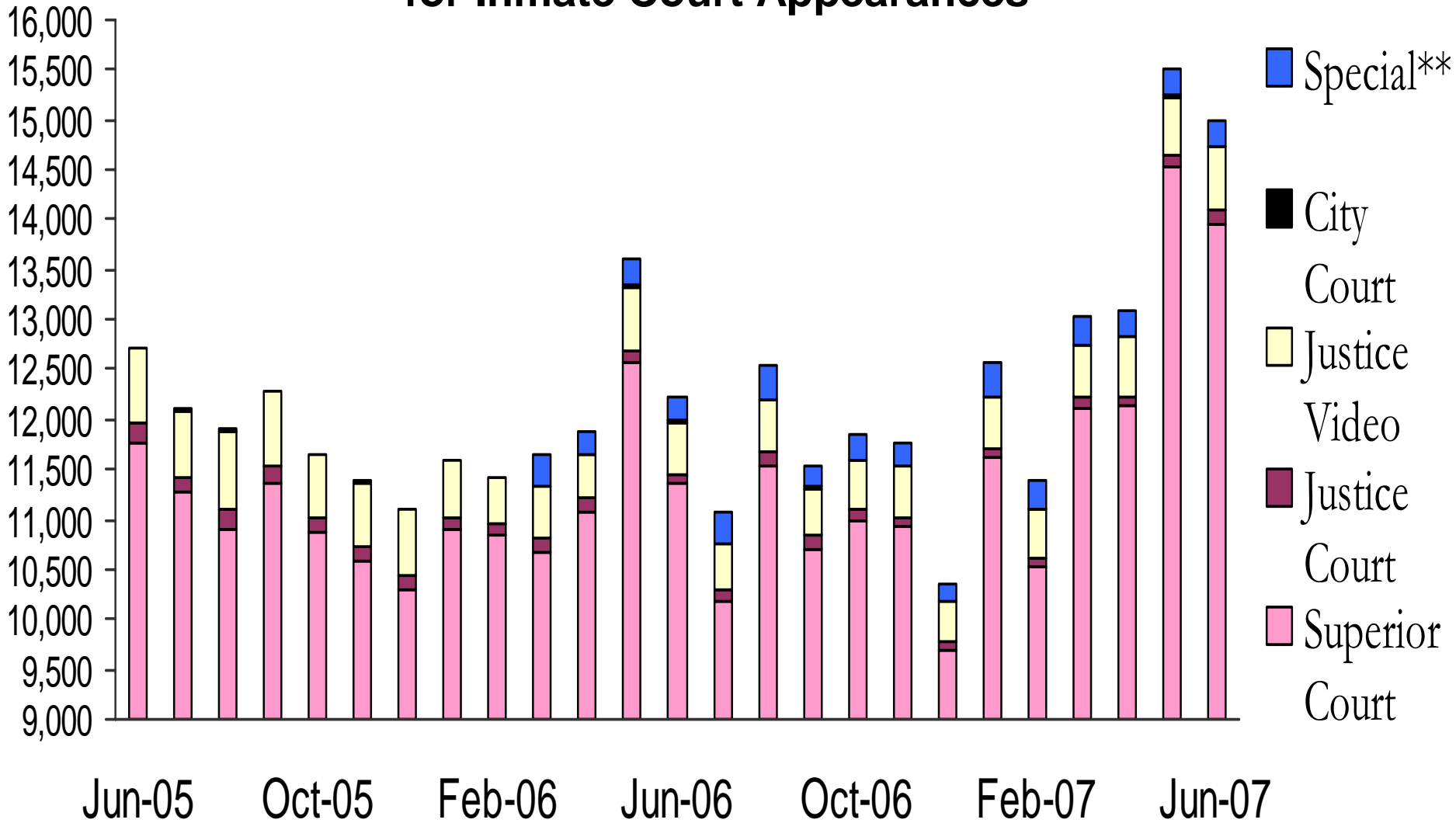
Average Length of Stay in Jail Pretrial vs Sentenced Population



Average Length of Stay in Jail for Pretrial Inmates



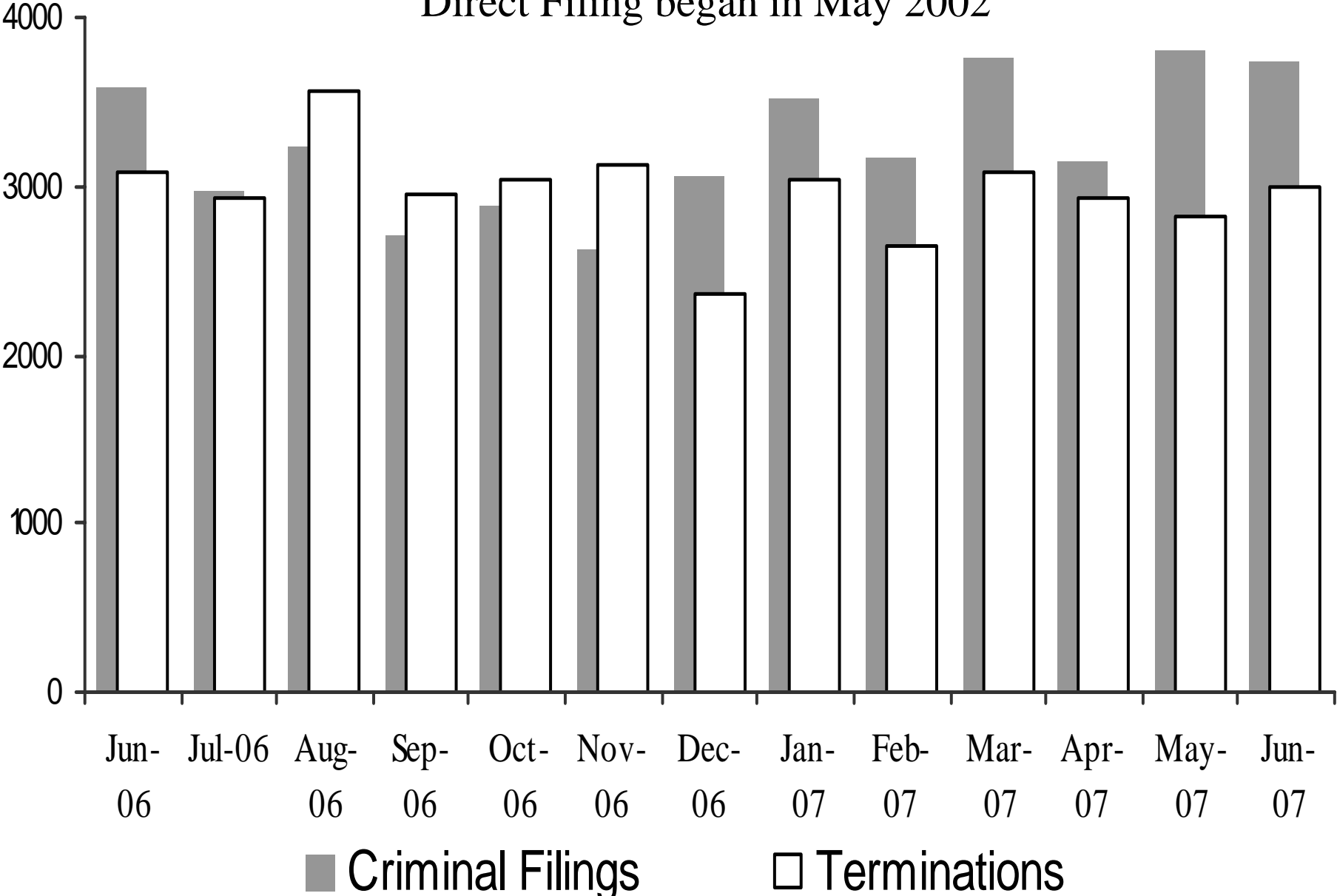
Sheriff's Office Transports for Inmate Court Appearances



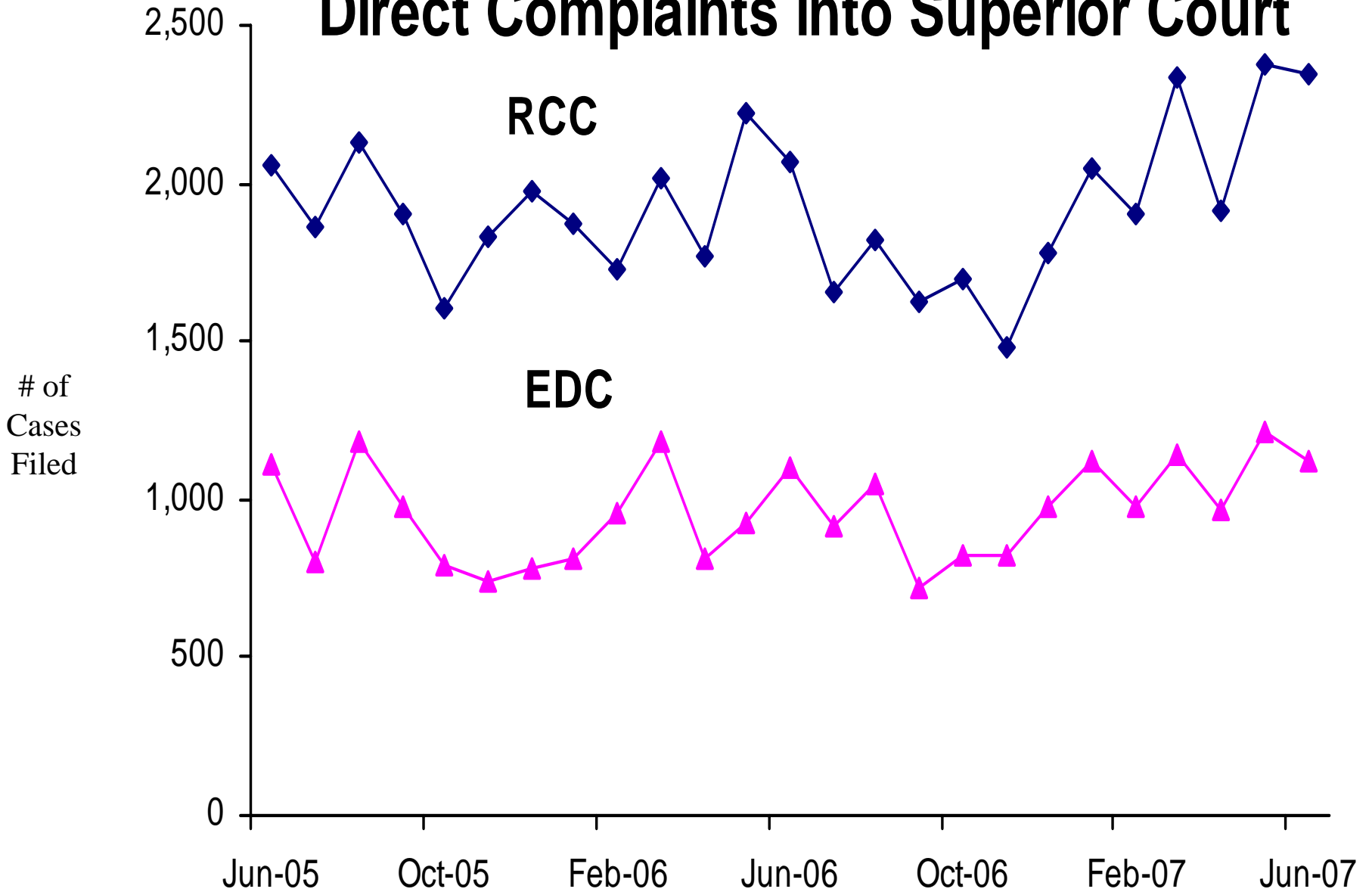

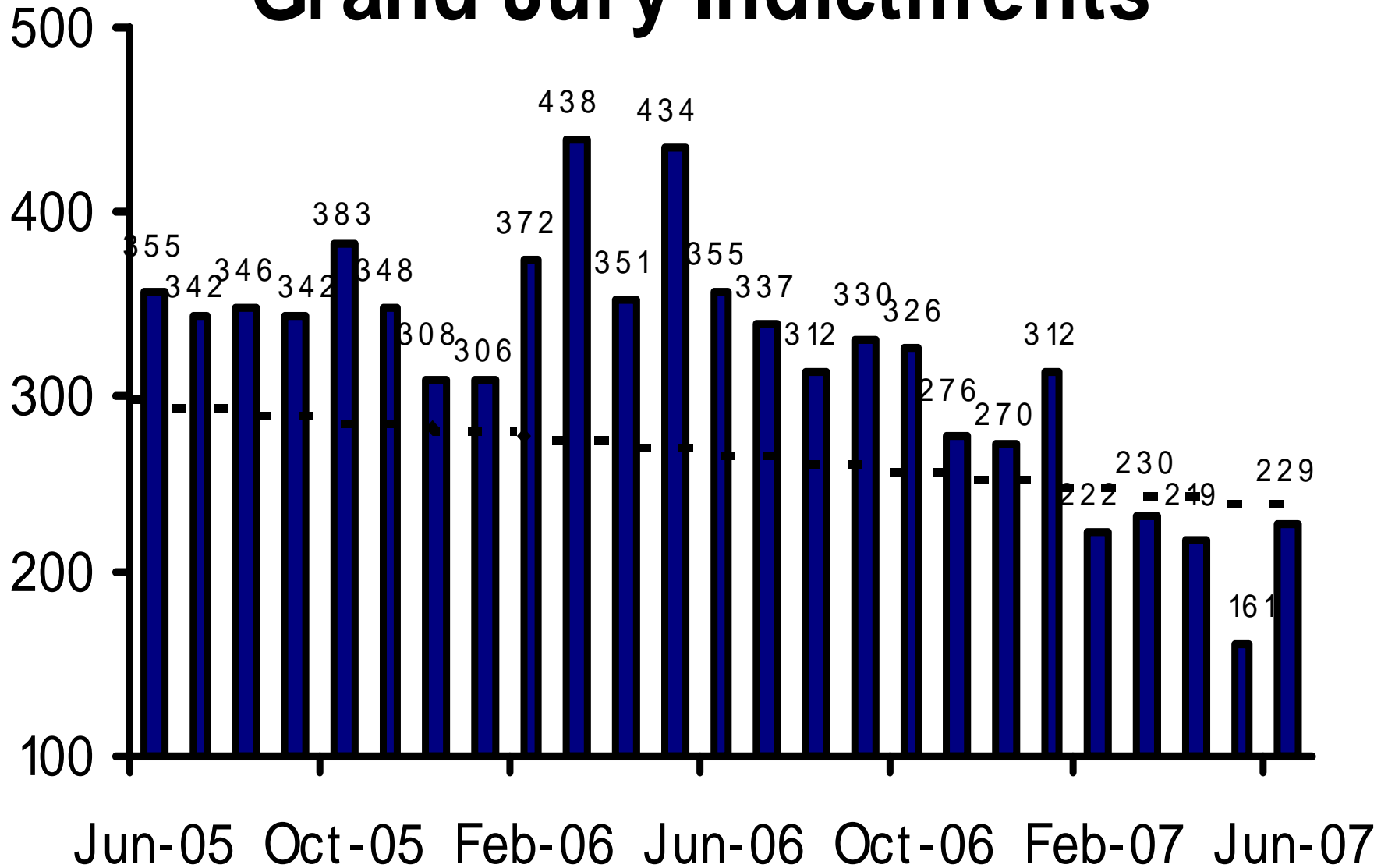
Direct Filing began in May 2002



Direct Complaints into Superior Court

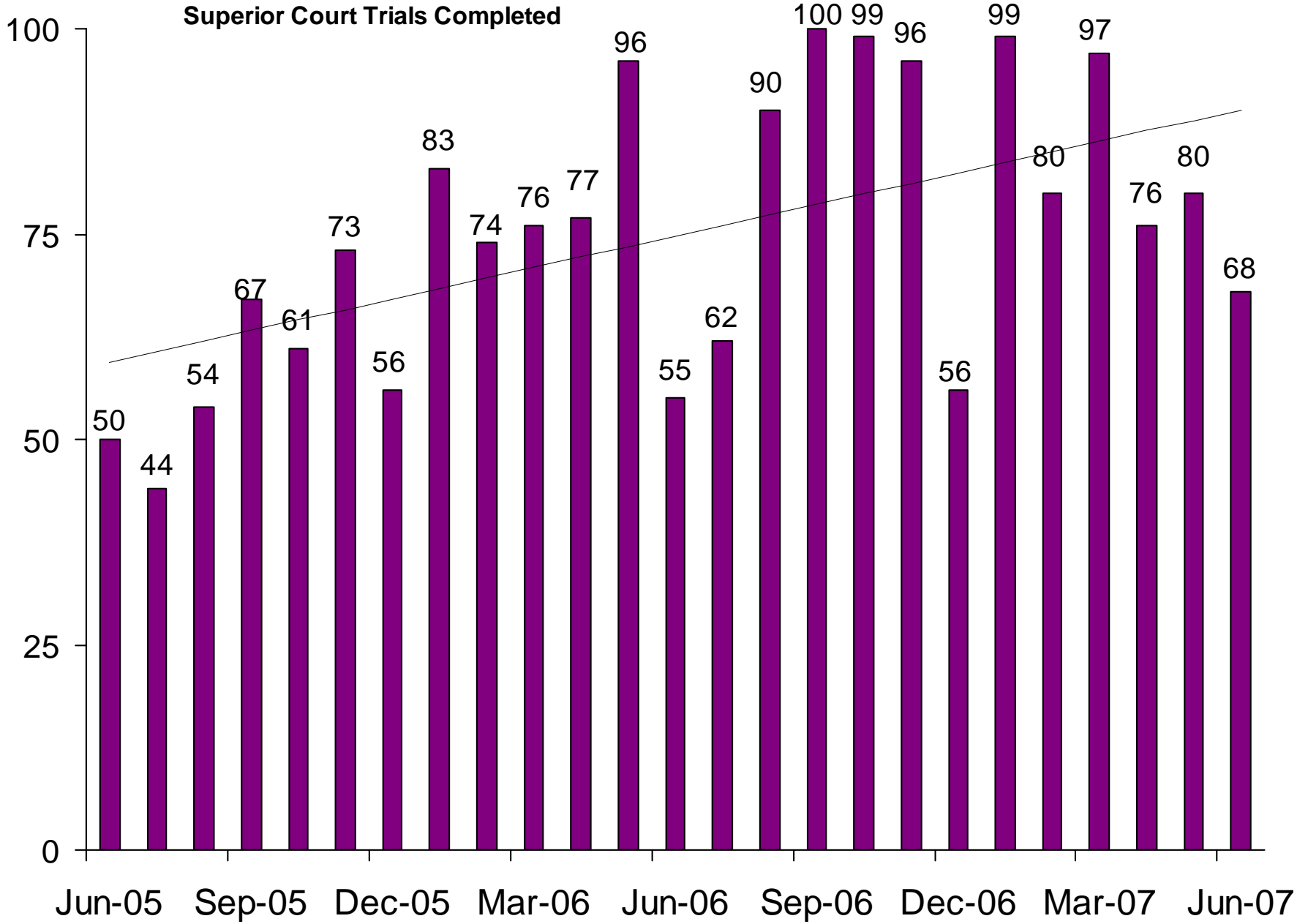


Grand Jury Indictments

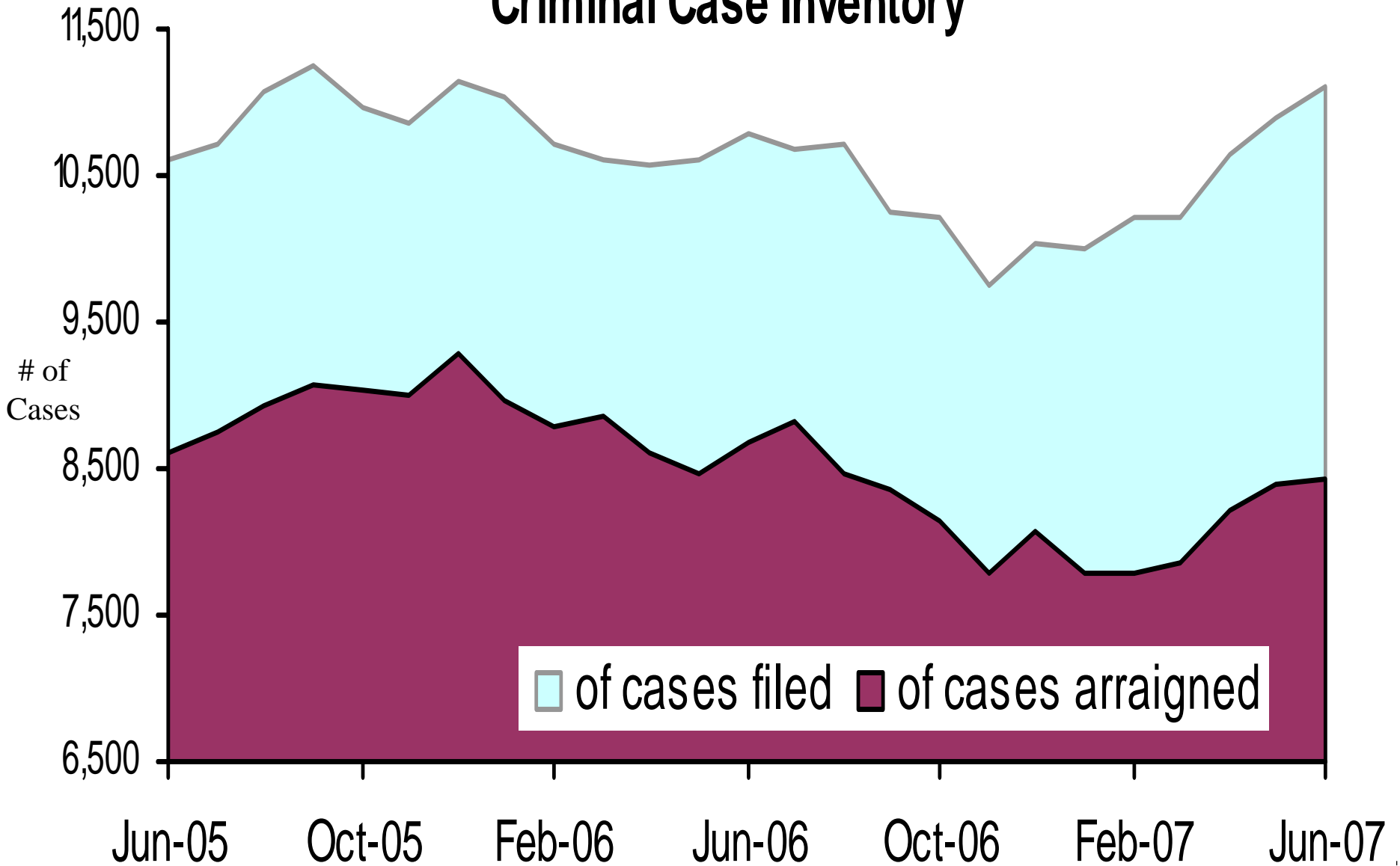

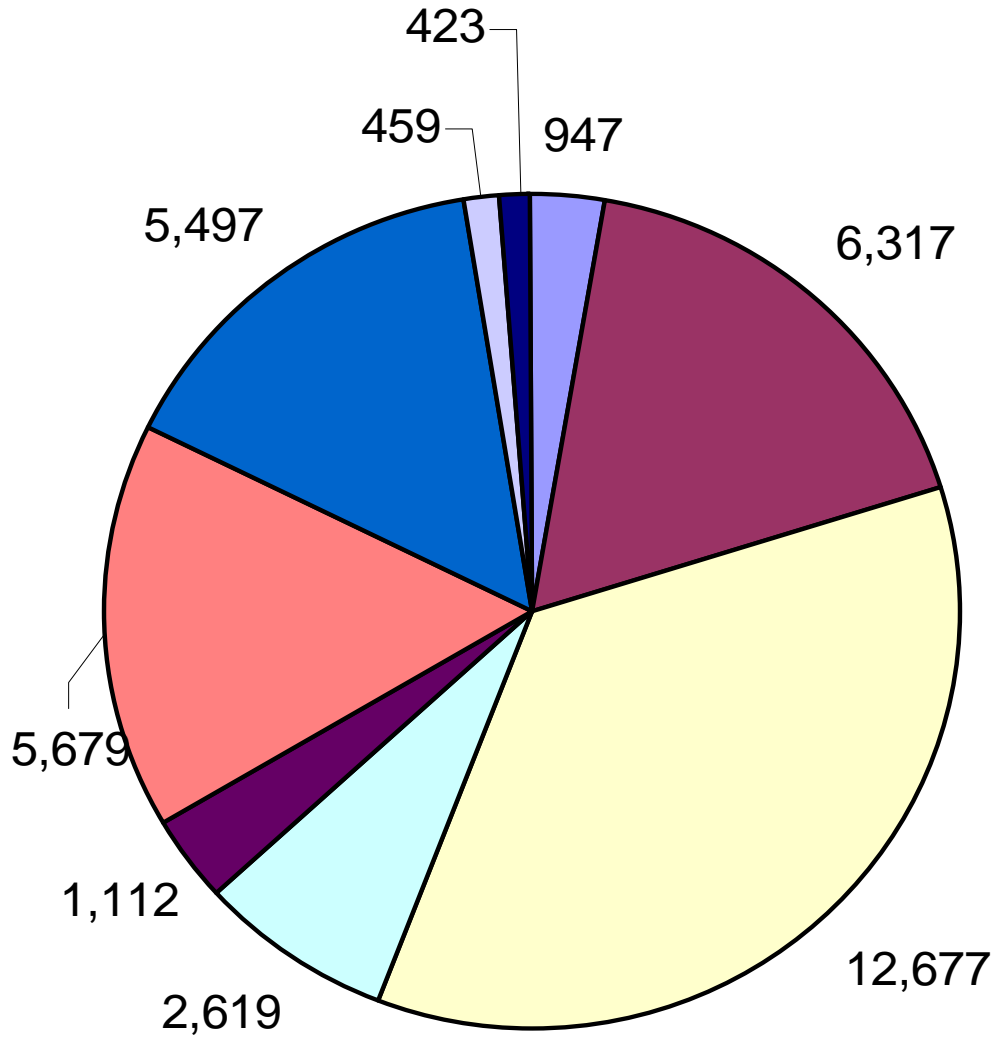
Superior Court Trials Completed



Active Pending Criminal Case Inventory

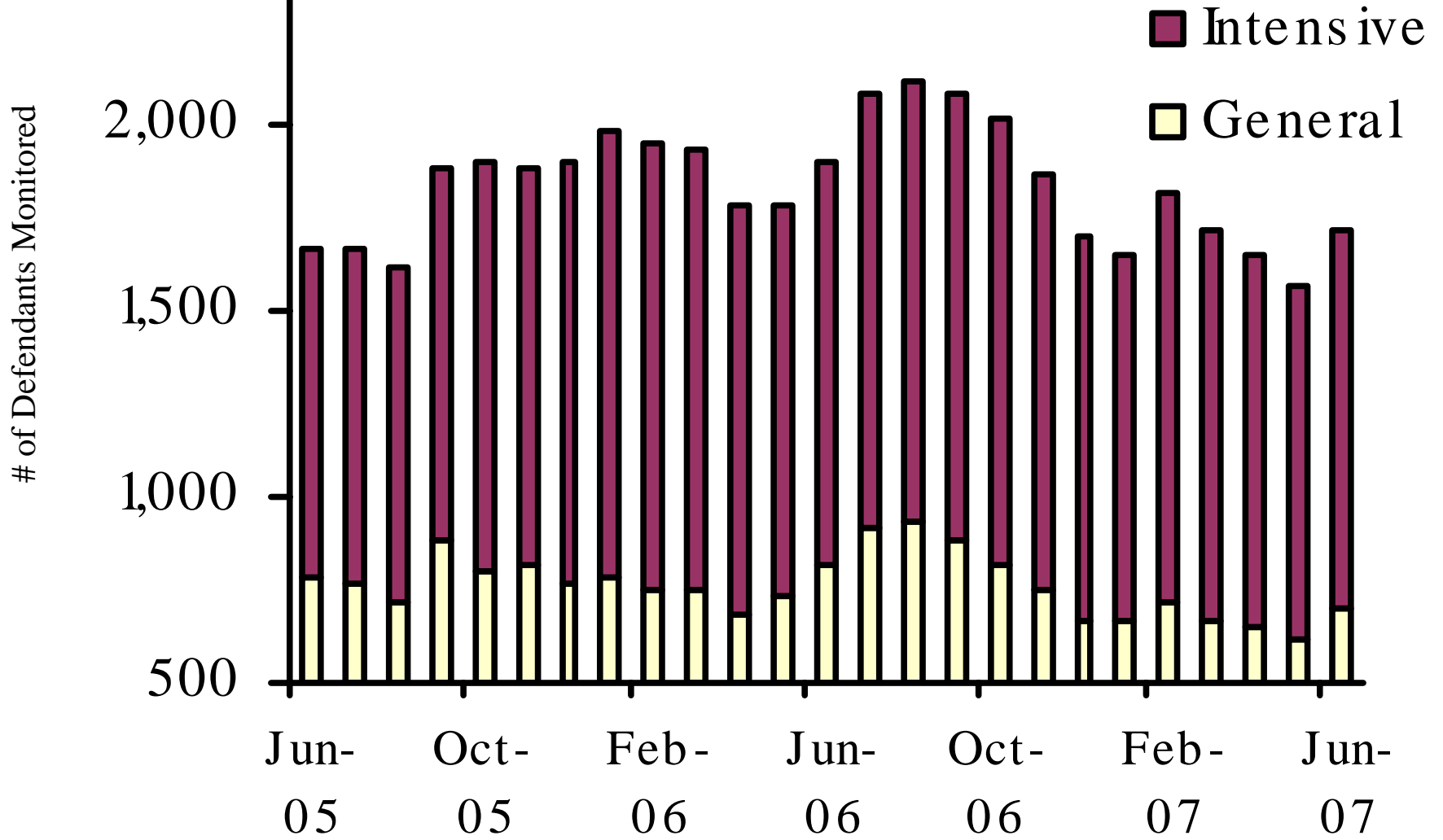

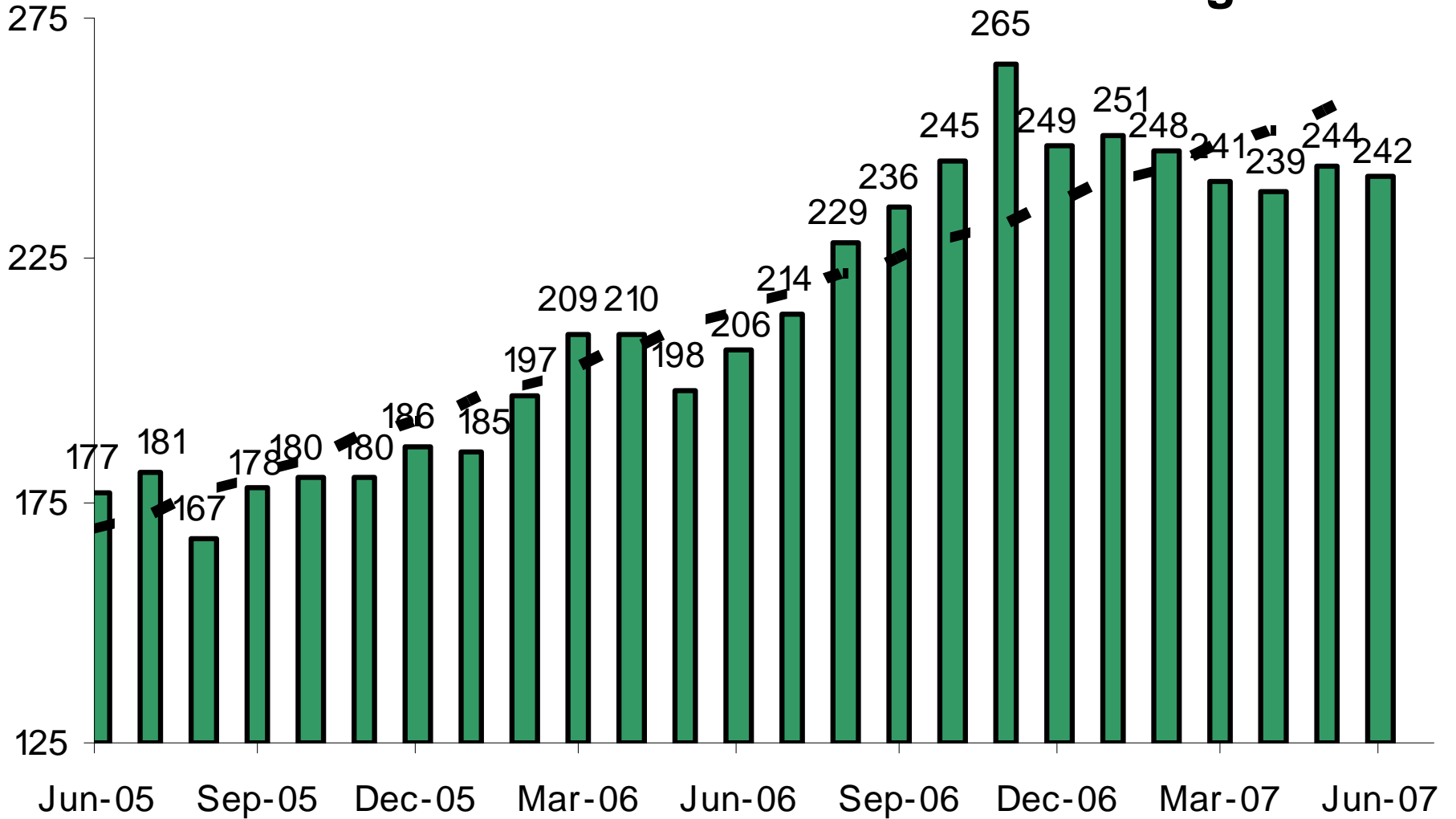

Pretrial Supervision Defendant Monitoring Unit



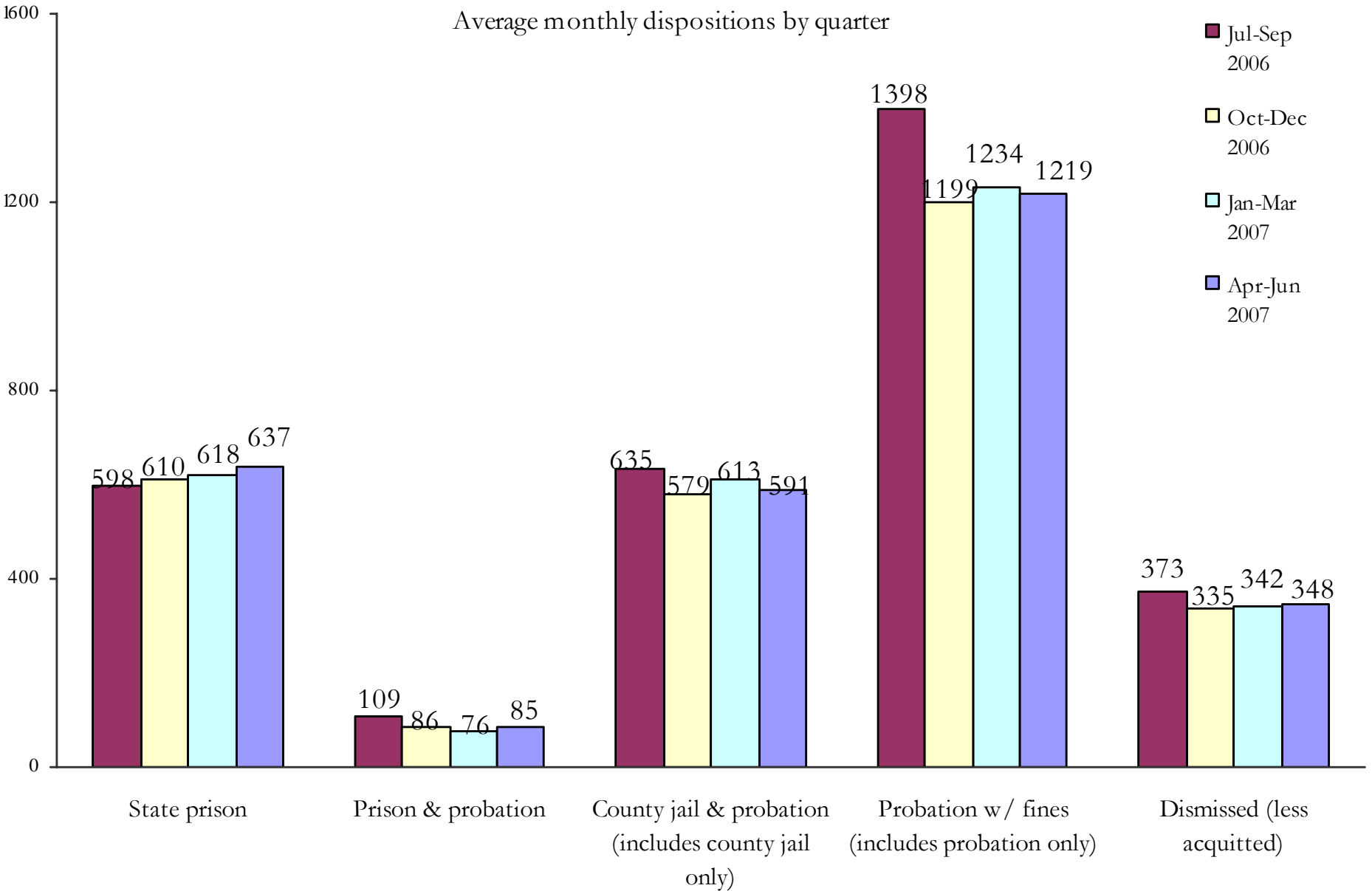
Pretrial Supervision Defendants on Electronic Monitoring



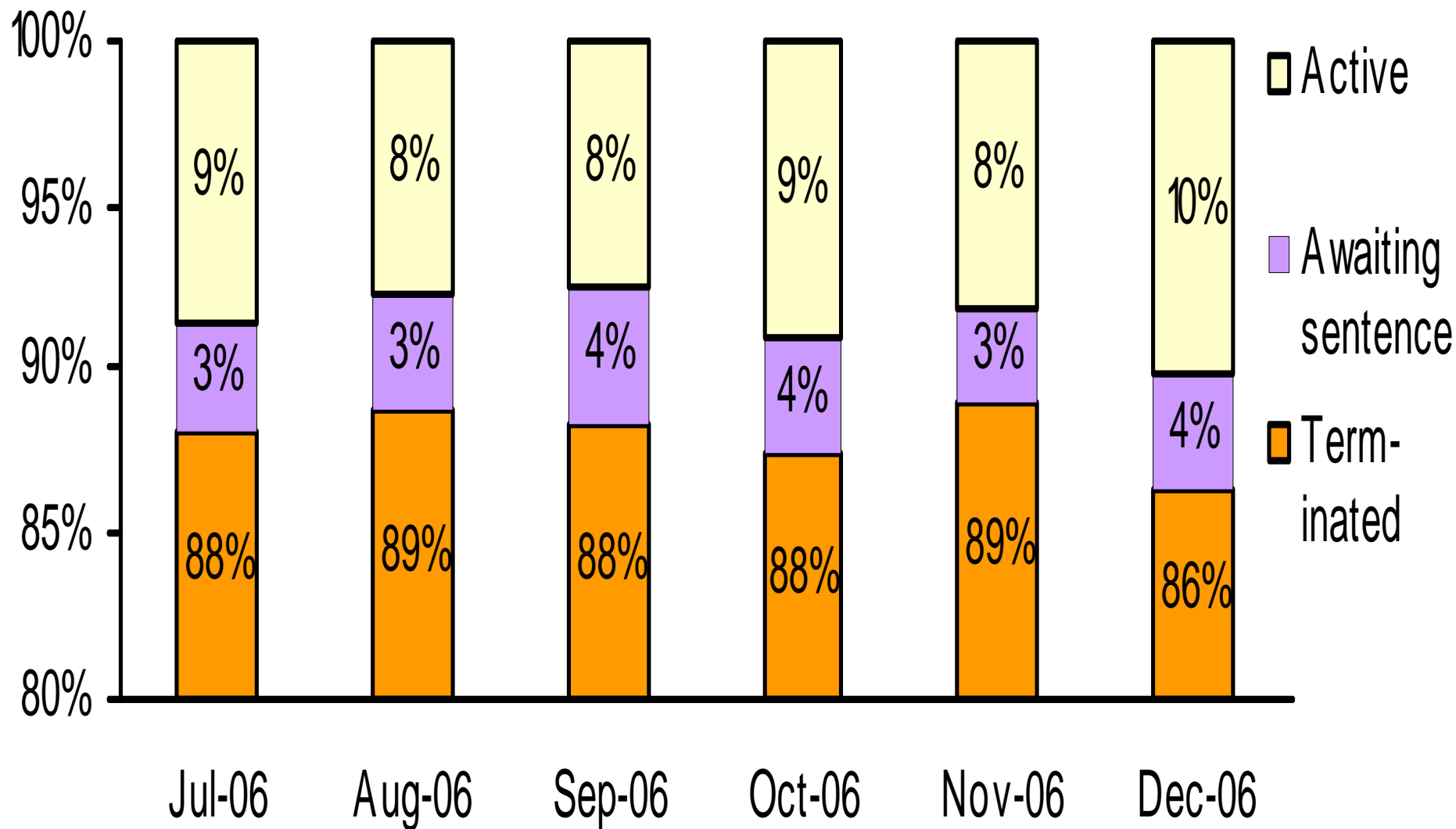
Disposition of Cases Terminated

Average monthly dispositions by quarter

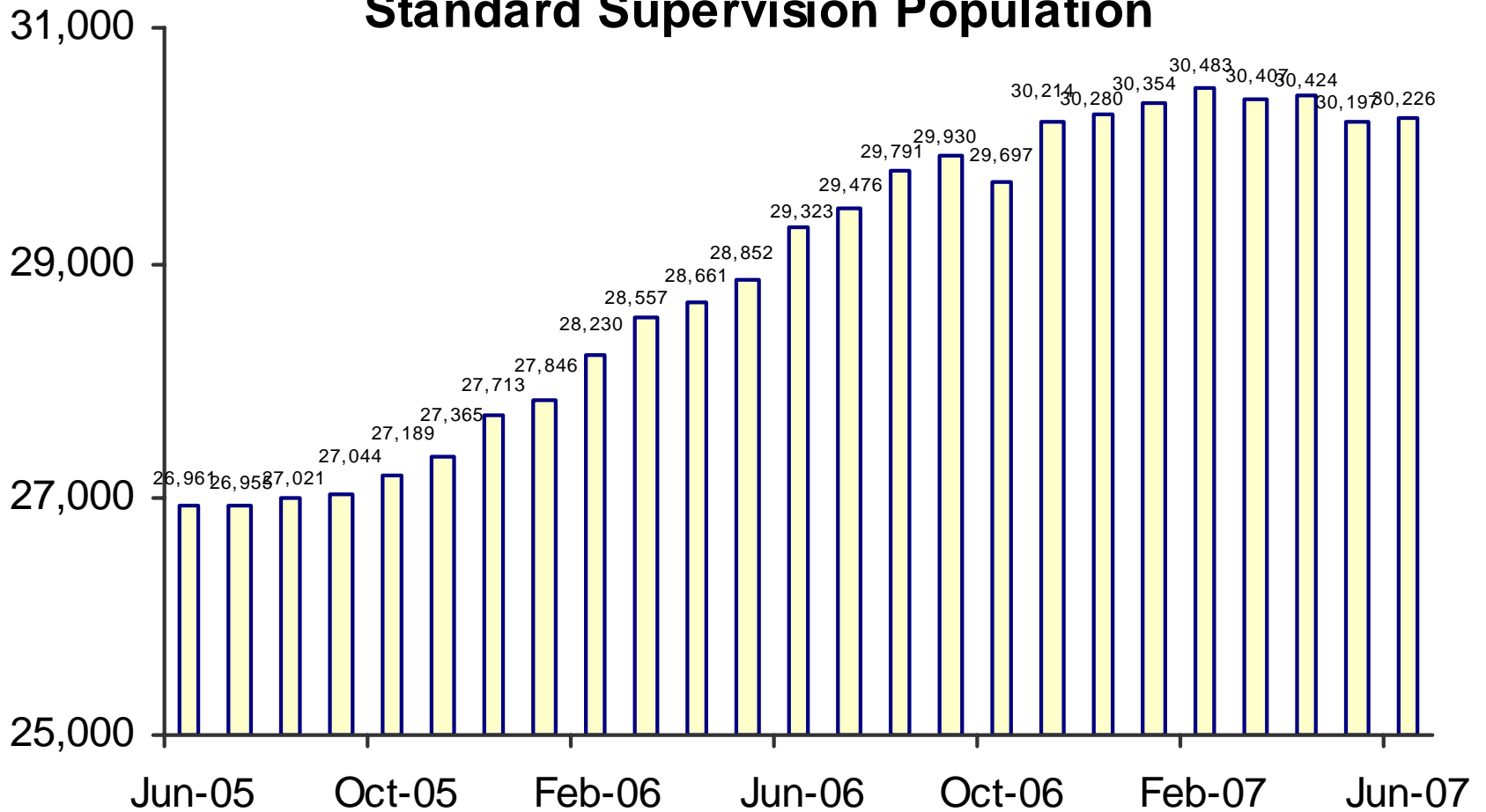

Status of Cases After 180 Days

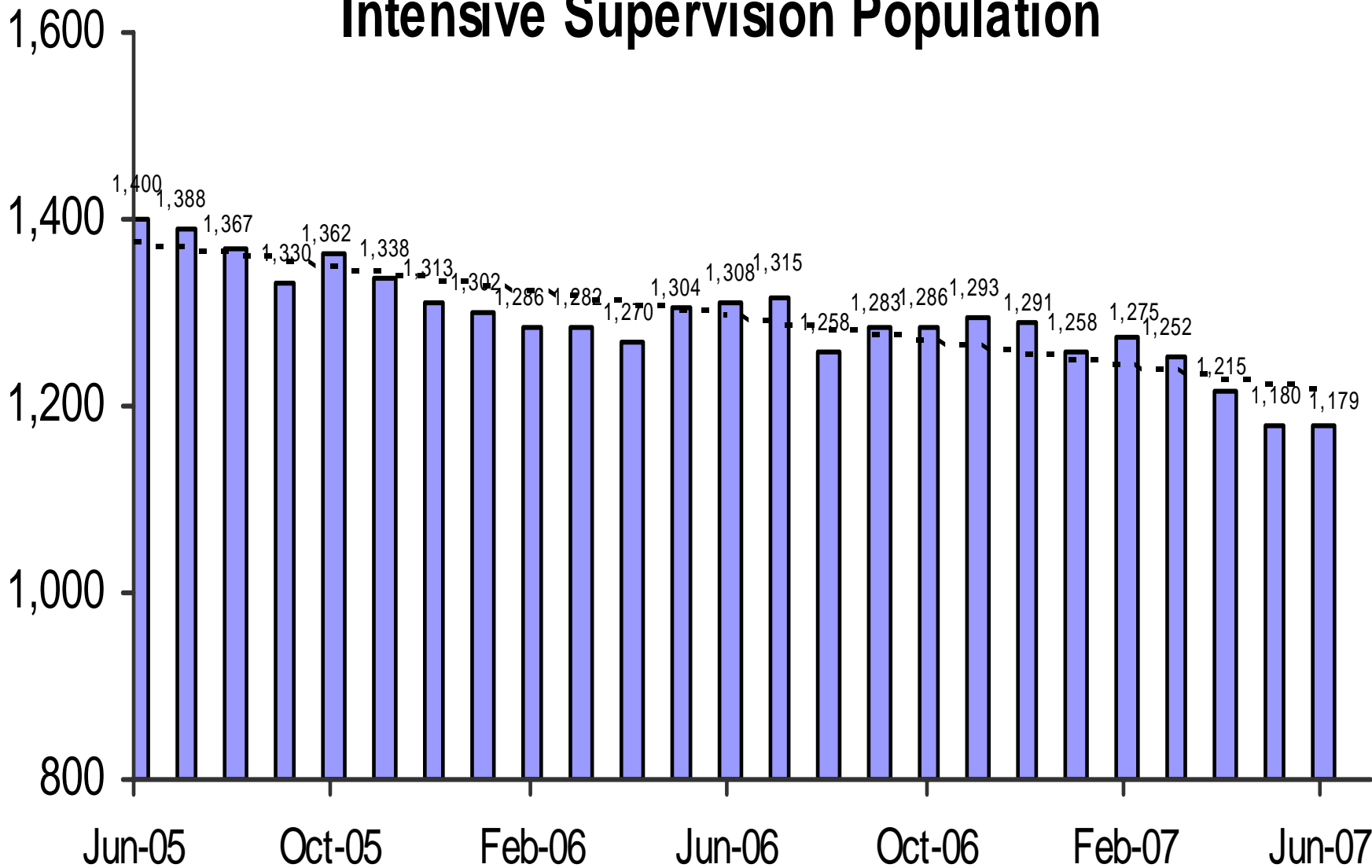


Adult Probation Standard Supervision Population

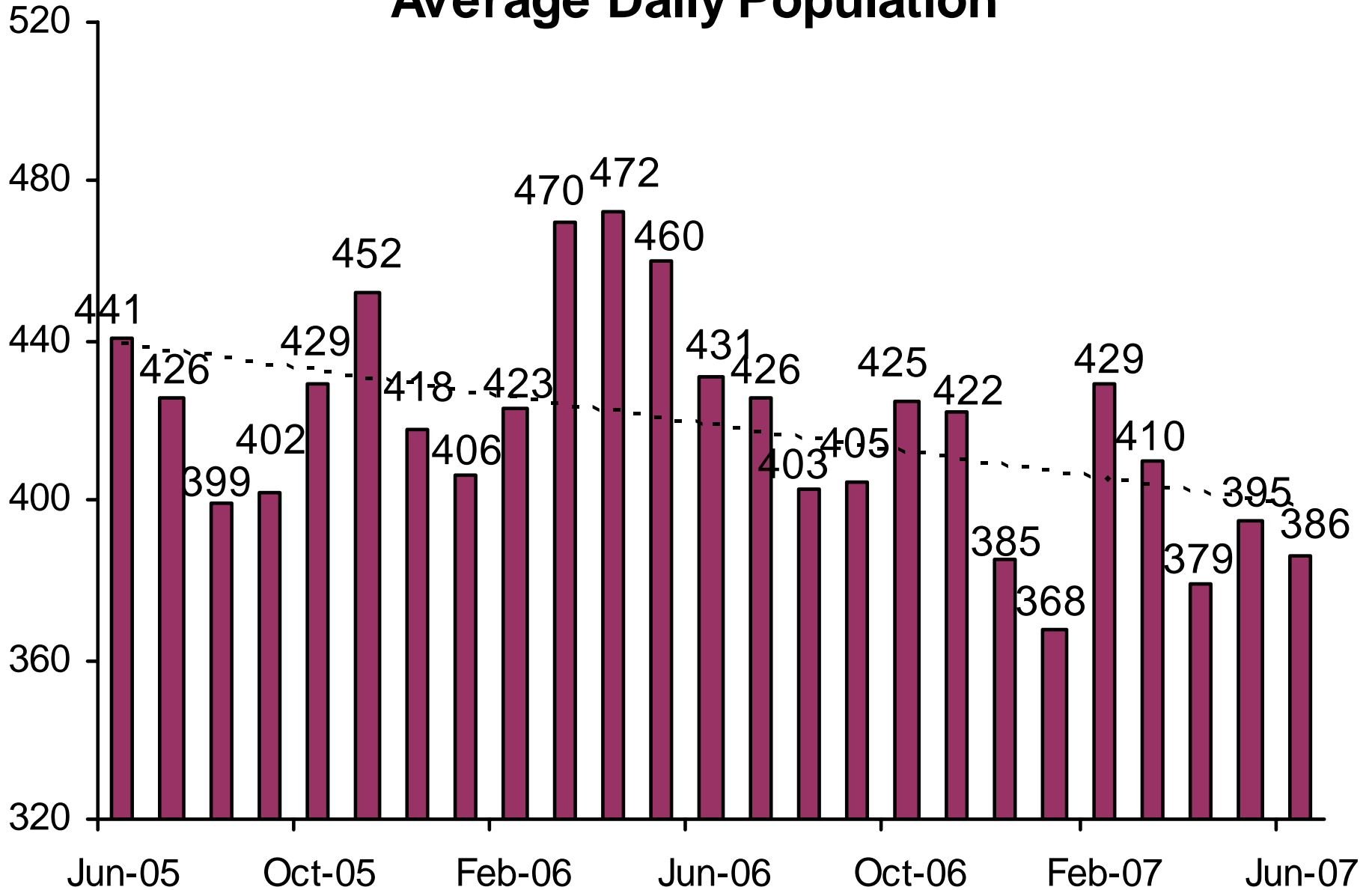

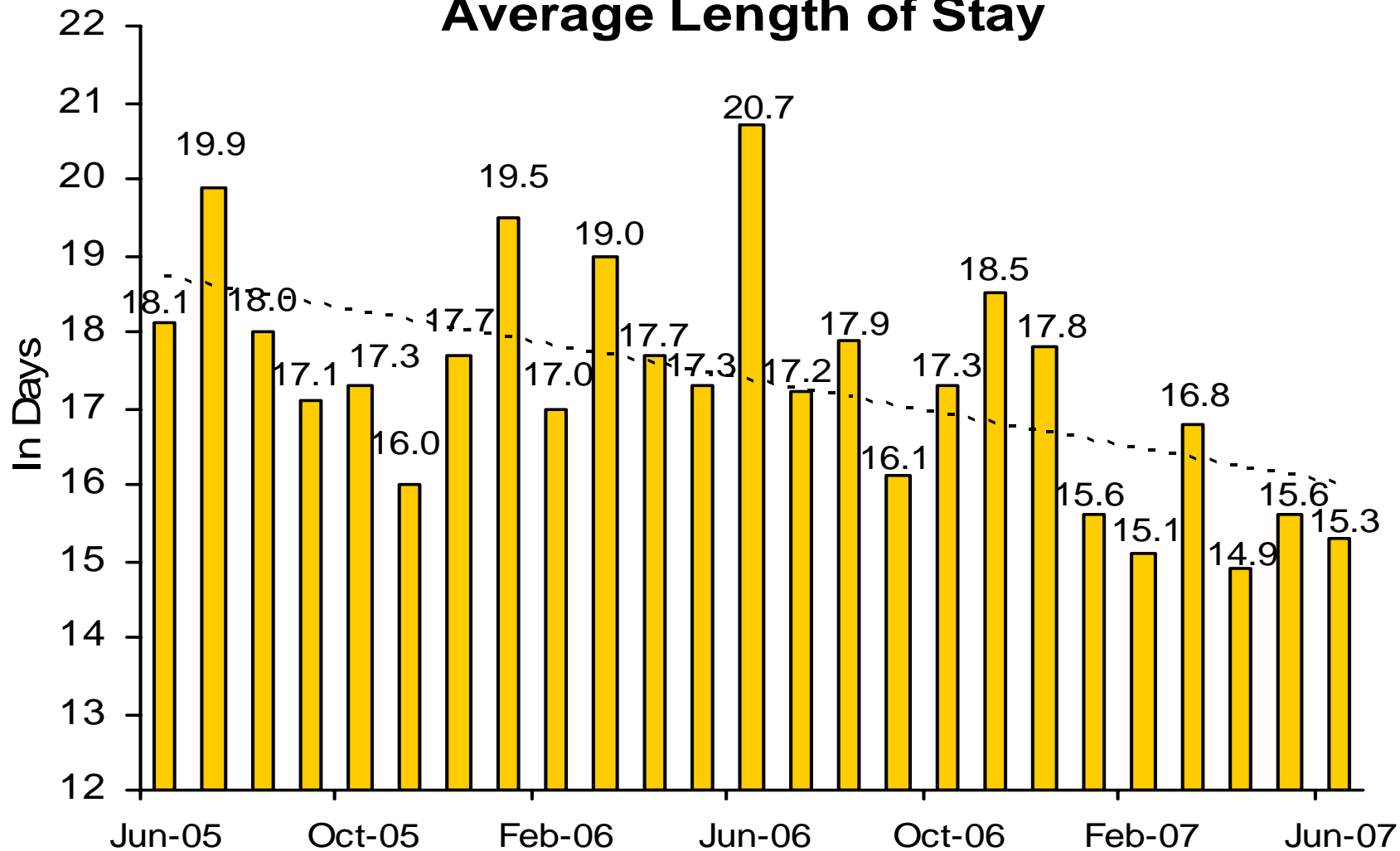
Adult Probation Intensive Supervision Population



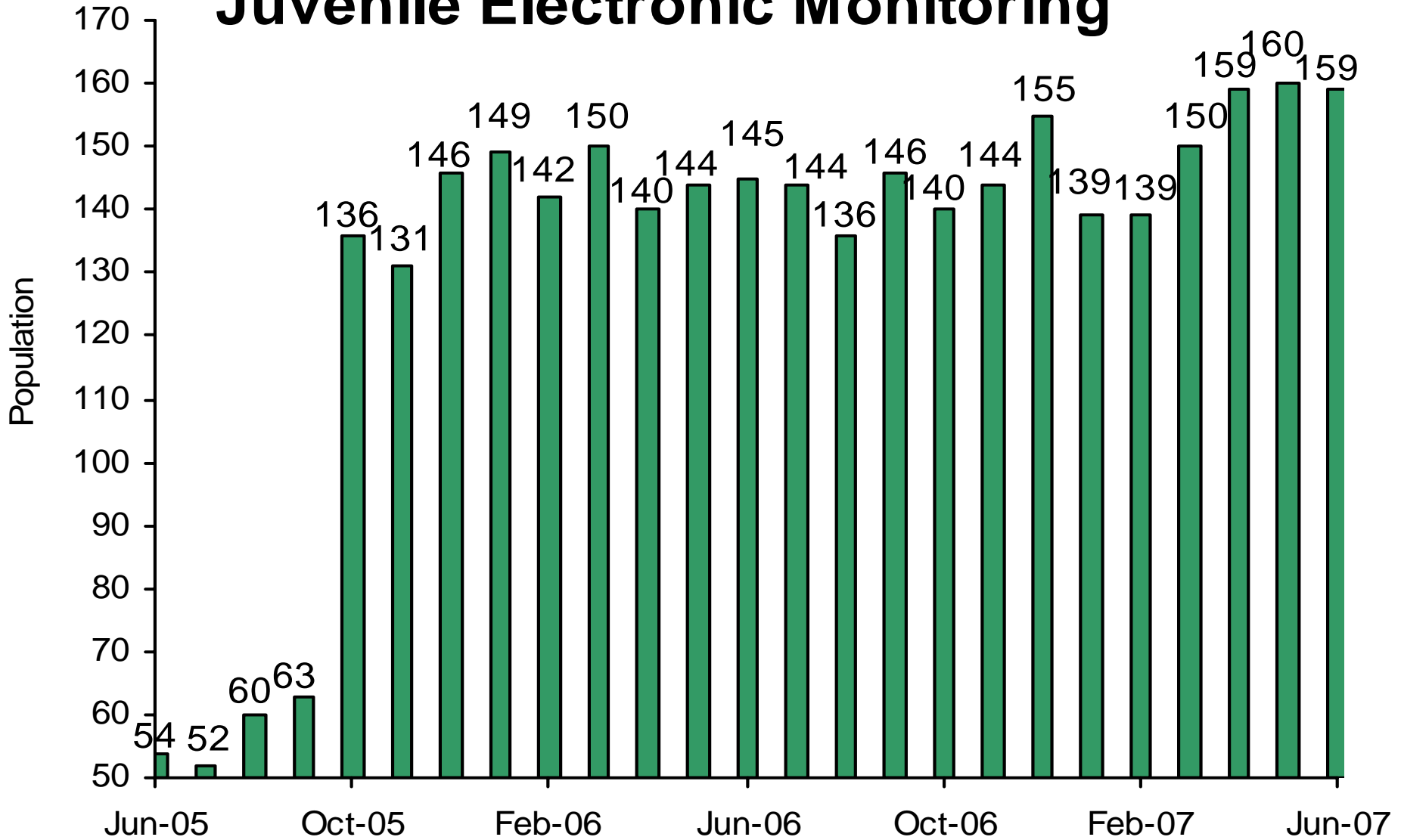
Juvenile Detention Average Daily Population



Juvenile Detention Average Length of Stay

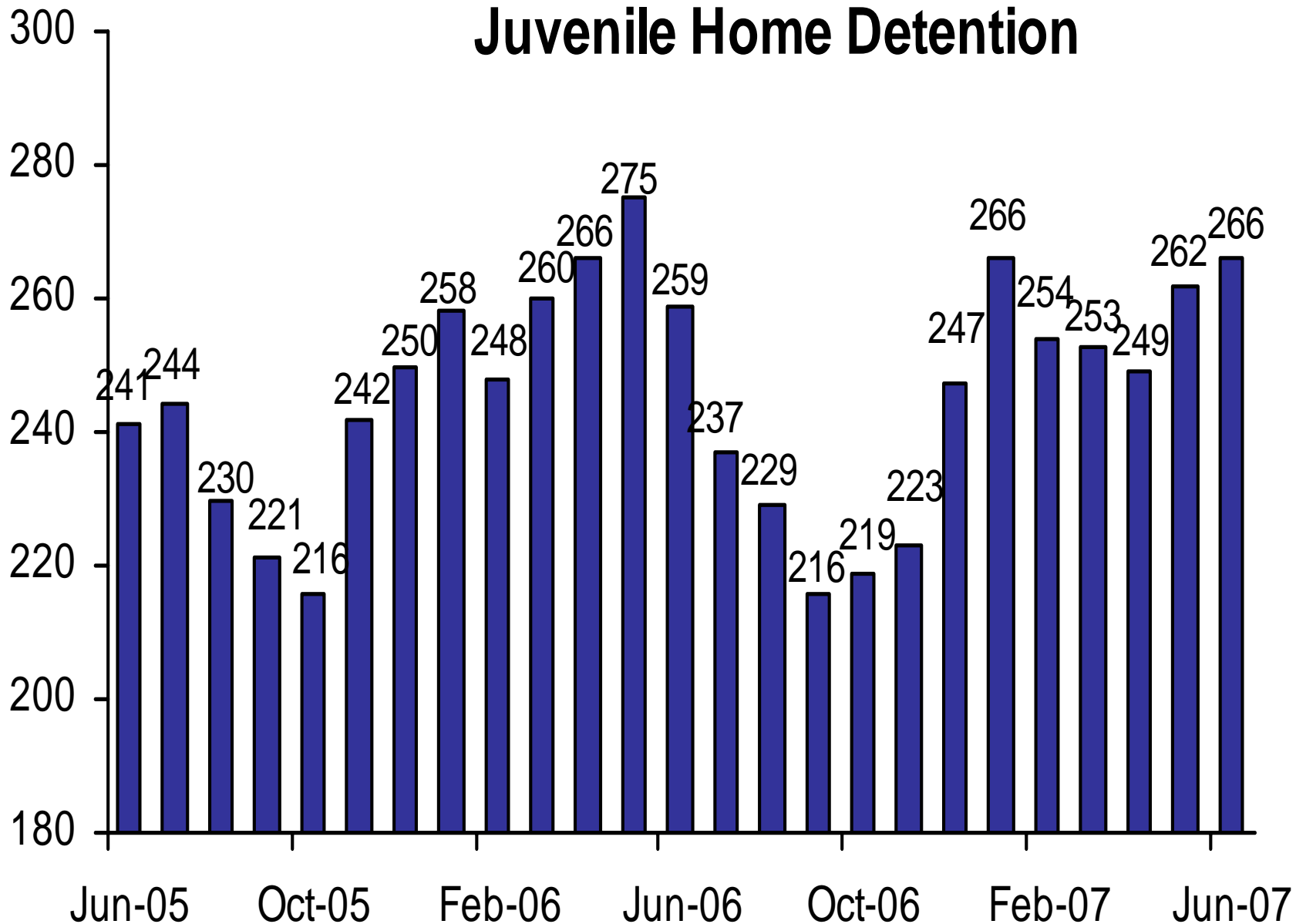


Juvenile Electronic Monitoring
